Layon nito na malaman ng isang tao sa pamagitan ng kanyang mga kakainin kung ilang calories content sa isang pagkain o inumin ang dapat nitong i-intake upang mapangalagaan niya ang kanyang kalusugan.

Paliwanang ni Janairo na nakahiligan na ng mga tao ang kumain sa mga fast food chain partikular

ang French fries kung saan ito ay may 300 calories intake.

“Paano yan kung kakain ka ng tatlong beses na French fries, nangangahulugan na 900 calories content na ito, paano pa yung pagkain mo ng chicken at pag-inom ng soft drink eh ang required lamang sa katawan natin ay 1,200 calories intake per person/day” ayon kay Janairo.

Dagdag pa ni Janairo na isa itong awareness sa tao, dahil kung kakain siya, malalaman niya kung ilang calories content ang required niyang i-intake sa kanyang katawan o yung tinatawag na BMI (body mass index) at makontrol niya ito.

Yes, There's Life After Retirement: Kumikitang Kabuhayan ng mga Lolo't Lola ng Tanza, Navotas City

Tuwing sasapit ang panahon ng Kapaskuhan, sagana ang iba't ibang negosyo, maliit man o malaki. *Peak Season* ika nga kung ituring ang panahong ito, lalo na at naghahanap ang mga tao ng magaganda at kakaibang mga bagay para ipangregalo.

Kabilang sa mga makabuluhang produktong pwedeng-pwedeng ipangregalo ngayong Pasko o maging sa ibang okasyon ay ang mga likha ng senior citizens ng Tanza, Navotas City. Kaya't malaki ang pasasalamat ng mga senior citizens ng Barangay Tanza Office of Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) sa ibinibigay na tulong sa kanila ng Department of Science and Technology-National Capital Region (DOST-NCR).

Pagpasok pa lamang sa kanilang opisina, bubungad na ang iba't ibang tela at ang ilang makinang panahi. Abalang-abala ang mga tao sa paggawa at pagtatapos ng mga order para sa Kapaskuhan. Ayon sa mga masisipag na lolo't lola, hindi na nila kailangan pang pumunta kung saan saan para ilako ang kanilang produkto, dahil sila na mismo ang pinupuntahan ng mga parokyano sa kanilang opisina upang mamili. Biro nila, sa ganda ng takbo ng kanilang negosyo, at sa bilis ng pag-asenso ng pananahi ng mga senior citizens ng Tanza, ay mukhang kakailanganin na raw nilang mas palakihin pa ang kanilang opisina.

Sa kasalukuyan ay 20 mananahi ang direktang nakikinabang sa proyektong ito. Karamihan sa kanila ay nagtatrabaho sa sarili nilang mga tahanan at sa sarili nilang bakanteng oras. Kabilang sa mga produktong tinatahi nila ang mga punda ng unan, kobre-kama, kurtina at maging mga T-shirt. Naglalaro ang kanilang presyo mula sa 30 pesos para sa punda ng unan, hanggang 450 pesos para sa magandang klase ng kobre-kama. Ang kinikitang mula sa bawat produkto ay hinahati sa tatlong bahagi: humigit-kumulang 70 porsiyento ang ibinabalik bilang puhunan, 25 porsiyento ang napupunta sa mananahi, at ang natitirang 5 porsiyento ay napupunta sa OSCA para sa mga gastos sa operasyon ng opisina.

Ayon kay Gng. Violy Reyes, presidente ng Barangay Tanza Senior Citizens Chapter, “*Napakalak-ing bagay ang naitulong sa amin ng DOST. Hanggang ngayon, mayroon pa rin silang itinutulong sa amin. Una, binigyan kami ng makina; ngayon pati materyales binigyan na rin kami. Hanggang ngayon kumikita kami. Nakakutulong ito nang malaki sa mga mananahi at sa mga kapwa ko senior.*”

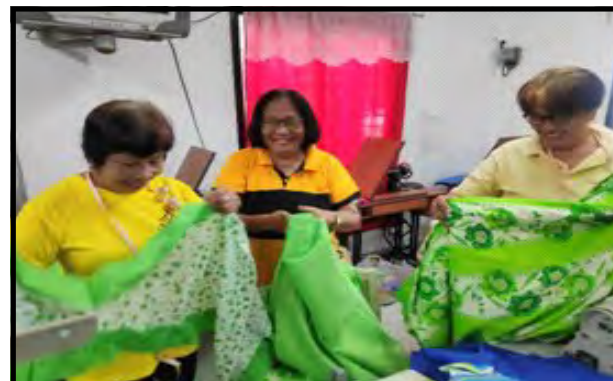
Taong 2016 nang ipagkaloob ng DOST-NCR sa Barangay Tanza Senior Citizens Chapter ang ilang makinang panahi: tatlong single needle high-speed sewing machines, at tig-iisang edging machine, computerized embroidery machine, at cutting machine. Ang mga nasabing makina ay patuloy pa ring nagbibigay-tulong-pinansiyal sa mga senior citizens ng Tanza kahit pa nga sila ay mga retirado na.

