Coffee Board to open field office in Amadeo town Jan. 16

AMADEO, Cavite — The Philippine Coffee Board, Inc. (PCBI) will open its South Luzon field office in Dagatan village of this “coffee capital” town on January 16.

PCBI Director Rene Tongson on Thursday said this initiative is not just about getting their services closer to the coffee farmers and stakeholders, but helping them monitor and extend all needed assistance to help boost the productivity of farmers.

“Simply put, kami ang lalapit sa kanila (we will be the one to go to them instead of the other way around),” he said.

The Amadeo, South Luzon field office will add up to PCBI’s existing satellite offices in Mindanao (Davao, Sultan Kudarat, Bukidnon, and in Jolo, Sulu), including one up north located in Baguio City.

The office will service coffee farmers and stakeholders in this town, includ-

ing in neighboring coffee-producing towns of Indang, Silang, Alfonso, Magallanes, Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo, the city of General Trias and other South Luzon locations. Tongson shared the PCBI will introduce post-harvest facilities “to teach farmers how to process specialty coffee”.

IMUS CITY TO OPEN 3 WEEKENDS FOR TAX PAYMENTS

IMUS CITY, Cavite — The city government of Imus will accommodate business and realty tax payments during the next three weekends. In an advisory issued Tuesday, City Mayor Emmanuel Maliksi also reminded business owners

to pay their taxes, permits renewal, and other regulatory fees before the deadline on January 20 to avoid interest charges for late payments.

Maliksi said the City Treasurer's Office will be open to the public from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on January 12-13, 19-20, and 26-27.

Owners and/or administrators of properties are also urged to settle their real property taxes before March 31.

An incentive of 20 percent discount for real property taxes for calendar year 2019 is offered for full payments made on or before January 20, and a 10 percent discount if paid in full before March 31.

A 10 percent discount is also provided for real estate taxes paid on or before the quarterly payment scheduled every 20th of January, April, July and October.

Maliksi further said the next quarterly installment deadlines for property taxes are June 30 for the second quarter, September 30 for the third quarter, and December 31 for the last quarter of the year.

Deadlines for business tax payments are April 20, July 20 and October 20 for the second, third, and fourth

Alangilan ng lungsod na ito kamakailan.

Ang naturang FabLab ay bahagi ng Shared Service Facility (SSF) project ng DTI Batangas at nagkakahalaga ng P12M.

Ayon kay Trade and Industry Calabarzon Director Marilou Toledo, ang naturang proyekto ay isa sa tatlong FabLab na binuksan sa Calabarzon sa taong ito.

Ang pagbibigay ng SSF para sa mga micro-small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) ay binibigyang prayoridad ng ahensya dahil malaking tulong ang pag-iinvest sa mga equipment para sa maliliit na negosyante.

Los Banos (UPLB) sa pamamagitan ng kanilang Technology Transfer Business Development Office na nagkakahalaga ng P14M at ito ay maaaring ipasimula sa mga negosyo. Ikatlo nga itong FabLab sa BatStateU," ani Toledo.

Aniya, hinahamon nya rin ang pamunuan ng iba pang state universities sa Calabarzon upang subukan ang pagkakaroon ng FabLab dahil malaki ang pakinabang nito lalo na sa mga negosyante.

Ayon kay BatStateU President Dr. Tirso A Ronquillo, ang naturang laboratoryong ay gagamitin ng mga estudyante para sa paggawa ng mga model design ng kanilang mga proyekto.

"Malaki ang magiging pakinabang ng mga mag-aaral natin dito, dahil magagamit nila ito sa paggawa ng prototype design at isa ito sa requirement ng curriculum lalo na at nagtuturo ang mga unibersidad ng fabrication tulad ng paggawa ng spare parts ng sasakyan, art works, signages at iba pa. Mas madali nilang matutunan ang pinag-aaralan dahil makikita nila kung ano ang itsura nito sa aktuwal at hindi puro guhit lamang sa whiteboard ang kanilang makikita," ani Ronquillo.

Duterte declares last Monday of January as 'National Bible Day'

MANILA — President Rodrigo R. Duterte has declared the last Monday of January every year as a special working holiday, in observance of the National Bible Day.

Under Republic Act 11163 he signed on Dec. 20, 2018, the President recognized the value of the Holy Bible as the core of Christian faith, especially in a predominantly Christian nation.

