Project VIPER, enhancing Cavite's capacity on disaster preparedness and response

AIMED to enhance the capacity of Cavite to prepare and respond to the Big One to lessen its impact on lives and properties, as well as facilitate meaningful participation among different stakeholders, Project VIPER (Vulnerability and Impact Reduction to Earthquake) successfully came up with the contingency plan for the province. Its success paved way for a confab that served as an avenue for presentation of accomplishments and challenges during the project journey through a Sharing of Lessons Learned Event held on August 14, 2018 in Bali Resort, Tagaytay City.

The sharing event celebrated the results of Project VIPER and took stock of the lessons learned throughout the almost year-long journey. Such development of coordination mechanism in the province involving civil society organizations will help link Cavite's contingency plan to Metro Manila's contingency plan.

Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office

members of all LGUs in Cavite who were involved in crafting the province's CP on the Big One were invited along with the Provincial DRMM Council. Other neighboring provinces in CALABARZON were also present at the end of project even to learn from Cavite's experience and discuss possible ways forward.

Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer Cecil Miranda expressed how proud the province is for the accomplishments of project VIPER, making a consortium, a contingency plan and a coordination mechanism all possible for Cavite through participatory processes in only a year.

Project VIPER developed from the "Big Preparedness: One Cavite" colloquium held in July 2017 where Cavite LGUs, the Provincial Government and

select Civil Society Organizations identified actions to better prepare for the impacts of the "Big One". The Big One is a 7.2 magnitude earthquake scenario triggered by the West Valley Fault.

The project was planned by the consortium formed after the 2017 colloquium. The consortium is composed of the Provincial Government of Cavite, Adventist Development and Relief Agency (ADRA) Philippines and Humanitarian Leadership Academy Philippines.

"Indeed, when people... work together, everything is possible," Dong Waña, Center Director of the Humanitarian Leadership Academy Philippines.

Academy Philippines acknowledged.

Tom Pignon noted "The work does not end here, Cavite's contingency plan is but a small contribution to the resilience of the country that we are all hoping for. We look forward to more of these initiatives."

GETTING TO KNOW THE 'ILUSTRADO' LIFESTYLE AT MUSEO DE LA SALLE

DASMARINAS CITY, Cavite – From the outside, it is just an unassuming 2-storey "Bahay na Bato" (stonehouse).

But it is different when you step in.

The 2,000-square meter building hosts a visual feast of antique family heirlooms from furniture, decorative objects, fine and applied arts displayed in faithfully recreated rooms – which are donated by or on long-term loan from collectors.

If one fancies antiques and curious on the way of life of the "ilustrados", Museo De La Salle (MDSL), an in-campus lifestyle museum of De La Salle University here, is a must on the bucket list.

The displays will certainly leave participants in awe as these offer details reflective of the lifestyle of this special class of people.

MDSL Director Cecille Torrevillas-Gelicame boasts of the museum collection, comprising 4,384 pieces of objects.

"Most of which depict the 19th century or Hispanic colonial period in the Phil-

ippines, and a few pottery collection dating back to pre-colonial Philippines," she said.

The 18 year-old museum, which first opened to the public in year 2000, "has been realized to encourage its own use in cross-disciplinary learning and growth in academic environment."

It was envisioned by its founder, Bro. Andrew Gonzalez, FSC, to be a repository - not only of heritage objects - but a landmark cultural institution and a learning space as well, where one can learn about Cavite and Philippine culture.

As Museo continues to be one of the lead museums in heritage preservation in South Luzon, it updated its mission statement in 2017 into "Museo De La Salle: Preserving Culture. Creating Possibilities" whose vision-mission statement states its directions to take, as a sustainable center that is committed to the safeguarding and promotion of the country's cultural heritage through its educational programs. That its leadership in the region

aims to develop informed communities that hold a profound regard for nationhood."

The museum also provides a living space where Philippine culture that is linked to its immediate community and which reaches out to the outside is illustrated.

"As we dedicate ourselves in gathering collectible objects of intrinsic val-

ue significant to the preservation of certain aspects of Philippine ilustrado lifestyle, MDSL also would like to be recognized as a resource center for heritage preservation through education," Gelicame said.

