Mall based clinic adds heart, women and child care centers in Bacoor branch

Bacoor, Cavite – Patients in and near Cavite needing heart, child and women care need not travel far as Wellpoint Medical Clinic and Diagnostic Center, Inc. (Wellpoint) added these services in their SM Bacoor branch.

This piece of great news was shared by president/Chief Executive Officer and Medical Director, Dr. Mary Melodie Patos-Abram as she briefs the media on the developments about their clinic on Wednesday.

The medical director, with her next in line Dr. Arlyn Sanchez-Garduque and General Manger John Henry Patos, have been doing the rounds to provide medical and dental services to the poor and the marginalized sector. Together with Wellpoint's team of board certified specialty physicians, experienced staff and well-equipped diagnostic facility, their mission is not just in Cavite nor Region IV-A (covering Cavite, Laguna, Rizal, Batangas, Quezon)

but countrywide. "This is our way of giving back and for more people to experience our services," she added. Other than the newly opened centers and foundation, other projects in the pipeline include more renovation, their own patient app and an improved website. Asked for any plans to have its in-patient facility, Abram said "in the near future." New dredging equipment to improve desilting of dams in Bacoor City

BACOR CITY, Cavite (PIA) – The National Irrigation Administration recently turned over dredging equipment to the City Government of Bacoor to help boost the dredging and desilting operations in Molino Dam and other existing dams in Cavite province

City Mayor Strike Revilla, together with Senator Mark Villar and National Irrigation Administration (NIA) Regional Manager Wilson Lopez led the turn-over ceremony for one unit of long-reach excavator with one unit of pontoon equipment.

Villar highlighted the significance of the equipment in facilitating year-round dredging and desilting operations for the Bacoor-Las Piñas river clean-up and control. "Nagbunga po yung pag lobby natin para magkaroon tayo ng pondo para makabili ng ganitong equipment na malaki ang maitutulong sa paglilinis ng ating ilog at ng Molino Dam. Matagal na po itong advocacy ng aming pamilya na pangalagaan ang ating mga ilog, kalikasan, at agrikultura kaya naman masaya kami na naisakatuparan ang proyekto na ito," Senator Villar stated.

Citing the importance of dredging operations, NIA Regional Manager Lopez said the new equipment will help address the problems with siltation and improve flood control in the city due to an increase in the dam's water storage capacity.

"The successful acquisition and delivery of this cutting-edge equipment proves the importance of inter-agency coordination in addressing pressing challenges in agriculture and the environment. This milestone marks a significant stride towards the preservation and sustainable development of the province's water resources," Lopez said.

Revilla emphasized the

unity and cooperation in achieving common goal.

He also revealed plans to further enhance the dam area, transforming it into a potential eco-tourism site that would create additional opportunities and livelihood for Bacooreños. 458 Cavite barangays now drug-cleared

TRECE MARTIRES CITY (PIA) – The Cavite Provincial Police Office (PPO) reported that a total of 458 barangays in Cavite are now considered "drug-cleared" as no drug-related

activities were reported. Cavite PPO Provincial Director Col. Christopher Olazo confirmed in an interview with the media that out of 829 barangays that were declared drug-affected, 725 are classified as slightly affected, 101 are moderately affected, and one is seriously affected.

These classifications are based on drug-related activities observed and reported in the barangays.

The slightly affected barangays have a few residents who use illegal drugs, whereas the more affected barangays have clandestine drug laboratories, warehouses, marijuana plantations, and drug dens.

The Cavite PPO also reported that 16 barangays in Cavite province are active participants in the community mobilization program to fight against drug-related activities, while 17 were declared drug-free from September 20, 2022, until April 20, 2023.

