ALFONSO: HIDDEN GEM OF THE SOUTH YET TO BE DISCOVERED

TRECE MARTIRES, Cavite (PIA) – Alfonso Municipal Mayor Randy Salamat disclosed his vision for the town becoming the ‘must-visit’ tourist destination in the south, which will pave the way for the development and progress of its tourism and agricultural industry. Mayor Salamat said in an interview with Bing Kimpo in Presidential Communications Operations Office’s Laging Handa Network Briefing News that the municipality consists of 6,996 hectares of agricultural land, 70% of which he intends to maintain solely for agriculture with the recent Land Use plan the LGU had submitted to Congress.

He envisions the municipality to have a distinct identity by not allowing the establishment of relocation sites to maintain peace and order in the town, and intends to further develop the tourism industry which could bring a bigger income for the local government to be able to bring government service to all sectors of society.

Tagged as the ‘Hidden Gem of the South’, the town boasts of hundreds of resorts, restaurants, events places and accommodation hotels, and “glamping” and camping sites filled with lush greenery and natural, cool running streams and waterfalls in the cool upland weather conducive for staycations.

Mayor Salamat in his first-term has accomplished several projects such as infrastructure, farm-to-market roads and water-irrigation systems; the construction of a dialysis and lying-in center to provide for the medical needs of his constituents; establishment of a central terminal that for the convenience of commuting residents; continued relief

assistance to families and individuals highly affected by the Taal Volcano eruption in January 2020 and COVID-19 response during the current pandemic.

He disclosed that the local government’s vaccination efforts has inoculated more than 70% of the target population with the town’s population at 66,000.

To date, about 31,060 residents are fully vaccinated including the pediatric population against COVID-19 with more than 500 vaccinations a day in the continued vax rollouts, Salamat added.

Meanwhile, the town’s agriculture industry produces many high yielding crops due to its fertile land and conducive weather. Fruit-bearing trees of different varieties, bananas, lettuce and now strawberries and grapes are currently being studied for full production.

Road constructions under President Rodrigo Duterte’s Build, Build, Build through the Department of Public Works and Highways road network projects, which include the recently opened the Tagaytay Bypass Road, are set to attract more progress to the town.

Another road project is the Cavite-Tagaytay-Batangas Expressway (CTBEX) with two intersections which will give access to the town and is seen to reduce travel time to and from neighboring cities and provinces greatly contributing to the economy of the municipality and the province as a whole.

“Consistency is the key,” Mayor Salamat said about continuing the administration’s ‘Responsabeng Serbisyo’, that progress and development should be sustained and continued with long-term planning and concrete plans for the future. (RBF/PIA-Cavite)

DEPED IMUS CITY IMPROVES RECRUITMENT PROCESS, LAUNCHES SMART HR: ONLINE HIRING SYSTEM

Putting premium on meritocracy and excellence espoused by the Civil Service Commission (CSC), the Schools Division of Imus City has formally shifted to a strategic human resource management through “SMART HR”, an innovative, citizen-centered online hiring system that will facilitate the recruitment, selection, and placement (RSP) process of potential qualified applicants.

During the virtual launch on Monday, January 10 via Google Meet, CSC Director Maria Theresa Poblador lauded SDOIC’s initiative which serves as an integral part of the Division’s RSP as a system in the PRIME-HRM (Program to Institutionalize Meritocracy and Excellence in Human Resource Management). “This is a manifestation of both developmental and transformative process to attain the mandate of every agency... to keep on improving the way it does its business, to look for ways to better deliver desired results, as well as meet the needs of its clients,” she said.

The CSC director also hopes that this innovation serves as benchmark to other agencies in their journey towards becoming smart organizations “because those who initiate change will have a better opportunity to manage the change that is inevitable.”

According to OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Mr. Ivan Brian L. Inductivo, the lead proponent of the System for Meritocratic, Automated, Reengineered, and Transparent Hiring for the Department of Education (SMART HR), the system is not just a response to the call of the pandemic but also part of SDOIC’s entire e-governance plan and part of a very massive and collective BIDA system that has a roadmap of developing frontline services and making sure that these are automated and accessible to the public.

