UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAM NG DOH, MATETENGGGA?

PINANGANGAMBAH-ANG matetengga lamang ang Universal Health Care (UHC) program ng Department of Health (DOH).

Sa panayam kay DOH-CALABARZON (Cavite Laguna Batangas Rizal Quezon) Regional Director Eduardo Janairo, posibleng matetengga lamang ang UHC program ng DOH dahil sa kakulangan ng pondo na mag-susustento ng ito.

Paliwanag ni Janairo na sa ginawang pagtalakay, na 75% sa pondo ng nasabing programa ay sagot ng National government na kinuha mula sa naunang Sin Tax Law subalit ang natitira ay kukunin mula sa Sin Tax 2 ng pamahalaan.

Dagdag pa nito na kinakailangang maipasa sa Kongreso at Senado ang panukalang batas para sa SIN Tax 2 na siyang planong pagkukunan ang pondo sa UHC program upang magtuluy-tuloy ito, na nagangahulugan na magdadagdag na naman ng panibagong pagtaas sa pr-

esyo ng sigarilo, alak, soft-drinks at iba pa.

Ayon pa kay Janairo na bagama't panibagong pahirap na naman sa tao ang Sin Tax 2, subalit kinakailangang tangkilikin ito upang may pangkukunan ng pondo ang UHC program.

Bukod sa problema sa pangkukunan ng pondo, sinabi pa ni Janairo na hindi rin kaagad-agad maipapatupad ang nasabing programa dahil kinakailangan pang kumpletuhin ang mga kagamitan dito at dapat na may sapat na kaalaman na ang mga taong magpapatakbo nito.

Umaasa naman si Janairo na pipirmahan na ito ni Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte at sa loob ng 2 hanggang 3 taon ay tuluyan na itong maipapatupad.

Sa ilalim ng UHC, ito ay programa ng pamahalaan kung saan sinisiguro na lahat ng Pilipino ay makatanggap ng libre at de-kalidad na serbisyong medical. **GENE ADSUARA**

Laguna Lake Highway bike lane opens

MANILA — Starting Thursday, cyclists will be able to use the 5.58-kilometer bicycle lane facility along the stretch of the Laguna Lake Highway in Taguig City.

This, after the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and Taguig City officials, headed by Mayor Lani Cayetano and Vice Mayor Ricardo Cruz Jr., formally opened the three-meter wide bicycle lane.

According to DPWH Secretary Mark Villar, the bike lane is protected by a two-meter planting strip to make cycling safe and comfortable for everyone.

"It is our priority to build safe roads and bridges that will also cater to bikers and pedestrians, hence the inclusion of protected bike lanes and sidewalk spaces in our new projects," Villar said in a statement.

Aimed at opening up

transportation, recreation, and health opportunities, the bike lane component was added to the 6.94-kilometer Laguna Lake Highway, which was constructed to serve as an alternative route to EDSA and C-5.

DPWH has allocated PHP1.28 billion for the construction of the highway, including the bicycle lane with provisions of street lights and road safety signage.

The multi-billion structure also features 1.5-meter sidewalks on both sides for pedestrian and an elevated dike to protect the people against flooding.

Likewise, the road can also be used as a temporary evacuation area during the occurrence of floods because of its high elevation.

The four-lane Laguna Lake Highway was completed in November 2018. **(PNA)**

Sentro sa Salin at may espesyalisasyon sa larang ng Araling Pampagsasalin, Panitikang Pambata, at Araling Filipinas (Philippine Studies).

"Maraming salamat sa KWF sa napakahalagang parangal na naghihimok sa mga limitadong iskolar sa Filipino na magsulat sa sariling wika. Kung tutuusin nakakatuwa ang kasalukuyang sitwasyon kung saan nasa gilid ng pagsulat ang wikang pambansa sa larangang akademiko. Sa ganitong parangal hindi lamang kaming mga guro sa Filipino ang mahihimok na gamitin ang sariling wika manapa't maging ang mga siyentipiko at mga iskolar sa iba't ibang larang," bahagi ng mensahe ni Fajilan.

Bilang pagkilala, inabot kay Fajilan ang plake ng pagkilala, palumpon ng bulaklak, gantimpalang salapi na nagkakahalaga ng PHP100,000, at pagkakatagong mailathala ang kaniyang disertasyon sa ilalim ng programang Aklat ng Bayan ng KWF.

Ipinahayag ng KWF na walang itinanghal na nagwagi sa kategorya ng tesis

(masteral). ang Lupon ng mga Hurado ng Gawad Balmaseda 2019 na binubuo nina Dr. Clement Camposano, Dr. Emmanuel C. De Leon, at Dr. Jovino Mirov.

