## CAVITE LGUs INTENSIFY ROAD CLEARING OPS

**BACOOR CITY, Cavite -- Local chief executives of Cavite's seven cities and 16 towns have intensified their road clearing operations and ridding the local sidewalks of illegal vendors.**

Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Secretary Eduardo Año earlier issued a memorandum ordering department officials to monitor the progress on compliance by the local government units (LGUs) with the directive of President Rodrigo Duterte to clean up public roads of obstructions to ease traffic congestion.

In Bacoor City, Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla implemented clearing and maintenance operations along the stretch of Zapote Road and public roads in the Bacoor Public Market.

Revilla directed the city's 73 village chiefs to clear public streets, especially major thoroughfares used for private ends, and the remove obstructions and illegal structures along Aguinaldo highway and Molino Boulevard in the city of over 600,000 people.

The mayor also instructed both the City Engineering Office and Bacoor Traffic Management Team to assist the barangays in their clearing operations.

In Kawit town, Mayor Emilio Angelo Aguinaldo has warned the 23 village chiefs to comply with the President's and DILG directives or face raps.

Among the areas the mayor wanted to give priority in the clearing operations are the major roads at Barangay Binakayan especially streets enclosing the Public Market, Zeus area in Muralas, the stretch of Centennial road from Barangay Gahak to Barangay Magdalo, Kalayaan Road in Barangay San Sebastian, and Tirona Highway to Magdiwang Highway at the town proper.

General Trias City Mayor Antonio Ferrer ordered the formation of the team composed of city traffic management chief Noel Morena, local police chief, Lt. Col. Marlo Solero, Liga mga Barangay (LnB)

Federation president Alfred Ching, Licensing office head Romel Olimpo, and Francisco Evangelista Jr. as head of the GenTri Civil Security Unit to supervise the clearing operations.

The team members are tasked to inspect and supervise the cleanup drive, especially along the stretch of Antero Soriano Highway from Bacao to Tejero; Tejero Crossing, Tejero-San Juan Road, Malabon Trias proper; Gen. Antonio Road from Bacao to Dulong Bayan to Brgy. 96th.

Busy roads like Governor Ferrer Drive from Barangay Prinza to Manggahan, Crisanto delos Reyes Avenue from Manggahan to Alingaro, Governor's Drive from San Francisco to Manggahan, up to the boundary at Trece Martires City, are up for clearing operations.

In Dasmariñas City, Mayor Jenny Austria Barzaga ordered the city government to implement "no parking" on busy public streets from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The mayor's order is covered through the city government Memorandum No. 240-S-2019, which declares the "no parking" zone on Molino-Salawag-Paliparan road anytime and the Placido Campos and Camerino avenues.

In her directive to the city's 75 village chiefs, Barzaga also ordered the clearing operations on all major and secondary public roads in the city. (PNA)

## Symposium for social and political awareness on hemophilia conducted

**TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA)** -- The first Hemophilia Awareness Symposium for social and political awareness was conducted in the province by the provincial government's Provincial Health Office (PHO) at the Cavite Collaboration Center for Public Health Auditorium here.

PHO Epidemiologist Dr. Nelson Soriano stressed the importance of having a Hemophilia Treatment Directory with identification cards of PWH (people with hemophilia) to be presented to healthcare providers in availing medical and dental services. He was quoted as saying: "Education is still the key along with proper information dissemination," in order to address this condition and expressed the hope that hemophilia be included in the Universal Health Care Bill.

Hemophilia, a genetically-inherited bleeding disorder in which the person's blood does not clot normally, remains unfamiliar to many Filipinos with about 10,000 Filipinos suffering from the disorder and only 1,500 have been registered with the Philippine Hemophilia Foundation, 28 of which are from Cavite.

The obvious unawareness about this condition by the public even by hospital personnel prompted the members of Hemophilia Advocates Philippines (HAP) to coordinate with the PHO and organize this event with the primary aim to raise social and political awareness for them to lobby their advocacy and seek

legislative measures that will address the hemophilia medical condition.

Pediatric hematologist from the Korean-Philippines Friendship Hospital and hemophilia advocate Dr. Melissa Montoya shared some knowledge on pediatric bleeding disorder and tips to manage cases in children such as the application of RICE which stands for Rest, Ice Packs, Compress and Elevate.