"As a predominantly Christian nation and the largest Christian nation in the Asia Pacific, this Act recognizes the value of the Holy Bible as the core of Christina faith," the R.A. read.

The law emphasizes the policy of the state that the government shall aid and encourage the development of the moral character and spiritual foundation of the Filipino people.

It was passed by the Senate as Senate Bill No. 1270 on Feb. 5, 2018 and adopted by the House of

Representatives as an amendment to House Bill No. 7544 on Oct. 10, 2018.

Senator Manny Pacquiao, the bill's author and sponsor in the Senate, said his measure calls for all Christians to "unite altogether and celebrate the Holy Bible as the cradle of human faith."

He said the proposed holiday was necessary for the "betterment of the country through God centered governance and people centered services."

Moreover, the senator-boxer also noted that the 1987 Constitution itself calls on government "to support efforts to strengthen the ethical and spiritual values and to develop the moral character and spiritual foundation of every Filipino."

The act will take effect 15 days after its complete publication in the Official Gazette or at least in two newspapers of general circulation. **(PNA)**

Likewise, on December 22 and 24, 2018, the provincial government have distributed motorcycle vehicles for the barangay officials of Pagasa 1, Imus and in the municipality of Silang to guarantee the peace and order situation in their locality. —(PICAD)

Duterte urges barangay officials to remain dedicated to service

PASAY CITY (PIA)—President Rodrigo Duterte yesterday urged barangay officials to remain dedicated to their service and promised that he will continue to be their ally in building strong communities.

The President was the guest of honor during the Barangay Summit on Peace and Order in the National Capital Region held Tuesday (Jan. 8) at the Cuneta Astrodome in Pasay City.

"I cannot help you if it's graft and corruption but I can help you in cases na in-enforce ninyo ang batas tapos masabit kayo. Kapag talagang ginawa ninyo in accordance with the law," Duterte told barangay officials.

"Just follow the law. Hindi ko naman sinabi you have to be very, very, very honest. Just be

fundamentally honest," he added.

Over 4,000 barangay and local government officials in Metro Manila attended the summit that aimed to encourage barangays and other stakeholders to join the fight against illegal drugs, criminality and corruption.

The DILG Chief Secretary Eduardo M. Año said issues concerning heavy traffic in Metro Manila were discussed including barangay policies on road obstruction and traffic.

"Kailangan natin ang tulong at kooperasyon ng mga barangay para maibsan ang lumalalang traffic sa Metro Manila. Umaasa ako na magkakaroon ng magandang kasunduan tungkol dito," he said.

Aside from the President

and the DILG Secretary, also present during the event are Undersecretary Allen Capuyan, Presidential Adviser on Indigenous People's Concern, who talked about understanding the CPP, NPA, NDF; DILG Undersecretary Martin Diño who spoke on the duties and functions of barangay officials; Asst. Secretary Jonathan Malaya gave a briefing on federalism; and an MMDA official discussed the role of LGUs in road clearing.

"I hope and I pray that something good will come out of the BOL. Though the plebiscite is forthcoming, we have every reason to believe that it would pass the people's will at sana magkaroon tayo ng kapayapaan because if not mahirapan tayo nito." Duterte said.

According to Pres. Duterte, the presidency was a gift from God and, in turn, he will do his job conscientiously with the fight against drugs

topping his agenda. He, however, admitted the gravity of the problem is overwhelming, saying "I could not really fulfill my promise to do away with drugs within six years. Impossible... It's going to be a continuing one."

The president even made a stern warning that in the remaining three years of his term, his administration will be targeting 'big time' people involved in illegal drugs.

Duterte's war on drugs has been continuously subjected to various

criticisms from the religious and civil society groups but the President maintains the effects of drugs have wreaked havoc to families, making some of them dysfunctional, and to the community, in general with crimes such as robbery, rape, and murder.

After his speech, President Duterte willingly obliged for photo ops, first with the Tolentino clan, then with the local government officials of CALABARZON. He was later serenaded with Tagalog songs by singer Faith Cuneta. (Ruel Francisco, PIA-Cavite)

Shortage of chicken looms

MANILA — There is a looming shortage of chicken in the country due to an apparent disagreement among stakeholders on the price of the commodity.

"The stakeholders could not seem to agree on what to do, but I hope they will," said Agriculture Secretary Manny Piñol, in an interview with the media on Tuesday.

Piñol noted prices of chicken have fallen to about PHP38 in some areas and farmers are losing, so "they should all agree to increase the farm gate price by at least PHP10 every week until such time they are able to reach the level where they will not be losing money anymore".

