TELEMEDICINE SA CALABARZON, PAKONSULTA PUWEDE NA SA GADGETS

HINDI na kailangan ng isang pasyente na pumunta sa ospital upang magpasuri.

Ito ay makaraang ilunsad ng Department of Health (DOH) sa rehiyon ng CALABARZON (Cavite Laguna Batangas Rizal Quezon) ang kauna-unahang programa ng Telemedicine.

Ayoy kay DOH-CALABARZON Regional Director Eduardo Janairo na sa pamagitan ng Telemedicine, ang isang pasyente, kahit nasa remote areas ay maari itong magpakonsulta sa pamagitan ng live video kung saan maaring kausapin ng isang doctor ang kanyang pasyente.

Pre-consultation, in-consultation at post consultation ay maaring isagawa sa programa ng Telemedicine.

Paliwanang ni Janairo na maaring suriin ng doc-

tor ang isang pasyente sa pamagitan lamang ng internet connections kung saan maaari silang magusap, masuri at magamot ang sakit nito na hindi kailangan magbiyehe papunta sa ospital.

"Telemedicine is technology in service delivery network. W will utilize telecommunication and information technology to provide clinical care from a distance" ayon kay Janairo.

Ang Telemedicine program ay inorganisa sa pagtutulungan ng Department of Science and Technology, AMD Global Telemedicine Inc., KonsultaMD Global Telehealth, Inc at Globe Telecom, Inc.

Bacoor City inaugurates school buildings in Molino IV

BACOOR CITY, Cavite – Two new 4-storey classroom buildings were inaugurated on Tuesday in Molino IV village here to address classroom congestions in elementary and high schools in the densely-populated school campuses.

Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado Revilla led the inauguration and blessing of the 4-story, 8-classroom building at Likha Elementary School and of another 4-story, 12-classroom building of Georgetown National High School, both located in Molino IV village.

The city public information office said the additional school buildings form part of the city's commitment to provide a conducive learning environment for its school children and "help reduce the per classroom student ratio to only 40 schoolchildren per classroom."

While at Likha Elementary School, Mercado also took distributed school bags to schoolchildren and promote the "Bakood" Festival activities, which the city

annually holds in honor of its patron saint, St. Michael the Archangel, as well as the city's 347th founding year.

According to Molino IV village chief Jeffrey Campaña the new school buildings boast of multi-benefits.

P1.164-M worth of drugs seized in Cavite

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite – This city police's Drug Enforcement Team (DET) seized about PHP1.164-million worth of suspected "shabu" (crystal meth) during simultaneous buy-bust operations on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Supt. Paul Bometivo, city police officer-in-charge, reported to Cavite Police Provincial Director Senior Supt. William Segun that eight suspects, listed as street level targets (SLTs), were arrested during three separate buy-bust operations in Sitio Sampalucan, Barangay Pasong Camachile 2 and Barangay San Francisco.

Bometivo said their intensified anti-illegal drug operations were in pursuit of the Cavite Provincial Police Office's Five Priority Projects to sustain the campaign against illegal drugs and criminality initiated by the provincial police director.

He said the DET's eight-hour anti-illegal drug operations, in coordination

with the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency 4-A (Calabarzon) and barangay officials in area, which began Tuesday night, bagged four SLTs at the Tropical Village Pabahay 2000 housing site in Barangay San Francisco.

Police identified the suspects as Randy Taway Vargas, 37, of Country Meadow Subdivision; Pedro Oraña Lazaga, 36, sales agent, of Sto. Domingo, Bay, Laguna; and Myla dela Cruz Cervantes, 32, and Jervic Waminal Saguindao, 35, housekeeper – both from Sitio Ilang in Barangay San Francisco.

The law enforcers confiscated during the operation seven plastic sachets of suspected shabu, weighing about 24 grams with a street value of PHP150,000 and the buy-bust money.

Authorities nabbed Dimarao Tanggao Bangon alias "Dima," 46, of San Agustin 1, Dasmariñas City, Cavite also in Tropical Village Pabahay 2000.

Bangon yielded five plastic sachets of suspected shabu weighing about 155 grams, with a street value of more than PHP1 million, and the PHP 9,000 buy-bust money.