Cavite PPO records showed that 4,226 anti-drug operations were conducted since September 2022, resulting in 2,608 drug-related arrests. **(Ruel Francisco/with reports from Cavite PPO)**

Kinatawan ng 840 na mga atleta, nakakolekta ang Pilipinas ng 58 ginto, 85 pilak at 117 tansong medalya para tumapos sa ikalima sa likod ng Vietnam (136-105-118), Thailand (108-96-108), Indonesia (87-80-109) at Cambodia (81-74-127). "It was really a strong performance," said Tolentino during Tuesday's Philippine Sportswriters Association (PSA) Forum at the Rizal Memorial Sports Complex. Nalampasan ng Pilipinas ang

medal na 52-70-104 sa Vietnam noong nakaraang taon, ngunit nabigo itong mapanatili ang pang-apat na puwesto. Binanggit ni Tolentino na 40 sa 87 silver medals na napanalunan ng mga Filipino athletes ay nagmula sa subjective sports kung saan ang resulta ay nasa kamay ng mga hurado. Conservatively, (we lost) 20 golds," he said during the forum presented by San Miguel Corporation, MILO, Philippine Sports Commission, POC, and the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

DOST 1 meets with Local Chief Executive, sets sights on transforming

ALAMINOS, CITY- The Department of Science and Technology Region 1, through OIC-RD Teresita A. Tabaog and Provincial Director Arnold C. Santos with their team, were warmly welcomed by the City of Alaminos through Mayor Arth Bryan C. Celeste and his staff on May 19, 2023. The visit aims to harness partnership in the implementation of the various programs, projects and activities (PPAs) of DOST 1 in the locality and serve as an venue to explore on the possible support of the agency to the city's goal of transforming into a Smart and Sustainable Community with focus on economic development, disaster preparedness, agriculture, tourism and improve living conditions for its residents with the aid of science, technology and innovation (STI). and sought their assistance with community-developed inventions to be promoted and utilized. He urged the team to have good communication and coordination as he foresees that the city could benefit a lot from the numerous PPAs that the agency offers. "Malaking tulong itong mga [DOST PPAs] sa amin. Let's have a good communication and coordination," he remarked. During her visit, OIC-RD Tabaog also met with local officials namely, Atty. Walter M. Macaiba, City Administrator and Mr. Eduardo A. Garcia, City Planning and Development Coordinator to discuss how STI could be leveraged to address their specific needs on salt iodization and bamboo industry. She also toured the Hundred Islands E-Kawayan Factory through the assistance of Mr. Jaime C. Navarro, Senior Administrative Assistant II, to identify other opportunities for collaboration and partnership. The visit of OIC-RD Tabaog with her team truly highlights the great role of DOST 1 in leading, directing and guiding the local communities towards a holistic development. She expressed optimism about the future of Alaminos City and its potential to become a hub of science, technology and innovation. OIC-RD Tabaog encouraged the local officials to work closely with her office to develop programs and initiatives that could drive progress and growth. With the agency's initiatives, and the full cooperation of the local government unit, the City of Alaminos may soon become a model of a Smart and Sustainable Community.

DOST, Congressman Flores ink partnership to launch project on Pineapple Fiber Extraction in Lantapan

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) and Representative Jonathan Keith Flores of the 2nd Congressional District of Bukidnon ink a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for a project on pineapple fiber extraction in Lantapan, Bukidnon. This collaborative project is envisioned to help minimize the waste management costs of the local growers, process quality pineapple fiber, generate employment, and create opportunity for additional income to the beneficiaries. The Pineapple Fiber Extraction project is a result of technology needs assessment conducted by DOST Bukidnon with a community in Lantapan. This led to the collaboration of establishing a dedicated facility equipped with specialized machinery. The project involves the processing of 45 tons of pineapple waste. This waste primarily consists of pineapple leaves that are typically discarded after the fruit is harvested. Instead of being treated as waste, the project aims to extract valuable fibers from these pineapple leaves. The project's target beneficiaries are the sixty-one (61) livelihood members of the cooperative and local pineapple growers in Lantapan, Bukidnon. These individuals will directly benefit from the initiatives and activities of the project, particularly in terms of income generation. The extracted fibers may be used in various purposes, such as but not limited to textiles, handicrafts, furnishings, accessories, and eco-friendly packaging materials. DOST through its Community Empowerment through Science and Technology (CEST) program has allocated funding to mobilize capacity building activities and acquire equipment such as a multi fiber decorticating