Nito lamang buwan ng Disyembre ay muling binigyan ng tulong ang mga senior citizens ng Tanza sa pamamagitan ng mga karagdagang tela at materyales na magagamit nila sa kanilang mga likhang produkto. Ang lahat ng mga ito ay bahagi ng programa ng DOST na Community Empowerment thru Science and Technology o CEST na naglalayong makapagbigay ng kabuhayan at makatulong sa pagbawas ng kahirapan sa mga komunidad sa pamamagitan ng siyensiya at teknolohiya.

Dagdag pa ni Gng. Reyes, “*Ginugol ko ang buhay ko para rito (sa organisasyong ito). Wala na akong iniisip kundi diyan na lang sa mga senior. Pero umuwi ako nang masaya... nagtatrabaho kami habang nagtatawanan lang, naglililang, pero pagkatapos, aba!, mayroon na kamiing pera. Para sa akin, hindi dapat yung umaasa lang ang mga matatanda sa bahay. Ang dapat ay iniisip natin kung ano pa ba ang magagawa natin habang malakas pa tayo. Mag-o-otsenta na ako sa March, pero natutuwa ako at pinapayagan pa rin ako ng mga bata kasi nakikita nilang nag-e-enjoy ako. Pakiramdam ko ay may silbi pa ako; at kahit may edad na, tuloy pa rin ang buhay.*”

GO BATS EMPOWERMENT OF BARANGAY TANODS VS. DRUGS CRIME

CAVITE — Former Special Assistant to the President (SAP)

Christopher Lawrence “Bong” Go on Tuesday cited the need to empower barangays by allowing them to hire more tanods (village watchmen) as they need.

“Minsan, kulang talaga

ang tanod para mapanatili ang kapayapaan at kaayusan sa isang lugar, lalong-lalo na sa mga malalaking barangay at sa mga lugar na sadyang mas maraming kaso ng droga at krimen,” Go said during the Ugnay-

an sa Barangay event held at Barangay Queens Row Central in Bacoor City, Cavite.

Go said he acknowledges that the maximum allowable number of tanods per barangay, currently limited by existing laws, may be inadequate to tackle the needs of various communities.

Go is also pushing for a Magna Carta for Barangay Officials that he vows to push for in the Senate.

For barangay workers and officials, Go said they deserve to have the same benefits that other government employees receive.

“Plano kong asikasuhin na mabigyan kayo ng tamang suweldo at mga benepisyo para mapadali ang pagharap ninyo sa mga pangangailangan ng tao,” Go said.

Go was welcomed by the entourage of former Cavite Governor Juanito Victor “Jonvic” Remulla, Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla, other provincial government officials, local leaders, and residents of Bacoor city.

Apart from discussing the needs of those serving their barangays, Go said a Malasakit Center will soon be opened in Cavite to serve local patients in need of quick medical and financial assistance.

“Magkakaroon talaga kayo ng Malasakit Center dito sa Cavite,” Go told event attendees.

“Kung may Malasakit Center na po kayo sa loob ng ospital, sa iisang kuwarto, (naroon) na po ‘yung representative ng DOH, DSWD, PAGCOR PSCO, at PhilHealth,” Go added.

The Malasakit Center is a one-stop shop initiative started by the former presidential aide and President Rodrigo Duterte where affordable and quality health-care services are made accessible to everyone.

In the center, satellite offices of Philhealth, DOH, DSWD, PCSO, and other relevant government agencies are housed in one location, making application and processing faster and easier for patients in need.

Ospital ng Imus fully operational by Jan. 24

IMUS CITY, Cavite — The city’s public hospital, Ospital ng Imus (ONI), would be fully operational by Jan. 24.

An advisory from the city mayor’s office said the hospital would start admitting patients to its 22 wards and 19 private rooms with 130 beds.

