SECURITY PREPARATIONS FOR MAY 13 POLLS 'ALL SET': PNP

MANILA — More than a week before the campaign period wraps up, the Philippine National Police (PNP) said security measures are all set as 160,000 police personnel will be deployed for the May 13 mid-term elections.

Col. Bernard Banac, PNP spokesperson, said the police force will remain on full alert status which took effect before the beginning of the Holy Week in April.

The number of police personnel was initially pegged at 143,000 but was eventually raised to further boost the peace and order management before, during and even after the Election Day.

"The PNP remains in full alert and increased the deployment of cops to 160,000 personnel as we assure the public that focused operation will be more active and intensified campaign against PAGS criminal gangs, wanted persons, gun for hire groups, and loose firearms

and violation of Comelec (Commission on Elections) gun ban through service of warrant of arrest and implementation of search warrants, checkpoints operations, police patrol response, 'Oplan Sita' and 'Oplan Galugad' as well as HVTs (high value targets) in illegal drugs," Banac told reporters in a press conference on Thursday.

Despite the increase of police deployment, Banac reiterated the PNP is yet to monitor any threats for the upcoming elections.

"We have not monitored any threats on the elections so far. We want to ensure no untoward incident will take place," Banac said.

PNP chief, Gen. Oscar Albayalde earlier reminded police officers to stay neutral and non-partisan in the conduct of elections.

He said the only role of police officers in the upcoming elections is to ensure peace and security, especially in election hotspots.

For his part, Department of Interior and Local Govern-

ment (DILG) spokesperson, Undersecretary Jonathan Malaya, said the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP) is also ready to assist the more than 44,000 persons deprived of Liberty (PDLs) in the city, district, and municipal jails in the country exercise to right of suffrage on May 13.

Malaya also said the DILG is one with Commission on Election (Comelec) in encouraging Filipinos to go out and exercise their right to vote.

"Indeed, change is within our hands. Nasa kamay na po ng mga mamamayan Pilipino ang pagpili ng mga kandidato (It is up for the Filipinos to choose candidates) (whom) they believe will usher the nation to inclusive change to achieve (our ambition of a prosperous and peaceful life for everyone). Huwag natin sayangin ang pagkakataong (ito) at lalong huwag po tayong pumayag sa vote-buying at vote-selling na ginagawa ng mga hindi matitinan kandidato. (Let's not waste this chance and let's not allow vote-buying and vote-selling perpetrated by deceitful candidates)," Malaya said. **(PNA)**

No pre-shaded ballots for May 13 polls: Comelec

MANILA — An official of the Commission on Elections (Comelec) on Thursday said there is no truth to allegations that official ballots for the May 13 mid-term elections have been pre-shaded.

Comelec Executive Director Jose Tolentino Jr. denied claims that the ballots have been marked using ultraviolet (UV) inks, making them invisible to the naked eye.

"We tested. The marks using UV inks weren't read by the VCM, which looks for a black ink or those that are always visible so to speak," he said in a press briefing.

Tolentino said there is a video circulating on social media, claiming that the ballots were marked by UV inks, making them pre-shaded but hidden.

The video also alleged that the hidden marks can only be seen using UV lamps.

"The ballots have QR codes, serial number, and precinct assignment. It was obviously a staged video because it doesn't have those features. It was a waste because they already staged a video yet they used the wrong ballot prop," Tolentino said.

He noted that those behind such activities will be held accountable.

"Once we know who they are, yes, of course," the Comelec official added.

Meanwhile, Tolentino said the three source codes of the remaining components of the automated election system (AES) have been deposited in escrow with the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas, as required by the Poll Automation Law.

The codes are the Operating System (OS) image rebuild for the Consolidation and Canvassing System (CCS), Transmission Router, and the Domain Name Server (DNS) Janitor.

"To be escrowed are the remaining source codes that were reviewed and certified by our international certification entity and were also reviewed by our local source code reviewers," he said.

"No one have found or said that they found that there is any malicious code embedded in the source codes," Tolentino added.

The source codes for the Election Management System, CCS, and the vote counting machines were first deposited last February. **(PNA)**

NPC scores media orgs with 'foreign funding'

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite - Hundreds of job seekers trooped on Thursday to the Robinson's Place activity center in Barangay Tejero here for a post-Labor Day Job Fair organized by the city government.

In an interview with PNA, GenTri Public Employment Service Office (PESO) head Ariel Mugol said the "My Only and Only Job Fair" was organized to extend as much assistance as possible to those seeking domestic and overseas employment.

