Modernisasyon, low carbon technologies isinulong para labanan ang global warming -Dominguez

LUNGSOD QUEZON (PIA) -- Inihayag ni Finance Secretary Carlos Dominguez III, Chairman-designate ng Climate Change Commission (CCC), ang isinumiteng "Nationally Determined Contribution" (NDC) ng Pilipinas ang magiging instrumento para umunlad ang ekonomiya sa pamamagitan ng pag-adopt ng modernisado at low carbon na teknolohiya gayundin ang mga pamamaraan na mapagpagaan ng krisis sa klima.

Ani Sec. Dominguez, sa papagitan ng NDC, ang ekonomiya ay mas tatag at mapapanatili ang pag-unlad.

Nauna nang inaprubahan ni Pangulong Rodrigo Roa Duterte ang unang "Nationally Determined Contribution" (NDC) sa bansa para mabawasan ang greenhouse gas (GHG) emission.

Ang layon nitong pababain ng 75 porsyento ang "GHG emission and avoidance" bilang pangako ng Pilipinas sa Paris Agreement on Climate Change.

Ang NDC ang kumakatawan sa layunin ng Pilipinas na ma-modernisa at magkaroon ng low carbon at resilient na pag-unlad para sa sektor ng agrikultura, waste, industriya, transportasyon at enerhiya mula taong 2020 hanggang 2030.

Ang 75% target ay base sa projected business-as-usual cumulative economy-wide emission ng bansa na 3,340.3 metric tons (MT) ng carbon dioxide equivalent (MtCO₂e). Nagpasalamat din si Sec. Dominguez sa mga ahensya --- Departments of

Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), of Agriculture (DA), of Transportation (DOTr) and of Energy (DOE); of Foreign Affairs (DFA); and the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA)—na na nagtulong-tulong para mabuo ang NDC sa kabilang dulo ng pandemya at tuluy-tuloy na mga bagyo na siyang nag pa antala ng proseso nitong nakaraang taon.

Pinasalamanan niya rin ang mga kinatawan ng mga industria gayundin ang mga lider sa academe at civil society organizations para sa mga ambag at suporta sa government's vision of a transformational NDC.

Sa kabilang banda, nanawagan din ang kalihim sa international community na magsama-samang patatagin ang global efforts for climate change mitigation and adaptation.

Ayon kay Sec. Dominguez, inaasahan ang developed nations, na nagdulot ng global climate crisis ayon sa kasaysayan, ay tutugon sa commitment nito sa Paris Agreement, na panatilihin ang global average temperature na hindi hihigit sa 1.5 degrees Celsius survival threshold.

Dagdag pa ni Sec. Dominguez, ang mga kritikal na oras ngayon hanggang 2030 ay oportunidad para sa transformative climate action para masiguro ang planetary well-being bago maging huli ang lahat.

Ang mga NDC ay mga pangako o "pledges" na isinumite ng mga bansa sa United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) bilang

"Hindi dapat ginagawa itong negative political weapon. Ang mga ganitong klaseng noble effort ay mas maganda kung manatiling nasa pribadong kamay para walang pulitika, walang kulay. Mawawala 'yung spirit of volunteerism, pagtutulungan na nakikita natin ngayon, at ang pagkakawanggawa para sa mahihirap nating kababayan," dagdag pa ng senador.

Mas maiging manghikayat na lang ng mga donasyon o mga potensyal na donors sa community pantries upang masiguro na magtutuloy-tuloy ito habang may mga kinakapos at nangangailangan ng pang-araw-araw na food supply sa kamaynilaan at iba pang lugar sa buong bansa, ayon sa senador.

"Kailangan din naman na ma-sustain ang ganitong napakagandang inisyatibo, isang malit na kakayahang na maraming natutulungan kaya kailangan ng mas marami pang magdo-donate," sinabi ni Gatchalian. Ang pag-usbong ng ganitong inisyatibo, ayon sa senador, ay nagpapakita ng pagiging matulungan ng mga sibilyan at mga NASA pribadong sektor na mag-ing kaagapay ng gobyerno sa pagbibigay ayuda sa mga nangangailangan. **(PIA NCR)**

Ayon sa punong lungsod, nararapat lamang na igalang at sundin ng mga mamamayan ng lungsod ng Lucena ang mga barangay marshals dahil sa ang ginagawa nila ay para lamang matiyak ang kaligtasan ng bawat isang Lucenahan.