The PHP300 million, three-story hospital, which stands on a donated 4,000 square meter lot, had its soft launch on October 12 last year, with services limited to emergency and outpatient care.

ONI, a level 1 hospital with major and minor operating capabilities, pro-

vides ancillary services such as laboratory, x-ray, and ultrasound.

The new state-of-the-art hospital, the first public hospital in the district, aims to provide quality, affordable and accessible healthcare.

Dr. Edgardo Figueroa, hospital chief, will lead a team of at least 20 doctors, 25 nurses and 15 consultants, including specialists on its services.

There are also plans to construct a Medical Arts Building worth PHP35 million near the hospital. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

on agriculture, housing, improved health service delivery, education, long-term sports development, localized peace talks, anti-drug and crime drive, anti-corruption drive, fire protection and prevention, creation of a Department of OFWs, as well as the creation of an office for senior citizen concerns. **(PR)**

If elected to the Senate, Go said he would legislate for the establishment of Malasakit Centers in more provinces and urban centers throughout the country.

Go also guaranteed local officials and residents of Barangay Queens Row Central that he would continue serving as the people’s link to President Duterte.

“Gaya ng sinabi ni Governor Remulla, ako po ‘yung maging tulay ninyo kay Pangulong Duterte,” Go said.

“Asahan niyo po, ‘yung Cavite po, pagdating ng panahon, di po kayo mapapabayaan: sa proyekto, sa atensyon, sa lahat po,” Go added.

Among the former presidential aide’s legislative agenda include programs

MOU FOR SILANG GREEN ENERGY PROJECT SIGNED

SILANG, Cavite — Waste management will no longer be a problem for this municipality after its local government signed a memorandum of agreement (MOU) with **Trashtalk Phil. (Waste Management and Green Solution Inc.)** for the implementation of a green energy project.

Under the MOU forged on Tuesday, the investor **Trashtalk** will put up waste-to-energy facilities in Barangay Biluso for the biodegradable-to-energy plant that can be used by households, the national grid or independent power suppliers.

"It's a big help to our town. It will address the pressing waste problem of our town and the whole nation, as well," Mayor **Lourdes 'Omil' Poblete** said in

an interview.

"We want the municipality of Silang to be the first local government unit to have a green energy project," she said.

Plant construction will start this month and is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

The green energy project will be undertaken in cooperation with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Department of Science and Technology, and Department of Energy.

Dr. Crispina Corpuz, consultant to the mayor, said when this project goes in full operation, it will reduce by 30 percent to 40 percent some 150 tons of waste collected and will save about PHP20 million of the PHP80 million annual budget on waste.

PDEA eyes saving street children hooked on solvent

QUEZON CITY (PIA) — The Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) is eyeing on saving street children hooked on solvent with the launching of its "Sagip Batang Solvent"

project soon.

PDEA Director General **Aaron N. Aquino** said "Sagip Batang Solvent" will rescue street children sniffing solvent and provide relief from

their addiction so that they could become productive citizens in the future.

He said the primary objectives of the project include: saving children involved in illegal drug activities (CIIDs); provide shelter/facility to CIIDs; provide reformatory and reintegrated interventions to CIIDs; and develop resistance to drug use among CIIDs; and change CIIDs to productive citizens.

"Just go around the thoroughfares of the metropolis and you see children sniffing inhalants like a normal display of feat," **Aquino** said.

The PDEA chief also said that the street children will be provided with reformatory and reintegrated interventions like education, counseling, and values formation, skills development, livelihood and entrepreneurship training.

Besides rescuing solvent-inhaling street children, **Aquino** sees the project as one of the measures to prevent ju-

venile delinquency.

PDEA will establish a model reformation center for the rescued 'batang solvent' to be completed in February 2019. The pilot reformation center will be in a rented facility in **Quezon City** which will have bedrooms, mess hall, kitchen, comfort rooms, receiving and entertainment room, study room, library, multipurpose hall, music room, garden, playground, security and staff to manage the facility.

Aquino pointed that priority targets for this project are children (male and female) aged 10 years old and below, adding that PDEA aims to establish a reformation center in each of the regional offices nationwide.

Likewise, PDEA will tap other government agencies, local government units, non-government organizations, private sector and other stakeholders as partners in this initiative. **(PIA-NCR)**

Olongapo court places Hanjin under corporate rehab

MANILA — An Olongapo court has formally declared cash-strapped shipbuilder, **Hanjin Heavy Industries and Construction Philippines Inc. (HHIC Phil.)**, under corporate rehabilitation.

