NCRPO sa pangunguna ng Regional Intelligence Division (RID), RID-Special Operations Group (RSOG) at ng RID - Regional Drug Enforcement Unit (RDEU) at ng mga counterparts ng mga ito sa limang distrito nito, tulad ng Northern Police District (NPD), Eastern Police District (EPD), Manila Police District (MPD), Southern Police District (SPD) at ng Quezon City Police District (QCPD) kung saan ang mga suspek na may kinalaman sa mga krimen tulad ng pagpatay, panggagahasa, pagnanakaw na may homicide at iba pang labag sa batas na mga gawain ay nadadakip at naihatid muli sa mga bilangguan upang panagutan at karahapin ang mga kasong kinasasangkutan ng mga ito.

Sa pinaka-huling datos, na ipinakita ni NCRPO Deputy Regional Director

for Operations (DRDO) PBGEN JACK L WANKY, nito lamang mula ika-23 hanggang ika-29 ng Enero taongkasalukuyan umaabot sa 470 katao na mayroong Standing Warrants of Arrest ang nadakip sa isinagawang Simultaneous Anti Criminality and Law Enforcement Operations (SACLEO) o iyung "Week-long One-Time-Big-Time Operation" ng mga pulis NCRPO.

Ayon kay General WANKY na siyang kumatawan kay NCRPO director PMGEN ESTOMO para sa naturang okasyon, nagsasagawa talaga ang NCRPO ng mga SACLEO sa ibat ibang lugar ng Kalakhang Maynila at kung minsan ay tumatawid pa upang pag-ibayuhin at palakasin ang anti-criminality at anti-illegal drug campaign ditto sa Metro Manila.

26 FIRMS IN NORTHMIN ACQUIRE IP RIGHTS THROUGH DOST

Twenty-six firms from various provinces in Northern Mindanao acquire intellectual property rights through the acquisition of trademark registration. The Department of Science and Technology has successfully assisted these firms through the SciTech Superhighway program. The certificates of registration are from and signed by the Bureau of Trademarks - Intellectual Property of the Philippines, with a 10-year validity period.

In partnership with the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOPIL) and the Technology Application and Promotion Institute (TAPI), DOST region 10 was able to endorse these applications. The SciTech Superhighway is a collaborative project of DOST-TAPI and IPOPIL to strategize ways to streamline and hasten formality examinations of IP applications and other administrative processes up until the financial assistance of the following fees: Filing Fee, 1st Publication Fee, 2nd Publication Fee, and Issuance Fee.

The applications were endorsed during the SciTech Superhighway 11th Technical Working Group (TWG) Deliberation Meeting in March 2022. Proceeding after the actions of the recommendation provided by the IPOPIL TWG member, the applications were then officially filed in May 2022. Assisted firms have finally received their Certificate

of Registrations in the last quarter of 2022.

In Bukidnon, there were three certificates of trademark registration given, while in Camiguin, there were six. Most of the 26 firms are in the food processing industry.

Copyright, trademarks, patents, and trade secrets are all different types of intellectual property (IP). Firms with trademark registrations are generally protected in terms of brand identity in the marketplace. It gives the owner the exclusive rights to prevent others from using or exploiting the mark in any way. Aside from being a source-identifier, differentiator, quality indicator, and an advertising device, a protective mark may also bring another stream of income to the owner through licensing or franchising.

In a Facebook post, one of the 2022 trademark registration recipients, Mr. Recarte Bacus of Candiisan Diversified Farm, expressed his thanks to DOST for facilitating their application. "Yeeeeeeyy na register na gyud sa Intellectual Property Office (IPO) ang "Tablea ni Candi". Daghan kaayong salamat Department of Science & Technology (DOST)-Bukidnon sa pag facilitate", he said.

PH dollar reserves seen to improve

MANILA – An economist forecasts continued increase in the country's dollar reserves, which improved to USD99.72 billion last January compared to the previous month's level. Data released by the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) Tuesday night showed that the January 2023 gross international reserves (GIR) of the country, however, was lower than the USD107.69 billion in the same period in 2022.

