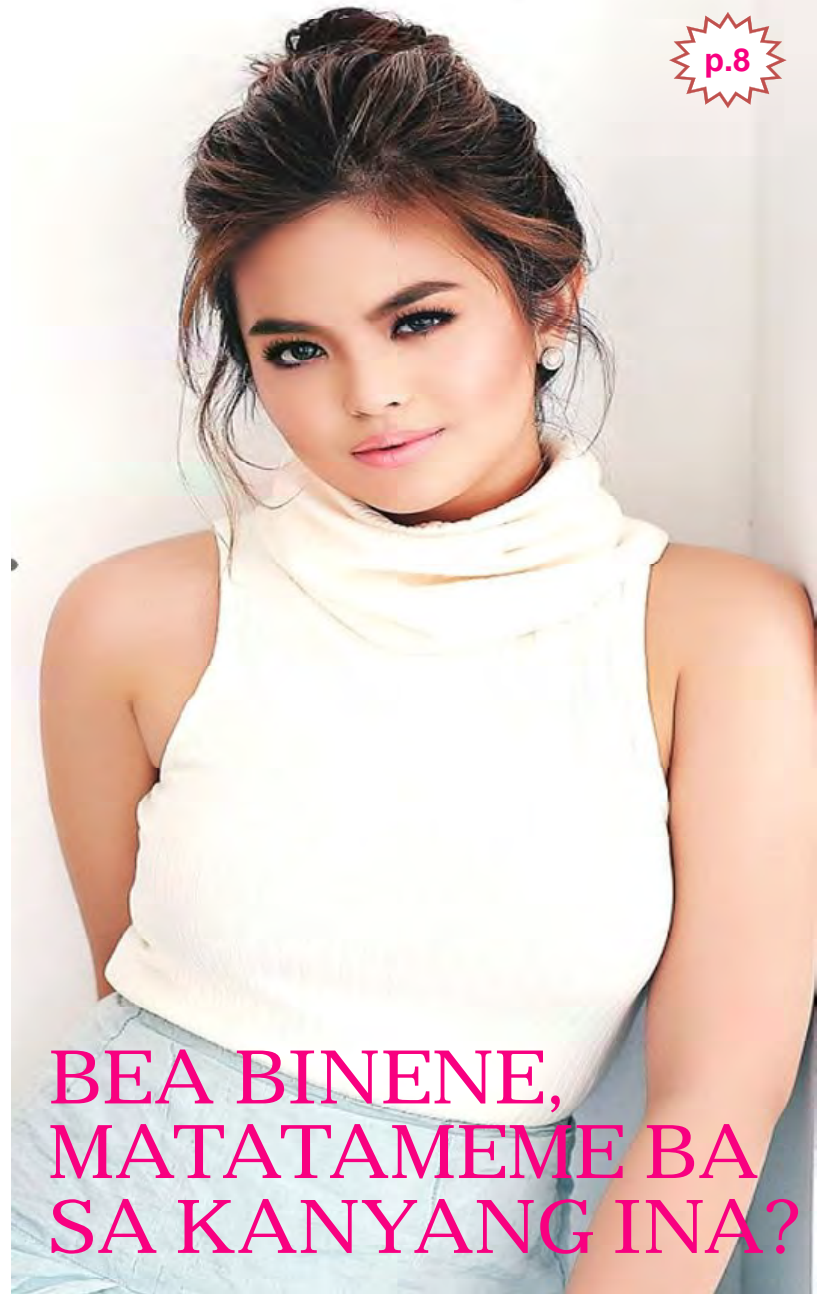

Dagdag pa ni Legaspi na ayon sa pakikipag-usap nito sa principal ng eskuwelahan ay mayroon na rin umanong estudyanteng nahulian ng hinihinalang marijuana sa loob ng paaralan.

Cavite town mayor urges contractor to speed up vital bridge project

NOVELETA, Cavite – Noveleta Mayor Dino Reyes Chua on Thursday urged the contractor of the Magdiwang Bridge, a vital link connecting this town to Cavite City and the towns of Kawit, Rosario and Tanza, to speed up the construction to ease the monstrous traffic in the area.

The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) closed the Magdiwang Bridge on Jan. 22, 2018 for major repair and rehabilitation. It was supposed to be finished in 90 days from Jan. 22.

The 70-day delay of the bridge project, causing traffic jams in the area during rush hours, has caught the attention of the mayor and the municipal engineering office.