“This is to reengineer the

way we provide our services, and to make our hiring process a reliable one—with trust and confidence—in terms of ranking, transparency and objective appraisal of credentials and competencies so that competent and worthy public servants will be on board with us,” Inductivo said.

Meanwhile, Schools Division Superintendent Dr. Rosemarie D. Torres claimed that the system is a breakthrough milestone and legacy for SDO Imus City which will help facilitate the fast and excellent services in terms of hiring and leading towards customer satisfaction.

“Now, our applicants need not to go personally to submit their pertinent documents for application. They may do it online via www.depedimuscity.com,” she said.

SMART HR is a capstone project of ASDS Inductivo as scholar of the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP).

Imus’ home-quarantined symptomatics given COVID care kits

IMUS CITY, Cavite (PIA) – Imus City aims to diminish the rapid transmission of the COVID-19 omicron variant through its Home Mitigation Program initiative which includes the provision of care kits to symptomatic patients undergoing home quarantine.

Imus City Public Information Office chief Jay Saquilayan says, “Once a symptomatic patient tested positive with the antigen test, he/she undergoes Real Time Polymerase Chain Reaction Test (RT PCR) for confirmation.”

Positive patients with no symptoms are advised to isolate for a required period of time while positive symptomatic patients undergo home quarantine and are provided COVID-19 Care Kits from the city government with priority to members of the vulnerable sector such as the Senior Citizens, Persons with comorbidities and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs). The care kits were distributed to the

Dasmariñas City public hospital restricts entry to unvaxed

TRECE MARTIRES, Cavite (PIA) – The management of the Pagamutan ng Dasmariñas, recently implemented the requirement for the presentation of COVID-19 vaccination card of individuals who need to access medical services and allow entry to the facility.

According to the Public Advisory of the said hospital, regulations allow patients for confinement whether vaccinated or not to be admitted in the hospital as well as children 11 years below who are not yet vaccinated against COVID-19.

Meanwhile, Persons who remain unvaccinated may present a doctor’s certificate to prove their health condition that restrict them from getting the vaccine.

‘Effects of lockdown outweigh the benefits’ – Gov. Remulla

TRECE MARTIRES, Cavite (PIA) – Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla stands firm on opposing plans of lockdown because the effects of a

never-ending lockdown outweigh the benefits.’ Remulla stated his opinion in the midst of the continuing spike in CoViD-19 cases in the province with 1,188 new positive cases recorded in the province as of January 9, 2022.

The province also recorded the highest number of Active cases in the CALABARZON region at 4,273 with more cases anticipated in the coming weeks.

Despite the CoViD-19 situation in the province, the CoViD-ICU capacity is at 41.5% in the province’s hospitals. Majority of the new cases recorded or 96.4% manifest mild symptoms or are asymptomatic and there are zero reported deaths in the province.

Thus, the governor remains optimistic that the province would once again overcome this crisis.

He emphasized the need to be responsible, knowledgeable, and disciplined to mitigate the spread of the virus.

“Omicron may be the most contagious variant yet given the tsunami of infections we are seeing. Better safe than sorry so let’s all do our part in protecting ourselves and those around us,” reminded Governor Jonvic.

In this time of pandemic, it is important to remain at home and make it a habit to observe the minimum health standards to keep safe from Covid-19. (Ruel Francisco with reports from Cavite Provincial Information Office)

Online influencers conference held to boost China-ASEAN ties

The first ASEAN-China Online Influencers Conference and Fujian Brands Promotion Tour along Maritime Silk Road concluded in Fuzhou, southeast China's Fujian Province on Jan. 13, a year after China and ASEAN celebrated the 30th anniversary of their dialogue relations and elevated their ties to a comprehensive strategic partnership.

Themed "Set Sail from Blessed Land when the Wind is Positive," the event also followed the implementation of the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP), the world's largest free trade deal that will bring new development opportunities to China-ASEAN ties.

During the three-day event, ASEAN diplomats to China and representatives from media organizations, as well as Chinese and ASEAN online influencers learned about Fuzhou's experience in developing digital industry and experienced the culture of Fujian province through field visits and online activities. They also shared what they saw and felt in the city on social media platforms.