He expressed concern that if the current situation continues, "some of the small players might get out of the business and we might have shortage of chicken by second quarter of the year".

Piñol said he also ordered for a review of the volume of chicken being imported into the country as this might be too much for the local market to absorb, and could end up hurting the local poultry industry.

A United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) report forecasts that the country's total chicken meat imports may expand by 9.67 percent to 340,000 metric tons (MT) in 2019, from the estimated purchases of

310,000 MT last year.

The USDA forecasts that global chicken meat exports will grow four percent, setting a new record this year. Shipments by major traders are fueled largely by rising consumption in developing markets, such as the Philippines, Angola, Cuba and Ghana.

For July-December 2018 period, the poultry sub-sector produced 5.45 percent more output. It contributed 18.44 percent to the total agricultural production. Output gains were noted for chicken, chicken eggs and duck eggs. The gross value of poultry production at current prices amounted to PHP 56.1 billion, higher by 19.19 percent compared to 2017 earnings. The sub-sector's output grew by 5.31 percent in the last three quarters of 2018.

Piñol said under the World Trade Organization (WTO) agreement with trade partners, the Philippines can institute remedies to protect local industries from being injured by over-importation.

Stocks in the cold storage right now for local chicken stands at 18 million kilograms while imported chicken is at 16 million kg. "That would represent over supply. The market could not absorb (such volume)," he said.

As such, he said, big players would tend to lower the price of chicken to the detriment of local producers.

The DA chief said once and for all, stakeholders and farmers "should agree among themselves (on the price of chicken) to protect themselves". (PNA)

CAVITE EXEMPTS SENIORS, PWDs FROM PAYING PARKING FEES

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite — All senior citizens (SCs) and persons with disabilities (PWDs) are now exempted from paying parking fees normally charged by business establishments within the province, as called for by a new ordinance which takes effect this year.

Provincial Ordinance No. 235, otherwise known as "Free Parking Ordinance for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability of the Province of Cavite" was introduced and sponsored by Provincial Board Member Valeriano S. Encabo.

The provincial legislation exempts SCs and PWDs from paying parking fees in malls, business establishments and private hospitals within Cavite province.

Availing parties, who must either be the driver or a passenger of the private vehicle, are advised to

present SC/PWD cards upon entry in the area/space/lot of the mentioned establishments.

However, the "free parking" privilege does not apply to overnight parking and applies only to all privately-owned vehicles and excludes public utility vehicles (PUVs) such as public utility jeepneys (PUJ), tricycle, buses, taxis or similar vehicles.

The cashier or booth attendant violating this ordinance shall be fined PHP500, while a PHP2,000 fine shall be imposed against the operator, manager and/or owner of the said parking space.

Provincial Board Secretary Michelle F. Alcuid added that the ordinance, which was approved by Provincial Governor Jesus Crispin Remulla on Dec. 11 last year, is now up for implementation. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

Caviteños lauded for role in economic uplift

CAVITE — Former Special Assistant to the President (SAP) Christopher Lawrence "Bong" Go on Tuesday lauded Caviteños for their role in the economic development of the country, and assured them of bringing their voice to President Rodrigo Duterte.

Go gave the assurance in his message at the Ugnayan sa Barangay event at the Capitol Hills Executive Subdivision Phase 1 Covered Court in Trece Martires City, Cavite.

Go said Cavite is an important contributor to the country's economic growth given its location and business-friendly environment.

"Malaki ang naitutulong ng mga Caviteño sa pag-unlad ng ating bansa. Kung kaya't ginagawa ng pangulo ang lahat ng makakakaya niya para mas mapalago pa ang probinsiya ninyo," he said.

Go was warmly welcomed by the entourage of Cavite Governor and congressional candidate Jesus Crispin "Boying" Remulla, former Gov. Juanito Victor "Jonvic" Remulla, Cavite Board Member and PBMLP Na-

tional Board Ryan Enriquez, Trece Martires mayoral candidate Gemma Lubigan, as well as other local leaders of the area.

The Duterte government, through the "Build, Build, Build" infrastructure program, has earmarked several important projects that would spur even more growth and development in the province and its people, according to Go.

Among others, right-of-way acquisition-related activities are ongoing for the PHP35.43 billion project consisting of a 44.63-km closed system Cavite-Laguna Expressway connecting the CAVITEX in Kawit, Cavite and SLEX in Binan, Laguna.

