REMULLA AT REVILLA PARIN SA CAVITE

NANALO sa pag-agobnador ng Cavite si Juanito Victor "Jonvic" Remulla laban sa dati ring gobernador na si Erineo "Ayong" Maliksi.

Si Remulla ay nakakuha ng 820,890 na boto mula sa 92.97% mula sa lahat ng voting precincts kumpara sa 493,085 boto na nakuha ni Maliksi.

Si Maliksi ay dating governor ng Cavite mula 2001 hanggang 2010 hanggang sa natalo ito ni Jonvic at naninilbihan itong governor mula 2010 hanggang 2016 matapos na palitan siya ng kanyang kapatid na si Jesus Crispin "Boying" Remulla na nanalo naman sa pagka-congressman ng ika-7 distrito ng Cavite.

Muli naman naluklok sa pagka bise gobernador si Ramon "Jolo" Revilla na walang nakalaban nitong nakaraang midterm election.

Sa Trece Martires City, nanalo naman si Gemma Lubigan, biyuda ng napatay na si dating Vice Mayor Alex Lubigan.

Si Lubigan ay nakakuha ng 27,981 na boto laban sa katunggaling si Melencio De Sagun, Jr. na nakakuha lamang ng 21,197 na boto mula sa 98.91% pooling precincts.

Matatandaan na binaril at napatay ang asawa ni Gemma na si Alex Lubigan noong July 2018 kung saan inakusahan si Melandres de Sagun.

Sa Bacoor City Cavite, napanatili naman ni incumbent Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla ang pagiging alkalde matapos na nakakuha ng botong 141,848 laban sa katunggaling si Jose Francisco na may boto ng 18,903 batay sa huling pagkakatala habang sinusulat ito.

Mananatili naman mayor ng Tanza, Cavite si Mayor Pacumio matapos na nakakuha ng mataas na boto laban sa katunggali at dating alkalde na si Marcus Ashley Arayata habang maluluklok naman na vice mayor si dating Board Member Raymundo del Rosario laban sa katunggaling si Arleen Arayata.

Mananatili namang mayor ng Gen Trias City si Antonio Ferrer at Vice Mayor Murito Sison habang si Indang Mayor Perfecto Fidel at Vice Mayor Ismael Rodil at Mendez Mayor Eric Vida ay mananatili sa kanilang puwesto dahil sa walang nakalaban nitong midtem election. **GENE ADSUARA**

Batangas, Quezon chosen as universal health care program pilot areas

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna — The Department of Health (DOH) has chosen Batangas and Quezon among the pilot areas in the implementation of the government's Universal Health Care (UHC) all-inclusive program for Filipinos.

"We are preparing the foundation for the implementation of the Universal Health Care at the local health system so we should be fully knowledgeable on how to implement it because this is our chance to fix our health care system wherein no patient should be left behind. Everybody should be afforded the right health care," DOH 4-A (Calabarzon) Director, Dr. Eduardo Janairo, said Friday.

The DOH 4-A has convened provincial, city and municipal health workers of Batangas and Quezon for their respective scheduled orientations and the pilot sites are currently preparing for their application of the UHC health programs.

Janairo said the DOH-identified UHC-Advance Implementation Sites (AIS) programs in the two provinces will be supported and contracted by both DOH and PhilHealth to demonstrate various approaches and mechanisms to achieve technical, managerial, and financial integration, as mandated by the UHC law that guarantees equitable access to quality and affordable health care for all Filipinos.

Under these arrangements, both public and private sector could work together towards the

achievement of a successful and efficient health care delivery network in the two provinces.

"At the same time, no patient should be worried or think about the huge expenses because the patient has to be aware of the expenses and know where to seek assistance if needed. These are the principles that we must include in the implementation of UHC so that all Filipinos could be well taken care of," Janairo noted.

President Rodrigo Duterte signed the UHC law, or Republic Act 11223 last February 20, paving the way for the automatic enrollment of all Filipinos covered under the National Health Insurance Program, which prescribes complementary reforms in the health system.

Janairo assured that the health department would address the inequities in health services, such as lack of manpower, health services, and medicines, which could be resolved under the UHC program through primary health care.

"We have to include these concerns in the entire health care system, on whatever is needed for medical services, so that patients could immediately have access to these. Whether they are from the highlands or on the streets, a concerned health office should be on hand to address these concerns in times of medical emergency. This is the accessibility provided for in the Universal Health Care," he added.