The event focused on economic and trade cooperation and cultural exchanges between China and ASEAN, and held three dialogues on digital economy, influencer economy and cross-border e-commerce.

It also acted as a matchmaker between Chinese and ASEAN enterprises. Fujian Asia-Pacific Economic and Trade Cooperation Promotion Association, China's first provincial-level business association responding to the RCEP agreement, set the stage for a series of agreements between Chinese and ASEAN industries, including a \$5.6 billion intended deal inked by Fujian's Eversun Holdings Group to invest in an ASEAN refinery.

The conference, joined by online influencers, expanded new space for telling stories about China-

ASEAN cooperation under the RCEP framework. It mirrored the broad cooperation between China and ASEAN countries on people-to-people exchanges and witnessed the deepening regional economic integration between the two sides.

China's Assistant Foreign Minister Hua Chunying delivered a speech at the conference via video link. She noted that the fruits of China-ASEAN cooperation in the past 30 years are made possible by the right historical choice taken by the farsighted leaders of the two sides who have embraced the trend of the times, and they are also a result of the unique ties between the two sides marked by geographical proximity and cultural affinity.

She said online influencers are telling the best stories and writing history every day. "Creative and empathetic, you are sharing the emotional highs and lows of ordinary people on social media and the Internet. Their experience of small serendipities and pursuit of big dreams strike a chord with every one of us and draw people closer across national borders," she remarked.

Both online and offline discussions were carried out at the event focusing on the correlation between influencer economy and cross-border e-commerce. The in-depth exchanges between Chinese and ASEAN online influencers reflected their expectation for the future development of e-commerce.

In a dialogue session, Chinese influencers shared the stories of their exchanges with ASEAN netizens, hoping to contribute to the cooperation between China and ASEAN on influencer economy and cross-border e-commerce through their influence.

Their ASEAN counterparts expressed similar aspirations. Cambodian gaming streamer Seaneang said that China and Cambodia enjoy a long history of friendship, and she hopes to further

Palace hopes voters fully vaccinated in time for 2022 polls

MANILA – Malacañang on Tuesday expressed hope that all registered voters will be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 in time for the national and local elections on May 9. Nograles said the national government is aiming to fully vaccinate 77 million Filipinos—including voters—by the first quarter of 2022 to help protect them against severe disease and death from the virus.

"Bago pa man sumapit ang April or even May, gusto natin yung adult population natin lahat po ay fully vaccinated. Sa ganoong paraan dagdag proteksyon para sa mga botante (Before April or even May, we want our adult population to be fully vaccinated. That way, it would be an additional protection for voters),"

the exchanges between the cultures of the two countries despite their differences. Indonesian influencer Harini Riswanda introduced her efforts to maintain strict inspection and integrity when promoting cross-border e-commerce. Alexandra Bounxouei from Laos believes that music and media are bringing closer the people from her country and China, though they speak different languages and have different cultures and traditions.

As China's first large forum joined by senior government officials, scholars and online influencers, the event was co-sponsored by the ASEAN-China Centre, Global Times Online, Department of Commerce of Fujian Province, Foreign Affairs Office of the People's Government of Fujian Province, and Fuzhou Municipal People's Government. It was supported by China Public Diplomacy Association and Mission of the People's Republic of China to ASEAN, and co-organized by Fujian Asia-Pacific Economic and Trade Cooperation Promotion Association. **PR**

Aside from getting their Covid-19 jabs, Nograles said voters should also continue adhering to minimum public health standards in polling precincts.

"Yung bakuna is one layer of protection, pero yung 'Mask, Hugas, Iwas', gaya nga ng sinabi ni [Health] Secretary Duque kagabi sa Talk to the People, more than 90 percent protection yun, adherence natin to minimum public health standards (The vaccine is one layer of protection, but as Secretary Duque said during last night's Talk to the People, adherence to minimum public health standards provides 90 percent protection from the virus)," he added.

Meanwhile, he said the Palace will leave it up to the Commission on Elections (Comelec) to ensure that such Covid-19 health protocols are observed.

On Dec. 31, 2021, Duterte deputized the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and other law enforcement agencies for the May 2022 polls.