Ayon sa Lucena City PIO, ang ginawang pagpapaalaala ni Mayor Alcala para sa kaniyang mga kababayan ay naglalayong maging ligtas ang mga Lucenahan sa gitna ng tumataas na kaso ng Covid-19 sa lalawigan ng Quezon.

Batay sa tala ng Quezon Integrated Provincial Health Office, ang lungsod ng Lucena ang may pinakamaataas na naitalang aktibong kaso ng Covid-19 kumpara sa ibang mga bayan at lungsod ng lalawigan.

Sa opisyal na Covid-19 bulletin na inilabas nitong Linggo, umabot na sa 137 ang kabuuang bilang ng aktibong kaso ng sakit sa Lucena City. DHSUD program pushes for climate-resilient homes

MANILA – The Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) is pushing for a housing microfinance strategy that will grant low-income families access to climate-resilient homes at affordable costs.

Secretary Eduardo del Rosario said DHSUD will hold consultation meetings and workshops with financial institutions, private developers, and other stakeholders to establish the Inclusive Green Housing Microfinance (IGHM) program.

"With the high price of land, especially in urban areas, affordability remains a major stumbling block to homeownership for many Filipinos who fall below the poverty line," del Rosario said in a statement Sunday.

A total of 6 virtual meetings are scheduled between April and May this year. It will involve the formulation of frameworks and the cre-

ation of long-term targets for the rollout of IGHM. "The department is committed to finding alternative means such as housing microfinance to help them afford their dream homes," del Rosario said.

The agenda for the consultation meetings include a discussion of major findings from the assessment of existing housing microfinance programs.

The meetings will assess the operations of existing housing microfinance programs nationwide, identify and address challenges related to housing microfinance, and analysis of green housing features.

"We are reaching out to our stakeholders, especially the microfinance institutions that are already implementing housing microfinance in the communities to gather insight, capture best practices, and ease barriers for an effective nationwide implementation,"

DOH Calabarzon urges seniors, persons with comorbidities to register to get COVID-19 vax

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna (PIA) – The Department of Health Center for Health Development Calabarzon on Monday called on all senior citizens and persons with comorbidities to register now in order to avail the government's free Covid-19 vaccine.

"We urge all senior citizens and persons with comorbidities to participate and register in our government's Covid-19 vaccination program to ensure added protection against the Covid-19 virus. The registration is voluntary and the vaccine is free," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated. "Once registered, an individual will undergo careful evaluation of health status and exposure risk. Only after due assessment can a person be vaccinated at their respective LGUs," he emphasized.

According to DOH CHD 4A, the online registration of priority groups A2 (senior citizens) and A3 (persons with comorbidities) is essential to ensure a smooth rollout of COVID-19 vaccines among the target population.

"Considering the limited supply of available vac-

cines, we also need to provide protection to our elderly due to the rising cases of Covid in the country," Janairo added.

As of April 15, 2021, a total of 106,513 individuals have already received their first dose of Covid-19 vaccine in the region.

A total of 7,313 senior citizens and 8,428 persons with comorbidities already received their first dose of Covid-19 vaccine.

All target groups are advised to register online through the Facebook page or pre-registration websites of their respective LGUs. Those who do not have access to the internet may coordinate with their barangay health workers for the vaccination registration.

After completing the registration, wait for text message or call from health workers for the next instruction. For other priority groups, wait for the announcement of the date of registration and vaccination. For further details on the government's vaccination program, visit the <https://doh.gov.ph/vaccines>. Hontiveros urges DSWD, DILG: Fix problems affecting safe, speedy release of 'ayuda'

Risa Hontiveros urged the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) to address reported problems surrounding the latest release of cash aid to struggling Filipinos, such as erroneous lists and crowded distribution venues.