Also ongoing are pre-construction activities for the PHP64.9 billion LRT Line 1 Cavite extension, starting from the Baclaran station to the future station at Niyog in Bacoor, Cavite.

Go added that a Malasakit Center will soon open in Cavite.

Similar to what happened on Tuesday morning at the Batangas Provincial Hospital in Lemery, Batangas, the government plans to launch a Malasakit Cen-

ter in Cavite to cater to the need for financial and medical assistance of poor and disadvantaged residents of the province.

"Mahalaga ang kalusugan ng mamamayan para mas makatulong sa paglago ng pamumuhay ng pamilya kaya kailangan natin tugunan ang mga pangangailangan ng mga may sakit," Go told the audience.

Malasakit Center, a brainchild of former Go and President Rodrigo Duterte, is a one-stop shop initiative where PCSO, DSWD, PhilHealth, and other relevant government satellite offices are housed together in one location to ease the process for patients in need of speedy medical and financial assistance.

There are presently 20 Malasakit Centers operating in various parts of the Philippines.

Go intends to add to this number through a law that would mandate the creation of Malasakit Centers in all provinces and urban centers of the country.

Related to the Malasakit Center, Go also stressed the need to increase available hospital beds for patients in crowded public

hospitals.

"Huwag natin pahirapan ang mga may sakit na pasyente; bigyan natin silang may sakit ng tamang higaan para gumaling sila nang maayos," Go said.

Meanwhile, Go emphasized the need to protect the welfare of barangay officials as well as barangay health workers by providing proper compensation and benefits packages and by pushing for a Magna Carta for Barangays.

Go said he is also supporting the move to extend the current term of elected barangay officials so that they can have more time to cater to the needs of their constituents.

The term of current barangay officials has been cut short to two years due to the postponement of the last barangay elections.

"Sila po ang frontliners natin sa pagharap sa mga pangangailangan ng ating mga barangay. Pagdating sa droga o sa kalusugan, sila ang ating maaasahaan kaya kailangan natin silang bigyan ng pagpapahalaga," Go added. (PR)

NOVELETA-MAKATI P2P BUS SERVICE OPENS TO COMMUTERS

NOVELETA, Cavite — After a month-long delay, the Noveleta-Makati Point-to-Point (P2P) bus service went on its maiden trip Tuesday with embarkation areas in this town going to destination points at the Makati Business District.

In an interview with Philippine News Agency (PNA), Mayor Dino Reyes Chua said the bus operator San Agustin Transport Service Corp. started operating at 6 a.m. Tuesday with a fleet of seven Golden Dragon buses, proceeding from their pick-up terminals in Puregold Noveleta and All Home, Kawit, going to the drop-off point in Trasierra in Makati City.

"This P2P will not only benefit people from Noveleta, but also the nearby towns of Rosario, Kawit, Cavite City, and Tanza," Chua said.

The new transport service has hourly trips starting 6 a.m., with its last trip leaving at 7 p.m.

Meanwhile, vice versa trips from Trasierra to Nov-

eleta starts at 8 a.m. and the last trip taking to the road at 9 p.m.

The P2P transport service charges passengers a flat-rate of PHP120.

"Nagpapasalamat po ako sa Department of Transportation (DOTr) and Land Transport Franchising and Regulatory Bureau (LTFRB) na nabigyan ng aksyon ang aming hiling (We thank the DOTr and LTFRB for acting on our request)," Chua added.

The P2P transport service has scheduled a 15-minute boarding time and its estimated arrival at destination point is about 30 minutes per trip.

The buses will traverse Cavite to NAIA Expressway to Skyway to Trasierra, Makati and vice versa.

Senior citizens and persons with disabilities (PWDs) are entitled to a 20 percent discount and have standard designated seats in the front bus seats, it was explained. **(Dennis Abrina/PNA)**

CA stresses evidence custody rules in drug raps

MANILA — The Court of Appeals (CA) stressed the need for law enforcement officials to implement rules in securing the chain of custody of evidence in drug cases.

In a 20-page decision dated Dec. 20, 2018 and released to the media Wednesday, the CA's ninth division set aside the June 2017 decision of Sorsogon City Regional Trial Court that found respondent Noel Lasca guilty of violation of Section 5 of Republic Act 9165 (Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act).

