LGU-IMUS HOLDS "TRAFFIC SUMMIT 2019 #WALANG FOREVER"

IMUS CITY, Cavite (PIA) – The City Government of Imus initiated the “Traffic Summit 2019 #WALANG Forever” at the City of Imus Training Center, The District-Imus as an effort to provide a solution to the perennial problem with transportation and traffic congestion being the main complaint of its residents.

The city government headed by Mayor Emmanuel Maliksi thru the City of Imus Traffic Management Office takes into consideration the daily struggle of commuting residents of the city particularly the difficulty in taking a ride due to the insufficiency of buses going out to nearby cities in the metropolis as well as the traffic congestion along the city's major thoroughfares.

Based on a survey, illegally parked vehicles along the road, sidewalks used by vendors, tricycles plying the main thoroughfares, undisciplined crossing of pedestrians, unauthorized loading and unloading zones, and the unsystematic manual inter-

vening of traffic aides especially during the rush hours were all identified as contributing factors to traffic congestion.

The summit served as a venue for concerned agencies and stakeholders to share their insights to identify and solve these problems.

Mayor Maliksi encouraged participants to share their ideas on how to lessen the burden and appealed for them, “to be part of the solution not of the problem.”

Heavy traffic congestion is usually experienced along Aguinaldo Highway, the main roads in Bucandala, Bayan Luma, Carsadang Bago, NIA(National Irrigation Administration), Nueno Avenue, Imus Market, Patindig Araw, and Malagasang Coastal/Open Canal.

Mr. Kristoffer John Dakis, Consultant of the Office of the Mayor presented the plans and programs of the Transport and Traffic Framework in hopes to ease the congestion problem. (Ruel Francisco, PIA-Cavite)

SWAD-Laguna offers financial assistance to persons living with HIV

CALAMBACITY, Laguna (PIA) – The Laguna provincial government ensures the welfare of Persons Living with Human Immunodeficiency Viruses (PLHIV) in the province by offering them financial assistance.

“Mayroon po tayong serbisyo para sa mga PLHIV o Person Living with HIV. Mayroon tayong ibinibigay na assistance sa kanila,” (We have services for the PLHIV. We will give them assistance) Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Team Leader Gina Dela Cruz announced during the 1st Quarter Provincial Advisory Committee (PAC) of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)-Laguna.

The PLHIVs in the province may visit the SWAD Office beside the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction

and Management Office (PDRRMO) Building in the town of Sta. Cruz to apply for financial support.

Dela Cruz disclosed that the DSWD has allotted a separate fund for the PLHIV aside from the augmentation provided through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS).

Five thousand pesos (Php 5,000) worth of financial assistance shall be given to each patient. “Ang atin pong protocol ay every after three months po pwede pong lumapit ulit.”

Assistance may be granted every after three months based on DSWD's protocol.

She said they are currently serving a total of five PLHIVs and urges all PLHIVs in the province to seek assistance from their office. (Joy Gabrido, PIA4A)

5 TALAMAK NA TROPICAL DISEASES, MAIIWASAN

SA tamang paghuhugas lamang ng kamay, anim sa 10 talamak na “Neglected Tropical Diseases” (NTD) sa bansa ang posibleng maiwasan, ayon sa Department of Health (DOH)- CALABARZON(Cavite Laguna Batangas Rizal Quezon).

Kabilang sa limang talamak na NTDs sa bansa ay ang filariasis, schistosomiasis, helminthiasis, leprosy, rabies at food and water borne disease.

Ayon kay DOH-CALABARZON Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo, mayroon limang strategy para sa prevention, control at tuluyang pagsugpo ng NTDs sa bansa kabilang ang paggamit ng preventive chemotherapy , intensified management disease management, vector at intermediate host control, veterinary intervention at the human-animal interface provision of safe water

sanitation at hygiene o simpleng paghubugas ng kamay.

Dagdag pa ni Janairo na ang NTD ay hindi prayoridad ng maraming local government units (LGUs) bunsod sa kakulangan ng pondo, tauhan at polisia na susuporta rito at kung walang sapat na kasananay upang masugpo ang sakit ay posibleng tumaas ang kaso nito.

If these health concerns are not properly and immediately addressed , it will continue to contribute to the high prevalence of NTDs in the country,’ ayon kay Janairo.

Ito rin ang dahilan kung bakit nagsagawa ang DOH-CALABARZON ng pag-sasanay ukol sa “Integrated Orientation on Neglected Tropical Diseases and Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (NTD-WASH) sa mga sanitary inspector . GENE ADSUARA

BOC NAIA seizes live venomous tarantulas from Poland

The Bureau of Customs turned over on Tuesday to Wildlife Traffic Monitoring Unit - Department of Environment and Natural Resources (WTMU-DENR) 757 live venomous tarantulas at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA).

These turned over wildlife animals valued at P310, 000.00, were seized by the customs agents of the Port of NAIA on Monday, 1 April 2019 at the Central Mail Exchange Center in Pasay City.