"Maliit na nga ang ayuda na ibinibigay sa ating mga kababayan, sana naman ay huwag na yan patagalin pa o ibulsa. The DSWD and DILG should look closely into all reports of problems involving the distribution of financial assistance, which is a matter of life and death for many Filipinos during this crisis," Hontiveros said.

The DILG recently revealed that only around P4.47 billion or 40 percent of allocated funds for cash aid or ayuda has been so far distributed in the National Capital Region (NCR) by local government units.

On top of this, Hontiveros noted the growing number of incidents - both reported in news and social media - stemming mainly from errors in government's list of beneficiaries for the cash distribution program.

"Mayroong mga reports na may listahan ng beneficiaries na may pangalan ng patay na tao o menor de edad, na di dapat qualified sa ayuda. Mayroong mga beneficiaries ng kasalukuyang Pantawid Program (4Ps) na nawala ang pangalan sa listahan para sa ayuda. Mayroon ding mga report ng mga beneficiary na hindi sinama sa listahan dahil hindi sila botante sa lugar. These stories are way too many to be mere fabrications and should be fully investigated," Hontiveros said.

Hontiveros added that due to erroneous list of beneficiaries and other issues, aid distribution venues in several areas have become regularly crowded with applicants, thus creating potential "super-spreaders" for COVID-19:

"Nakakabahala iyan, dahil kasama sa mga pumipila at nakikipagsiksikan para sa ayuda ay maraming senior citizen na mas vulner-

able sa COVID-19 at iba pang sakit."

"Nakakalungkot na 2021 na pero hindi pa rin maayos ang proseso ng pagbibigay ng ayuda. Ang haba-haba ng pinipila ng mga kababayan natin para lang kumuha ng ayuda, pero pagdating nila sa distribution venue, madami ang wala sa listahan at walang mauwi sa kanilang pamilya. There has been an entire year to fix the database of cash aid recipients and devise a better aid distribution, but it seems not much progress has been made," Hontiveros said.

The senator then urged the DSWD and DILG to create a unified and comprehensive database of cash aid recipients from the various existing lists of aid beneficiaries held by the DSWD and local government units. To do this, Hontiveros said the DSWD must complete its 'poverty survey' to determine the true number and identities of poor Filipinos who need financial assistance during the pandemic.

In the meantime, the DSWD and DILG should remove errors in government's list of aid beneficiaries, including removing dead, fictitious or unqualified persons, Hontiveros said. She also said that government officials or employees involved in acts of corruption or fraud using these assistance funds should be immediately investigated and prosecuted.

To avoid the spread of COVID-19 in aid distribution venues, Hontiveros then reminded local officials to see to it that health protocols, such as physical distancing and wearing of masks, are followed by everyone. She also recommended using large facilities with open ventilation such as public gyms for such large activities.

"The government should act with a sense of urgency and due diligence. Buhay ng Pilipino ang nakataya dito. Kung makupad ang pamahalaan sa pagbibigay ng ayuda, baka hindi sa virus mamatay na ang mga kababayan kundi sa gutom," Hontiveros concluded. PR

PRRD allows grant of 'one-time' P20-K aid to EC pensioners

MANILA – President Rodrigo Duterte has authorized the grant of one-time financial assistance of PHP20,000 to qualified pensioners under the employees' compensation (EC).

Administrative Order (AO) No. 39, signed by Duterte on Monday, empowers the Employees' Compensation Commission (ECC) to grant a one-time cash aid to around 31,000 pensioners of the Social Security System (SSS) and Government Service Insurance System (GSIS).

In signing the AO, Duterte recognized that "the adverse effects of the pandemic on the economy, supplementary health necessities for the battle against the virus, and restrictions imposed on our mobility and social interaction, have increased the financial and health burdens experienced by the EC pensioners."

"The ECC is hereby authorized to grant a one-time financial assistance of PHP20,000 to EC pensioners for permanent partial disability, permanent total disability and survivorship, in the private and public sectors, subject to the availability of funds and pertinent laws, rules, and regulations," the AO read. The ECC, SSS, and GSIS are directed to appropriate and release the amounts necessary to cover the one-time financial assistance from the reserves of the relevant Social Insurance Fund (SIF) that the SSS and GSIS administer under the EC program.

