VP DUTERTE JOINS CAVITE OFFICIALS IN RELIEF DISTRIBUTION

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) – Top officials of the national government recently visited the province to see the devastation brought by severe Typhoon Storm Paeng.

A week after President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr., came to the province, Vice President Sara Duterte joined Senator Ramon Revilla, Jr. in the distribution of relief packs to thousands of residents who were greatly affected by the recent calamity on Sunday, November 6.

VP Sara and Senator Revilla initially went to Barangay Bacao in the city of General Trias where they distributed a total of three thousand food packs to somehow augment the families' daily needs.

After the distribution activity in General Trias, they proceeded to the Imus Sports Complex to distribute a total of two thousand five hundred food packs to Imuseños affected by Typhoon Paeng.

In her message, VP Sara addressed the countrymen who were victims of Typhoon Paeng, emphasizing the importance of preparing for the impacts of calamities and disasters. She advised on the proper planning and research for areas that are safe from disasters.

"Kaya po kapag tayo ay nag-design at nag-iisip kung saan natin ilalagay ang ating mga bahay ay iniisip din natin ang tubig baha, lindol, at hangin dala ng bagyo," VP Sara tweeted.

(That's why when we design and think about where we will put our houses, we must also think about flood water, earthquakes, and winds brought by typhoons.)

Senator Bong Revilla is grateful to the vice president for joining the distribution activity. He also inspired the affected families urging them to stay strong.

"Gaya ng palagi kong sinasabi, huwag tayong panghihinaan ng loob dahil sa hindi ibibigay ng Panginoon ang pagsubok

DSWD-4A execs cleared of any wrongdoing

MANILA – Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Secretary Erwin T. Tulfo has cleared the officials and personnel of Field Office - Calabarzon (Region 4A) against any irregularities and incompetence in the release and distribution of aid after Typhoon Paeng hit Cavite.

Tulfo said DSWD's fair and impartial inquiry showed that the Field Office has just implemented the provision of assistance in "an orderly manner."

DSWD Calabarzon Regional Director Barry Chua and Assistant Regional Director for Operations Mylah Gatchalian were absolved from the allegation as they were only following the existing guidelines.

The investigation was made after Noveleta, Cavite Mayor Dino Chua accused the DSWD-Calabarzon officials and personnel of incompetence in the delivery and distribution of reliefs for Paeng victims.

"I have informed Mayor Dino Chua of the result of our investigation that I find no fault or mistakes committed by our Region IV-A officials and staff," Tulfo said during Monday's flag raising ceremony.

Earlier, Chua and Gatchalian were temporarily transferred to DSWD Central Office pending the investigation of the alleged stringent requirements being asked from victims of the calamity during the payout of cash assistance.

Tulfo also said the identification (ID) card was the sole requirement to receive aid, in compliance with the auditing rules. "Every centavo we give out to those in need must be accounted for and backed by a piece of document to show that our funds really go to the poor and the needy of this country, and to protect our personnel from graft and corruption cases," he said.

Tulfo vowed to protect and defend DSWD personnel as long as they are committed to fulfilling their duty anchored on the Department's mission to

"alleviate the suffering of the poor, the needy, the elderly, the vulnerable and the marginalized members" of the society.

"However, make no mistake! I will not condone those members of our agency who treat our clients with disrespect, abuse their position, or get involved in corruption," he said. He assured to protect the welfare and well-being not only of DSWD's intended beneficiaries but also of its employees. (PNA)

Private respondent in 1990 Navy drug procurement raps cleared

MANILA – The Sandiganbayan has cleared a private individual who had been among those convicted in a graft case against Navy officials found responsible for the anomalous procurement in 1990 of medical and dental supplies.

In the 3-page resolution dated Nov. 3 and written by Associate Justice Amparo Cabotaje-Tang, it granted the motion for reconsideration filed by private individual Ermina L. Castillos.

Castillos had pointed out that she had been cleared in the case and that the amended information no longer included her as an accused and therefore "she should not have been convicted in the said cases as she was neither arraigned nor tried in the said cases."

Graft court orders raps vs. ex-Bataan gov to proceed

MANILA – The Sandiganbayan has ruled to continue with the trial of a former Bataan provincial governor facing graft charges.