Under Memorandum Order No. 59, law enforcement agencies and other concerned agencies are directed to coordinate and cooperate with the Comelec in the performance of their duties and functions.

The Comelec earlier said unvaccinated voters will be allowed to cast their votes in the upcoming elections. However, those in quarantine are not allowed to vote unless Congress passes a law allowing them to vote by mail.

As of January 17, the Department of Health said a total of 55,195,488 Filipinos are now fully vaccinated against Covid-19.

With the current pace of vaccination, Nograles said the country is set to fully vaccinate 70 percent of its total population in 53 days. **(PNA)**

PRRD OKs expansion of limited F2F classes by February

MANILA – President Rodrigo Duterte has approved the recommendation of the Department of Education (DepEd) to expand limited face-to-face (F2F) classes in areas under Alert Levels 1 and 2 by February, Malacañang said Tuesday. This, after DepEd Secretary Leonor Briones proposed the "progressive expansion" of in-person classes in areas under Alert Levels 1 and 2 following the positive outcome of the pilot run from Nov. 15 to Dec. 22, 2021.

Schools in areas under Alert Level 3--such as Metro Manila--will not be included in the expansion phase due to a surge of Covid-19 infection in these areas.

"Walang objection si Pangulo doon (The President has no objection to the recommendation)," Cabinet Secretary Karlos Nograles, acting Presidential spokesperson, said in a Palace press briefing.

Nograles, however, said F2F classes will only be allowed with concurrence of local government units (LGUs) and consent of parents and other stakeholders.

"It will be the DepEd and the [Department of Health] combined that will be

assessing the expansion of pilot implementation nung (of) face-to-face classes," he added.

During Duterte's prerecorded Talk to the People aired Monday night, Briones described the pilot run of limited F2F classes as "highly successful", noting that there was a high level of attendance among students.

She said a total of 287 schools and 15,000 students participated in the pilot run. There were no confirmed Covid-19 cases among the participants of the pilot implementation.

For the expanded phase, Briones said she has recommended that only vaccinated teachers and non-teaching personnel will be allowed to participate.

Meanwhile, she also recommended that vaccinated students will be preferred to participate during the expansion phase.

Last month, Duterte said he was pleased with the "gradual" rollout of pilot limited face-to-face classes.

"I'm glad that they have thought of this just dahan-dahan lang, huwang masyadong mabilis kasi (gradually, not too fast because of) just the better part of prudence," he said. **(PNA)**

Expect colder days in Metro Manila until March: PAGASA

MANILA–The temperature in Metro Manila dipped to a new record low since the onset of the northeast monsoon or amihan and may even fall further until the end of this weather system by around late March.

The temperature dipped to 19°C at 6 a.m. on Tuesday, lower than the 19.7°C record low on January 16 this year as amihan is surging,

Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) weather forecaster Ana Clauren said.

"It's possible for Metro Manila to experience

even lower temperatures during forthcoming amihan surges," she said.

Clauren said such surges can be expected as northeast monsoon is already beginning to peak. According to PAGASA, the annual amihan starts over Siberia as cold, dry air mass that gathers moisture while traveling across the Pacific Ocean.

On Tuesday, the state weather bureau said amihan is affecting Metro Manila and other parts of the country.

Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rain are possible due to amihan, it said. **(PNA)**

Usapang Sports via Zoom at live streaming sa TOPS FB page at YouTube. Ayon kay Kiram, 'test in discipline' ang pandemya para sa mga atleta. "Although, regular ang communications namin sa mga Sports Association at sa kanilang mga officials and coaches, yung pananagutan kung nagsasanay ba sila ng tama, sapat ang pagkain at training, kung nasusunod ba yung programa na ibinigay ng coach ay nasa kamay ng mga atleta at mga NSAs concerned," sambit ni Kiram.