Cavite town gives Ancajas hero's welcome

MAGALLANES, Cavite — World boxing champion Jerwin Ancajas received a hero's welcome here for his successful defense of the International Boxing Federation super fly-weight title on May 5, 2019.

Mayor Jasmin Maligaya-Bautista spearheaded a motorcade for Ancajas, nicknamed 'Pretty Boy' on Wednesday around Magallanes town.

"Our local government, along with our Sangguniang Bayan members and barangay chairmen, recognizes the convincing win of Pretty Boy. Long live Pretty Boy Ancajas," Bautista said in a media interview.

Ancajas, a Navy reservist, was also given a hero's welcome by the Philippine Navy upon his arrival at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport on May 15.

A native of Panabo City, Davao del Norte, Ancajas scored a seventh round technical knockout victory against Japanese challenger Ryuichi Funai in Stockton, California.

The 27-year-old champion, who currently lives in Cavite City, has improved his ring record to 31-1-2 with 21 wins via stoppages.

He trained for five-week at the Marine Base Gregorio Lim in Ternate, Cavite prior to the fight. **(PNA)**

Janairo further said that 33 areas, including Batangas and Quezon, were chosen because of the willingness and support of their local chief executives to participate in the program and also due to the high probability of success in these areas.

He said Batangas and Quezon health care workers could share lessons and experiences that serve as basis for the development of national policies on the integration, particularly of local health systems and for UHC in general.

Other UHC-AIS identified pilot sites are Valenzuela and Parañaque in the National Capital Region; Dagupan in the Ilocos region; Baguio and Benguet in the Cordillera region; Isabela, Nueva Vizcaya, and Quirino in

the Cagayan Valley region; Bataan and Tarlac in Central Luzon; Oriental Mindoro in Mimaropa (Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon and Palawan); Masbate and Sorsogon in the Bicol region; Aklan, Antique, Guimaras and Iloilo in Western Visayas; Cebu in Central Visayas; Biliran, Leyte and Samar in Eastern Visayas; Zamboanga del Norte in Zamboanga Peninsula; Cagayan de Oro and Misamis Oriental in Northern Mindanao; Compostella Valley and Davao del Norte in the Davao region; Sarangani and South Cotabato in Soccsksargen; Agusan del Sur and Surigao del Norte in Caraga; and Maguindanao in the BARMM (Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao). **(PNA)**

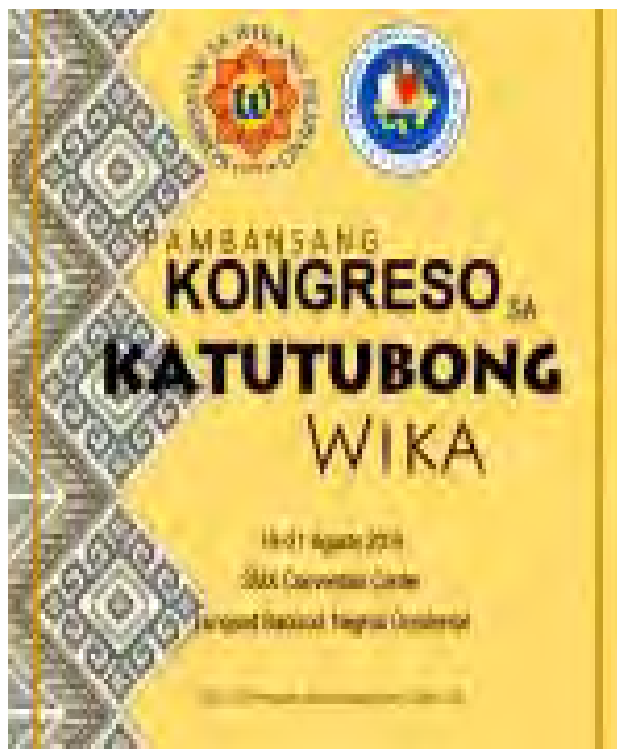

IMUS CITY INAUGURATES NEW, BIGGER JAIL FACILITY

Imus City, Cavite (PIA) – The city government here led the recent inauguration of the new and bigger facility of the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP) to address the problem of overcrowding in jail cells and somehow prevent the spread of diseases among inmates.

“The national government funded the construction of the five-storey jail building that costs P32-million and could accommodate between 800 to 900 inmates and more,” explained Imus City Engineer Christian Sarno.

The new building stands on a 1,920-square meter lot at the Civic Center area, also called Land Transportation Office (LTO) compound in Barangay Palico IV.