A resolution dated Nov. 3 written by Associate Justice Edgardo M. Caldona turned down a motion filed by Leonardo B. Roman, then Bataan provincial governor, who is accused of graft in the 2003 contract for the construction of a mini-theater at the Bataan State College in Abucay town which allegedly benefited a private contractor, VF Construction.

Roman had filed a "motion for leave to file a demurrer to evidence" last

Legal shield for environment defenders, climate activists sought

MANILA – The Commission on Human Rights (CHR) on Monday urged the government to provide legal protection for environmental defenders and climate activists who promote climate awareness and education.

In a statement, the CHR noted that the Philippines plays an important role in leading and demanding climate action in the global arena as it is the fourth most climate change-vulnerable country in the world.

This, as international communities come together for the 27th Climate Change

Associate Justices Bernelito R. Fernandez and Ronald B. Moreno concurred in deleting her name from the Sept. 16, 2022 decision where the Sandiganbayan has convicted retired Philippine Navy Rear Admiral Gilmer B. Batestil, and private individual Edna R. "After a circumspect consideration of the arguments presented by the parties, the Court is of the considered view that the motion for leave to file demurrer to evidence (filed by Roman) is bereft of merit," the court said in ordering the case to proceed.

Earlier, Environment Secretary Maria Antonia Yulo Loyzaga, the head of the country's delegation to COP27, said the damage caused by Severe Tropical Storm Paeng is a "reminder of the devastating impacts of climate change."

Apart from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, representatives from the Departments of Finance, Agriculture, Energy, and the Climate Change Commission, climate scientists and climate and development experts composed the Philippine delegation to COP27.

"We call for concrete actions from all governments to review and enhance their nationally determined contributions," the CHR said.

"We forward our recommendations to the Philippine government to ensure equality and non-discrimination in climate adaptation and mitigation measures through our National Inquiry on Climate Change report," it added.

The CHR appealed to local

Gov't vows to sustain gains in labor market

MANILA – The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) welcomed the improvements in the country's labor market, as the unemployment rate settled at 5 percent in September, the lowest since the onset of the pandemic.

"The recent survey results show the gains of the full reopening of our economy. The government will leverage on this momentum by strengthening policy interventions and investing in innovation and technology systems geared toward generating higher quality employment that provides adequate income for Filipino workers and their families," Socioeconomic Planning Secretary Arsenio Balisacan said in a statement Tuesday.

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) reported that the unemployment rate in September 2022 fell from 5.3 percent in August.

PSA Undersecretary Dennis Mapa also noted that the September 2022 unemployment rate is the lowest since the number of jobless Filipinos peaked at 17.6 percent in April 2020, the height of the pandemic.

Amid the challenges brought by a faster inflation rate, Balisacan said the government is prioritizing interventions that would ensure food security, as well as targeted subsidies, such as fuel and crops, "to help protect the purchasing

economy," Crystal Clear Inc. Chief Operating Officer Rose Estampador said in a news release on Tuesday.

SANTA MARIA, Laguna (PIA) — The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) IV-A and the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) Sta. Cruz join forces to issue show-cause orders to 55 households and establishments built on protected area landscapes in Barangays J. Santiago and J.P. Laurel, Santa Maria,

DENR 4A issues show-cause order vs 55 households, establishments in Laguna protected area

Laguna on November 3, 2022.

The structures served with show cause orders were previously identified by CENRO Sta. Cruz belonging to lands under the Presidential Proclamation No. 1636, s.1977 or the declaration of a national

park, wildlife sanctuary and game preserve to some parts of Bulacan, Rizal, Quezon Province, and Laguna.

DENR IV-A cited on the show-cause order the need to enforce the Republic Act 7586 or National Integrated Protected Area System (NIPAS) and Republic Act 11038 or Expanded National Integrated Protected Area System (ENIPAS), which prohibits the building and development of structures in protected areas to ensure that the local biodiversity continues to thrive.

In an interview with PIA CALABARZON, DENR IV-A Regional Executive Director Nilo Tamoria stressed the importance of implementing laws for protected areas to curb the effects of deforestation and to support the wildlife in the area's forestland.