Aniya, hindi lamang Pilipinas bagkus maging ang mga kapit-bahayna bansa ay naapektuhan ng COVID-19 kung kaya't nalimitahan din ang pagsasanay ng kanilang mga atleta. "This coming SEA Games, kumpiyansa ako sa kakayahang

ng ating mga atleta, but for sure, hindi ganoon katindi ang impact, simply because on the issue of COVID-19. In 2019, yung performance natin ang tindi kasi todo naman ang training hindi tulad ngayon naapektuhan talaga. But, still as what I said earlier, morale obligation nila ang magsanay, kami naman sa PSC todo pa rin ang suporta financially," aniya.

Overall champion ang Team Philippines sa Manila SEAG nitong 2019. Sa Hanoi, sasabak sa 39 sa kabuuang 40 sports ang Team Pilipinas, ngunit ilan sa mga sports na humakot ng medalya ang Pinoy sa Manila edition ay hindi lalaruin sa Vietnam.

"We already submitted the entry by number sa Vietnam with around 627 athletes.

Yung entry by names sa April pa kaya may time pa ang mga NSA para mapili kung sino ang mga potensyal medalists para sa PH Team," pahayag ni Kiram.

Aniya, nakapagpalabas na ang PSC ng P200 milyon para sa kinakailangang equipment, training expenses, exposures para sa SEA Games at may nakalaang pang P50 milyon para sa tournament proper kabilang na ang travel expenses, kagamitan at allowances.

Hinimok ni Kiram ang mga atleta na panatilihin ang disciplina at pagpupunyagi para maabot ang pinakamataas na level ng pagiging kompetitibo, higit at subok na ang kakayahang ng Pilipino sa sitwasyong nangangailangan nang mas mataas na pang-unawa at sakrispisy.

"Kami naman sa PSC trabaho pa rin. Kahit na may nagkakaroon na rin COVID-19 sa aming mga frontliners, we make sure na maibibigay pa rin ang pangangailangan ng ating mga atleta, gayundin ang support na hinihingi ng mga NSA at iba pang sports institution tulad ng paglalakad sa visa requirements and tax exception para sa mga bibiyahe abroad," ayon kay Kiram.



Active cases in Cavite almost breach 10K mark

Trece Martires, Cavite (PIA) - Two weeks into the year 2022, the rapid increase in Covid-19 cases recorded in the province brought the number of Active cases to almost ten thousand.

The CoViD-19 Case Tracker released by the Provincial Health Office as of 2pm today, January 13, 2022 recorded 2,096 new cases in the entire province, the highest number recorded in a period of ten days from January 3, 2022.

The rapid transmission of the virus was evident as recorded new cases jumped from 214 on January 3, 2022 to more than one thousand cases daily starting January 8 onwards.

The total Active cases of 9,807 is equivalent to 7% of the total number of

Confirmed cases now at 138,793. According to LGU records, most cases recorded are either asymptomatic, or are experiencing mild symptoms.

Among the 23 cities/municipalities in the province, Imus City tops the list for the highest number of Active cases with 2,584 cases followed by the city of Bacoor with 1,398. Following third in the list is the city of General Trias with 910 recorded Active cases, the cities of Dasmariñas and Trece Martires at fourth and fifth with 904 and 551 recorded Active cases respectively.

Meanwhile, the total Recoveries is more than 125K and CoViD-19 related Deaths recorded is at 3,364. (Ruel Francisco with reports from CoViD-19 Case Tracker PHO)

1K post office employees get booster jabs

MANILA - Postmaster General Norman Fulgencio of the Philippine Post Office said some 1,000 frontline personnel received their booster shots against Covid-19 during the recent Post Office's first booster vaccination drive with the assistance of Presidential Adviser for Covid-19 Response Secretary Vince Dizon and Manila Mayor Francisco "Isko Moreno" Domagoso.

Another 2,500 doses will be allocated for another batch of post office employees and their eligible dependents on February 3.

"At the start of the year, a total of 3,500 booster shots has been allotted to post office employees and their families which is necessary to protect them against Omicron variant of Covid-19," Fulgencio said in a news release on Wednesday.

He said getting a Covid-19 vaccine booster shot "gives the public confidence that we are serving, including post office personnel and letter carriers they are dealing with are fully

vaccinated with booster, erasing fear and doubts of acquiring the virus".

Postal areas nationwide are advised to coordinate with their local Barangay Health Unit for their booster shots.