The old jail facility that was used for years was only a 100 square meter city jail that could only house up to sixty detainees.

DOE eyes 70% cap on power plants' contracting capacity by Q3

MANILA — Power producers in the Philippines will be required to have a 70-percent cap on their contracting capacities, likely by the third quarter of 2019, to ensure availability of buffer supply during times of need.

Department of Energy (DOE) Undersecretary Felix William Fuentebella, in a briefing Wednesday, said they are now in talks with all stakeholders for this policy.

“Soon... (We can release the Circular) in three months,” he said.

The contracting capacity of a certain power plant is described as the portion of its expected total electricity output that can be sold in advance. By limiting the amount of power that can be pre-sold to only

70 percent, the DOE is assured that there will be 30 percent electricity remaining to tap for emergencies.

Fuentebella explained that this measure is aimed at ensuring that reserve electricity is available to fill a sudden power gap, such as when a power plant shuts down temporarily.

“There'll be no generator that will be a replacement every time. We will distribute the replacement,” he said pointing out that the reserves can be sold through replacement power contracts or the spot market when reserves are low.

The DOE executive said this policy will cover new contracts, as well as those for renewal.

SC disbars lawyer who snubbed suspension order for 11 years

MANILA — A lawyer who ignored for 11 years the order of the Supreme Court (SC) suspending him from the practice of law has been disbarred by the High Court.

In a decision released recently, the SC ordered Renato B. Pagatpatan disbarred following a complaint of Rev. Fr. Jose P. Zafra III.

Zafra had sued two of the wayward lawyer's clients but was made the subject of a letter complaint sent by Pagatpatan to the Bishop of the Diocese of Tandag, Surigao Del Sur.

A subsequent inquiry by the church later cleared Zafra, who then initiated the administrative complaint against Pagatpatan.

The lawyer turned out to have engaged in the unauthorized practice of law at the time, having been suspended by the court in another administrative

case against him.

“Attorney Pagatpatan had been representing party litigants in court from 2005 until the case was filed before the IBP in 2016,” said the SC, adding that the lawyer “made a mockery of this court's authority by defying this Court's suspension order for over eleven years”.

“If Zafra had not filed the instance case, Attorney Pagatpatan would have continued disregarding the suspension order of this court,” the tribunal said.

The SC found Pagatpatan guilty of simple misconduct and fined him PHP5,000 for unethical behavior over his letter against Zafra, and disbarred from the practice of law effective immediately.

“His actions clearly constitute gross misconduct which is a sufficient cause for suspension or disbarment,” the tribunal explained. **(PNA)**

Seek medical advice first before trying diet plans

MANILA — As various types of fad diets and fitness programs become a trend, a health expert on Thursday reminded the public on Thursday to consult a doctor first before trying these diets.

In an interview with the Philippine News Agency (PNA), Philippine Heart Association (PHA) president Nanette Rey said fad diets and fitness regi-

grid is experiencing yellow and sometimes red alerts due to low power reserves.

“Like ketogenic diet, it's a high-fat diet, and it does not discriminate on what fat you're taking, you could be taking the good fats and the bad fats. If you're taking it for three months, your cholesterol will go up, and if you're taking a lot of bad fats, it will deposit in the veins and they will block the veins,” she said.

Citing intermittent fasting as another method of losing weight, Rey said it is not advisable for those who are diabetic and are taking medications.

“It will require you to fast for 16 hours which is too long for a diabetic patient. When a person goes under a diet or fitness regimen, it's always best to consult a doctor first. Find out

Kudos to PNP for peaceful elections for media workers: Egco

MANILA — Presidential Task Force on Media Security (PTFoMS) Executive Director Jose Joel Sy Egco on Thursday lauded the Philippine National Police (PNP) for the generally peaceful media environment during the last mid-term elections.

“Very few cases of media violence were recorded in the last political exercise. Historically, the exact opposite is the norm. We assumed that the peace and order situation for the last polls will not be any different from past elections,” Egco said.

“But because of the proactive measures we took with the help of the PNP, there was hardly any major media violence case that happened. We commend the PNP and its leadership, as without their vigilance and dedication, this would not have been at all possible,” he added.

Egco said one of the measures undertaken by the PTFoMS was his request to Albayalde to put all PNP units on heightened alert nationwide from May 10 to 15 to prevent violence against media workers “who are either running for office or covering the elections”.