In a commentary on Wednesday, Rizal Commercial Banking Corporation (RCBC) chief economist Michael Ricafort said the country's dollar reserves can get a lift from continued resiliency of the inflows from overseas Filipino workers (OFWs), the revenues of the business process outsourcing (BPO) sector, foreign investment inflows, foreign tourism, and Philippine offshore gaming operators (POGO) revenues. These inflows, he said, "could still cover the yearly

trade deficit/net imports that reached a record USD58.3 billion for 2022."

"Moreover, the continued increase in fund-raising and other investment banking activities by the country's biggest companies/conglomerates, in view of the recent rising trend in global/local bond yields in recent months, funding preparations amid more decisive new investments and expansion plans as the economy reopens further towards greater normalcy, could entail some increase in foreign investment inflows that could add to the country's BOP and GIR, on a cash flow basis," he said.

Ricafort said the current GIR level of the country remains adequate as it is equivalent to 7.5 months of imports, higher than the three to four months international standards. He said the dollar reserves to date "would continue to provide structural support/buffer/cushion for the peso exchange rate, especially greater protection vs. any speculative attacks, going forward." **(PNA)**

Lucena's 'tinapa' top seller in DTI's 'Kalakal' store

LUCENA CITY – This city's One Town, One Product (OTOP), the gourmet "tinapa" or smoked fish is the top-selling product at the Kalakal-Quezon shop located at the Grand Central Terminal here.

The store, a project of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) in the province, opened last week.

In an interview on Tuesday, Mhae Villasin, the consolidator/operator of Kalakal-Quezon, said they often have to restock the bottled gourmet tinapa because the savory dish is always sold out at the end of the day.

"Eighty-five percent of our sales is because of the tinapa and clients always look for it," Villasin said.

She said the DTI-Quezon opened the Kalakal store to promote the products of micro, small and medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and help them grow their business.

"Kalakal" is a Filipino word that means merchandise. Villasin operates and manages the shop which caters to starting and

established MSMEs from the 39 municipalities and two cities of Quezon province.

"A town's OTOP is encouraged to be displayed and sold here, free of charge," she noted.

Aside from the best-selling tinapa, Villasin noted the brisk sales of other towns' products including the popular "suman sa gata" of Infanta, mango pie of Candelaria, "pansit habhab" and langonisa of Lucban, "suman sa lihiya" of Tiaong and San Antonio and the "pinagong," which is a turtle shaped bread, from Sariaya town.

She encouraged other micro-entrepreneurs to put their products, especially the OTOP, on display at the Kalakal-Quezon, noting that they also facilitate marketing the merchandise both locally and internationally.

Villasin said the MSMEs must only submit the required documents including their DTI business name. Their items should also pass their standard quality control, she added. **(PNA)**

New Zealand encourages Moro, IPs to avail of Manaaki scholarships

DAVAO CITY (PIA) - The Government of New Zealand has opened Manaaki scholarships to Filipinos wanting to pursue masters and doctorate studies in New Zealand and they are encouraging people belonging to indigenous and Moro cultural communities to avail of the scholarship. "We have over a thousand scholars over the past years. However, there has been a firm resolve to encourage applicants from indigenous and Bangsamoro Moslem practitioners and scholars," says New Zealand Aid Manager Dyan Rodriguez. Rodriguez together with New Zealand Ambassador to the Philippines Peter Kell has been going around Davao City to promote the Manaaki scholarship.

Manaaki which is an indigenous New Zealand word meaning to cherish or sustain is an annual scholarship program offered to Filipinos who have not reached the age of 40 pursuing post-graduate studies.

It has benefited around 2,000 Filipinos however according to Rodriguez only three are from the Bangsamoro community.

"We hardly have any representation from the indigenous communities," Rodriguez added. She hopes there would

be many from the cultural groups who would access the scholarship program considering that the New Zealand government has been supporting the peace process to various development projects.