Dr. Montoya also revealed that, "I have recommended to the Department of Health (DOH) for the allocation of Factor 8 concentrate to the Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital (GEAMH)," and this gave much hope to PWH since only a number of hospitals could handle patients with bleeding disorders.

Likewise, Social Welfare Officer III Brendalyn Salazar of PSWDO enlightened the members of the PWH with the simple procedures and requirements on seeking financial and medical assistance including requests for wheelchairs from the Office of the Provincial Governor.

She also assured them with their support stating, "Our office will lobby for the inclusion of PWH patients in the special cases like chemotherapy and dialysis patients qualified to receive financial assistance from the provincial government on a regular term."

The event was attended by medical practitioners, city and municipal health officers, doctors and dentists from public hospitals, nurses from the rural health units, members of the PWD federation, employees of the provincial government's Provincial Health Office, Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office, Provincial Information and Community Affairs Department, and members of HAP. ## DENR CALABARZON celebrated the World Mangrove Day

In line with the celebration of World Mangrove Day on June 26, 2019, the DENR CALABARZON Conservation and Development Division organized a mangrovetree planting activity, conducted at Barangay Talisay, Calatagan, Batangas. The mangrove tree planting activity was participated in by 60 volunteers from the DENR CALABARZON, CENRO Calaca, Batangas, Ecosystems Research and Development Bureau (ERDB), Local Government Unit of Brgy. Talisay, and the Samahan ng Nagkakaisang Mangingisda sa Barangay Talisay (SNMBT) People's Organization. A total of 1,200 propagules of Bakawang Lalaki and Bakawang Bato species were planted. According to Ms. Violy Gulapo, Senior Science Research Specialist from the ERDB, a total number of 500,000 hectares of mangrove forest in 1918, has drastically gone down to only 117,000 hectares in 1995. In 2011, it has gradually increased to 257,362 hectares<sup>1</sup> which may be attributed to coastal rehabilitation programs implemented by government, NGO and communities. She added that three main functions of the Mangrove Ecosystems are for fishery production, for environmental protection, and as a carbon sink. She commended the Agency for conducting Mangrove rehabilitation programs but she reminded that people conducting planting activities should have enough knowledge in proper zonation of the mangrove. She emphasized that we have to monitor the success rate of every planting activity. Mr. Rodrigo de Jesus, president of the SNMBT, disclosed that their organization does regular mangrove planting activities since 2007.

### PHILRACOM OFFICIALS DAPAT NG PALITAN

## DENGUE CONTROL AND PREVENTION

With more than 6,000 dengue cases in the entire province of Cavite, the Provincial Health Office in partnership with BASF Philippines, Inc. conducted mosquito misting at the Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital compound in Trece Martires City on August 3, 2019. Personnel from BASF Philippines, Inc. started mosquito misting around the vicinity of GEAMH early in the morning, an initiative which is part of their corporate social responsibility. On behalf of the Provincial Health Office, Ms. Annabelle Dilig, OIC-Administrative Office for Public Health and Mr. Wilfredo Atas, Construction and Maintenance Foreman of GEAMH received 200 pieces of Interceptor Mosquito Nets and some larval and insect control products from BASF Philippines, Inc headed by Mr. Ronaldo Mercado, President and Managing Director together with Mr. Manolo Sambrano, Head-Agricultural Solutions, Mr. Randall Evangelista, Sales Manager-Agricultural Solutions and Ms. Paola Norial, Accounts Development Officer... --(PICAD)

The Court pointed out that the authority of the ERC was limited only to the implementation of the CSP, and that the ERC had no power and authority to postpone the CSP's application.

All PSA applications submitted by the DUs on or after June 30, 2015, were required to comply with the CSP in accordance with 2015 circular issued by the Department of Energy (DOE).

In the same ruling, the SC ordered that the power purchase cost after compliance with the CSP shall

retroact to the date of the effectiveness of the PSA, "but in no case earlier than June 30, 2015, for purposes of passing the purchase cost to the consumers."