The PTFoMS chief said the local PNP units have been required to regularly apprise the Task Force “on cases of media violence or even the absence thereof”.

Based on PTFoMS records, there were only three instances when the

intervention of the Task Force has been sought in the recent national and local elections.

The Task Force received report about a photographer of a major daily who was reportedly mobbed by supporters of a mayoralty candidate after he took pictures on their alleged vote-buying activities.

The memory card of the media worker's camera was forcibly taken, prompting the PTFoMS to immediately order an investigation.

The Task Force also has also coordinated with the PNP to provide security for group of five journalists who felt they were in a “dangerous situation” while covering the elections in a certain province.

It also acted on a complaint by a GMA network stringer who said unidentified men wearing jackets and riding a motorcycle passed by along the highway and uttered to him in the vernacular the words “GMA patay ka na! Lumay ka na!” (GMA your dead already, go away) while showing gesture of slashing his neck.

Egco said the Task Force has also immediately contacted the provincial police director in the area and “he responded quickly”.

“The Task Force continues to closely monitor cases of media violence and is committed to fulfill its mandate to protect the life, liberty and security of media workers 24/7,” Egco said. **(PR)**

'BOYING' REMULLA WINS CONGRESS SEAT FOR CAVITE'S 7TH DISTRICT

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite — The provincial board of canvassers (PBOC) in Cavite officially proclaimed on Wednesday former Cavite Governor Jesus Crispin "Boying" Remulla as winner of the 7th district congressional race.

The proclamation at the Sangguniang Panlalawigan session hall here, was chaired by lawyer Arnulfo Pioquinto, with lawyer Gavino Mapano as vice-chair and Dr. Cherrylou Repia as member-secretary.

The proclamation was held after the canvassing of votes cast last Monday for the House of Representatives member in 357 precincts of the 7th District of Cavite.

In the certificate of canvass of votes, Remulla obtained 128,674 votes over his rival Gengen Arayata, who garnered 61,031 votes.

The 7th district of Cavite covers this city, including the towns of Indang, Tanza, and Amadeo. **(Gladys Pino-PNA)**

PhilHealth reminds public facilities to register Point of Service patients promptly

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) reminds all concerned health care institutions (HCIs) to register their patients assessed as financially incapable (FI) under the Point of Service (POS) program within 72 hours from assessment so that their claims will not be denied.

The reminder was issued in the light of observations and reports that there are HCIs registering their patients assessed as FI thru the POS beyond the 72

hour requirement or sometimes even a month after discharge.

The POS is a program provided in the Government Appropriations Act (GAA) for the current year, to cover all Filipinos under the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP), including the unregistered and inactive registered members especially those who are financially incapable.

Filipino citizens who will be covered under the POS Program, must be admitted in a ward type of accommodation and classified as financially incapable to pay his/her PhilHealth contribution according to the DOH classification on indigents. Members availing of this program shall be included in the PhilHealth membership database for possible inclusion in the list of indigent beneficiaries whose premiums are to be shouldered by the National Government.

PhilHealth offices nationwide are ready to process the PhilHealth Identification Number (PIN) of patients enrolled as POS-FI immediately upon receipt of requests from public HCIs. Hence, HCIs are therefore encouraged to promptly register their FI patients to avoid denial of claims due to delayed issuance of PIN.

Trece Martires city welcomes first lady mayor

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite — Gemma Lubigan was officially proclaimed mayor-elect of this city on Wednesday by Commission on Elections (Comelec) city officer, lawyer Jastine Marie dela Cruz.

Lubigan, who ran for mayor to continue the "unfinished business" of her slain husband, city vice mayor Alex Lubigan, is the first ever female to hold the city's top post.

"A challenge for me," Lubigan said on her new task, aware of the big expect-

tations of city folks from her.

Lubigan and her party-mates occupy the majority of local positions, including vice mayor Romeo Montehermoso and seven out of the 10 city councils.

She won by more than 6,000 votes against former city mayor Melencio de Sagun.

Trece Martires City has 92 clustered precincts, with 84,430 registered voters. Some 61,982 city residents came out to vote last Monday. **(PNA)**

SC clears division lawyer of 'bogus resolutions' allegation

MANILA — The Supreme Court (SC) has cleared one of its division clerks of court who was named in a letter-complaint for alleged irregularities in the issuance of minute resolutions.

In an April 10 resolution released on Wednesday, the High Court's en banc said it dismissed the administrative complaint against SC 2nd Division Clerk of Court, lawyer Ma. Lourdes C. Perfecto, for lack of basis and ruled to "consider this case closed and terminated."