The campus-based museum also commits to promote the interests of museology and continuously uphold appreciation of the culture and the arts

through engagements in special events, from exhibitions, lectures under its "Art Talk and Heritage Talk Programs", workshop and capacity building and museum education programs, "of course, other than constant collaborations with other museums," Gelicame added.

The second level gallery is subdivided into meeting, prayer, master's bedroom

and office rooms, and dining and event hall reminiscent of the 19th century Philippine Ilustrado lifestyle.

The display areas are restricted but guests may still get their 'Instagrammable' or 'selfie' pictures in the allowable, public areas.

Entrance to the museum comes for a fee, and it is open Tue-Sun, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (**Gladys Pino-PNA**)



SSS TO WORK CLOSELY WITH DFA, DOLE TO ENSURE OFW COVERAGE

THE state-run Social Security System (SSS) is expected to work closely with the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) and Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) in ensuring the compulsory social security coverage of overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) under the proposed Senate Bill that will amend the Social Security Law with Senator Richard Gordon as principal author.

SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Emmanuel F. Dooc said that one of the proposed measures under Senate Bill 1753, which seeks to amend the 21-year old charter of the pension fund, is the mandatory coverage of OFWs over the world to protect them from hazards of contingencies.

"Based on latest statistics, there are more than two million OFWs around the world but only more than 583,000 are actively paying their SSS monthly contributions. With the help of Sen. Richard Gordon, our SS champion in the Senate, our goal is to make sure that all Filipinos in and out of the country are protected under the SSS," Dooc said.

"And we are also aware that this goal of ours is not as simple as it seems. This means tremendous work for us and partner agencies like DFA and DOLE, which oversee OFWs. We will be working closely with them to deliver the SSS mandate and to make sure that we will make the hopefully soon-to-be-law implemented," Dooc added.

Senator Gordon ensured other lawmakers during the interpellation on the Senate floor that the mandatory coverage of OFWs will be properly implemented by the SSS as they work hand-in-hand with other government agencies.

Gordon, together with officials of the pension fund, said one of the ways to implement this is through strengthened bilateral

agreements with different countries in the world.

"There are only 13 states that have agreed to have a treaty with us to cover all workers but that should not stop us. Today, we have 13, tomorrow, well 15, your honor. Next year, we may have 17 and of course, that should not stop the Department of Foreign Affairs and our DOLE. And all of us should always bring this advocacy that we should protect all workers of the world," Gordon said.

To date, the Philippines thru the SSS as lead negotiator, has already forged into 13 bilateral social security agreements with Austria, UK and Northern Ireland, Spain, France, Canada, Quebec, Netherlands, Switzerland, Belgium, Denmark, Portugal, Germany and Japan.

Gordon deemed the proposed measure a landmark bill as it will enable the SSS to fulfill its objective of universal coverage.

"It is our constitutional duty to afford full protection to labor, whether local or overseas, and fundamental to this is the provision of social security protection to all Filipinos, including OFWs. It is likewise provided in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights that everyone has the right to social security," the senator said.

Dooc, meanwhile, said that the main purpose is to provide OFWs the mechanism to save in order to secure their retirement through entitlement to lifetime SSS pension benefits, the value of which is at least P5.00 per peso amount of what they contributed.

He explained that an OFW paying the maximum monthly SSS contribution of P1,760 (or about USD35) for at least 10 years will be entitled to a wide range of SSS benefits and privileges such as: basic monthly pension amounting to at least P6,400 upon retirement, disability or death,

with an additional monthly benefit of P1,000; other benefits for pensioners like 13th month pension, dependents pension, and supplemental monthly allowance of P500 for disability pensioners; short-term benefits in the form of cash allowances for sickness (up to P57,600 per year); and maternity for female members (up to P32,000 for normal delivery/miscarriage and P41,600 for caesarian delivery); funeral grant amounting to at least P20,000; salary loan of up to P32,000, and direct housing loan of up to P2-million.

In the event of death, 100% of their pension will be transferred to their spouse and dependent children as primary beneficiaries. The least that they can get if unable to complete 10 years of contributions upon retirement is a refund of all their contributions plus interest.

