## CAVITE EXHIBIT PAYS TRIBUTE TO 'ANLUWAGES'

**DASMARIÑAS CITY, Cavite**

-- An art exhibit that pays tribute to the craftsmanship of Filipino carpenters, back when they were called "anluwages", is ongoing at the Fe Sarmiento-Panlilio Room of the Museo De La Salle, at the De La Salle University here.

The exhibit, "ANLUWAGE: Creating Forms. Mastering Function", provides a glimpse of the remarkable craftsmanship of Filipino artisans and their unique skills of combining aesthetics and function.

"Especially so, now that in the advent of technology and high-powered tools, these artisanal skills are slowly becoming rare," Cecille Torrevillas-Gelicame, National Committee on Museums vice head and Museo De La Salle director, said on Friday.

She said putting up the exhibit was not easy because the "anluwage" is not just about their works, "but the love and the devotion given by these traditional artisans to the works of art."

Research realizations

Preparations for the exhibit called for extensive research and discussions, before the final artworks were gathered and put on display.

In the process, the exhibit revealed just how architecture evolved through the years, and that old Filipino master "anluwages" were actually the first practitioners of "green architecture".

Green architecture minimizes the harmful effects of construction projects on human health and the environment and its practitioner or designer attempts to safeguard air, water, and earth by choosing eco-friendly building materials and construction practices.

Gelicame also shared how Chinese artisans played greatly in history when it comes to "anluwages".

"Apparently the Chinese brought in the skill and taught our natives how to be as meticulous as they were," she said.

Gelicame said another realization is that the works of "anluwages" were guided by no less than their culture.

"Di mawawala ang superstition belief (Their work was guided by their superstitious beliefs)," she said.

"The Oro, Plata, Mata is part of the 'anluwage' belief, including the best time to cut trees for the right projects, and various rituals," she added.

From house parts, furniture pieces to galleons

Meanwhile, former prime minister and now chairman of the MDLS Board of Trustees, Cesar EA Virata, said that "anluwages" could have shared other lines of their craft.

"Meron ding umuukit, at gu-mawa ng mga santo, at ng dalawang malaking galleon na ang troso ay galing Maragondon (There were sculptures and they made saints, and two galleons using wood from Maragondon)," he said.

The "anluwages" also made the "paraw" (sailboat), named the San Bartolome, which Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo used for his trading business.

Virata said he was happy that the MDLS is paying tribute to these artisans through the exhibit because the "anluwages" made use of whatever available materials they had back then, using simple tools.

Revive the craft

Virata called for the revival of the olden Filipino craftsmanship of "anluwages" by planting more construction trees.

"Magtanim ng construction wood, magtanim para sa panggatong, magtanim tayo para sa mga prutas, magtanim tayo para maingatan ang mga gilid ng bundok, at kinakailangan magtanim tayo para sa paggawa ng bahay at kasangkapan (Plant construction wood for firewood, for fruits, to protect the mountains, and for building houses and furniture pieces)," Virata, a descendant of Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo, said as he spoke before members of the South Luzon Association of Museums (SLAMs), students and media during the exhibit

opening on September 24. The province of Cavite is home to centuries-old churches, heritage homes with some well-preserved old wooden furniture pieces and authentic wooden house parts that visitors view with awe, silently wondering how such elegant wood pieces were crafted back then, sans technology.

The exhibit, made possible by DLSU-D Architecture Department, Jherdzfont Graphics, and Cavite's Provincial Tourism Office, also tackles sustainability through the concept of "Green Architecture".

"Anluwage", which runs until December 14, is the museum's offering for the Museum and Galleries Month observed every October by virtue of Presidential Proclamation 798 s. 1991. This year's celebration theme is "Building the Nation, One Exhibit at a Time".

The exhibit also forms part of "Project Bayani: Curating South Luzon", a simultaneous exhibit to capture in a single theme the thrusts of each participating museum.

The MDLS is open from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesdays to Saturdays. (By Gladys Pino-PNA)

## NCCA asks museum execs to come up with year-round events

**DASMARIÑAS CITY, Cavite**

- The National Commission on Culture and the Arts (NCCA) is encouraging members of the South Luzon Association of Museums (SLAMs) to come up with activities all year round aside from the month-long celebration of the Museum and Galleries Month (MGM) in October.

Fr. Harold Rentoria, OSA, NCCA Commissioner on Cultural Heritage, made the call when asked for ways to "level" up the impact of the MGM 2019 celebration during the South Luzon kick-off held at the College of Tourism and Hospitality Management (CTHM) of the De La Salle University campus here on Tuesday.

"Our encouragement is that the celebration should not only be on the month of October domesticated month, but it should be a year-long celebration," Rentoria said.

The Museums and Galleries Month (MGM) is observed every month of October by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 798, s. 1991.

For some time, the NCCA has put the national celebration on hold and revived it anew this

year to bring back the purpose of galleries and museums to the consciousness of the Filipino people.

"This is what we at the NCCA is really pushing - that you visit museums because it reminds us of our past, of who we are," Rentoria added.

Holding activities regularly will continue the advocacy to promote awareness, and also help in educating the people of what museums and galleries are all about.