Three other drug suspects were arrested during the buy-bust operations in Sitio Sampalucan, Pasong Camachille 2 at about 1:30 a.m. on Wednesday.

Arrested were Marissa Silangga Gonzales, 36; Jomerel Arcon Dumandan, 33, tricycle driver; and Gellie Lumbreras Primero, 35, all residents of Pasong Camachille 2. The city DET seized from the suspects six plastic sachets of suspected shabu worth PHP6,500 and the buy-bust money.

The eight drug suspects, now detained at the General Trias Police Station, are facing criminal charges.

The drug evidence was submitted to the Cavite police's Crime Laboratory Office for chemical analysis. **(Dennis Abriana/PNA)**

DTI TO HOLD 4TH CALABARZON MSME DEV'T COUNCIL CONFAB ON SEPT. 27

TAYABAS CITY, Quezon — The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) 4-A (Calabarzon), in partnership with the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI) - Southern Luzon, is spearheading the 4th Regional MSME (micro, small and medium enterprises) Development Council Conference at the St. Jude Coop Hotel and Resort here on Sept. 27.

The conference aims to instill innovation and enhance competitiveness among MSMEs in the region.

Mia Angeline V. COPS BUST 5 BIG-TIME FAKE TITLE SYNDICATE IN TAGAYTAY CITY

TAGAYTAY CITY, Cavite - Five suspected members of a big-time fake land title and deeds syndicate were arrested during an entrapment operation by city police operatives on Monday afternoon.

Police Regional Office (PRO4A) Calabarzon Regional Director Chief Supt. Edward Carranza personally visited the Tagaytay City Police Station, where the five suspects are now detained, to supervise the filing of cases of large scale estafa and falsification of public documents against them.

Carranza also called for the other victims of the big-time syndicate to also file charges against the suspects.

Senior Supt. William Segun, Cavite Police Provincial Director commended the operating team, led by city chief of police Supt. Elmer Decena, "for a job well done."

Decena identified the arrested suspects as Gerardo Matuod Trinidad, 58 of Phase 1, Barangay Bagtas, Tanza Cavite; Aireen Celis Tan, 52 of Merced Street, Barangay 683, Paco District, Manila; Rochel Cristobal Alcantara, 49 of Balagtas St., Balagtas Royal Mansion in Barangay 2, Pasay City; Michael Cadorniga Sarabosing, 34 of Arellano St., San Agustin, Malabon, Metro Manila; and William Gonzales Pineda, 48 of M. Natividad St. Sta. Cruz, Manila.

Decena said the five suspects were apprehended during an entrapment operation inside the Bag of Beans Coffee Shop at Robinson Supermarket at Barangay Maharlika West, Tagaytay City.

According to Decena, the entrapment operation was launched when victims Ester Mariano Rosales, 68, a widow, and a residents of General Lizardo St., 28th Avenue, Quezon City; and a certain Yoshihisa Tsujimoto, 46, of 7272 J. Victor St., Barangay Pio del Pilar, Pasong Tamo, Makati City, personally sought assistance pertaining to the alleged estafa and falsification of land titles.

Police investigation revealed that the victims already paid around PHP80 million as initial payment for the eight parcels of land sold to them by the five suspects.

However, the victims later discovered the land titles given to them by the suspects were spurious.

This prompted Decena to launch their joint entrapment operations with the San Jose Municipal Police Station, Batangas at the coffee shop, which resulted in the arrest of the five suspects.

Operatives also recovered from them some PHP24,000

cash and the marked "boodle" money used for the entrapment operation. (Dennis Abrina/PNA)

GENTRI SETS SEPT. 27 DEADLINE FOR PASSPORT APPLICATION

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite – The city government's Investment Promotion Office (IPO) will only accept pre-registration for available slots for the Department of Foreign Affairs' 'passport on wheels' program until 5 p.m. on Sept 27.

The IPO gives preference to city residents on its mobile pre-registration, which is ongoing from Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until September 27 at the IPO located at the 4/F of the City Government Hall here.

GenTri's officer-in-charge (OIC) for Investment and Promotion Romel Olimpo said Tuesday that the city has been supporting the "passport on wheels" program that aims to de-clog the cue-in of applicants in the DFA Manila Head Consular office and to bring government service closer to the people.