Ang Gawad Julian Cruz Balmaseda ay ang pinakamataas na pagkilala na handog ng KWF para sa natatanging tesis at disertasyon sa agham, matematika, agham panlipunan, at iba pang kaugnay na larang gamit ang wikang Filipino.

Ang parangal ay ipinaganalan bilang pagkilala sa Filipino manunulat na si Julian Cruz Balmaseda dahil sa kaniyang mga natatanging sulatin gamit ang wikang Filipino.

Layunin nito na hikayatin at palaganapin, sa pamamagitan ng mga insentibo, grant at gawad ang publikasyon sa Filipino at ibang mga wika ng Filipinas ng mga akdang orihinal, kabilang ang mga teksubuk at sangguniang materyales sa iba't ibang disiplina.

NHCP LEADS COMMEMORATION OF AGUINALDO'S 55TH DEATH ANNIV

KAWIT, Cavite — Acting Executive Director Ludovico D. Badoy of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) led national, provincial and local officials in commemorating the 55th death anniversary of the country's

first president, Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo, at his former abode-turned-shrine in Kaingen village along Tirona Highway here Wednesday.

The NHCP-managed shrine, acclaimed as a "House of History", served

as "centerstage" for the ceremonies which began with the celebration of a Mass and went on with flag raising and wreath-laying rites. A Philippine Navy (PN) contingent led by Capt. Edwin M. Nera offered military honors.

Aguinaldo's descendants were present in the event, along with provincial political leaders.

Born in Kawit, Cavite on March 22, 1869; Gen. Aguinaldo was the seventh of eight children of Don Carlos Aguinaldo and Doña Trinidad Famy who were in the salt trading business.

His name may be synonymous to a plethora of things arising from his courageous and bold exploits, as well as various accusations against him. Aguinaldo became president at the young age of 29.

NHCP Cavite Cluster Head and Museo ni Emilio Aguinaldo curator Haidee Paulette M. Bedruz told the Philippine News Agency (PNA) that although Aguinaldo wished to live up to 100 years old, he fell short by six years, when at age 94, he succumbed to coronary thrombosis at the Veterans

The late revolutionary president's remains were interred in a tomb built on the grounds of his Kawit residence.

The establishment of the Asocacion de los Veteranos de la Revolucion is one of the great legacies of Aguinaldo, along with his contributions in the founding of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines, in recognition of revolutionary war veterans' valuable services and sacrifices in the quest for independence.

The death commemoration of Aguinaldo serves as a prelude to his sesquicentennial birth commemoration on March 22, which has been declared a national holiday. (**Gladys Pino-PNA**)

Quezon City provides free livelihood, skills training

MANILA — The Quezon City local government is providing free livelihood and skills training as part of its commitment to alleviate poverty in the locality.

This became evident as the Quezon City Council passed a resolution last Monday allowing a facility in Barangay Mariana to be used for free livelihood training and seminars.

Authored by Councilor Raquel Malangen, City Resolution 7632-2018 authorizes Mayor Herbert Bautista to enter into a tripartite memorandum of agreement with the Lion's President League of the Philippines (LPLP) and Barangay Mariana.

The MOA will allow the

LPLP to conduct livelihood training and seminars for the residents at the newly-built two-story training center of the barangay.

"The LPLP has made its representations with Barangay Mariana and the Quezon City government to allow it to continue its advocacy of providing free livelihood and skills training at the Barangay Mariana Training Center," the resolution said.

Under Andanar's leadership, the Philippines was delisted from the Reporters Without Borders' (Reporters Sans Frontières) list of five most dangerous countries for journalists. (**PNA**)

GENTRI STEPS UP ANTI-RABIES DRIVE

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite — The veterinary office here has stepped up its yearly anti-rabies campaign through massive vaccinations of pet dogs and cats in all 33 villages in the city, as preemptive move against the spread of the deadly disease and to ultimately achieve its goal of a rabies-free city.

City Agriculture Officer Neri Marquez said Wednesday that authorities are strengthening the city's dog-registration program and sustaining the mass anti-rabies vaccination in the city "to keep our dogs free from rabies infection that could be fatal to unwitting victims of dog bites."

"We encourage more dog owners to submit their dogs and cats for registration, especially this coming

summer months when most students are on school vacation and their visiting friends are prone to dog bites," Marquez said.

The City Agriculture Office, which also supervises animal control, has seen the registration of some 17,793 dogs and 1,048 felines that were vaccinated in 2018 and is bent on increasing the record by at least 10 percent.

Under the Anti-Rabies Act of 2007, all local government units (LGUs) are required to establish a central database system on the domesticated animal population for the purpose of vaccination.