According to District Collector Carmelita Talusan, the 757 live Tarantulas classified as endangered wildlife species were found concealed in gift-wrapped oatmeal and cookies. “The shipment was sent from Poland by a certain Wojciech Pakasz and was consigned to Jesse Camaro, a resident of Caloocan City,” she added.

Violators of Illegal Wild-

life Trading may face imprisonment of one (1) year and one (1) day to two (2) years and a fine of twenty thousand pesos (Php 20,000.00) to two hundred thousand pesos (P200,000.00) based on R.A. 9147 (Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act) and/or three (3) years and one (1) day but not more than six (6) years imprisonment or a fine of not more than three hundred thousand pesos (Php 300,000.00) under unlawful importation pursuant to RA 10863 (Customs Modernization and Tariff Act).

From 2018 up to present, BOC-NAIA has turned over to DENR a total of 2,152 wildlife and endangered species including the 250 geckos, 254 corals and other endangered reptiles which were apprehend thru air parcels, baggage and shipments. Recently, 63 iguanas, chameleon and bearded dragons were also intercepted through the efforts and vigilance of the frontliners and operatives of BOC-NAIA.

In March 2019, the Bureau of Customs was globally recognized for its successful anti-illegal trade efforts which resulted in the seizure of 1,529 smuggled turtles from Hong Kong.

“BOC NAIA will continue to protect the borders against importation and exportation of illegal wildlife trade and other prohibited and anti-social goods,” Talusan stressed.

PhilHealth introduces new claim requirement to ensure quality of care

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) recently introduced a policy to ensure that its members who seek treatment in hospitals are provided with health care services that are of the desired quality and at par with existing medical standards. In its PhilHealth Circular No. 2019-0002 entitled “Documentary Requirements for Claims Reimbursement and Medical Prepayment Review of Claims (Revision 2),” the state health insurer prescribes a medical pre-payment review and requires the use of Claim Form 4 (CF4) for all admissions starting March 1, 2019. Medical pre-payment review is done prior to actual processing, wherein claims that are not compensable as well as those that are not compliant with existing policies and standards on quality of care shall no longer be processed. The review shall be based on data from the CF4 which summarizes a patient’s pertinent clinical information. The submission of the CF4 eliminates the submission of voluminous complete clinical charts for claims reimbursements. The policy does not preclude submission of other documents if necessary. The new policy shall cover claims using case rates with the exception of directly filed claims those for confinements abroad and claims for Z Benefits, among others. The new system enables PhilHealth to efficiently assess provider claims and to detect irregular practices such as

over utilization or under-utilization of services; unnecessary use of diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and interventions; irrational medication and prescriptions; fraudulent, false or incorrect information; gross or unjustified deviations from currently accepted standards of practice and/or treatment protocols; inappropriate referral practices; use of fake, adulterated, misbranded or unregistered drugs; among others. “With this new policy, we aim to maximize our limited human and financial resources to promptly act on good and compliant claims. This also translates to faster turnaround time for claims processing, and good health outcomes for our patients.” PhilHealth Acting PCEO Dr. Roy B. Ferrer explained


The Policy, signed last Feb 8,2019, allowed for a transition period for the month of March for hospitals to align and update their systems. To help HCIs in adapting to the new system, PhilHealth allowed facilities with eClaims systems to transmit the encoded CF4s of admissions starting March 1, 2019, while other HCIs may still use available offline applications provided by PhilHealth. On the other hand, those manually submitting claim applications shall submit soft copy of encoded CF4 together with manually transmitted claim application. Claims submitted to PhilHealth without the required CF4 shall be returned to the hospital for compliance starting April 1.

CAVITE PROVINCE REGISTERS HIGHEST DENGUE CASES IN CALABARZON

DOH -CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) yesterday reported a total of 5,616 cases of Dengue Fever in the region from January 1, 2019 - March 16, 2019 with 18 deaths recorded as presented during the Regional Consultative Meeting and Updates on Vector-Borne Disease Program for Provincial and City Coordinators held at the BSA Twin Towers, Ortigas Center, Mandaluyong City from March 20-22, 2019.

According to the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (RESU), the province of Cavite has the highest number of dengue cases with 1,788 followed by Batangas with 1,248 and Laguna with 1,135; Quezon with 823 and Rizal with 622 cases.

This year's number of cases is 1% lower compared to the same period last year with 5,603 cases. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 100 years old. Majority of the cases were males with 2,990 cases (53%).

Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated the

regional office and the local government units are continuously monitoring the increasing dengue cases and all logistics are in place should there be a surge in the number of cases.

"We have deployed Regional Vector Control Spraymen to barangays with high incidence of Dengue cases and also trained sanitary inspectors and spraymen of Laguna and the top 10 municipalities/cities with dengue cases on the preparation and application of insecticides for Dengue control such as misting/fogging and residual spraying, for outbreak response," Janairo disclosed.