The petitioner in the case claim that by extending the CSP deadline from November 2015 to April 2016, the ERC allowed Meralco, along with its seven affiliated power generating companies, tying up 3,551 megawatts, or 90 percent of its supply, to enter 20-year contracts that would cost consumers PHP12.4 billion a year. (PNA)

## SC affirms decision on 'bidding' for power supply deals

**MANILA** -- The Supreme Court (SC) affirmed with finality its decision directing the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) to conduct a competitive selection process (CSP) on all power supply agreements (PSAs) submitted by distribution utilities.

In an advisory Wednesday, SC Public Information Office chief and spokesperson Brian Hokasa confirmed that resolution was made during its July 23 en banc session and denied the motions for reconsiderations filed by the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG) on behalf of the ERC and the counsel for Panay Energy Development Corporation (PEDC).

"Acting on the following motions for reconsideration of the decision dated May 3, 2019, the Court re-

solved, by the same vote and with Associate Justice Henri Jean Paul Inting joining the majority, to deny with finality the said motions for reconsideration as the basic issues raised therein have been passed upon by this Court and no substantial arguments were presented to warrant the reversal of the questioned decision," the Court ruled.

In its original May 3, 2019 decision, the Court held that the ERC gravely abused its discretion and therefore exceeded its jurisdiction when it unilaterally postponed the effectiveness of the CSP requirement for power distributors to get at least two offers for supply of electricity before awarding a PSA, ensuring the least cost for electricity consumers.

## RELIEF DISTRIBUTION IN CAVITE

**Continuous rains brought by the southwest monsoon (habagat) and low pressure area (LPA) affected coastal communities and those living along rivers and creeks in the province of Cavite. In a prompt response, Governor Jonvic Remulla directed concerned offices, primarily the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) and the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO) to assess the situation for the effective allocation of relief resources.**

On August 5, 2019, Governor Remulla spearheaded the distribution of relief packs in Tanza and Trece Martires City with the team of volunteers from PSWDO and PDRRMO.

The governor underscored that the program is intended to somehow help the families on their basic needs, since most of the livelihood are halted due to the bad weather condition. Likewise, Governor Remulla provided safety reminders which are very vital for their health during the rainy season amidst the dengue outbreak in the province.

In Trece Martires City, Mayor Gemma Lubigan, Vice Mayor Bobby Montehermoso and the city councilors joined the governor during the relief distribution program held at the South Summit covered court in Barangay Aguado for a total of 4,000 recipients.

Meanwhile, in Tanza, wherein most of the affected families are fisherfolks, relief goods were distributed at the covered courts of coastal barangays Julugan V and Amaya VII. Local officials headed by Mayor Yuri Pacumio and Vice Mayor Munding del Rosario together with the members of the Sangguniang Bayan thanked the provincial government for prioritizing their constituents during calamity situations.

Four thousand packs were allotted for the consumption of barangays Julugan I-VIII, same with the relief goods received by the residents of Barangay Amaya.

The locals were also relieved with the presence of other guests including Congressman Boying Remulla, Vice Governor Jolo Revilla, Board Members Ping Remulla and Lito Langit who also told recipients to stay dry and stay safe.

Other coastal municipalities such as Kawit and Naic are next to visit for donation of relief.

## Mayor Isko to convert Manila into 'smart city'

**MANILA** -- Manila Mayor Francisco "Isko Moreno" Domagoso on Thursday said he plans to convert Manila into a "smart city" to better serve his constituents.

In an ambush interview with the media, Domagoso said he had a brief meeting with the Commercial Section of the United States (US) embassy on the important elements of a "smart city" such as an enhanced flood monitoring and prevention, traffic management, and Manila resident ID issuance.

"Smart city is, how I can make your life easier as a citizen, so, these things like technology, study, infrastructure, human development. Smart in such a way you address every sector of the society, you accept there is a problem and you address it," Domagoso added.

Citing that the US has offered a grant for the design of the "Smart City of Manila", Domagoso said his administration is pushing for the digitalization of the local government and all application and hardware preparations are now being made.

"I was asked what we want to prioritize, sabi ko (I said), once and for all, study Manila geographically with regard to the flooding problem of the city para magkaroon ng (so there could be a) drainage plan, catch basin, everything that will address the flooding in Manila because I told the group of US ambassador, the country is a tropical country and we'll be experiencing lots of rain, within 8 months there will be rain in between," he said.