"Umaasa ho ako na matatapos po nila ang construction as soon as possible para bumalik sa normal ang daloy ng trapiko sa aming lugar (I hope that they (contractor of the Department of Public Works and Highways) would complete the construction as soon as possible so the flow of traffic in our place would be back to normal)," Chua said.

The mayor and the municipal engineering office have been closely monitoring the construction of Magdiwang Bridge, following complaints from motorists and constituents

that reached his office, on a daily basis.

Chua is coordinating from time to time with the contractor, Hexmind Construction, to monitor the speed of construction of the bridge, after the 70-day delay.

The mayor admitted he has been appeasing constituents who have lodged complaints at the town hall over the inconvenience and clarified that the bridge project is not being undertaken by the local government but by the DPWH, costing some PHP 31,032,842 as posted in the construction site billboard.

Since the bridge's closure, Noveleta Traffic Management Bureau chief Ricky Saria has provided traffic re-routing advisories to the riding public and townfolk as they guide motorists and commuters to the alternate routes towards Barangay San Jose and Barangay Santa Rosa in this town.

"Kami rin naman sa barangay, napupurwisyo din dahil sa mga dumadaang mga malalaking sasakyan at ingay dahil sa pansamantalang route diversion dito (we in the barangay are also inconvenienced by the passage of big vehicles and trucks and the noise in the temporary route diversion)," a visibly irked villager said. **(Dennis Abrina/PNA)**

DOE Pushes More Safety Measures in the RE Sector

CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY – The Department of Energy (DOE), today held a public consultation in its bid to enforce operational safety and security in the renewable energy (RE) sector. Led by the Renewable Energy Management Bureau (REMB), the public consultation focused on the draft Renewable Energy Safety, Health and Environment Rules and Regulations (RESHERR) Code of Practice.

The event aimed to inform the RE developers on the "E-Safety" tenet of the DOE's E-Power Mo campaign, and to solicit their inputs on the RESHERR draft. About 20 RE developers from Mindanao participated in the public consultation.

Earlier, Energy Secretary Alfonso G. Cusi said that part of the DOE's push for energy diversification and

resiliency is the promotion of additional RE in the country's energy mix. "We are doing everything we can to empower Filipino consumers by giving them access to renewable energy development," said Cusi. In pursuing this policy, he stressed that it should take into consideration the factors of safety and cost effectiveness for the consumers.

The RESHERR Code of Practice will set internal and external operational safety guidelines for all RE facilities. In addition, it also contains provisions addressing environmental concerns, such as air, land and water pollution resulting from RE activities.

RE developers would likewise be able to use the code in conforming to the Energy Resiliency Compliance Plan, which would institutionalize national adap-

tive standards against human-induced and natural disasters.

Among the topics discussed during the consultation include the general safety guidelines, workplace safety monitoring and control, requirements needed for electrical work, demolitions, and the precautionary measures in dealing with hazardous, flammable and explosive materials.

The public consultation was sponsored by the United Nations Development Programme - Development for Renewable Energy Applications Mainstreaming and Market Sustainability (DREAMS) project.

The project was the

product of the partnership between the DOE and the Global Environment Facility-UNDP. Similar public consultations were earlier held in Cebu (6 June) and Manila (18 June).

The DOE continues to accept comments and suggestions on the RESHERR draft to ensure a more comprehensive policy issuance. Interested parties may email their inputs to mikko.real@yahoo.com on or before Thursday, 5 July 2018.

Widow of slain Cavite vice mayor breaks silence in FB post

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite – An emotional post by Gemma Lubigan, widow of slain Trece Martires City vice mayor Alexander C. Lubigan, broke her silence as she shared through social media on Thursday her sentiments and outburst over what she described as a brutal death that only a devil can perpetrate.

"Bakit ganun? Kinuha nila ang buhay mo sa ganayang paraan? NAPAK-ABRUTAL!!!! Gawain lang ito ng mga DEMONYO!!! (Why did they take your life in that very brutal way!!! Only the devil can do this!)"

Gemma initially turned down interviews and had her sister-in-law, Kristine Lubigan Lucero, act as the family spokesperson. She went public with her emotional post for the first time through her Facebook account, "Gem Lubigan".

Her husband was killed in an ambush by still unidentified suspects in front of the Korean-Philippines Friendship Hospital along Trece-Indang Road of Barangay Luciano here, shortly before 3:00 p.m. on July 7, 2018. The regional and provincial police, in previous statements, have both declared "politics" as one of the possible motives after initial investigation revealed the slain vice-mayor's intent to run for a mayoralty post when his third and last term as city vice mayor ends in 2019.