"It educates us of who we are and it will strengthen our identity as Filipinos," said Rentoria.

This year's nationwide celebration, themed "Building the Nation, One Exhibit at a time"

acknowledges the roles of museums and galleries as instruments in creating national consciousness for Filipinos. There will be separate kick-off ceremonies in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

The NCCA, through its National Committee on Museums (NCNA-NCOM), has partnered with Museo De La Salle, an in-campus museum of DLSU here, for the South Luzon launch.

Joining Rentoria in the panel of resource speakers during the launch were National Committee on Art Galleries Head John Delan Robillos, and Cecille Torrevillas-Gelicame, National Committee on Museums vice head and Museo De La Salle Director. (PNA)

## Heritage and urbanization, how an icon stood the test of time

**KAWIT, Cavite** -- The province of Cavite, with its plethora of historical sites (not to mention events), is being transformed as an investment hub in the greater capital region. With this changing landscape, how will history play in the backdrop of modernization and industrialization?

In celebration of Museums and Galleries Month this October, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), through its Museo ni Emilio Aguinaldo (MEA), has mounted the exhibit "Emilio Aguinaldo Shrine: Identity on Shifting Landscape" from October 5 to November 22 to present the rich historical and cultural face of the iconic Emilio Aguinaldo Shrine amid recent developments and the influx of migration.

Cluster head of NHCP-Cavite and MEA curator Haidee Paulette Bedruz said Thursday that the theme came about as the construction of new establishments and the imminent completion of a business site offer a new face for the town. "It gives people new things to see and visit in Kawit, unlike in the past where(in) visiting Kawit means visiting the Aguinaldo Shrine," she said.

The NHCP has brought this concept to revisit the role the Aguinaldo Shrine played in the town's historical, cultural, and tourism dynamics.

By creating awareness of the significance of built heritage in perpetuating the ideals of the 1896 Revolution and the Proclamation of Independence in 1898 as relevant to the people

in the present, Bedruz expressed hope that this would empower Kawiteños to see the value of the Aguinaldo Shrine, "amidst their current progress and continue to associate themselves in the identity of the house."

"As presented in its narratives, it will show how the Aguinaldo Shrine has been part of the larger community of Kawit, allowing it to remain a part of our national history yet relevant to the local perspective of the people," she said.

In recent years, cultural mapping engaged the community and saw the significance of other heritage sites, such as the Irasan, Pandayan, and the St. Mary Magdalene Church.

In the past, these sites were visited not for tourism but for their actual purposes. Today, they are part of a bigger cultural and historical narrative of the town.

The Museum and Galleries Month is observed every October by virtue of Presidential Proclamation 798 series of 1991. This year's celebration theme is "Building the Nation, One Exhibit at a Time".

The exhibit also forms part of "Project Bayani: Curating South Luzon", a simultaneous exhibit among members of the Southern Luzon Association of Museums. The project attempts to promote a museum route by creating a unifying exhibit to capture in a single theme the thrusts of each participating museum.

The MEA is one of the three NHCP-run museums in Cavite, along with Museo ni Bal-

## DOH CONCLUDES BASIC WHEELCHAIR TRAINING FOR CALABARZON

Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON

(Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 started the four-day "Wheelchair Service Package Training Basic Level" for wheelchair users, Person with Disability (PWD) coordinators and caregivers of the province of Rizal held at Ciudad Christia Resort in San Mateo Rizal from September 17-20, 2019.

According to Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo, there are a total of 130 personnel trained from various provinces of the region. "Most wheelchair users are now equipped with the proper knowledge on how to effectively use their devices, render assistance to other users in the maintenance and repair and provide assessment and evaluation in selecting a wheelchair that is suitable for their needs," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

"Some PWDs use wheelchairs as their only means of movement, that is why it is important for them to have a wheelchair that fits and properly adjusted to their own physique as soon as they get out of bed and use it and start their daily routine," he added.

The WHO Wheelchair Basic Level Training includes an 8-step service-delivery process that includes assessment by professionals, the development of a wheelchair prescription with the involvement of the wheelchair user and family, proper fitting and adjustment of the

wheelchair, training of the wheelchair user and caregiver in maintenance and wheelchair handling skills, and long-term follow-up for refinements, routine servicing and periodic replacement.

DOH Regional PWD Outcome Manager Paulina A. Calo said that using wheelchairs promote independence and social participation. "Ineffective use of the wheelchair by its user compromises independence and may result to unwanted accidents. Proper skills for positioning and doing pressure reliefs, driving the wheelchair on flat and uneven terrains including navigating in various obstacles, such as stairs, humps, curves and falling safely must also be taught accurately."

One of the participants, Mr. Emmanuel Jamisol, Federation Vice President from Cainta, Rizal and a wheelchair user for 23 years said, "napakaimportante ng training na ito sa aming mga wheelchair users dahil ito pa lang ang training na nakapagbigay ng mga mahalahagang impormasyon at naturuan kami ng ibat-ibang pamamaraan sa tamang paggamit kasama na ang pagkumpuni ng wheelchair. Mas naintindihan ko na at naunawaan ang kahalagahan ng wheelchair sa pang araw-araw na gamit ko nito."