Job seekers swarm GenTri Job Fair 2019

MANILA — The National Press Club of the Philippines, on the eve of World Press Freedom Day, criticized media outfits and organizations for allegedly receiving foreign funding for operations.

"And here, we are referring to the fact that for many years now, other media organizations are directly receiving from foreign sources to fund their activities, particularly from front organizations identified with the United States' Central Intelligence Agency and from non-government organizations based in Europe," NPC said in a statement Thursday.

Citing "available facts", the group named five media outlets "as direct beneficiaries of foreign largesse running in the millions of pesos each year."

"The issue of legality and constitutionality of such sordid practices aside, they are ethically indefensible and

morally reprehensible," it stressed.

The NPC also accused the groups of committing "the worst form of corruption when they started accepting what amounts to as bribe money from foreign interests."

"The result is a people divided, a government unable to focus on its job of good governance and a profession — our profession — fast losing its credibility and standing as a pillar of our democracy."

Asked for the basis of their accusations, Paul Gutierrez, NPC vice chairman said: "Actually we were intrigued by, una 'yong mga column ni Bobi Tiglao then sumunod may nilabas (doon sa) Thinking Pinoy. Ako on my part personally, titingnan ko rin mismo 'yong website na pinagsasabi nya and it appears there."

Hours before the statement's release, one of the organizations identified to have received foreign money underscored that the Constitution only bans foreign ownership, not funding. **(PNA)**

MGA HEALTH WORKERS SA CALABARZON, SINANAY SA PAGTUROK NG INSULIN

SUMAILALIM ang may 120 na mga health workers mula sa CALABARZON (Cavite Laguna Batangas Rizal Quezon) ng pag-sasanay ng Department of Health (DOH) para sa tamang pagturok ng Insulin sa mga pasyenteng may sakit na diabetes.

Ayon kay DOH-CALABARZON Regional Director Eduardo Janairo, ang mga health workers ang mga first line responders sa mga Rural Health Units (RHUs) na siyang takbuhan ng mga pasyenteng may sakit na diabetes kaya nararapat lamang na matuto ang mga ito sa tamang pagturok ng Insulin.

"We need to provide our health workers who are the first line responders at the Rural Health Units (RHUs) the proper knowledge in insulin administration to avoid delays in the treatment and management of diabetic patients who resides in the provinces," ayon kay Janairo.

Ayon sa datos ng Philippine Society of Endocrinology Diabetes and Metabolism (PSEDM), noong taon 2016 ay mayroon 3.5 million na mga adults ang may diabetes, 1.8 million dito ay undiagnosed at mula sa numerong ito, 65.6% na mga Filipinong babae ay obese.

Paliwanang pa ni Janairo na ang diabetes ang pang-lima sa nangungunang pabigat na sakit sa bansa kung saan gumagastos ang pamahalaan ng P20.4 billion para sa paggagamot at mga kumpilikasyon nito o P295 thousand annually/pasyente at mababawasan ito sa blood glucose control gamit ang insulin.

Kabilang ang mga Nurses, provincial and municipal health officers, non-communicable disease (NCD) coordinators mula sa iba't ibang probinsya ng rehiyon ang matagumpay na pumasa sa pag-sasanay. **GENE ADSUARA**

Calabarzon economy grows 7.3% in 2018, fastest in 6 years

MALVAR, Batangas — The economy of Calabarzon (Region 4A) grew at 7.3 percent in 2018, the fastest in six years, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) reported.

PSA-Calabarzon Regional Director Charito Armonia said the acceleration was brought about by the faster growth of Industry and Services, as well as the turn-around performance of Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishing (AHFF).

The Calabarzon region is second in terms of the largest share of the country's Gross Domestic

Product (GDP) at 17 percent.

In the GDP growth rate of 6.2 percent in 2018, National Capital Region contributed the most with 1.8 percentage points, followed by Calabarzon with 1.2 percent.

Among the three major economic sectors, Industry continued to account for the largest share at 62.3 percent of the region's economy; followed by Services with 32.9 percent share. AHFF had the least share of 4.8 percent.

Industry grew at a faster pace with 7.9 percent in 2018, from 7.8 percent in 2017. It was mainly driven

by the upswing of the Manufacturing sub-industry to 8 percent growth from the 7.4 percent growth in the previous year.

Construction also contributed to the upward trend in Industry, recording a growth of 9.5 percent, although slower than the 15.6 percent growth in 2017.