Among the top 10 cities and municipalities with the most number of Dengue cases in CALABARZON are Dasmarinas (339), Lipa City (276), Bacoor (261), Batangas City (255), Calamba City (239), Imus (218), Lopez (217), San Pablo City (203), Tanauan City (176) and General Trias (171).

"We are already making rounds in the provinces to ensure that Dengue Fast Lanes are established and

functional in all hospitals, and also to ensure that Dengue NS1-RDT are available to all health centers and public hospitals to be used for the early detection of dengue disease," he emphasized.



PAO asks SC to consolidate Dengvaxia cases in QC court

MANILA — The Public Attorney's Office (PAO) on Thursday asked the Supreme Court (SC) to consolidate before one court the criminal and civil cases in connection with the deaths allegedly arising from the Dengvaxia anti-dengue vaccine.

In a 25-page suit, families of victims whose criminal complaints were among the initial batch of criminal cases ordered by the Department of Justice (DOJ) filed before various courts with the help of the PAO asked the tribunal that the cases instead be transferred and consolidated before the Family Court of Quezon City.

The cases are now pending before the Quezon City Metropolitan Trial Court (MeTC); San Pedro, Laguna Municipal Trial Court (MTC); Muntinlupa City MeTC; Balanga, Bataan MTC; and Caloocan City MeTC.

The PAO also sought the designation of a special court under the Quezon City

Regional Trial Court to hear and decide on Dengvaxia civil cases.

PAO chief Persida Rueda-Acosta said she sees more cases filed in the coming days and informed the SC that the office has already identified 120 deaths in connection with Dengvaxia.

"Considering the declaration of Sanofi of the adverse effects of the Dengvaxia vaccine, there is a great probability that more deaths will occur in the succeeding days, thus, the filing of more cases involving death of Dengvaxia recipients is not remote," Acosta said.

"Neither undue advantage to nor prejudice to the substantial rights of any of the parties will result from joining the trial of the instant cases. On the contrary, all parties, both the prosecution and the defense, as well as the court, will benefit from conducting a joint trial as it will save them time, expense and hardship entailed in conducting multi-

To further improve the Malaria service in the region, DOH-CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) provided equipment to the five Malaria Elimination Hubs located in the provinces to be used for diagnostic and entomological training, quality assurance, and research and development.

"We need to have reliable diagnosis, highly effective and appropriate treatment and preventive measures to manage and implement malaria interventions," he emphasized.

He also reminded local health officials to make sure that the donated equipments will also have funds

for preventive maintenance and preservation. for immediate response." Among the equipments donated were stereoscope microscope, desktop computer package with printer and uninterruptible power supply (UPS), chinstrap, coverall, faceshield, global positioning system (GPS), gloves, hard hat, visor bracket and carabao bait trap (CBT).

In CALABARZON, only two provinces were declared as Malaria free namely, Cavite, and Batangas.

According to the 2018 Malaria status, there is a total of 4,933 cases reported. From this figure, 4,847 were local cases and 86 were imported cases. The National Capital Region has 27 confirmed cases and CALABARZON has 7 confirmed cases recorded. Palawan accounts for 94% of the cases.

Malaria Elimination Hubs are established in epidemic-risk and malaria free provinces/cities with the responsibility of overseeing and sustaining malaria-

free status of different respective provinces and cities.

The hubs will ensure anti-malaria interventions in areas with stable and unstable transmission of malaria, and shall sustain provisions of anti-malarial diagnostic, treatment and preventive measures in epidemic-risk, malaria-prone and malaria-free areas. It will also ensure that anti-malaria services are accessible to all clients and community members even in malaria-prone or malaria-free areas.

The Philippines envision the country to be Malaria Free Philippines by 2030. The goal is to reduce malaria incidence in the Philippines by 90% in 2022.

Currently, there are 50 provinces declared as malaria free, 27 provinces in various malaria stage elimination and 4 provinces with Malaria cases recorded according to the National Malaria Elimination Program. **BN**

Supreme Court, like in the past, will and shall not tolerate any illegal or corrupt activities within its ranks," the SC said.

At least 13 judges and 10 prosecutors are supposedly on the narco-list.

Two years ago, the SC initiated a probe on the first batch of judges on the narco-list — Exequiel Dagala of the Dapa-Socorro, Surigao Municipal Circuit Trial Court; Adriano Savillo of the Iloilo City Regional Trial Court (RTC); Domingo Casiple of the Kalibo, Aklan RTC; and Antonio Reyes of the Baguio City RTC.

Dagala was cleared of allegations of involvement in the illegal drug trade, but he was ordered dismissed by the High Court in September 2017 for immorality and gross misconduct.

Savillo and Casiple were likewise cleared of involvement in illegal drugs.

Meanwhile, the SC ordered in February 2017 the filing of administrative charges against Reyes for corruption for allegedly dismissing a drug case in exchange for a sum of money. (PNA)