# DOH LAUNCHES MAG-PINGGANG PINOY TAYO IN CAINTA

**Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon)** in partnership with the Food and Nutrition Research Institute (FNRI) and Ajinomoto Philippines Corporation (APC) and the municipality of Cainta, Rizal on Friday, September 20, 2019 launched the 2019 Mag-Pinggang Pinoy Tayo! Program to promote the newest per-meal food guide for households of Cainta in Rizal province.

"Malnutrition is a health burden that greatly affects children. When not properly addressed it can cause various illness and even death. Kung ang mga batang ito naman ay nabuhay, nagkakaroon sila ng panghababuhay na depekto sa katawan, gaya ng stunting o hindi tamang paglaki at depekto sa mata, diabetes at heart disease," Regional Local Health Division Chief Dr. Noel G. Pasion stated in his message.

"Adequate nutrition is one of the factors that encourage growth and development of children. As parents, we must provide them with a balanced diet with the right nutrients including three daily meals and two healthy snacks if desired. Ang mga Pilipino ay mahilig kumain ngunit kung ating susuriin ito ay hindi balance at sobra sa carbohydrate at kadalasan kulang sa

protina," he emphasized. He also stressed that nutrition not only promotes health it also prevents diseases. "The foods we eat and the nutrients they provide are the environmental factors that influence our growth, development, functional abilities, and health."

Dr. Pasion reminded parents the importance of proper nutrition and the need to develop healthy eating habits among their children during their growing years. "They must be guided on how to prepare nutritious food for their child's physical and mental growth and this is where our health workers come in, to properly educate mothers and caregivers on the importance of the MPPT program in their daily life." The MPPT program will target a total of 2,500 households in Cainta, Rizal. Among the barangays included are San Andres and San Juan (with 750 households (HH) each), San Isidro (540 HH), Sto. Domingo (320 HH), San Roque and Sta Rosa/Nino (with 70 HH each).

According to the 8th National Nutrition Survey, CALABARZON ranks sixth in stunting and first in the prevalence of overweight nationwide. The prevalence of stunting in the country has increased from 30.3 percent in 2013 to 33.5 in 2015 while underweight increased from 19.9 percent to 21.6 percent.

Cainta City Health Officer

Dr. Edgardo M. Gonzaga disclosed that the prevalence of wasting or below weight-for-height in the city is at 1.65% (638) children out of the 38,617 and the prevalence of stunting or low height-for-age is at 1.37% (597 children out of 43,544) taken during the Operation Timbang (OPT) Plus held in 2018.

"We are conducting an annual weighing and height measurement of all preschoolers 9-71 months old or below six years old to identify and locate the malnourished children and provide the nutrition interventions needed for them to reach the normal weight and height," he emphasized.

The objective of the MPPT program is to educate every family in the community through the Barangay Health Workers (BHW), Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS) and mothers and encourage them to adopt a healthy lifestyle attitude to lessen the prevalence of malnutrition including healthy lifestyle diseases.

A ceremonial contract signing was also held for the project orientation and training of Barangay Health Workers (BHW), Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), and other community partners that will focus on the promotion and importance of using the Pinggang Pinoy food guide in the daily preparation of food for the family. ## PRRD signs law creating Judges-at-Large posts

**MANILA** -- President Rodrigo Duterte has signed a law creating 100 positions of Regional Trial Judges-at-Large and 50 Municipal Trial Judges-at-Large.

Duterte signed the "Judges-at-Large Act of 2019" Republic Act No. 11459 on Aug. 30

but a copy was made public on Wednesday.

The R.A. 11459 amends "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980".

Under the law, the 100 Regional Trial Judges-at-Large and the 50 Municipal Trial Judges-at-Large will have

no permanent salaries and may be assigned by the Supreme Court (SC) as acting or assisting judges to any Regional Trial Court in the Philippines as public interest may require.

Regional Trial and Municipal Trial Judges-at-Large are entitled to salaries, privileges, allowances, emoluments, benefits, rank and title of a Regional Trial Judge and Municipal Trial Judge, respectively.

It also states that the Supreme Court will determine the length of such temporary assignment.

After the period of the temporary assignment, the Judicial and Bar Council (JBC) will recommend to the presidential appointees to Judges-at-Large positions.

The JBC will also recommend to the President the permanent sala to which the Judge-at-Large will be appointed.

Qualifications of Judges-of-Large include being a natural-born Filipino citizen; at least 35 years of age;

and for at least 10 years has been engaged in the practice of law in the Philippines or has held a public office in the Philippines requiring admission to the practice of law as an indispensable requisite."

Aside from their salaries, justices and judges will receive a monthly longevity pay equivalent to 5 percent of the monthly basic pay for five years of continuous, efficient, and meritorious service rendered to the Judiciary.

The amount necessary of the implementation of the law will be charged against the available appropriations of the Judiciary under the current General Appropriations Act. After, the amount necessary for its continuous implementation will be included in the annual GAA.

The Supreme Court, in consultation with the Budget Secretary, will promulgate the necessary rules and regulations (IRR) on the implementation of the law. (PNA)