Given its 1,500 passport application slots, Olimpo is confident that "we can still accommodate even those from nearby municipalities" like Kawit, Rosario and Tanza.

Those who will pre-register will be required to fill out a pre-registration stub with the applicant's personal information such as last name, first name, middle name, maiden name (for married women), status, gender, birthplace, birthday and contact number.

"No documents will be submitted during the pre-registration process," Olimpo clarified.

Pre-registered applicants will then be submitted for DFA verification, evaluation "therefore, those who pre-registered are not guaranteed of a slot, appointment, unless approved by DFA."

Applicants who passed the initial verification process will be notified of the next phase, which is the encoding and checking of requirements.

"Once ok, applicants will receive an email from DFA with their reference number and payment instructions so they can settle the fee to any authorized payment centers and make themselves available on the processing date on Nov. 8, to be held at the Robinsons Place here," Olimpo added.

The Mobile passport fee is the same with the Expedite Rate of PHP1,350 (including courier fee).

The processing of passports at Mobile Passport Services is guided by the Philippine Passport Act of 1996 and the implementing rules and regulations, other relevant Department Orders, Circulars and Memoranda.

Under the said act and its implementing rules and regulations, and the foreign affairs department's directive, the mobile passport service will not cater to applications for the replacement of lost valid passports.

However, the mobile passporting here will entertain applications for lost and expired passports and personal appearance is required for all applicants.

For a seamless handling of all applications, the city government, as well as the DFA, is not accepting walk-in applicants during the day.

New P2P routes open Monday

BACoor CITY, Cavite – Commuters of this city, as well as Dasmariñas City now have an alternative, safer and more convenient way to commute from and to Makati city as MetroExpress Connect, Inc. launched its 'maiden route run' of additional premium point to point (P2P) routes on Monday.

For the MetroExpress soft launching, Nadine Villados, Corporate Communications Supervisor, said the ride is for free for their Monday promotional campaign but will start collecting fares Tuesday.

Villados said the MetroExpress fare is PHP150 for Dasma City while PHP 110 for Bacoor City, and will have around eight new buses servicing both cities, with four coming from Dasmariñas and another four from Bacoor.

MetroExpress buses will have its origin from Camella (Dasmariñas) and Vista Mall Daang Hari (Bacoor) and end points are San Lorenzo Place (Makati), and route is via Muntinlupa Cavite Expressway (MCX) and Skyway.

The P2P transport system is one of the Department of Transportation's (DOTr) priority projects to alleviate traffic congestion as it introduced the "park and ride or kiss and ride concept", in response to the commuters and riding public's need for a safe, convenient and comfortable transport.

The "park and ride" is for car owners who can leave

their car parked in the mall then ride the P2P bus to their destination, while the "kiss and ride" is for parents/guardians who may opt to bring their kids to the terminal and kiss them before their loved ones board the premium bus ride.

The point-to-point (P2P) service commitment prohibits frequent stops as the buses will travel directly from the terminals to their drop off points.

There will be six morning take offs from Dasmariñas City, where the first four runs every 30 minutes from 5:30 a.m. until 7 a.m.; and 10 a.m. and 11 a.m.; while the afternoon take off schedules are 12 noon and 1 p.m. and resume again, every hour, from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Bacoreños, on the other hand, will have eight dispatches in the morning, with the first 4 schedules happening every 30 minutes: 6 a.m., 6:30 a.m., 7 a.m., 7:30 a.m.; followed by 10 a.m., 11 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

The afternoon schedules are 12 noon, 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m., 3:30 pm, and every hour thereafter from 4 to 6 p.m.

The premium P2P bus service will leave from Makati city to Dasmariñas city at 8 am, 8:30 am, 9 am, 9:30 am, 12 noon, 1 pm, 2 pm, 3 pm, and every hour from 5 to 8 p.m.

The Makati to Bacoor schedules start at 7:30 am, 8 am, 8:30 am, 9 am, 10:30 am, 11:30 am, 12:30 pm, 1 pm, 1:30 pm, 2:30 pm, 3:30 pm, 4:30 pm, and every

An MNSA thesis, academics awardee shares feat

IMUS CITY, Cavite – A ranking military official never expected he would bag the major academic awards that were kept secret until their graduation from the premiere military college - National Defense College of the Philippines (NDCP). But, as far as this Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) official is concerned, he did his best in the top military academic institution.