A provident fund scheme, called the SSS Flexi-fund, is also being offered exclusively to OFWs to allow them to set aside an additional portion of their earnings abroad and maximize their returns.

"SSS contributions are OFWs' long-term savings for the future, especially when they eventually decide to return home and stay for good to retire," Dooc said.

Senator Gordon stressed that every Filipino worker during his productive years should follow a sure-fire formula to become self-reliant and financially independent: "WORK, SAVE, INVEST, PROSPER."

PCOO to head federalism information drive campaign

THE Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO), together with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) will spearhead the public information drive campaign on federalism.

"Ang Presidential Communications Operations Office po ang nangunguna, starting this week dito sa Federalism Communications Campaign, tayo po ay kabahagi ng inter-agency media campaign para dito sa federalism," Communications Secretary Martin Andanar said on a radio interview last Tuesday.

The inter-agency task force will be creating a broader communication plan in disseminating information on the administration's plan to shift to federalism.

"Pinag-usapan po natin kung ano yung mga communications strategy na gagawin natin para maipakalat natin sa buong Pilipinas ang mensahe ng federalism bago po ito maging ganap na batas at bago po ito balangkas ng ating mga Congressman at Senator at mapirmahan tungo po sa ini-expect natin na plebesito sa federalism."

According to Andanar, the team targets to explain the information on federalism to various provinces down to the barangay level.

"Napag-usapan po namin na kada rehiyon ay magkakaroon po tayo ng mga spokespersons at

magkakaroon din po tayo ng mga Cabinet members na bababa doon sa mga rehiyon para po matulungan ang ating national government sa pagpapaliwanag ng mga importanteng punto nitong draft constitution ng federalism," he added.

The Communication Secretary also added that chosen information disseminators will be undergoing training provided by the DILG.

"The Department of Interior and Local Government will be the one spearheading the training at meron din pong katulong dito ang DILG at ito po ay ang CHED at meron pang mga civil society na tutulong po sa atin," Andanar said.

PCOO is also tasked to

create and distribute standardized dissemination materials on federalism.

"Ang PCOO naman ay in-charge sa distribution, pagdating sa media, sa radyo, telebisyon, sa mga pahayagan, sa online at sa on-ground sa pamamagitan po ng Philippine Information Agency," Andanar said.

Meanwhile, Presidential Spokesperson Harry Roque earlier announced that some P90 million is allotted for the inter-agency task force, however P10 million will be given to PCOO.

"The initial amount that has been identified for dissemination is P90 million, but P10 million will go to PCOO for production of materials," Roque said.

Euro-II Compliant Diesel

The Department of Energy (DOE) also issued a Memorandum Order requiring oil companies to provide Euro-II compliant automotive diesel oil to help reduce fuel prices.

"Pursuant to existing Philippine National Standards on Diesel Fuel Quality and in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 8479, otherwise known as the Downstream Oil De-

regulation Law, Republic Act 8749, otherwise known as the Philippine Clean Air Act and for the purpose of reducing the impact of rising

petroleum prices in the world market, all industry players are hereby directed to provide at the retail level Euro-II compliant automotive diesel oil as a fuel option for the transport and industrial customers," the Memorandum Order stated.

It also directed oil companies offering Euro-II compliant diesel to submit a monthly compliance report, indicating the list of participating retail outlets.

According to Sec. Cusi, the sale of said diesel will be subjected to close monitoring by the DOE.

Cusi Orders Importation of Low-Cost Oil to Help Arrest Inflation

ing function to generate added income for the government. "PNOC-EC will source low-priced petroleum products particularly diesel, to mitigate the impact of volatile oil prices," Sec. Cusi said.

The measure is expected to have a ripple effect on taming the prices of basic

commodities, thus controlling inflation. The resulting price relief would ease the plight of consumers.

Under the project, the trading function of PNOC-EC will be employed in the acquisition of low-priced fuel which will mainly come from state deals.

The PNOC-EC Board

chaired by the Energy Chief is drafting the trading procedure and policy safeguards for the public on the proposed importation.

The products bought at a special price will be made available to dealers, operators and independent petroleum players under a Memorandum of Agreement.