"We encourage courses that contribute to the Mindanao agenda like good governance (specifically on peace and conflict studies, indigenous studies), climate change, agriculture, and renewal energy," Rodriguez said.

The 2024 Manaaki scholarship will have 16 slots for Filipinos. It will be an online application process, all information can be found on the New Zealand embassy's Facebook page or at the website: nzscholarships.govt.nz.

Ambassador Peter Kell said that the scholarship is not just about studying in New Zealand but also learning how New Zealand and New Zealanders see the world.

"One of the things about New Zealand is that we have embraced our indigenous heritage and we incorporate that heritage into contemporary New Zealand in ways that people in Mindanao particularly the indigenous people and the Moro people will understand," Ambassador Peter Kell said. **(PIA/RG Alama)**

BOC does not charge tax using Gcash, bank transfer

QUEZON CITY, (PIA) -- The Bureau of Customs (BOC) is warning the public against scammers who pose as agency officials or employees and demand payment for taxes or other fees using virtual wallet applications such as GCash or bank transfer. The BOC clarified that they do not collect custom duties and taxes using personal accounts and even through remittance centers.

"BOC officials, including the BOC Customer Assistance and Response Services, do not directly communicate with parcel recipients via phone call, text message, or email to inform them or ask them to pay via bank deposit or money transfer for parcels

to be released," according to the BOC statement.

This was after a fake letter with the BOC logo was discovered. It is addressed to Yannahsher's Office Supplies dated December 4, 2022, charging a fee for tax and fees (processing, branding and clearance/documents/file compilation) amounting to P128,585.45. But it is still suspicious that they want to pass the payment through GCash of bank transfer to release 35 laptop computers for such a company.

The letter, which is said to be a certified true copy, was signed by Raquel de Jesus of the BOC-Central Records Management Division and former commissioner Rey Guerrero. **(PIA-NCR)**

BJMP- QDJ help desks provide clientele accessibility

INFANTA, Quezon (PIA)— The BJMP Quezon District Jail through the leadership of Jail Supt. Jack Lord B. Cariño, District Jail Warden, reinforced the help desk in jail to grant persons deprived of liberty (PDLs) and their families with government-provided social welfare and support services. The formation of help desk is a presidential directive with the support of the Presidential Management Staff (PMS), aimed at extending assistance to PDL and their families that shall include but not limited to medical, shelter, educational, livelihood, transportation, burial and other related services. Jail Help Desk Officer (JHDO), Jail Officer 2 Joefrie B. Anglo explained a verbal or written request of the PDL or his immediate family members should be forwarded to the help desk for appropriate evaluation and assessment on the request. "We incessantly exert effort

in ensuring that all concerns in frontline services are properly attended, otherwise if such request can't be addressed in the jail level, it shall be properly referred to other agencies/offices of the Government for their appropriate action," said Anglo. Anglo added that duty escort and custodial officers make the necessary follow-up with the concern agency to process the assistance, and in order to immediately provide the requested assistance. The BJMP Quezon District Jail works closely with the Provincial Social Welfare and Development (PSWD), the Education (Dep Ed) and Health Departments (DOH), all of which are tasked to provide assistance to the needs of PDL under investigation, undergoing trial or serving short sentences, and to their immediate family members. **(RMO/PIA Quezon with reports from BJMP-Quezon)**

December 2022 unemployment rate lowest in over 17 years

MANILA – The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) reported Wednesday that the country's unemployment rate stood at 4.3 percent in December 2022. PSA Undersecretary Dennis Mapa said unemployment rate in December 2022 is the second lowest since April 2005, only behind the November 2022 unemployment rate of 4.2 percent. Within the period, there were 43,000 jobs lost in the labor market as the number of jobless Filipinos increased to 2.22 million in December from 2.18 million in November last year. On year-on-year basis, December 2022 unemployment rate declined from 6.6 percent during the same month in 2021. Labor force participation last December stood at 66.4 percent from 67.5 percent the previous month. Employment rate in December 2022 slightly slipped to 95.7 percent from 95.8 percent in the previous month. This means 49 million Filipinos aged 15 years and above have jobs during the month.