Electricity, Gas and Water Supply posted a faster growth of 3.9 percent in 2018 from 3.4 per-

cent in 2017. Mining and Quarrying accelerated to 3.5 percent in 2018 from 1 percent in 2017.

Out of the 7.3 percent growth of the region in 2018, Industry remained the biggest contributor of 4.9 percentage points followed by Services with 2.4 percentage points, while AHFF contributed the least with 0.03 percentage point. **(Maroe T. Geñosa/PNA)**

400 new scholars to benefit from OWWA

QUEZON CITY (PIA) — Some 400 new scholars will benefit from the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration's Education for Development Scholarship Program (EDSP) this coming school year.

OWWA Administrator Hans Leo J. Cacdac said the scholarship grants are meant for children of overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) who have passed pre-qualifying examination administered by the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI).

Eighty-four of the new EDSP scholars came from Region IV-A while the National Capital Region and Region III has 46 each.

Meanwhile, Middle East-based qualifiers from Al Khobar and Riyadh have 21 passers each.

Other qualifiers come from the following regions according to the number of passers: Region VI (43), Region VII (33), Region V (32), Region X (13), Region XI (12), Region XII (10), Regions I and II (9), CAR and Region IX (6), Region IV-B (4), Region VIII (3) and CARAGA with two grantees.

PROFESSIONAL SHARED WORK SPACE OFFERED IN CAVITE

IMUS CITY, Cavite — A shared working space concept might work for micro, small to medium businesses, including freelance professionals and students needing a quiet, presentable and equipped workstation but do not have the means yet to pay for the overhead cost.

City Work Spaces (CSW), a 90-square-meter office space with four rooms, storage area and hallway located at this city's busy side, is offering shared office spaces for a minimal cost.

"We collaborate to achieve," said CWS operations manager Maricris Ansagay on Wednesday, noting the business concept was coined to help individuals or companies who are just starting up to

build up their businesses and limit their overhead cost.

As co-founder of Caviteñaraketeras, a group of freelance businesswomen and service providers who sell "everything under the sun," Ansagay knows that the "struggle is real" in finding a professional work environment to conduct client dealings and do the product presentations and calls.

Aside from the shared spaces, CSW is also a one-stop business center with shared services like photocopy, print, scan, fax, and storage rental. For that important client meeting or business presentation, CWS also has separated private rooms and a spacious training hall, "to help them ink that important deal."

CSW also offers busi-

ness retooling seminars or do collaborative events with its clients to further boost their businesses.



Oversight body looks into solutions vs. power outages

MANILA — The Joint Congressional Power Commission on Thursday convened a public hearing to find solutions to address the recent spate of power outages in Luzon.

The hearing, which was called to order on the heels of the simultaneous power plant shutdowns, was presided by Senate committee on energy chair Sherwin Gatchalian and his House counterpart, Marinduque Rep. Lord Allan Jay Velasco.

Gatchalian said the oversight body would determine the timetable of solutions to prevent another series of brownouts.

Department of Energy Secretary Alfonso Cusi said the agency has been building capacity, noting that it is working to increase the power grid's contingency reserve to 25 percent to cover peak demand in the power system.

"We have been building capacity. We have been encouraging business investors in the energy sector," Cusi said.

Cusi said the agency is also seeking more investments in merchant power plants to further spur competition in the electricity spot market.

Cusi said the government was able to successfully sign a memorandum of understanding with China for several merchant plants to be set up in the Philip-

"They are looking at 600 to 1,200 merchant plants in the country. Instead of giving us a grant, (they would have to) find an investor that would put up a merchant plant. We were able to successfully convince them and it is already in process. It would help us build capacity," Cusi said.

Aside from building capacity, Cusi also stressed the need to revisit the Electric Power Industry Reform Act (EPIRA) law. **(PNA)**

SC affirms guilty verdict vs. suspect in Tacurong car bomb attack

MANILA — The Supreme Court (SC) has upheld the decision of the Court of Appeals (CA) convicting the suspect in the car bomb attack in Tacurong City, Sultan Kudarat four years ago.

In a nine-page resolution dated March 6 penned by Associate Justice Rosmarie Carandang, the SC's Third Division said Datu Karim Masdal's acts constituted the complex crime of double murder, warranting the imposition of the maximum penalty for murder.

The blast which targeted Maguindanao Governor Esmael Mangudadatu's vehicle convoy also killed Maguindanao provincial board member Datu Russman Sinsuat Sr. and civilian Raffy Pareñas.