"[L]imitado, regulated ang pananatili ng mga istruktura dahil malaki po ang impact ng mga istrukturang ito sa loob ng pinangalagaang pook o malaki po ang implication nito sa biodiversity ng ating protected area. Kung manatili at hindi i-address ang presence ng mga structures, mga establishments ay malaki po ang magiging impact nito kaya't sinimulan po namin ngayong araw na ito ang page-serve ng show cause order," says Director Tamoria. Th director said that the issuance of show-cause orders will serve as an avenue for those residing and operating businesses in protected areas to assert their legal rights.

He explained that while having individual titles of land is not permitted in a protected area, the DENR respects the private rights of the individuals who built the said structures five years prior the passage of NIPAS on 1992.

"In principle, dapat pinapabayaan natin ang protected area pero syempre meron naman 'yang ilang mga regulation na maaaring manatili, pursuant dun sa mga permiso na iginagawad ng iba't-ibang ahensya, lalonglalo na po ng DENR."

The owners of the structures were given 5 days to respond and submit corresponding documents and requirements to CENRO Sta. Cruz.

One of the mandates of DENR IV-A and its Protected Area Management Board, is preserving the protected area landscapes and the biodiversity in order to combat the effects of climate change.

Tamoria said that the Tropical Storm 'Paeng' has taught us that extreme weather conditions are inevitable due to the effect of climate change. But it can be reduced once the proper programs and policies are enacted.

"Masalimuot po, mahirap pero kailangang gawin. Hindi na po natin kailangang umabot na naman na magkaroon na naman ng [Bagyong] Ondoy, Paeng[...] Ang mga istruktura, wala namang kapasidad na mag-observe ng excess water. Makakadagdag pa yan sa bigat na pinapasan ng lupa. Kapag saturated ang lupa, guguhog at guguhog po iyan. Hindi na po kaila, totoong-totoo na po ang epekto ng climate change," according to the director.

He appealed to the public that compliance to local environmental laws is just one of the many ways an ordinary Filipino can do in preserving our planet.

"Ang atin pong ginagawa ay bahagi lamang ng implementasyon ng pagpapatupad ng batas. Ito po ay proseso, kung talaga namang lehitimo niyang mga istruktura at establishments sa ating nasasakupan ay wala pong problema. 'Yan po ang kanilang ipapaliwag."

Tamoria added, "Pero kung hindi po naaayon, istriktro po nating i-implementa ang ating batas. Ang atin pong pamahalaan ay nananawagan sa mamamayan na sundin po natin ang batas. Marami naman pong oportunidad sa ibang area na dapat doon tayo nagtatayo ng istruktura. tumugon po tayo sa tinatadhana ng batas at para wala tayong maging problema sa hinaharap." (CH/PIA-Laguna)

PCUP, DOLE to seal deal on livelihood, job opportunities

MANILA—The Presidential Commission for the Urban Poor (PCUP) and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) are set to sign a memorandum of agreement (MOA) to coordinate their efforts on giving access to livelihood and employment opportunities to urban poor groups. PCUP chairperson Elpidio Jordan Jr. said the two agencies agreed to seal the agreement after a virtual meeting with DOLE workers' welfare and protection cluster Assistant Secretary Dominique Rubia-Tutay and labor employment officer Erickson Mag-isa. The signing will be in line with the PCUP's

celebration of “Urban Poor Solidarity Week” (UPSW) on December 7. This year's UPSW theme dubbed “The PCUP and the Urban Poor Sector: Together Meeting the challenge of the New Age,” is the agency's mandate to support President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s pro-poor initiatives and alleviation program. Marcos has vowed to fast-track the country's economic recovery and bring progress and development not only in urban centers but also in the countryside. “We will not leave a single stone unturned in helping our urban poor. Ito ang nais ng ating Pangulo—ang masolusyunan ang

kahirapan sa ating bansa sa pamamagitan ng pagbibigay ng oportunidad sa ating mga maralita sa trabaho at kabuhayan (This is what our President wants—to solve poverty in our country by giving opportunities to our poor people in work and livelihood),” he said. Late last month, the PCUP renewed its cooperation with the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) as it enhances its pro-poor programs. Jordan and PCSO Chair Junie Cua discussed the former's advocacy to support the administration's poverty alleviation program, particularly for persons with disabilities and senior

citizens, and its upcoming UPSW. Cua expressed support for both initiatives, vowing to provide medical supplies and food packs that would be distributed to accredited urban poor organizations. The PCUP, created during the administration of then President Corazon Aquino in 1986, is a commission under the Office of the President tasked to promote and protect the rights of urban poor organizations and communities, including informal settler families. Specifically, it responds to issues on urban poverty such as demolitions, reclamation, and housing. **(PNA)**