The tribunal said that the complainant, Alberto C. Yap,

"failed to specifically aver and prove any misdeed that may have been committed by Atty. Perfecto."

The court explained that Yap's one-page letter failed to contain any elaboration on the alleged money-making modus operandi that Perfecto had employed in issuing the alleged bogus minute resolutions.

"Such bare allegations, without any iota of evidence, do not merit the Court's consideration," the court said, adding that it "finds as untenable" the complainant's allegation that Perfecto had issued bogus minute resolutions. **(PNA)**

Experts tackle medical care for elderly persons with cancer

MANILA — Medical experts, doctors, scientists, academics and political leaders in Asia Pacific countries convened on Wednesday to formulate medical care policies for countries with increased cancer cases among older populations.

In her keynote speech at the 2019 International Society of Geriatric Oncology (SIOG) policy meeting, Dr. Susan Pineda-Mercado, deputy secretary-general of the Philippine Red Cross, stressed that changes in the aging population's disease structure create the need for specific types of medical care in the country.

Citing that many among the elderly have cancer or are more prone to the disease, Mercado said the government must promote appropriate care for them.

"The medical care demand must be upgraded to one that will be suitable for an aged society diagnosed with cancer, addressing the needs of

older people with cancer is not just about social justice — it is also our moral responsibility," she added.

According to the World Health Organization (WHO), aging people have high risk of cancer because of their unhealthy behaviors and lifestyles. WHO said the occurrence of cancer among elderly persons tends to increase with countries in Southeast Asia and Europe that are leading in morbidities.

In connection, WHO estimated that persons aged 60 and up will surpass the population of 10 years old and under by 2030 and by 2050 they will be 2.1 billion — outnumbering children who are 5 years old and below.

Mercado said based on these estimates of the Philippine Statistics Office there will be more than 8 million older Filipinos in the succeeding years.

"It comprise of 8.2 percent of the country's population, thereby

placing the Philippines in the outset of an ageing population. The ageing of the population is irreversible, and it will continue to increase significantly," she said.

Meanwhile, Dr. Hans Wildiers, SIOG president, confirmed that cancer is "a disease of aging worldwide".

"But, even though older persons comprise the majority of cancer cases, they are more likely to receive less treatment and are under-represented in clinical trials," he said.

To properly address this issue, Wildiers enjoined the policy meeting participants to always refer to SIOG guidelines and educational tools that are essential to good clinical practice in geriatric oncology.

"The recognized need for enhancing clinical practices and research and education for the elderly population with cancer represents a new shift in thinking, with the objective being able to provide all coun-

tries with health capabilities to monitor, prioritize and maintain locally relevant, system integrated health research and clinical practices," Mercado said. She also enjoined the participants to a collaboration that would support individual researchers, institutions and governments in establishing well-designed and impactful international partnerships.

"Let us continue to demonstrate to policy makers how important such associations are for combatting cancer in the vulnerable elderly, as we seek improved access to infrastructure and funding for our partnerships," she added.

Held in Mandaluyong City on Monday, the SIOG Policy Meeting 2019 is a gathering of regional stakeholders, who share knowledge and experiences, to formulate policies for medical professionals and public health officials in providing better health care for the elderly with cancer. **(PNA)**

VOTE BUYING MARS PEACEFUL MIDTERM POLLS IN CALABARZON

CAMP GEN. VICENTE LIM, Calamba City — Vote buying has marred the erstwhile peaceful conduct of Monday's midterm elections in the five vote-rich Calabarzon provinces of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon, according to the region's top police official here.

"Except for incidents of vote-buying, we are very thankful that the public have shown their support and cooperation with the authorities so that we could all have safe and peaceful elections," said Calabarzon Police Regional Director, Brig. Gen. Edward Carranza, on Tuesday.

The regional police command has set up its Regional Election Monitoring Action Center (REMAC) at the multipurpose center in this camp, and deployed 12,500 cops prior to Monday's polls.

"Our police personnel on the field and those who are under operational and administrative part of Police Regional Office Calabarzon had indeed work beyond what is expected from them. With the peaceful outcome of this year's election in all parts of the region, they are truly commendable," he said.

The Philippine National Police (PNP) is still placed under full alert status as the poll body conducts its transmissions of official results and the canvassing of votes.