"We are taking early guard to make our employees safe against new cases of infection surge across the country," Fulgencio said. The government noted that vaccinations and boosters help lower the mortality risk and the burden on the country's health infrastructure.

Fulgencio thanked President Rodrigo Roa Duterte for his support in the vaccination of post office workers and for his continuing effort to protect employees from contracting the virus to keep the workplace safe.

"It is necessary for our essential workers to secure vaccines most especially the letter carriers who are usually exposed in the field, as they continue to interact with the public in delivering mails and parcels," he said. (PR)

DA to import 60MT of fish due to 'Odette'-induced shortage

MANILA - Department of Agriculture (DA) Secretary William Dar said there is a need to import 60,000 metric tons (MT) of small pelagic fish to meet the demand for the first quarter of 2022 due to the damage incurred by the fishery sector from Typhoon Odette in December last year.

Dar also announced on Tuesday the signing of the Certificate of Necessity to Import after the assessment showed significant damage and reduced fish production, especially galunggong (round scad), sardines, and mackerel.

In a Laging Handa public briefing, Dar said they are working to remedy the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources' projection of a 119,000 MT fish supply deficiency during the first three months.

"We are bolstering the aquaculture sector to close gaps in fish production and

sustainably improve our catch," he added.

The fishery sector incurred some PHP4 billion in total value loss and damage after "Odette" lashed the country on Dec. 16 and 17, 2021.

The DA also foresees spikes in fisheries and aquaculture input costs as global prices of petroleum and fish feed inch upwards.

"We are, as always, striking the crucial balance to ensure fish security among consumers while coming to the aid of our fish producers," Dar said.

The DA allotted PHP50 million from its PHP1 billion Quick Response Fund post- "Odette" for the distribution of marine diesel/gasoline engines, fiberglass fishing boats, and distribution of relief goods such as canned tuna, sardines, and frozen fish.

Another PHP35 million worth of interventions were also distributed to affected regions. (PR)

Fully vaxxed Calabarzon residents hit 8M mark

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna (PIA) - Calabarzon region continues to log the second-highest Covid-19 vaccination rate in the entire region, where around 3,044,846 individuals have been fully vaccinated and 209,918 individuals already inoculated with Covid-19 booster doses.

Meanwhile, around 1,046,674 indigent residents have already received complete doses of Covid-19 vaccines, which provided them full protection against severe symptoms of the deadly disease.

The Department of Health stressed the importance of getting vaccinated against Covid-19 amid the rising number of Covid-19 cases in the country.

Earlier this month, Secretary Francisco Duque III urged the public to complete their Covid-19 shots which are effective in reducing the transmission of the deadly virus. — Patricia Bermudez, PIA4A

Deadline extended for Bar examinees' submission of requirements

MANILA - The Supreme Court (SC) has extended the deadline of the submission of documents of Bar examinees until mid-February.

In a bulletin released Tuesday, the high court said "the deadline for submitting the physical, original copies of the pertinent documents for the Bar application process has been moved to February 15, 2022".

The original deadline for the documents, which include a verified petition to take the Bar, is on January 31.

"(W)e recognize that the recent Covid-19 surge and the crippling effects of Typhoon Odette have made it difficult for many examinees to comply with the deadline. Thus, it is moved to sometime after the Bar Examination," the SC said.

The exam will be held on February 4 and 6, instead of the previous January 23 and 25, citing a high rate of infection among examinees and support personnel.

About 16.8 percent of the 8,546 examinees who responded to an e-mail are either positive for Covid-

19, living with someone positive for the virus, or under quarantine as a direct contact and are at risk of not being able to take the examination if the original schedule were to push through.

The SC also extended the deadline to February 2 for examinees to take the required sample exams.

The sample exams are non-graded practice tests that simulate the experience of using Examplify, a secure exam delivery program, for the actual examinations.

The SC encourages applicants to take the sample exams multiple times to ensure that they are familiar with Examplify's features and functions.