The CA pointed out officers from the Philippine National Police (PNP) and Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) failed to secure the chain of custody of evidence under Section 21 of RA 9165 when they did not conduct the inventory of the sachets of shabu confiscated from the accused at the place of the seizure due to unavailability of mandatory witnesses.

"In this case, however, the physical inventory of the seized drugs was not immediately conducted at the place of seizure. In fact, the buy-bust team, along with the appellant, had gone to the Burabod Barangay Hall, about 900 meters away from the place of seizure, to conduct the physical inventory," read the ruling penned by Associate Justice Gerar-

dine Fiel – Macaraig.

Associate Justices Apolinario Bruselas Jr. and Myra Garcia-Fernandez concurred in the ruling.

"Given that there are patent irregularities present at the point of seizure, which is the 'fist link' in the chain, there is no more practical value to establishing the unbroken chain of custody to show the integrity and the evidentiary value of the seized items were properly preserved," the court explained.

The CA explained that the "entire rationale of placing witnesses at the scene and conducting an inventory and photographing in their presence immediately after the seizure of the dangerous drugs is to guarantee with moral certainty that the items were indeed recovered from the accused and not planted by the police officers."

The appellate court further held that while RA 9165 provides exemption to the rule, the prosecution in this case failed to sufficiently provide a justification for the violation of the rule by the arresting authorities.

"While, this Court fully supports the State's campaign against illegal drugs, it cannot turn a blind eye to breaches of the requirements under the law and the rules. We hold that it is the core duty of the prose-

MANILA — For crafting effective ordinances and resolutions, the Quezon City Council has been recognized as the most outstanding local legislative body by the Department of the Interior and Local Government-National Capital Region (DILG-NCR) for the third time.

tive agenda, easily accessible information on approved resolutions and ordinances, legislative tracking system, capability development trainings for the councilors and their staff, and innovations such as the "Batas QC" mobile application.

The DILG cited approved measures by the city government that are firsts in the country and were later copied by other cities and the national government.

"Some of our codes and ordinances lauded by the Department of the Interior and Local Government are the road safety code, traffic management code, dangerous drugs code, responsible gaming ordinance, comprehensive socialized housing code, and fair market values ordinance," Belmonte said.

"On behalf of the Quezon City Council, I would like to commend Mayor Herbert Bautista for giving us directives that challenged us to work harder," she added.

Rizal prov'l police chief reinstated, 19 cops face dismissal

CAMP VICENTE LIM, Calamba City — Chief Supt. Edward Carranza, regional director of the Police Regional Office (PRO4A) in Calabarzon, on Wednesday announced the reinstatement of relieved Rizal Provincial Director Senior Supt. Lou Evangelista.

Evangelista, including Cainta chief of police, Supt. Pablito Naganag, and 18 other cops were earlier relieved two days after Atty. Glen Chong's close aide and bodyguard Richard Red Santillan were killed in an encounter in Cainta, Rizal last Dec. 10.

Carranza said an investigation found that Evangelista had nothing to do with the operation so he was reverted back to his position.

PRRD eyes arming mayors vs. NPA attacks

MANILA — President Rodrigo R. Duterte said he plans to allow the purchase of individual firearms so that mayors could protect themselves and their constituents from possible attacks by communist rebels.

In a speech in Masbate City on Wednesday night, Duterte said he is considering allowing local chief executives to purchase firearms to combat the New People's Army (NPA).

"Ako sinasabi ko lang sa NPA, ayaw kong arman ang mga tao. Pero 'pag sige ganun ang ano (I want to tell the NPA, I don't want to arm people. But okay, if they're like that), I will allow the purchase of individual firearms," Duterte said.

"Pati 'yung mga mayor bigyan ko 'yan ng armas talaga. Wala

On Dec. 12 last year, Carranza ordered the relief of Evangelista and Naganag "to ensure impartiality and preclude any suspicion of undue influence by the two police officials in the ongoing administrative investigation being conducted by the Rizal Provincial Internal Affairs Service (PIAS)" related to the incident.

Meanwhile, the regional police office's internal affairs office said investigations are being conducted on 19 Calabarzon (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) erring cops who are currently facing dismissal proceedings, which are part of the police continuing internal cleansing program. **(PNA)**

The President repeatedly vowed to provide communist rebels with housing and livelihood if they lay down their arms and return to the government fold.

Earlier, Malacañang described the 50-year insurgency as a "failed rebellion" as members of the NPA are ageing and declining in numbers. **(PNA)**