Stressing that flooded streets have been the pe-

The inception phase aims is to achieve stakeholder consensus regarding the objectives for the project, define the software scope and limitations, including the vision, estimate schedule, define acceptance criteria and

include inspectors from the Department of Engineering and Public Works (DEPW), Manila Health Department (MHD), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and other departments, offices, and bureaus of the nation's capital.

## SC EYES VIDEO CON FOR HIGH-RISK/SICK INMATES, WITNESSES

**MANILA** – High-risk prisoners and those seriously ill will be allowed to appear and/or testify before courts through videoconferencing technology under a pilot project to be tested in Davao starting next month, the Supreme Court (SC) said Tuesday.

In a statement, the High Court said it has approved the proposed Guidelines on the Use of Videoconferencing Technology for the Remote Appearance or Testimony

of Certain Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) in Jails and National Penitentiaries.

The guidelines shall be tested for a period of not more than two years between the following: the Davao City Hall of Justice and the Davao City Jail; the Davao City Hall of Justice and the Special Intensive Care Area (SICA), Camp Bagong Diwa, Bicutan; and the Davao City Hall of Justice and the New Bilibid Prison, Muntinlupa City.

A special commit-

tee chaired by Associate Justice Diosdado M. Peralta drafted the guidelines which aim to guarantee and preserve the constitutional rights of the accused in court proceedings who are PDLs being detained in a district, city or provincial jail or a national inmate committed in a national penitentiary.

The Court said the videoconferencing technology eliminates the safety, security and health risks posed by the personal appearance of PDLs who is “considered to be high-risk or afflicted with highly contagious diseases.” Such risk is not only posed on the accused but also to judges, court personnel, and the public in general.

The Court has been “employing modern technology, e.g., using live-link television testimony in criminal cases where the witness or the victim is a child and the presentation of testimonial evidence through electronic means in both civil and criminal cases.” In 2001, the Court gave the family courts the green light to use videoconferencing equipment in trials involving the testimonies of children.

The guidelines provide that “the remote appearance and testimony of an accused in a videoconference proceeding shall closely resemble his or her otherwise in-person courtroom testimony and experience.”

It also said “the dignity and solemnity in a video-conference proceeding shall be the same as those of an in-court proceeding. The remote location shall be viewed as an extension of the courtroom.”

The guidelines also detail the procedures to be observed allowing the defense counsel to be physically present with the PDLs at the jail or in court at the PDLs’ option.

The guidelines state that the video cameras must be placed and positioned in such a way so as to cover the same image the PDLs at the remote location would see if he or she

## DOH Caraga Inutile vs Dengue, One Died caused by Deworming

**BUTUAN CITY** – Dengue cases in Caraga region increases said the Department of Health – Caraga, it intensified the 4S campaign in the different provinces of the region. Data released by DOH-Caraga as of July 22, 2019 shows more than 6,000 dengue cases recorded in the region, higher compared to last year’s figure of only 2,300 which very alarming already.

This is very high compared to last year’s cases of 2,300, but questionably, with the new graph, DOH still considered it below the alert level,” said Regional Director Dr. Jose Llacuna Jr. Computation shows a 260.86% increase of Dengue cases in Caraga, yet, DOH Caraga was not yet alarmed.

The health department also reminded the different barangays to continuously perform the 4S campaign to prevent the spread of dengue disease. These are: search and destroy; self-protection measures; seek early consultation; and say no to indiscriminate fogging.

The DOH Caraga also recognized the effort of the local government units in the region for their constant implementation of the health programs to the public.

The public asked why fogging is not the first line of defense of killing mosquitoes and ultimately stopped Dengue when it should be the best. Fogging should be an act of war against mosquitoes or the best prevention rather than cure to totally eliminate mosquitoes instead of allowing them to multiply. The public now thinks of a possible conspiracy between hospitals and governments inutile moves to fight the killer mosquitoes when it can simply be done by a discriminate fogging.

Likewise, it also monitors the number of cases on measles and ensures the conduct of school-based immunization including deworming in the provinces of Caraga region. The official added that they are coordinating with the Department of Education to ensure the provision of immunization to school-age children by September, this year.

Last week, DOH launched the school-based immunization and deworming in coordination with the Department of Education to immunize all our school age children. That by September 30 as emphasized