In a four-page "commencement order" dated Jan. 14, **Olongapo Regional Trial Court Branch 72 Judge Richard A. Paradeza** acted on the firm's petition filed under **Republic Act 10142**, otherwise known as the "Financial Rehabilitation and Insolvency Act of 2010".

In the stay/suspension order, which formed part of the court directive, the **Olongapo court** suspended all actions or proceedings in court or otherwise for the enforcement of all claims against **HHIC Phil. Inc.**

It also "suspends all actions to enforce any judgment, attachment or other provisional remedies against **HHIC Phil Inc.**," and "prohibits **HHIC Phil Inc.** from selling or disposing (of) its properties except in the ordinary course of business", as well as prohibits the firm from making any payment of its outstanding liabilities.

The court also ordered the creditors, government agencies and all interested parties to file a comment on Feb. 8 and prohibited **HHIC Phil. Inc.**'s suppliers of goods and services from withholding the supply of the goods and services in the ordinary course of business for as long as **HHIC Phil. Inc.** makes payment for the said goods and services.

The court also authorized **HHIC Phil. Inc.** to pay its regular administrative expenses as they become due and ruled that contracts not confirmed in writing by **HHIC Phil. Inc.** within 90 days following the issuance of the commencement order shall be considered automatically terminated.

The firm located in **Subic Bay in Zambales** employed up to nearly 28,000 persons at its peak before financial woes forced it to trim down its workforce to around 20,000 last year.

Hanjin revealed that it has **USD1.3 billion** in outstanding loans — **USD400 million** from **Philippine banks** and **USD900 million** from **South Korean lenders.** **(PNA)**

PRO 3 reshuffles 16 chiefs of police in Central Luzon

CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, Pampanga (PIA) — Police Regional Office 3 reshuffled a total of 16 chiefs of police in Central Luzon as election period begins.

"The revamp does not automatically mean that the chiefs of police are underperforming in their duties instead they have already stayed in their position for the maximum allowable period of two years," **Police Regional Director PCSupt. Joel Napoleon Coronel** clarified.

Nueva Ecija has the most reshuffled with nine followed by **Zambales** with four, **Bulacan-two**, and **Bataan-one**.

"We are adhering to the

directives of higher headquarters and this movement was deliberated and approved by our Regional Oversight Committee, at the same time it is the nature of police work, especially police officials to be assigned to different fields to further test their capabilities," **Coronel** added.

"I also gave directives to all our provincial/city police offices to go 'tooth and nail' in our aggressive operations against criminals and gun-for-hire syndicates as well as stern implementation of gun ban to ensure the peaceful holding of credible and fair elections this May," the official furthered. **(CLJD-PIA 3)**

DOH, PSH LAUNCH PROGRAM TO CURB HYPERTENSION PREVALENCE

TAGAYTAY CITY, Cavite – The Department of Health (DOH) has partnered with the Philippine Society of Hypertension (PSH) for a joint project initiative aimed at addressing the increasing prevalence of hypertension and non-communicable diseases (NCDs) in Cavite province.

The program, Cardiovascular Risk Assessment and Management Initiative, which is anchored on DOH's Package of Non-Communicable Disease Interventions (PhilPEN) initiative, was officially launched before cardiologists from the public and private sectors at the Taal Vista Hotel here Friday.

In his keynote address, DOH-4A (Calabarzon) Director Dr. Eduardo C. Janairo stressed that "the greater progress in addressing cardiovascular diseases can be achieved through the cooperation of different sectors."

Janairo added that while it can be seen that NCDs are driven both by health and non-health variables, the health sector cannot adequately prevent and control these diseases on its own and a multi-sectoral approach (MSA) is required to establish enabling environments in the community.

"So that healthy choices become the most attractive choice," he said.

Due to the high cost of diagnosis and treatment of hypertension and NCDs, Janairo said a strategic ap-

proach to these diseases relies on early detection and care using cost-effective and sustainable health care intervention that are integrated in the primary health care facilities, such as the barangay health stations, rural health and other community health centers.

"We see our future focusing more on prevention, especially on the four modifiable behavioral risk factors – unhealthy diet, physical inactivity, harmful use of alcohol, and tobacco use," he said.

The joint project, set to pilot in Cavite province, is seen to result in more Filipinos being assessed, screened and diagnosed early to prevent debilitating and sometimes fatal complications.

"Once successful (in its pilot run), we shall look forward to its duplication in the whole Region 4 (Calabarzon and Mimaropa) and eventually in the entire nation," PSH president Dr. Alberto A. Atillano said.