Meanwhile, Mayor Antonio Ferrer emphasized that a permanent and non-transferable registry shall be provided by the city government unit to all registered dogs and the registration is up for renewal yearly. **(Dennis Abrina/PNA)**

QUEZON REMAINS TOP AGRICULTURAL PRODUCER IN REGION 4-A

LUCENA CITY, Quezon — The provincial government, through the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPA), has vowed to increase farm production and income through sustainable programs and projects.

Provincial Administrator Roberto Gajo presented the latest Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) data indicating Quezon remains as the top agricultural producing province of various farm products in the Calabarzon Region (Region 4-A), which groups Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon.

He said the province's share in the region's 'palay' (rice) production reaches 42 percent while corn production at 75 percent; fruits — 26 percent; coconuts — 86 percent;

and vegetables — 62 percent.

"Ibig sabihin, sa lawak po ng mga lupain ng lalawigan ng Quezon na pinagayaman ng ating mga magsasaka, nagbigay ito ng kongkretong resulta pagdating sa antas ng produksyon (this means that the vast farmlands of Quezon tilled by our farmers have resulted in concrete results in the high level of production)," he said.

Gajo noted that Governor David Suarez has directed to boost the income not only of the farmers and fisherfolk but also their cooperatives and associations.

He said higher income translates to not just ensuring there is food in the household, but also savings for their daily basic necessities and education

for their children.

Gajo said there are other projects and programs that can provide alternative livelihood and enterprise support services to farmers and the agricultural workers, in partnership with the city and municipal agricultural offices and the Department of Agriculture and Philippine Coconut Authority.

These include processing and production of virgin coconut oil, coconut sap sugar, "lambanog" (coco wine), and copra besides its other by-products.

Gajo further said "Serbisyon ng Suarez sa Agrikultura" (Suarez agriculture services) also promotes other alternative livelihood for farmers, such as the Quezon herbal program which established the Quezon herbal pavilion at the Quezon National Park in Atimonan town.

He disclosed that a year after the herbal program's implementation, the pavilion and the various seminars conducted at the site have drawn around 15,000 tourists and educational and field visitors.

Gajo said the provincial government also provides crop insurance benefits aimed at helping farmers, fisherfolk and the agricultural sector during accidents, calamities and other emergencies, as this sector is highly vulnerable to disasters and climate change.

He identified OPA's various programs in support to the agricultural development strategies of the province, including production enhancement support program; farm mechanization and post-production management program; and agri-enterprise development program. (*Gideon Belen/PNA*)

SC affirms Sandiganbayan HDO vs. Cebu solon

MANILA — The Supreme Court (SC) upheld the travel ban issued by the Sandiganbayan against Cebu (3rd District) Rep. Gwendolyn Garcia over a pending graft case.

"All told, the Sandiganbayan did not commit abuse of discretion, much less grave, in denying the motion for reconsideration and the prayer for the lifting of the HDOs (hold departure orders) issued against the petitioner. The HDOs were validly issued pursuant to its inherent powers as a court of justice," the SC said in a decision dated Oct. 17, 2018 and only made available to newsmen late Monday.

The High Court, through Associate Justice Andres B. Reyes, Jr., turned down the petition filed by Garcia, which questioned the valid-

ity of the HDOs against her on the ground that they were issued before she was able to exhaust her legal remedies and even before there was a final determination of probable cause against her.

The case involved alleged anomalies in the purchase of 10 parcels of land 24.9-hectare property for the provincial government's housing and seaport projects in 2008 when Garcia was Cebu governor.

"In this case the Sandiganbayan acted within its jurisdiction when it issued the HDOs against the petitioner. That the petitioner may seek reconsideration of the finding of probable cause against her by the Ombudsman does not undermine nor suspend the jurisdiction already acquired by the Sandiganbayan," the SC explained. (*PNA*)

Phillip Lacson Medina, chairman of the Sumilang Fiesta Executive Committee and member of the Silang Heritage Council, shared that this year's celebration also marked an event by the faithful community with the Episcopal coronation for the Blessed Mother of Silang by His Eminence Bishop Reynaldo Evangelista of the Archdiocese of Imus on January 31.

Medina said the town was originally established as a parish on Feb. 3, 1595. Thus, present officials of the Silang Parish Council for Culture and Heritage (SPCCH) and the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) filed a petition, through their Parish Priest Marty Dimaranan, before the Imus Bishop who granted the request for the Episcopal coronation in celebration of its 424 years as a parish.

"Credit also goes to various religious organizations with the barangay-based Basic Ecclesial Communities (BEC) who led the fundraising campaign from the faithful, and the proceeds were used to purchase the sterling silver fineries and regalia in honor of the Blessed Mother's devotion to the community of Silang," he added.