Carranza said the REMAC has monitored around 14 incidents of vote buying where 32 suspected persons were arrested, including the confiscation of some PHP 426,000 in aggregate cash seized from vote buying suspects from Quezon, Laguna, Cavite, and Batangas.

Meanwhile, Carranza extended the regional police headquarters' expression of sympathy and condolence to a Batangas police officer who succumbed to a cardiac arrest while on poll duty on the eve of election.

"While it turn-out generally peaceful, we are very saddened by the loss of one of our men, Police Staff Sergeant Ramil Briones Dagle, member of Batangas City Police Station, who suffered from heart attack while rendering election duties at Soro Soro Karsada Elementary School, Barangay Soro Soro Karsada, Batangas City," he said. 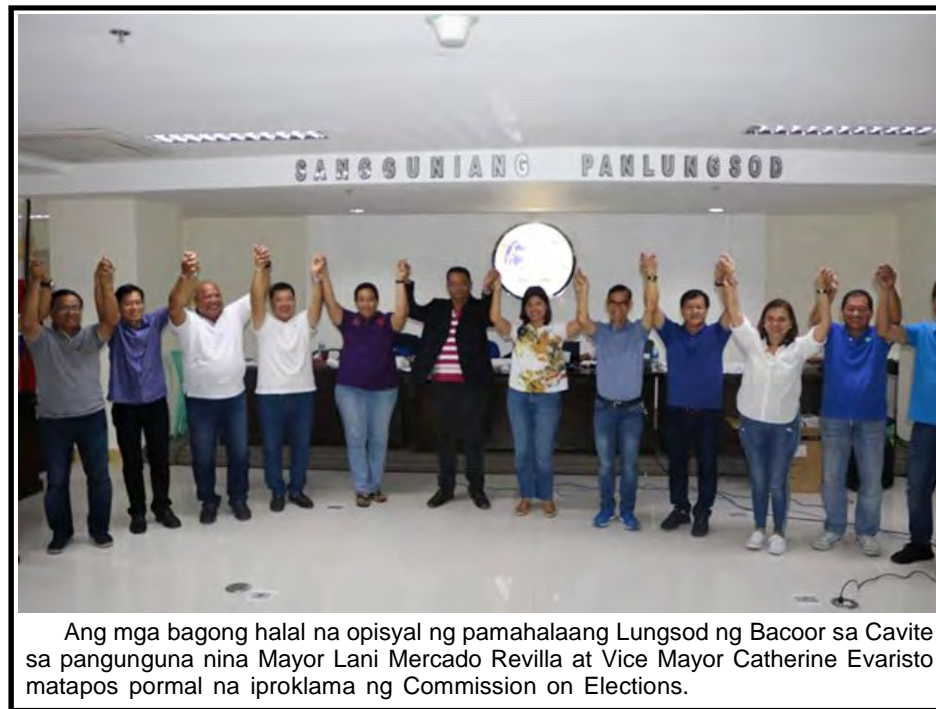

SC affirms CA ruling vs. AMWSLAI membership expansion

MANILA — The Supreme Court (SC) upheld a Court of Appeals (CA) decision stopping the Air Materiel Wing Savings and Loan Association, Inc. (AMWSLAI) from amending its by-laws to expand its membership base to include 24 additional agencies of the executive department.

AMWSLAI members consist of personnel of military and police personnel and their dependents.

The SC's Second Division said the appellate court did not commit any error in ruling that Regional Trial Court of Pasay City, Branch 119 (RTC) gravely abused its discretion when it granted AMWSLAI's petition for certiorari on Sept. 11, 2015 and issued a writ of preliminary injunction, preventing the Monetary Board of the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP-MB) from implementing its June 26, 2015 denying AMSWLAI appeal to allow its expansion.

"As correctly ruled by the CA, AMWSLAI should have filed an appeal before it under Rule 43 of the Rules of Court (Rules) - and not a petition for certiorari before the RTC under Rule 65 of the same Rules - considering that the CA has appellate jurisdiction over resolutions of public respondent which are issued in the exercise of its quasi-judicial

functions," the SC said.

"Accordingly, the RTC did not have jurisdiction to act on the above-mentioned certiorari petition, much more issue the ancillary writ of preliminary injunction against public respondent," it added.

In its June 29, 2018 decision by Associate Justice Maria Filomena Singh, the CA's Tenth Division granted the petition filed by the BSP-Monetary Board seeking the reversal of the Pasay RTC ruling in favor of AMWSLAI.