Gem, addresses the

post to "Daddy Bulek" her term of endearment to the slain vice mayor, as she admits being at a loss on what happened.

She shared her husband's political sacrifices since 2016, the hardships he endured and how her husband was ganged up while serving his term as vice-mayor without mentioning names.

She said her husband told her then to let everything pass, believing that in the end they'll see some gains and even quoted him as saying "hayaan na natin mommy, patawarin n(a) lang natin sila, basta tayo may peace of mind at masaya, kakayanin ko ang lahat (let it be, mommy, let's forgive them, as long as we have peace of mind and we're happy, I can handle everything)."

The wife and the couple's eldest daughter were on board another vehicle trailing the vice-mayor's black Hilux pick-up truck after spending fitness exercises during the ambush.

Gemma and her daughter personally witnessed how the suspects, who were on board a similar vehicle model but without license plates and conduction sticker, killed her husband.

A physical match of the suspects' vehicle was found abandoned along the Mabacao-Pantihan Bridge, Barangay Tulay B in Maragondon, Cavite at 6:55a.m.

Gemma hopes her husband's death will serve its purpose, that justice will be served and that "their corruption practices will end."

She adds that her husband's simple wish was to serve, as he had chosen the country over his family.

She even shared that during his last day, the vice mayor even told her that since he is fighting for a cause, God will guide and protect him.

"Akala mo bullet proof ka na sa sobrang faith mo kay LORD. Kawawa na ang TRECE, nakakatakot na sa Trece. Sana di na masundan ang ganitong trahedy. Sana hipuin ni LORD ang puso nila kung meron man

sila nito para maging mabuti n silang tao," (you thought you're bullet proof due to your faith to the Lord. I pity Trece, it has become a scary place, hopefully, this tragedy will end. May the Lord touch their hearts, if they have one, for them to become better persons).

Gemma is now also seeking the Lord's guidance to help the family get through the tragedy, to move forward without the head of the family, and to guide all agencies working together to immediately resolve the case.

As at this writing, the post has already generated more than 3,000 reactions and 900 shares. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

'PULIS NATIN CARAVAN' GOES TO CAVITE

BACOR CITY, Cavite – The Philippine National Police (PNP) in Cavite has partnered with the city government to bring its community relations program to the communities under the "Pulis Natin Caravan" (PCV) at the Strike Gymnasium here on Tuesday.

Cavite Police public information chief and spokesman Chief Inspector Chito Macaspac said the project of the Director of Police Community Relations Group (DPRG) is headed by Chief Supt. Rodel Sermonia to bring the various police services to the communities.

Macaspac said police frontliners set up designated desks "to accept citizen's complaint, women's and children's, including human rights concerns and cybercrime complaints".

Motorcycle verification and

clearances from its highway patrol group (HPG), and processing of license to own and possess firearms were also processed at the event.

Other services include security license processing, financial advice and issuance of official receipts, request for drug testing and macro-etching, conduct of Neuro Psychiatric Examination, free BP and BS, follow-up of cold cases and complaints plus free legal advice.

Bacoor City police chief, Supt. Vicente Cabatingan, who represented Cavite PPO Director Police Senior Supt. William M. Segun, led the PNP's contingent while the office of Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla was represented by City Councilor Alde Pagulayan. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

PhilHealth, Hospital and Medical Associations Agree on Major Issues

THE country's lead organizations of health care institutions and medical professionals have reached an accord with the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) to synergize efforts and ensure better implementation of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP).

Present during the meeting held at PhilHealth's Head Office in Pasig City last week were Acting PhilHealth President and Chief Executive Officer Dr. Roy B. Ferrer, Dr. Rustico Jimenez, President of the Private Hospitals Association of the Philippines, Inc (PHAPI), Dr. Jesus M. Jardin, Vice President for Mindanao of the Philippine Hospital Association (PHA) and Dr. Jose P. Santiago Jr., President of the Philippine Medical Association (PMA). Also present were Dr. Irene Florentiño Fariñas, Joyce Ann Ceria Pereña, and Dr. Anna Melissa Guerrero of the Department of Health's Pharmaceutical Division.

The medical associations agreed to implement the provisions of PhilHealth Circular 2018-0007 which introduces the Claim Form 4 for claims starting September 1. The form summarizes a patient's pertinent clinical information and eliminates the submission of complete clinical charts for all claims for reimbursement. PhilHealth earlier deferred the implementation of the said policy based on the request of the PHAPI.