DOE vow to assess electric coops' performance fairly

MANILA — The Department of Energy (DOE) assured that it will deliver a fair assessment on the performance of electric cooperatives (ECs), following an announcement that it will review the franchise compliance of ECs nationwide.

"There will be due process for all ECs. Our priority is to address the root causes of their problems and help in their rehabilitation so they may provide the quality of service consumers in their franchise areas truly deserve," DOE Secretary Alfonso Cusi said on Wednesday.

The DOE said last week that it will look into the quality of services delivered by ECs, which is supposed to be government's partners in electrifying far-flung areas, after many ECs have reportedly failed to comply with their mandate.

The DOE named 17 ECs "that have been chronically failing to provide satisfactory services required by their electric distribution franchise". These include DANECO in Davao del Norte, ALECO in Albay, BASELCO in Basilan, CASURECO III in Camarines Sur, FICELCO in Catanduanes, LASURECO in Lanao, MASELCO in Masbate, OMECO in Occidental Mindoro, ORMECO in Oriental Mindoro, PALECO in Palawan, PELCO in Pampanga, SULECO in Sulu, and ZAMCELCO in Zamboanga.

The department noted that even President Rodrigo Duterte has expressed his dismay over the poor power services in Palawan and Masbate.

Residents have reportedly been complaining about the persistent and unresolved brownouts in their areas, even as some ECs are heavily in debt and have been failing to pay creditors.

DOE also said it may cancel the franchises of non-compliant ECs.

"As we seek to attain total electrification of the country by 2020, we will ensure that all operating ECs are providing the best services to their consumers. Our fellow countrymen deserve nothing less," Cusi earlier said.

"We trust that ECs in these problem areas will cooperate with the DOE's constructive efforts to get to the heart of their long running problems. We will work with the ECs in creating and implementing viable solutions for the benefit of their consumers," he added.

ECs and the National Electrification Administration have provided services to 78 provinces, 1,475 cities and municipalities, 36,057 barangays, 123,198 sitios, and 12.71 million household connections according to Philippine Rural Electric Cooperatives Association (PHILRECA).

Meanwhile, PHILRECA, in a statement over the weekend, reacted to Cusi's call for the revocation of the 17 ECs franchises, saying the industry deserves assistance rather than punishment. "We call on Secretary Cusi to treat all electric cooperatives with fairness and justice. We deserve no less," the PHILRECA statement read.

Rather than cancelling the franchises, PHILRECA said it is best for the government to support these ECs by rehabilitating them. (PNA)

DOH warns public against flu

MANILA — The Department of Health (DOH) on Tuesday urged the public to take extra precaution to avoid contracting and spreading the flu virus during the peak months of the flu season.

"Binabantayan natin kung ano iyong strain at talagang by middle of the year nagbabakuna na tayo. Sa Pilipinas ang peak lang talaga ng flu-like illnesses itong panahon na malamig (We're looking at the strain and by the middle of the year we conduct vaccinations. In the Philippines the peak of flu-like illnesses is

this cold weather)," Undersecretary Eric Domingo said in a statement.

The flu season starts in October, peaking from January to February when temperature drops, Domingo said.

Based on DOH records, flu cases in the country have declined in 2018 as compared to the same period in 2017. From Jan. 1 to Dec. 15, 2018, some 153,659 cases of influenza-like illnesses were reported, which is 17 percent lower than the 127,632 cases during the same period in 2017.

The DOH differentiated flu from common cough and cold. It said flu is accompanied by high fever and muscle pains, which last for days.

"Ang nakakatakot lang kasi na gusto nating ma-prevent iyong mga flu na nagkakaroon ng komplikation. Kasi maaari siyang mauwi sa pneumonia at of course maaaring in the end makamatay (What we're wary about is to prevent flu with complications. Because it could lead to pneumonia and of course could lead to death in the end)," Domingo said.

The flu's different strains are contagious once they come in contact

with the body through coughs from another person, holding contaminated objects or touching the mouth or nose.

The public is advised to cover their mouths when coughing or sneezing to prevent the spread of the flu virus as it can be fatal to the human body. If not immediately addressed by a health professional, it could cause severe effects or complications.

The DOH advised the public to keep the immune system strong by:

* Taking more water and fluids like orange juice and six to

eight glasses of water every day.

* Sleeping at least six to eight hours a day

* Making sure to exercise and eat fruits and vegetables

* Making it a habit to wear face mask especially when in crowded places or when travelling to avoid contracting flu virus

The DOH also advised parents to ensure their children's full protection against flu by getting a complete set of vaccination. Senior citizens can get free flu shots in barangay health centers and DOH-accredited hospitals. (PNA)