machine, fiber brusher/spindle machine, and hydraulic presser to extract pineapple fiber. Aside from the provision of technology, DOST will also provide training for fiber extraction, equipment utilization, and maintenance for standard implementation of the extraction process, ensuring that the fibers extracted are of consistent quality. The MOA signing was conducted in Malaybalay City on May 2, 2023. During the MOA signing, congressman Flores expressed his thanks to DOST for the science and technology-based interventions. "Atong pagpasalamat sa coordination with DOST kay sila pud ang nag step up nga nag provide ani na makina. I hope na kaning inyung grupo, mao lang ang sugod sa atong mga beneficiaries na matagaan ug access to this type of projects in partnership with the DOST para makita pud sa uban unsa ka successful ang inyung gibuhit hinaot unta ma replicate pud para mas daghan pa na komunidad ang magbenefit ani na programa", he said. He emphasized that it's important for this project to be successful so it can be replicated to other parts of the province and thus give benefits to more people. Also present during the event are the target beneficiaries, Lantapan pineapple growers, DOST Bukidnon Provincial Director Ritchie Mae L. Guno, and the legislative staff of the Bukidnon Satellite Office of Congressman Flores. This project promotes innovation in the utilization of natural and renewable resources. It aligns with the DOST's broader goals and CEST Program's objective in achieving environmental conservation, promoting sustainable development, and addressing the challenges posed by climate change. 628 Subanen learners benefit from DOST's S&T Digital library

Six hundred twenty-eight Subanen learners from Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA) in Concepcion, Misamis Occidental are now actively using STARBOOKS, the country's first S&T digitized library, in seven public schools. After six months of deployment, teachers have observed significant improvement in learners' competence. The beneficiary schools are Concepcion National High School, Malvar Elementary School, Migubay Elementary School, Balongkot Elementary School, Debaloy Elementary School, Concepcion Central School, and San and Francisco Elementary School. "In the few months of using this offline teaching tool, we have noticed great results on the side of our learners through their actions and the way they respond to given commands and directions during classes. They are now much more eager to come to school compared to those last times when the said scientific referencing tool hasn't yet been installed. They become more attentive, energetic, and participative in class if the STARBOOKS is the teaching tool to use during discussions", said Ms. Winilyn C. Magdusa,

San Francisco Elementary School. Learners can now explore and learn science and technology in a more comprehensible and enjoyable way amid their isolated geographical location since its installation on September 16, 2022. Moreover, teachers expressed gratitude to DOST-10 for the assistance as it helped them in delivering their classroom lectures innovatively. "It revolutionized my teaching strategies to the extent that I can explore and connect my subject to interdisciplinary schemes, and for the scientific referencing tool", said Jamael Marohombsar, Debaloy Elementary School. STARBOOKS is a Science Digital Library developed by the Science and Technology Information Institute of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST-STII) to make S&T information accessible and available to the public, especially those without access to the Internet. With STARBOOKS installed, learners in these seven GIDA schools can now easily access thousands of digitized science and technology resources. BSP to cardholders: Avoid 'sangla-ATM' scheme

QUEZON CITY, (PIA) -- The Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) advises cardholders to refrain from participating in "sangla-ATM" schemes which require them to use their ATM cards and personal identification number (PIN) as collateral for loans. According to BSP, the "sangla-ATM" scheme may lead to financial troubles for cardholders as it may be difficult for them to monitor withdrawals made by people to whom the ATM card and PIN were given. Creditors may also withdraw amounts higher than the cardholders' debt. This advisory is issued in line with the BSP's continuing program to guide Filipinos on safe and proper ways to handle money, credit, and savings

through financial education and personal finance management lessons. Likewise, BSP advises borrowers to understand the terms and conditions of loan agreements to protect themselves against unreasonable demands. For information on microfinance, personal, and other small loan facilities, the public is encouraged to directly inquire with banks and other BSP-supervised financial institutions, such as pawnshops, money service businesses, electronic money issuers, and non-stock savings and loan associations. Being the government's chief communications arm, our mandate is to help create an enlightened citizenry empowered to make informed decisions," she said.

Arzadon hopes that through this partnership, the DENR will be able to realize its goal of helping communities conserve, manage, and utilize the country's natural resources.

maka-adapt dun sa bagong pamamaraan at teknolohiya." Tamoria is hopeful that the partnership would bear more collaboration among government agencies to attain a common goal.