"It will also confirm the compatibility of the applicants' laptops with Examplify. Answers to the Sample Exams will not be checked and have no bearing on the applicant's actual performance in the 2020/21 Bar Examinations. Only the download of the Sample Exams and upload of the answer will require an Internet connection," the SC said. (PNA)

BIR's digital transformation projects to benefit taxpayers

MANILA – The Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) has a total of 49 projects in the first phase of its 10-year Digital Transformation (DX) Roadmap, of which 14 have already been launched or implemented as of the last quarter of 2021.

In a report to Finance Secretary Carlos Dominguez III, the BIR said 26 of the 49 DX projects involve "elevating taxpayer experience and innovating BIR service processes," nine are on "enhancing administration and the BIR's support services," another eight are on "aligning policies to a BIR digital workplace," and six more are on "enabling the digital backbone" of the Bureau.

The BIR said its ongoing DX programs, which have expanded the range of electronic payment channels that allow taxpayers to file and pay their taxes online, enabled the bureau to continue collecting taxes even amid the mobility restrictions that have been put in place during the pandemic.

In 2020, the share of tax payments from e-payment channels amounted to PHP1.66 trillion, or 85 percent of its total collection of PHP1.95 trillion.

Dominguez has ordered all agencies attached to the Department of Finance (DOF) to implement their respective digital transformation programs long before the pandemic. Among the DX projects already launched or implemented by the BIR include its Internal Revenue Integrated System (IRIS), which serves as the bureau's central tool and repository to process taxpayer information; and the Enhanced Internal Revenue Stamps Integrated System (IRSIS), which is an application that manages the ordering, production, distribution, affixing and tracking of revenue stamps to monitor the proper payment of excise taxes on tobacco products.

The BIR also has a single hotline number and its

chatbot "REVIE" on its website to assist taxpayers with general inquiries on top of being able to email the bureau regarding their concerns.

Both the hotline and chatbot projects were launched last June.

The BIR has also put in place its Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS), Electronic Fund Transfer Instructions System (eFTIS), and other e-payment channels to allow taxpayers to pay taxes online.

In 2020, the BIR recorded 447,188 ePayers, representing an increase of 472 percent or 369,070 taxpayers when compared to the number of ePayers in 2015 who totaled just 78,118.

The BIR has made e-payment channels such as GCash, the Land Bank of the Philippines (LandBank) ePayment System, and Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) PayTax Online System available to taxpayers since 2017.

From 2019 to 2020, the BIR added Union Bank of the Philippines (UnionBank) online, PesoNet, and PayMaya as e-payment channels.

Only 43 percent of the total number of tax returns were filed electronically in 2015 through BIR's eFPS and eBIRForms System.

In 2020, about 94 percent of the tax returns were already filed electronically. From the 1.91 million e-payment transactions made with the bureau in 2015, this number rose to 4.01 million electronic payment transactions in 2020, representing an increase of 110 percent.

The BIR is also implementing other digitalization projects to improve its services, including:

- eAppointment - an online or digital medium accessible at the BIR website that taxpayers may use to book or request for schedule of meeting/conference with revenue officers/officials regarding matters on taxation;

- Online application for Tax Clearance for Bidding Purposes (TCBP) and Tax Compliance Verification

Construction of 380-km Laguna-Albay PNR route to start soon

MANILA – The Department of Transportation (DOTr) awarded the single largest rail contract worth PHP142 billion, or about USD2.8 billion, to a Chinese joint venture to build a 380-kilometer Philippine National Railways (PNR) route.

The construction will run from Barangay Banlic

in Calamba, Laguna to Daraga, Albay.

The contract was signed on Monday by DOTr Secretary Arthur Tugade and representatives of the China Railway Group Ltd., China Railway No. 3 Engineering Group Co. Ltd., and China Railway Engineering Consulting Group Co. Ltd. (CREC JV).

The contract includes the design, construction, and electromechanical works for the project.

"Listed in both the Hong Kong and Shanghai stock exchange, CREC JV ranked 35th on the Fortune Global 500 list and 5th among China's top 500 enterprises in 2021," the DOTr said in an announcement on Tuesday.

The project will span across 39 cities and municipalities in four provinces and two regions.

Aside from the construction of 380 kilometers of railway, the project will include 23 stations, 230 bridges, 10 passenger tunnels, and a 70-hectare depot in San Pablo, Laguna.