But as the graduation rites unfolded at the Tejeros Hall, AFP Commissioned Officers Club House in Camp Aguinaldo, Quezon City on Sept 10, newly confirmed Philippine Army Colonel Gulliver Lapitan Señires, GSC (INF) PA with his wife in tow was surprised when the top graduate-awardees were announced during the occasion.

He shared he was truly honored as National Defense Secretary Delfin N. Lorenzana graced the event and congratulated him and a few other awardees.

Although he admitted to have exerted his best efforts in academics, Señires was a bit surprised when his name was called as silver medalist for graduating with a general weighted average (GWA) of 1.13 for his Master's Degree in National Security Administration (MNSA) Regular Course 53.

And to add a feather to this cap, the military colonel also bagged the "Bronze Award" for this master's thesis entitled 'Localized Peace Process: Towards Creating a Geographically-adoptive, Mass-based Indigenous Transition Model' from among the Top 10 shortlisted for the awards.

He was the only graduate in his batch who bagged two awards in separate categories, where the others merely excelled either in academics or thesis.

The 'bronze' thesis

Señires shared that "my thesis was an improvement of the program I initiated in Kalinga," where he served as Battalion Commander of the 50th Infantry Battalion in charge of internal security operations in Kalinga Province and 2 Municipalities South of Apayao Province.

He draws inspiration from his constant interaction with communities in far-flung areas in the countryside, including personal conversation with members of the New People's Army (NPA), the armed wing of the Communist Party of the

Philippines) as he laid down and discussed various propositions to finally end the insurgency in the Region, as well as the whole nation.

According to Señires, when national efforts to forge peace with the CPP-NPA-NDF (or collectively known as CNN) fail, the threat is most felt in these (far flung, countryside) communities where extortion, encounters and disturbances happen.

"So I ask the question, when will these violence stop?"

His thesis highlights a "Reconciliation Program for NPA in Kalinga" as an offered solution to end insurgency in this Region, because based on his personal experience "the major reason why they (the NPAs) don't surrender is because they have criminal cases, they don't want to go to jail."

Señires hopes that his thesis model, which is applicable in all areas in the Phils, an LGU led (and support from all sectors of society), where customary practice of indigenous peoples are applied and integrates former rebels into mainstream society as peaceful and productive citizens, if adapted by the AFP will put the 5 decades of armed conflict with the CNN to rest.

Groomed to be a priest, not a soldier

Growing up to an idealist lawyer as father, this third son of the late Atty. Godofredo Villarín Señires, Jr. and housewife Leonora Lapitan Señires was actually groomed to be a priest, "the supposed military in the family is our eldest, Godofredo III, he shared.

"Our profession (including his 3 other siblings) were somewhat planned before us, where one should be a soldier, an engineer, a priest and a journalist, "and my (late) father really took time to expose us where needed to somehow awaken these callings in us," he shared.

He recalled the Sunday masses at the National Shrine of Our Mother of Perpetual Help (also known as Baclaran Redemptorist Church) during his childhood years.

But, fate had his way, when his brother had "vision" issues, "we compromised to shift roles, he will be the priest and I will pursue a military career."

Thus, this, then young 'Menudo' (an all male Latino boy band that was popular in the '80s) fan ended up

in the Philippine Military Academy (PMA), and joined the Philippine Army after he graduated in 1992.

NDCP's MNSA Program

As peace and order plays a vital role in the country's progress and development, the men and women tasked as administrators of the country's national security must have the broad skills and proper attitude to perform their multifarious responsibilities, which is what NDCP's MNSA program equips its graduates of.

The program provides the needed education in terms of analytical and conceptual skills to prepare them to meet the broad challenges emanating from the internal and external environment.

Señires was among the 65 who completed the course on this batch.

His classmates include officials from the civilian government agencies, private Sector, foreign military students (Sri Lanka Army, Bangladesh Navy, Indian Air Force, Pakistan Air Force, Nigerian Army, Royal Malaysian Air Force and Malaysian Army) and officers from the country's military service branches such as Philippine Air Force, Philippine Navy and the Philippine Army.