Mapa said the slightly lower employment rate and an uptick in unemployment rate in December 2022 are "statistically not significant." He said what is needed to be highlighted is the significant decline in the number and share of underemployed Filipinos. Underemployment last December went down to 12.6 percent from 14.4 percent a month ago and from 14.7 percent a year ago. Mapa said the number of underemployed, or those who are seeking more working hours, decreased to 6.2 million in December 2022 from 7.16 million in the previous month, a difference of 960,000 underemployed Filipinos. "What is clear is there were more jobs with higher quality (in December 2022)," he said in mixed English and Filipino. PSA data showed that the average working hours in December last year improved to 40.3 hours per week from 39.3 hours and 39.7 hours per week in November 2022 and December 2021,

Smart Communications Inc. reported a total of 14,569,983 SIMs registered, which is 21.43% respectively. National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) Secretary Arsenio Balisacan said in a statement that the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028 pursues high-quality jobs for Filipinos. "Alongside providing high-quality jobs, we must ensure that their skills are not just aligned with current in-demand requirements but can also continuously keep up with the demands of evolving and emerging jobs," Balisacan said. He added creating more and high-quality jobs in the agriculture sector while ensuring food security for Filipinos remain the top priorities of the administration. **(PNA)**

Results On Civil Works, Goods and Services and Consulting Services, among others must be posted in three conspicuous places and the FDP portal in a concise and timely manner. Receiving the GFH also entails an unqualified or qualified Commission on Audit (COA) opinion of the immediately preceding year. Navotas has obtained COA's Unqualified Opinion, the highest mark it can give an LGU or government agency, for seven consecutive years. It is the only LGU in Metro Manila with such record. Last year, the city was also conferred the DILG Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG). The GFH is a component of the SGLG along with Disaster Preparedness; Social Protection; Health Compliance and Responsiveness; Sustainable Education; Business Friendliness and Competitiveness; Safety, Peace and Order; Environmental Management; Tourism, Heritage Development, and Culture and the Arts, and Youth Development. **(PIA-NCR)**

Land titling project benefits over 16K farmers: DAR

MANILA – A total of 16,888 agrarian reform beneficiaries (ARBs) nationwide have received their individual electronic land titles and have benefited from the Department of Agrarian Reform's (DAR) Support to Parcelization of Lands for Individual Titling or Project SPLIT. In a press release on Tuesday, DAR Secretary Conrado Estrella III assures that despite the tedious and rigorous process of subdividing collective certificates of land ownership awards (CCLOAs), the DAR is slowly but steadily making some progress in Project SPLIT. DAR Assistant Secretary for Field Operations Joey Sumatra, concurrent SPLIT national director, said a total of 18,802 e-titles covering 23,898 hectares of agricultural lands nationwide have been distributed.

He said that DAR has already validated around 522,688 hectares out of the 591,572 hectares funded for parcelization. This is equivalent to 88 percent accomplishment, covering 50,249 previously distributed CCLOAs. However, Sumatra clarified that the newly validated agricultural lands are still subject to re-documentation. This is to complete the required documents for each ARB to be submitted to the Registry of Deeds (RODs) for eventual registration. Meanwhile, Estrella announced that documents for around 38,196 hectares of agricultural lands have been submitted to various RODs (Register of Deeds) nationwide, and have been cleared for processing and generation of e-titles to be released and distributed to ARBs within this year. "Subdividing collective CLOAs for each individual ARBs undergoes a very rigid process and we cannot afford to make a mistake," he said. He said that around 107,344 hectares of farmlands have been re-documented and are due for submission to the RODs for final evaluation and assessment. The RODs will do the validation of data, revisit copies of CCLOAs with annotated ARBs, the approved survey plans, and the actual master lists of ARBs, while the DAR-SPLIT validation team is tasked to establish who among the listed ARBs have already passed away, abandoned or sold their rights of ownership, are still in possession of their respective shares of farm lots, and those merely squatting in the absence of any proof of transfer of rights of ownership. "Everything is really done under close scrutiny since we do not want to redo the process. We want to make sure that everything is in order," Estrella said. The World Bank-funded SPLIT project aims to improve land tenure security and stabilize the property rights of some 1.14 million ARBs nationwide covering 1.37 million hectares of land, by subdividing the previously distributed CCLOAs, and turning them into individual land titles for distribution to qualified ARBs. **(PNA)**