The Court also affirmed the appellate court's order for Masdal to pay PHP300,000 as civil, moral and exemplary damages for each of the victim.

The tribunal added that following the abolition of the death penalty in the country, it has reduced the penalty of death to reclusion perpetual with no eligibility for pa-

role.

"In the case at bar, the circumstances surrounding the fateful day of August 15, 2011, when the explosion at Alunan Highway led to the death of Pareñas and BM Sinsuat, show an unbroken chain of facts which establish beyond reasonable doubt Masdal's culpability," the Court ruled.

Masdal claimed he was innocent of the charges considering that the prosecution failed to present evidence on how the bomb was detonated and that without this evidence, he should not be convicted of double murder.

Masdal says a certain Montasir merely handed him a cellphone and told him to send a text message once the Mangudadatu's convoy arrives adding that he felt obliged to follow the instruction out of fear for his life.

"To begin with, although Masdal claims that Montasir threatened him into submission, the former failed to specify the extent of the threat given by the latter. He did not mention any serious bodily harm that would have

PNP welcomes suggestions to boost fight against illegal drugs

MANILA — The Philippine National Police (PNP) welcomes all suggestions from different sectors on how to improve law enforcement, particularly the government's campaign against illegal drugs.

At the same time, PNP chief, Gen. Oscar Albayalde also welcomed the release of findings and conclusions of a study made by the Ateneo Policy Center on the PNP anti-drug campaign, particularly on the left-hand approach that encourages drug offenders to submit themselves to voluntary rehabilitation and reform.

"As we have said we are willing to listen and engage all sectors, including the academe, that is concerned and willing to assist the PNP in the fight against illegal drugs. The PNP is always open for any suggestions that will improve on our law enforcement, 'yung aming pagtataas ng standard namin (raising our standards) and how we enforce the law. Malay natin, meron silang (Who knows

they might have a) bright idea, remember they are in the academe," Albayalde told reporters in a press conference Monday.

The PNP chief has directed Maj. Gen. Ma-O Aplasca and Maj. Gen. Benigno Durana Jr., directors of Operations and Police Community Relations, respectively, to get in touch with the proponents of the study for a discussion to further improve the anti-drug campaign.

He stressed that it should be understood that Oplan Tokhang is essentially a Police Community Relations operation that supports the overall anti-drug strategy while in Oplan HVT (high-value target) it is unfortunate that there had been some incidents wherein operations turned awry when the subject offered armed resistance to police intervention.

"Unfortunate situations like these obscured the well-meaning intentions to Tokhang and associated it with violation of certain

rights. And this is how the negative "labeling" of Tokhang started, more so, the bloated figure of 7,000 deaths attributed to it by the Ateneo study," Albayalde said.

"Tokhang is only a strategy which is an innovative approach where previous strategies failed. We understand that it is easier to criticize. We welcome suggestions and even constructive criticism, but only if these can offer a solution," he noted.

Albayalde has assured the public that the PNP remains committed to performing its mandate to enforce the law although some policemen have been accused of human rights violations amid the conduct of anti-drug operations which sometimes result in the killing of drug suspects.

"This is the very reason why we have internal cleansing. To balance our operations to make sure that our operations on the ground will not (result in) abuse and we want to as-

sure the people that we are doing this in order to prevent abuse of power by our law enforcers at the same time perform our mandate. I would like to point out that it is the PNP's constitutional mandate to enforce the law on illegal drugs," said Albayalde.

On Sunday, PNP spokesperson, Col. Bernard Banac said that according to government's records, the "Real Numbers PH," the drug war has so far resulted in 5,281 fatalities from the time it was launched in July 2016 until February 28, 2019.

He said since 2016, a total of 8,440 personnel have already been disciplined for various offenses and illegal acts. Out of this number, he said 4,500 were suspended and 2,600 were dismissed from the service.

Of those dismissed, 322 were found positive for use of illegal drugs and 119 either for coddling, protecting drug suspects or not attending court duties. (PNA)

MMDA reimplements 'heat stroke break' policy for field personnel

QUEZON CITY, April 29 (PIA)—The Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) is reimplementing a policy that allows additional 30-minute daily "heat stroke break" to on-duty traffic enforcers and street sweepers in order to cope with the summer heat.

MMDA Chairman Danilo Lim has signed a memorandum to protect its field personnel from heat exhaustion, heat stroke and heat cramps due to severe

heat wave.