Señires treats the "MNSA time" more as an opportunity to rekindle family ties, as "I have been deployed away from home most of the time, and taking the MNSA means having to spend more time with family, especially my wife and kids," he shared.

But keeping the balance on his multi-roles, as a husband, father (to 3 children), son, brother and his duty as designated Army Group Coordinator (main task is to process release of support for Army students like allowance, POL allocation, uniforms including admin works like assignments, etc to the Philippine Army Headquarters), not to mention contending with 64 different personalities (a mix of intelligent, practical, experienced and deviant ones during the program), was the challenge he has to face.

"But as a military professional, this is your mission, where you must 'properly' work your way around, give it your best," Señires shared.

Besides, the AFP 'schooling' process, from

his Infantry Basic and Advanced Courses, CGSC and Master of Military Arts and Science from US Army Command and General Staff College in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, Scout Ranger Class 125-96, and Master of Strategic Affairs from Australian National University, Acton ACT in 2008 has long prepared him for this.

Best practices he can share

"I just don't listen to lectures during the class, I record them," so he can go back, and review anytime.

Active participation during group discussion is also key, "be critical, if you don't agree with the lecturer, then present your argument," as the NDCP allows for 'no-holds-barred' discussion "as we are talking about our national security here."

Señires also advised future-MNSA course takers to submit turn-ins in time, "don't depend on deadlines, do your works in advance."

Other than giving your best, most important is "to make sure you answer the question as clearly and concise as possible."

"Enjoy the course, make friends that could widen your horizon and influence, this is the best take-away from the program."

Lastly, focus on your studies, not the awards. "Self-improvement is your goal, the award will come naturally in the end."

Other than Señires, the other thesis awardees include "Bronze": Col Ferdi-

nand Melchor C Del Cruz, GSC (MI) PA (Philippine-Malaysian-Indonesian Trilateral Cooperation to Counter Violent Extremism: Challenges and Prospects) Silver Award: Col. Adonis Ariel G. Cavite town intensifies campaign vs. criminals, illegal drugs

INDANG, Cavite - The local police have intensifying its anti-criminality and war against illegal drugs after eight barangays of the 36 barangays in this town have been drug-cleared.

Chief Insp. Mark Gatdula, this town's acting police chief, said Monday they are seeking heightened support from the local government unit (LGU) and the barangays to eradicate illegal drugs and crimes in the locality.

"The local police have eight drug-cleared barangays, and we want to improve more to clear other barangays so that the crime rate in this first class municipality will go down," Gatdula assured.

The drug-cleared barangays are Guyam Munti, Harasan, Limbon, Carasuchi, Tambo Balagbag, Poblacion 3, Kaytambog and Mataas na Lupa with 28 more that are up for drug-clearing operations.

"To demonstrate the local village officials' cooperation, the barangay officials have undergone the drug tests in line with the drug-free workplace campaign for barangay drug-clearing," he added.

He said the local cops are also conducting their barangay visitation to brief local village leaders and discuss laws pertaining to abuses against women and children, curfew for minors, 'Clean Rider Campaign', 'Oplan Kadena', and other anti-criminality Campaign.

Gatdula said the local police's 'Oplan Kadena' (operational plan chain)

encourages local residents and owners of motorcycles to chain-lock their vehicles when parked.

"Hinimihok ho namin ang mga motorcycle owners na ikadena ang mga motorcycle unit nila kapag sila magpa-park sa ibat-ibang lugar para makaiwas ho tayo sa pagnakaw ng ating mga motorsiklo (We are encouraging motorcycle owners to secure their motorcycles with chain-lock if they would park in any area to avoid motorcycle-napping)," he said.

He said that the local police have been urging motorcycle owners to register their respective two-wheeled vehicles at the police station under the police's "Clean Rider" campaign, an initiative to rid the streets of unregistered or stolen motorcycles used by notorious riding-in-tandem criminals.

The police said the procedure to be declared "clean" motorcycle owners requires them to submit either the receipt of purchase of the motorbike or the vehicle's certificate of registration, the owner's driver's license, and a government-issued identification card.

The "clean" riders could easily be spotted with the police stylized-badge sticker design with the semblance of the sun in the Philippine flag attached to the motorcycle.

The sticker is also color-coded according to the city or municipality where the motorcycle is registered. **(Dennis Abrina/PNA)**