The parties acknowledged the advantages of using the Claim Form 4 as it will ensure quality of care through a review of provider compliance to PhilHealth's policies and accepted medical practice. They also agreed on the new implementation date, noting that it will give them enough time to train their staff in using the said form.

During the meeting, PhilHealth also emphasized among the medical practitioners that only drugs and medicines that are listed in the latest edition of the Philippine National Formulary will be paid for. The clarification was made in light of concerns raised by the providers as a result of the deferment of

implementation of PC 2018-0007.

The PNF is a list of essential medicines prepared by the National Formulary Committee in consultation with experts and specialists from organized professional medical societies, medical academe and the pharmaceutical industry.

PhilHealth also advised providers that should they continue to prescribe and use drugs and medicines that are not listed in the PNF, they should directly coordinate with the DOH so that these medicines can be included in the PNF.

Addressing news reports that some hospitals are on the brink of closing down due to delayed reimbursements, PhilHealth bared its efforts to ensure speedy, yet accurate evaluation and processing of claims for medical reimbursement. These included the hiring of 206 encoders who were deployed to Regional Offices to help in the encoding of entries in claim forms. Some Regional Offices are also working overtime to cope with the influx of claim documents to review and process.

It has also continued to advocate among its accredited providers the use of electronic claims (eClaims) to enable them to submit the claim documents online. Various options to implement the eClaims were also provided to ensure immediate compliance.

The state-run health insurer is also pro-actively informing providers about the status of their claims through their official e-mail accounts. The email messages contain information on the status of claims paid, claims that are still for payment, claims that are pending, denied and returned to the providers. The initiative will facilitate the reconciliation of PhilHealth's records with those of its providers.

Ferrer appealed to PhilHealth's partner-providers to honor the agreements reached and to get in touch with him or his team for any other concerns, instead of using national media. **(END)**

GENERAL TRIAS CITY LAUNCHES URBAN GARDENING PROGRAM

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite – Amid the industrial 'boom' in this city, the city government is sprucing up to become an environment-friendly

and green city by encouraging residents to transform idle lots and backyards into urban gardens.

"Let us plant in our backyards and encourage others also in their open spaces in their respective areas," urged City Councilor Vivencio 'Pafo' Lozares, chair of the Committee on Agriculture of the Sangguniang Panglungsod (city legislative

council) during the launching of the "Urban Agriculture Practices" at the Barangay Pinagtipunan Demonstration Farm here.

"Sayang naman ang mga vacant spaces sa ating lugar, mas maganda po kung ito ay may mga tanim na maari nating magamit sa ating pagkain sa araw-araw (The vacant spaces here remain idle, so it is bet-

ter if we have these planted and harvest them later for our daily food requirements)," Lozares added.

City Mayor Antonio Ferrer, through the City Agriculture Office headed by City Agriculturist Nerie Marquez, conceptualized the urban gardening program not only for a greener environment but also to spare households from additional expenses on food ingredients.

At Tuesday's gathering at the demo farm, Marquez also encouraged homeowners to plant vegetables in their backyards and open spaces for greener environment and save money from buying basic cooking ingredients and condiments.

She said these are the easily grown variety in the garden like tomato, chili, okra, eggplant, 'tanglad' (lemon grass), and malunggay, among other vegetables.

Meanwhile, the Department of Education (DepEd)-GenTri schools division, through school superintendents Dr. Edna Bayot and Dr. Lorie Garcia, also launched their indigenous school farming or garden at the Sunny Brooke Elementary School in Barangay San Francisco.

The DepEd officials also encouraged school principals and teachers in the city's 33 barangays to teach their students to plant indigenous plants in their respective campuses.

Bayot said that the use of indigenous plants can address malnutrition among kids and school teachers are instrumental in teaching learners to integrate growing of vegetables and encourage parents to adopt the school's greening program.

According to the Food and Nutrition Research Institute (FNRI), the indigenous vegetables comprise the varieties that are native to a particular environment.

While these plants are usually abundant in rural spaces, these could be planted even on small plots or 'paso' (pots) in the urban areas like this city, which is still dotted with quite a number of open spaces and green patches where these vegetables could be grown.

School officials and homeowners said that even small amounts of consuming green, leafy and nutritious indigenous vegetables could ensure good health and prevent malnutrition among kids. **(Dennis Abrina/PNA)**

Philippines now has social security partnership with Germany, Japan

THE Philippines, with the Social Security System (SSS) taking the lead in its pursuit, now has bilateral Social Security Agreements (SSAs) with Germany and Japan effective June 01 and August 01 of this year, respectively, ensuring the protection of social security rights for more than 230,000 Filipinos abroad.

SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Emmanuel F. Dooc said that these bilateral SSAs, aimed at reducing or eliminating nationality- and territory-based restrictions on social security, will benefit an estimated 47,214 Filipinos in Germany and 182,917 Filipinos in Japan, who are working or residing permanently in these two countries.

SSAs promote the welfare of all persons covered under the social security programs of either or both countries for retirement, disability and death contingencies. Its guiding principles are embodied in the 1962 ILO Social Security Convention No. 118 on the Equality of Treatment and the 1982 ILO Social Security Convention No. 157 on the Maintenance of Social Security Rights. There are four salient features of an SSA namely: (1) equality of treatment, (2) export of benefits, (3) totalization of insurance periods, and (4) mutual administrative assistance.

"With the bilateral SSAs in place, Filipinos are now entitled to social security benefits under the same conditions applicable to nationals of Germany and Japan and we are looking forward to extend the same protection to more Filipinos working or residing abroad," said Dooc.

Covered persons and their beneficiaries, through the provision on export of benefits of the SSA, can receive their social security benefits regardless of whether they decide to reside in the Philippines, in Germany, in Japan, or even in another country.

The "totalization of insur-

ance period" allows the consolidation of contribution periods made in both countries for the benefit of a worker who fails to meet the minimum qualifying conditions for pension entitlement in either or both countries.

For example, under the Philippine Social Security Law, a member must have at least 120 monthly contributions to qualify for a retirement pension. Without the SSA, a member with only 100 monthly contributions will only receive a lump-sum amount consisting of total contributions paid plus interest.

"Without the totalization provision of the agreement, a member will not be entitled to a retirement pension if only 100 monthly contributions are paid. However, under the agreement, he or she may qualify for a retirement pension if at least 20 or more monthly contributions or creditable periods are made under the social security scheme of Germany or Japan," said Dooc.

Further, as designated liaison agencies, the bilateral SSAs will be implemented by the SSS and the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) for the Philippines, the Deutsche Rentenversicherung for Germany and Japan Pension Service for Japan, to facilitate mutual administrative assistance.

"The SSS, in collaboration with the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and other social security institutions, will continue to pursue SSAs with other countries to promote the welfare of overseas Filipinos and ensure social security protection in times of contingencies", said Dooc.

In total, the Philippines has 13 bilateral SSAs with Austria, UK and Northern Ireland, Spain, France, Canada, Quebec, Netherlands, Switzerland, Belgium, Denmark, Portugal, Germany and Japan covering more than 1.34 million OFWs.

Publishers, judges' groups back Marquez bid for SC justice post

MANILA – The Publishers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PAPI) has thrown its unequivocal support for the appointment of the Supreme Court administrator Jose Midas P. Marquez as associate justice of the high tribunal. PAPI is presently headed by Nelson Santos as president.

PAPI is the fifth organization to endorse Marquez following the announcement and letters of support by the Philippine Judges Association (PJA), Philippine Trial Judges League (PTJL), Metropolitan and City Judges Association of the Philippines (MetCJAP), and the Philippine Association of Court Employees (PACE) to the Judicial and Bar Council (JBC).

Juan P. Dayang, PAPI chairman emeritus, said their group's endorsement is an affirmation of their trust in Marquez's experience in the high court, and in appreciation for his abiding concern in protecting the welfare and survival of community newspapers, particularly in the publications of judicial and legal notices.

Dayang said "in many PAPI previous engagements on various concerns, including issues affecting the press, Marquez

has always been clear in his position relative to community journalists and the exercise of press freedom, something the media should also be proud of."

A former president of the Manila Overseas Press Club (MOPC), Dayang stressed that the court administrator's familiarity with the high tribunal and his supervisory function over lower court judges make him decidedly qualified to become a Supreme Court associate justice.

He also expressed regrets over the move of certain sectors that have raised opposition to Marquez for being short-listed by the JBC roster.

Recently, in an effort to derail Marquez's SC bid, Rjhay Laurea, founder of the Group of Unified Youth for Social Change, filed a complaint against on the supposed misuse of the \$21.0-million loan from the World Bank.

Marquez, who was SC official spokesman under two chief justices, however, responded and said the project and its funds never passed through his office despite his numerous positions. "That was under the Program Management Office, which was never un-