DTI to consumers: Report sellers of uncertified products

CALOOCAN CITY, (PIA) --The Department of Trade & Industry (DTI) enjoins consumers anew to report retailers, distributors, and manufacturers that sell uncertified products, through the Consumer Care Hotline at DTI (1-384) or consumercare@dti.gov.ph. To protect consumers or potential buyers of electrical and electronic products; mechanical or building and construction materials; and chemical and other consumer products and systems, DTI-Bureau of Philippine Standards (BPS) regulates 87 products and systems through implementing Mandatory Product Certification Schemes: the Philippine Standard (PS) Quality and/or Safety Certification Mark Licensing Scheme and the Import Commodity Clearance (ICC) Certification Scheme. Recently, the DTI – Fair Trade Enforcement Bureau (DTI-FTEB)'s month-long focused enforcement operations in October 2022 swept almost 5 million pesos worth of uncertified products from the National Capital Region (NCR). DTI enforcement teams led by FTEB Officer-In-Charge (OIC) Director Atty. Marimel Dancel Porciuncula and

OIC Assistant Director Atty. Joseph Manuel P. Pamittan topped off the 4-week streak of heightened enforcement in Pasig, Parañaque, Malabon, Caloocan, and Quezon City to ensure the availability of only safe and reliable consumer products. The DTI enforcement teams kicked off the intensified operations in Pasig City, 3-7 October. The teams have clamped down on 719 pieces of uncertified ceramic plumbing fixtures (sanitary ware), electric blenders, electric fans, electric kettles, inner tubes for tires, low-carbon steel wires, rerolled steel bars, safety belts (seat belts), self-ballasted LED lamps, snap switches, and tires for automotive vehicles worth Php2,814,089.00. After Pasig, the teams inspected retail firms in Parañaque City, 10-14 October, which resulted in the crackdown of 366 pieces of uncertified products worth Php856,859.76. The sealed products include electric blenders, electric fans, electric food mixers, electric grills, electric irons, electric juicers, electric rice cookers, electric stoves, extension cord sets, induction cookers, lead-acid storage batteries, low-carbon steel wires,

motor vehicle brake fluids, ceramic plumbing fixtures (sanitary wares), self-ballasted LED lamp, and tires for automotive vehicles. Building on the successful operations, similar enforcement was conducted in Malabon and Caloocan City, 17-21 October. The teams seized 839 pieces of ceramic plumbing fixtures (sanitary wares), Edison screw lamp holders, electric fans, electric food mixers, electric kettles, PVC electrical tapes, extension cord sets, helmets and their visors, inner tubes for tires, low-carbon steel wires, monobloc chairs/stools, plugs, self-ballasted LED lamps, snap switches, socket-outlets, television sets, and tires for automotive vehicles worth Php341,771.50. Ending the month strong, the firm enforcement operation in Quezon City, last 24-28 October has led to the sealing of 404 pieces of uncertified low-carbon steel wire, tires for automotive vehicles, electric coffee makers, and electric grills worth Php973,763.50. Out of the 347 firms inspected, 61 non-compliant stores were issued Notices of Violation (NOVs), mandating them

to explain within 48 hours from the receipt of the notice. The nationwide campaign of DTI against uncertified items in the market underscores the enforcement of DTI technical regulations mandating compliance with Philippine Standard Certification Mark Schemes, particularly Department Administrative Order No. 02, Series of 2007. FTEB OIC Director Atty. Porciuncula emphasized that the Department is consistent and steadfast in its enforcement activities to address the persistence of uncertified products in the market. Meanwhile, Consumer Protection Group Officer-In-Charge Atty. Ann Claire C. Cabochan expressed full support by heading the enforcement operation in Quezon City. “We express our support for legitimate businesses and issue a reminder for sellers to be compliant with our regulations. FTEB's sustained efforts in the market through regular enforcement operations play a critical role in ensuring the welfare and safety of consumers,” said Asec. Atty. Cabochan. **(dti/pia-ncr)**