Under Republic Act No. 8367, otherwise known as the "Revised Non- Stock Savings and Loan Association Act of 1997," membership in Savings and Loan Associations (SLA), such as AMWSLAI must be limited to a "well-defined group."

The Monetary Board is vested with the authority to ensure that SLAs comply with this requirement.

However, in May 2014, AMWSLAI sent a letter-application to the Integrated Supervision Department I (ISD) of the BSP for the approval of its proposed amendment to its by-laws to give way for the expansion of its membership to cover employees of 24 other agencies of the Executive Department, as well as their relatives by consanguinity and affinity. Calabarzon posts 7.3% economic growth for 2018

MALVAR, Batangas (PIA)- The economy of Calabarzon has accelerated from 6.7% in 2017 to 7.3% in 2018 based on the report conducted recently by Philippine Statistics Authority IVA at the Occasions Garden in Lima Park Hotel here.

According to PSA IVA Regional Director Charito Armonia, the acceleration was considered as the fastest in six years and was brought about by the growth of Industry and Services as well as the turn-around performance of Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishing (AHFF).

Out of the 7.3% growth, Industry remained the biggest contributor at 4.9% followed by Services with 2.4% and AHFF contributed the least with 0.03%.

Among the three major economic industries, Industry sector has the largest share at 62.3% of the region's economy followed by the Services sector with 32.9% and AHFF had the least share of 4.8%.

Compared to the report in 2017, Industry grew at a faster pace of 7.9% from 7.8% which was mainly driven by the upswing of the Manufacturing sub-industry to 8.0% from the previous 7.4%. Construction also contributed to the growth although it was recorded in

ister Shinzo Abe.

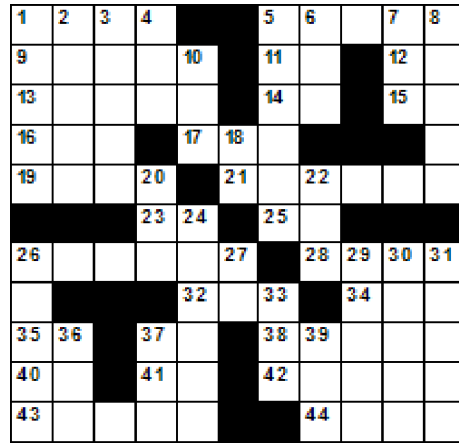
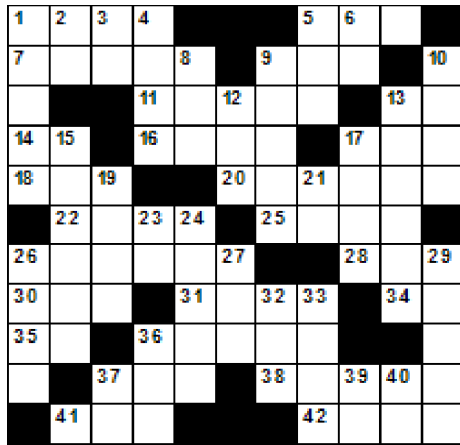
Earlier, Panelo bared that the President will attend the International Conference on the Future of Asia on May 30-31.

CA STARTS HEARING ON AMPARO SUITS BY MILITANT LAWYERS

MANILA — The Court of Appeals (CA) on Tuesday held its first hearing for the petition for a writ of amparo lodged by a lawyer's group against the military, accusing the government of red-baiting.

Lawyers of the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG,) led by Assistant Solicitor General Angelita Villanueva-Miranda on the part of the government, and lawyer Rachel Pastores of the Public Interest Law Center (PILC) on the part of the petitioners, attended the hearing.

The hearing was presided over by members of the Special 15th Division led by division chairman Stephen Cruz and Associate Justices Pedro Corales and Hermano Legaspi as members.

The CA hearing was a preliminary conference to consider the possible stipulation of facts between the parties and set the dates for subsequent hearing.

The PILC, representing members of the National Union of Peoples' Lawyers, said it will present 10 witnesses to prove its case when the next hearing is held on June 4.

The OSG, meanwhile, said it will question the petitioners "locus standi" or legal standing to initiate the suit and will present five witnesses to present their side.

The CA was tasked by the Supreme Court to conduct hearings on the petition and to submit its report to the high court.

Present during the hearing were Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) Deputy Chief of Staff for Civil-Military Operations, Major Gen. Antonio Parlade Jr.; AFP spokesperson, Marine Brig. Gen. Edgard Arevalo; and Presidential Communications Operations Office Undersecretary Lorraine Badoy.