The program seeks to bring down the diseases' prevalence by 3 percent in the next five years.

Hypertension prevalence in adult population (18 years old and above) in the Philippines increased from 11 percent in 1992 to 28 percent in 2013, with high incidence reported in Cavite.

Based on DOH data released in 2009, cardiovascular disease remains one of the leading causes of death in the country, with

170,000 Filipinos dying each year.

Heart attack and stroke are the top killer diseases in the country while 60 percent to 70 percent of Filipinos have not been treated or have seen a cardiologist, according to 2016 data from the Philippine Heart Association.

During the launch, the participants were treated with lectures on the matter.

The participants in the forum, composed of cardiologists from the public and private sectors, expressed their commitment of support for this health initiative. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

"Pahimis" Coffee Festival slated

AMADEO, Cavite — The municipality will officially kick off its annual "Pahimis" Coffee Festival of thanksgiving scheduled on February 22 to 24 with a coffee farmers' symposium next week.

Local tourism officer Jam Medina Tibayan on Friday said the event aims to gather some 350 coffee farmers from this town and neighboring coffee-producing towns of Indang, Silang, Alfonso, Magallanes, Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo and city of General Trias.

The forum set on January 16 will be done in partnership with local tourism council and Philippine Coffee Board, Inc. (PCBI), and will carry the theme Pick Red "Specialty Robusta".

Forum topics include "Bringing Back the Glory of Cavite Coffee," "Organizing Farmers' Cooperative," "Coffee Quality Assessment" and "Women in Coffee".

Meanwhile, the annual "Pahimis" Coffee Festival aims to promote Cavite coffee for domestic and worldwide consumption, and revive the farmers' interest in coffee farming, enhance coffee yields, and attain a competitive coffee price in the world market.

Festival activities include street group and dancing competition, cultural presentations, thanksgiving mass, awarding of the most outstanding coffee farmer, opening of trade fair, and a variety show to entertain revelers.

Amadeo town boasts of 4,508 hectares of coffee farm land, the largest land area devoted to coffee farming in the entire of upland Cavite, thus considered the biggest coffee producer in the province. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

CALAX operations to start a year-early with funding secured

Province of Cavite (PIA) – The Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX) project is seen to start commercial operations of some segments in the Laguna side as early as July 2019 with the funding for the construction and concession secured by a loan.

Metro Pacific Tollways Corp. (MPTC) Chief Financial Officer Christopher Daniel C. Lizo disclosed that the company had closed the P24.2-billion loan with six banks namely: BDO Unibank, Inc.; Union Bank of the Philippines, Inc.; Rizal Commercial Banking Corp. (RCBC); Bank of the Philippine Islands (BPI); Security Bank Corp.,

and Land Bank of the Philippines.

The loan is intended to finish the P35.43-billion (45.29-kilometer) CALAX project, funding the Laguna and Cavite segments.

The first 10 kilometers of CALAX on the Laguna side is scheduled to open in July, a year earlier from schedule while the entrance from the Cavite side might be delayed since substantial right of way from the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) is not yet given.

"Some sections ahead, some sections delayed. We're opening Sections 6 to 8, which is from Mamplasan to Sta. Rosa, July. So that's ahead of schedule... Cavite, admit-

tedly delayed. Kulang pa 'yung right of way [Right of way is still lacking]," explained Mr. Lizo.

Meanwhile, MPCALA Holdings President and General Manager Roberto V. Bontia revealed that the Cavite side is targeted to start construction by first quarter next year.

"They will start hopefully first quarter of next year," he said. CALAX is targeted to open by July 2020 which will connect the Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEx) to the South Luzon Expressway (SLEx) giving much convenience to commuters with reduced travel time from the two points by half from one hour and 30 minutes to forty

DBP partners with LGU GenTri

General Trias City, Cavite (PIA) – The Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) recently entered into a partnership agreement with the local government of General Trias to further improve its administration and provision of services to its constituents.

The undertaking will involve projects for the automation of its human resource and payroll processing and the setting-up of Point-of-Sale system (POS) and internet payment gateway (IPG) facilities.

"With the POS facility, residents and business owners in General Trias City can now pay their real property taxes using debit, credit and prepaid cards, while the IPG would facilitate online acceptance of payments of the taxpayers' real property and business dues," DBP president and chief executive officer Cecilia Borromeo said.

DBP will also install two additional ATMs in the city to

serve the local government's employees and its residents.