SAN JOSE, Occidental Mindoro (PIA) -- Nagkaloob ng mga cold storage facility ang Department of Agriculture (DA) sa industriya ng sibuyas sa lalawigan, ayon sa Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPA). Sa panayam ng DA kay Engr. Alrizza Zubiri, opisyal ng OPA, sinabi nitong unang pinondahan ng Kagawaran ang pagtatayo ng dalawang cold storage facility na maaaring maglaman ng 10,000 red bags ng sibuyas bawat isa. Inaasahang anyang magagamit ang nabanggit na mas malaking kapasidad na storage sa taong 2024.

Isa pang tulong na ibinibigay ng DA ay sa pamamagitan ng Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Division (AMAD). Tumutulong ang AMAD sa marketing ng mga produktong agrikultura ng probinsya. "Nai-link ng AMAD ang isang kooperatiba na nagtatanim ng white onion sa Jollibee Corporation," ayon pa kay Zubiri. DOST-CAR PROMOTES ECO-FRIENDLY PINOY INVENTIONS

THE Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) promotes products using eco-friendly technologies by top Filipino inventors in a forum held in Baguio City on Tuesday, Feb. 7.

The event at Elizabeth Hotel was attended by DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations, Engr. Sancho A. Maborang; Dr. Nancy A. Bantog, regional director of DOST-CAR; Engr. Angel L. Maguen, assistant regional director of DOST-CAR; Engr. Victoriano Ocon, CEO of Vic Metal Fabrication and Environmental Services, Inc.; Engr. Jimson Uianza, president of Lead Core Technology System, Inc. (LCTSI) and Entrepreneur, Francisco 'Popoy' Pagayon, chairman of the Filipino Inventors Producers Cooperative (FIPC).

Resource persons Uianza discussed about energy storage system while Ocon talked about solid waste management along with Pagayon who showcased his multi-purpose speed grains solar dryer Portasol. Maborang acknowledged that DOST-CAR has potential to offer a lot in science technology and innovations but was somehow "overlooked" and he promised to focus on the region this time.

The technology offered by Ocon's Advance Waste Solutions (AWS) is the latest and currently provides the best way of waste management. Easy installation, low operation cost, minimal land requirement and a

healthy solution to waste problem are just few of the advantages of this technology.

Waste, garbage thrash are some of the social environmental problems affecting and increasing with time and population and need to be addressed, according to Ocon. These wastes are clogging canals, waterways, streets, open dumpsites and sometimes being burned in open spaces despite efforts of local government units and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) to address the issue.

On the other hand, Pagayon said his Portasol doesn't need maintenance, repair. This is a grain drying equipment especially needed during rainy season and to avoid contamination from insects and rodents.

"Our target are small-time farmers who are forced to sell their rice cheap because it's wet or damp," Pagayon explained. But with Portasol, they can sell at a higher price. He said that with the help of DOST, they were able to use hybrid plastic as technology for doing his invention.

He said that based on studies, the farming industry loses P12-billion a year from the ineffective ways of rice drying.

The hybrid generator system is another technology used by Lead Core Technology System, Inc. or LCTSI headed by its president Engr. Uianza. The company is a 100% Filipino corporation. It achieved the status of a "Total Stored Energy Solutions Provider," on its



10 years of existence in the industry.

The company offers wide range of products from industrial batteries, fuel cells, renewable energy and to services such as installation, monitoring and testing, commissioning and preventive maintenance. Uianza presented his hybrid generators using only running water that can

supply a small house with 5 kw power.