The government, through the National Task Force to End Local Communist Insurgency, is working to uncover organizations used as legal fronts of the terrorist Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

The CPP-NPA is listed as a terrorist organization by the United States, the European Union, the United Kingdom, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, and the Philippines. (PNA)

SC orders re-arrest of 2 suspects in US Marine's death

MANILA — The Supreme Court (SC) voided the downgraded sentence of probation handed down by a Makati court against the two individuals, who ganged up on and mauled to death George Anikow, a US Marine, in a street fight seven years ago.

In a two-page resolution dated March 27, the SC First Division affirmed the decision issued by the Court of Appeals (CA) in March last year and ordered the re-arrest of Galicano Datu III and Crispin dela Paz.

Reiterating the CA's decision on the matter, the High Court said: "(T)he Regional Trial Court of Makati City Branch 59 committed grave abuse of discretion amounting to lack or excess of jurisdiction when it granted petitioner's application for probation."

Makati City Branch 59 Presiding Judge Winlove Dumayas, who erroneously granted the application for probation, had earlier been ordered dismissed from the service by the court for downgrading the penalty against the two after finding them liable only for homicide instead of murder in 2014.

"The circumstances surrounding the killing of George Anikow showed the gravity of the crime and to grant probation to the perpetrators would clearly diminish its seriousness," the SC explained.

The tribunal noted that the trial court erroneously relied on the post investigation report of the Makati City Parole and Probation Office (MCC-

PO) and failed to make its own determination.

In its March 2018 decision, the CA ruled that before granting probation, the court should consider the possibility of the offender to reform, together with the demands of justice and public interest, along with other relevant circumstances.

It noted that the application for probation is an admission of guilt on the part of an accused, however, Anikow's killers stood by their innocence, which is contrary to their availment of the benefits of probation.

Furthermore, the appellate court held that probation should have not been issued by the trial court since it would depreciate the seriousness of the crime committed by the two accused.

"The evidence at the trial established that Anikow was stabbed, kicked and punched multiple times, even after he had disengaged from his attackers and unable to defend himself or retaliate, resulting in his death. The nature of the crime of homicide and the manner of its commission is undoubtedly serious," it noted.

Anikow was stabbed to death in a brawl that happened outside the gate of Bel-Air subdivision near Rockwell Center, Makati City, on Nov. 24, 2012, when he confronted a group in a car trying to convince a guard to allow them to pass through the village gate. (PNA)

356 nabbed, P12-M seized in anti-vote buying ops: PNP

MANILA — The Philippine National Police (PNP) seized a total of PHP12.208 million in cash during operations against vote-buying across the country.

Based on the report from January 13 to May 14, authorities also arrested 356 persons in 225 reported vote-buying incidents nationwide.

The PNP said 85 suspects have been identified but they remain at large while eight minors have been "rescued" during the police operations.

The highest number of arrests were made in Metro Manila with 136 in nine reported incidents yielding PHP541,000 in total.

Of the total amount, Caraga Region has accounted for almost PHP8 million from 10 people apprehended, followed by Northern Mindanao with PHP1.12 million from 17 people arrested and Ilocos Region where 24 suspects yielded PHP561,000.

PNP spokesperson Col. Bernard Banac said the confiscated money have been submitted to prosecutors as evidence for criminal complaints filed against the suspects.

PNP chief Gen. Oscar Albayalde on Tuesday assured that they will further strengthen their capability to address vote-buying and selling activities in the next elections.

Albayalde said unlike the past years, the PNP now is more pro-active in apprehending personalities involved in vote-buying. Albayalde admitted that there were reports of "massive" vote-buying during the May 13, 2019 elections.

"There are several factors on vote buying. First, our elections are automated. Seemingly, the Comelec (Commission on Elections) said the VCMs (vote counting machines) are incorruptible so the tendency is for the candidates to go directly to the voters. Another is that we haven't seen any candidate getting suspended or investigated for alleged vote buying," he said.

The PNP chief, however, admitted that allegations of vote-buying are hard to prove.

For his part, DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año lauded the Task Force Kontra Bigay composed of the Comelec, DILG, PNP, and the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) for their concerted effort to confront head-on the menace of vote-buying in our country.

He said the arrest of hundreds of perpetrators is an important step in reducing if not eradicating this clear affront to our democracy.

"I congratulate the Comelec for its decisive leadership and we look forward to working with them