Under the memorandum, traffic enforcers who work in shift 5 am to 1 pm, the prescribed "heat stroke break" is from 10 am to 10:30 am or 10:30 am to 11 am; for those working from 1 pm to 9 pm shift, the break time shall be observed from 2:30 pm to 3 pm or 3 pm to 3:30 pm; and for 2 pm to 10 pm shift, the break time shall be observed from 3 pm to 3:30 pm or 3:30 pm to 4 pm.

For street sweepers who are on-duty from 6 am to 2 pm, the

prescribed "heat stroke break" is from 11 am to 11:30 am or 11:30 am to 12 noon; for 7 am to 4 pm shift, they shall observe 12 noon to 1 pm regular break time; while those working from 11 am to 7 pm shall observe 2:30 pm to 3 pm or 3 pm to 3:30 pm break time.

According to the MMDA chair, on-duty field personnel are allowed to leave their posts in shifts and take a break to allow their bodies

to cool down.

"Heat stroke break shall be done alternately by those who are assigned in a particular area to maintain visibility of traffic enforcers and street sweepers and to ensure that field operations are not hampered," said Lim.

Field personnel may also avail themselves of additional 15-minute break time in case the heat index in Metro Manila reaches 40 degrees Celsius and above.

The policy shall take effect until May 31, 2019. (PIA InfoComm/MMDA)

4 'drug pushers' killed, 8 arrested in Bulacan buy-bust ops

CAMP GEN ALEJO SANTOS, Bulacan —Four drug peddlers were killed and eight other drug suspects were arrested during the simultaneous operations conducted by Bulacan police on Monday and early Tuesday morning.

Col. Chito G. Bersaluna, director of the Bulacan Police Provincial Office, identified the slain drug suspects as Renato Piano alias Intoy, 33, of Barangay San Rafael V, City of San Jose Del Monte; Renato Gonzales alias Totoy, 31, a resident of Barangay Guyong, Sta. Maria; Rommel Candule and Glen Paguntalan, both included in the drug watch list of San Rafael Municipal Police Station.

Bersaluna said Piano and his unidentified cohort engaged the police officers in a shoot-out to elude arrest after the

consummated drug transaction in Barangay San Rafael V, City of San Jose Del Monte around 11:30 p.m. Monday.

This prompted the operatives to retaliate that resulted in the neutralization of Piano while his cohort managed to escape, he said.

Likewise, he said the two other slain suspects Gonzales and Candule were killed after a botched drug transaction in Barangay Poblacion, Sta. Maria town on early Tuesday morning.

"The two suspects violently resisted arrest. They did shoot it out with the police officers when they were to be arrested. This prompted the police officers to return fire that resulted in their death," he said.

On the other hand, Bersaluna said the San Rafael police

GenTri to inspect vital infra after 6.1 magnitude quake

GENERAL TRIAS CITY,

Cavite — The city government directed on Tuesday its engineering, fire and general services offices (GSO) to immediately inspect all private and public buildings, including vital infrastructure projects under its jurisdiction after the 6.1 quake that jolted Luzon last April 22.

In an interview, city Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) head Romel Olimpo said the directive, issued through a memorandum signed by Mayor Antonio A. Ferrer, is in response to the call of Interior and Local Government Secretary Eduardo M. Año's to all local government units (LGUs) to inspect all buildings in their areas of responsibility to ensure public safety.

Año, in a press briefing last week, urged all LGUs to immediately inspect all buildings following the 6.1-magnitude earthquake on April 22 which jolted parts of Luzon, including Cavite's Tagaytay City (intensity IV), and the cities of Dasmarinas, General Trias, Cavite and the town of In-

dang (intensity III).

"Although the city's joint inspection team (comprised of BPLO, city fire, engineering, health, environment, planning and treasurer's offices) conducts weekly inspection to validate the local establishments' compliance to local and national safety regulations, another round of inspection will be conducted.

"To check whether the previous earthquake caused any structural damage that will jeopardize the safety and health of its users," Olimpo said.

General Trias, a component city of Cavite, is home to the Gateway Business Park, and boasts of a steady increase in its registered commercial establishments and infrastructure developments.

Although the city government has no jurisdiction over factories inside the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA), it will closely coordinate with PEZA's engineering department regarding the DILG directive. (Gladys Pino-PNA)

Abner Sanchez, who formerly surrendered under Oplan Tokhang, was arrested by Obando Municipal Police Station.

Orlando Victoria, also an Oplan Tokhang surrenderer, was apprehended by the San Miguel Municipal Police Station.