In a Facebook post, Chinese Ambassador to the Philippines, Huang Xilian, said the project will be the "fastest and longest railway segment so far in the Philippines" and "another milestone" for the relationship between the Philippines and China.

Huang said the project is so far the "highest-funded G-to-G (government-to-government) project" between the two countries. Once operational, travel time between Calamba, Laguna and Legazpi, Albay will be shortened to four hours from the usual 12 hours and will serve 14.6 million passengers yearly. The project is also expected to create "more than 10,000 direct construction jobs each year" aside from "hundreds of thousands" of jobs in related areas, according to Huang.

"I wish the scenario come true the soonest and the project a smooth progress!" Huang posted.

The PNR Bicol project is a 565-kilometer railway that will connect Metro Manila to the southern Luzon provinces of Sorsogon and Batangas.

Its passenger trains will run at a speed of 160 kilometers per hour while freight trains will run at 100 kilometers per hour. (PNA)

Right lagundi dosage can relieve Covid-19 symptoms: DOST

MANILA – A medical doctor and project leader of the study on lagundi as adjuvant therapy for mild Covid-19 reminded the public that there is a prescribed dosage for the herbal medicine that treats cough and asthma.

Department of Science

and Technology (DOST) Secretary Fortunato de la Peña, in a taped report aired Friday afternoon, said the prescribed dosages will ensure that treatment using lagundi will render positive results.

Citing the recommendations of Dr. Cecilia Marambala-Lazarte, the project leader of the lagundi clinical trial by the University of the Philippines Manila with the support from DOST-Philippine Council for Health Research and Development, he said adults may take the 600-milligram (mg) tablet or 5 milliliters (ml) of the 600 mg syrup thrice daily.

Pediatric patients' dosage requirements, on the other hand, would vary depending on the age range.

The 300 mg syrup may be taken thrice daily by children, following the suggested dosage per intake: 2.5 to 5 ml for ages 2 to 4; 5 ml for ages 4 to 6; and 7.5 to 10 ml for ages 6 to 12, according to de la Peña.

People 12 years old and above may also take the 600 mg tablet thrice daily, he added.

"By following these guidelines, the use of lagundi may alleviate mild Covid-19 symptoms. Lagundi has long been used for cough and asthma relief," the DOST chief said.

The clinical trial on lagundi as adjuvant therapy seeks to determine if the herb can provide symptomatic relief for mild Covid-19 patients without comorbidities or if it can decrease the progress from mild to moderate or severe cases.

The two-stage, randomized double-blind, placebo-controlled study was conducted from July 2020 to August 2021. (PNA)

Too early to think of 2022 growth target revisions: NEDA exec

MANILA – It is still early to think of any revisions in the 2022 growth target even with the Alert Level 3 implementation in several parts of the country, a National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) executive said Tuesday.

While Alert Level 3 movement restriction has been raised until end-January 2022 in more than 80 areas around the country, including the National Capital Region (NCR), NEDA Undersecretary Rosamarie Edillon said the decision is partly made as a "balancing act" for health and economic aspects.

"With respect to the target for the year, it's still early days to be revising whether upwards or downwards because it's just January 18. There are still a lot of developments that can happen, hopefully very positive developments on that," she said during the virtual presser hosted by the Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO) for the Task Group on Economic Recovery and National Employment Recovery Strategy (TGER-NERS).

The inter-agency Development Budget Coordination Committee has set a 7 to 9 percent growth target for this year and 6 to 7 percent for 2023-2024.

Authorities said Alert Level 3 in the NCR Plus, which covers the NCR and neighboring provinces of Rizal, Laguna, Cavite, and Bulacan, costs the economy around PHP3 billion every week.

Edillon said latest figures on the impact of the Alert Level system on the economy are "tamer" compared to the effects of the enhanced community quarantine and the modified enhanced community quarantine.

She said the improving vaccination rate in the country is a plus as it provides added protection of the population against the coronavirus disease 2019.

Edillon said the economy has experienced heightened movement restrictions in the past, thus, "we think we are now much better at managing these risks."

"...There's still enough time to catch up," she added. (PNA)