The ECC, in coordination with the SSS and GSIS, shall issue the implementing rules and regulations (IRR) necessary for the effective implementation of the order.

AO 39 takes effect immediately following its publication in the Official Gazette

or a newspaper of general circulation.

Earlier, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) approved a resolution mandating pension-issuing agencies and their servicing banks and other financial institutions to adopt alternative modes of validation for senior citizen pensioners. Currently, senior citizens no longer need to make a physical appearance to claim their pension.

"The IATF considered the health and safety of senior citizen pensioners in approving this resolution and directed relevant government agencies to issue the corresponding memorandum circulars for its implementation by March 1, 2021," Presidential Spokesperson Harry Roque, also acting as IATF-EID spokesperson, said in a statement.

Roque said the IATF-EID's latest directive was meant to protect senior citizens who are considered vulnerable to Covid-19.

"Alam naman natin na tayo ngayon ay nasa gitna ng pandemya at ang mga seniors ay isa sa high-risk at vulnerable sa Covid-19. To ensure their safety, the resolution was approved so they would no longer be required to make a personal appearance in banks and financial institutions just to claim their pension)," he added. Free data access to TESDA website extended until 2022

MANILA – Globe Telecom announced on Monday it will extend providing its subscribers free data access to get resource materials from websites of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and other educational platforms until 2022.

These platforms include websites of the Department of Education (DepEd) Commons and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), as well as the Globe eLibrary (<https://globelibrary.ph/>), an online platform which features eLearning videos and age-appropriate and engaging e-books.

This means that for the school year 2021-2022, Globe and TM subscribers will not incur data charges when accessing those websites. It does not include free access to pages that users may need to open outside of TESDA, DepEd Commons, and CHED's

domain.

"We endeavor to help enhance opportunities for self-learning by making quality content available to teachers and students. We hope our customers will take advantage of this free service to DepEd, CHED, and TESDA for their online learning requirements," Yoly Crisanto, Globe's chief sustainability officer, said in a statement.

TESDA Secretary Isidro Lapeña earlier told the Philippine News Agency (PNA) that Globe started providing free access to TESDA's online courses in August last year. This enabled individuals to learn various skills from the TESDA Online Program (TOP).

"Through Globe's support, our online courses are made more accessible," he said.

Most of the TOP courses are only short courses that learners could complete, compared to full qualifications. (PNA)

'Generosity virus' infects Filipinos nationwide

MANILA – If the coronavirus can be killed with kindness, Filipinos could have easily prevailed against the pandemic.

Lately, community pantries have been sprouting everywhere, inspired by initiatives along Quezon City roads, where donations have been pouring in.

"The virus of generosity named Community Pantry is gaining momentum all over the country. The Filipino spirit of 'bayanihan' is ever alive. That compassion and generosity is a universal language that everyone understands," Fr. Edgardo Vizcarra of the Comboni Missionaries wrote on Facebook.

He praised the pioneer of such initiative and who showed "that nobody is so poor or rich who cannot reach out and give to those who are in need of basic daily commodities such as food".

Netizens have reported similar pantries all over the country.

Most believe that community pantries exist simply because there are good-

hearted individuals who wanted to help and not because the government is not doing anything.

"Madami pa din matulungan at may malasakit lalo sa parte ng mga taong mis-mong apektado. Hindi naman kasi talaga kakayanin ng gobyerno lahat sa sobrang dami ng apektado ng pandemya (Many really wants to help, especially those who got affected. The government cannot do everything especially with so many people affected by this pandemic)," Chai Chai, who works in Rome, Italy, said.

"Gusto lang nila talagang tumulong. 'Di naman nag-kulang ang government. Lahat na ibinigay sa tao, eh (They only want to help. The government has already given everything to the people)," netizen Misette Regisaurelio said, adding that financial aid from the national government and food packs from the local government units have been distributed several times.

Mall operator links with QC for vaccine rollout

CALOOCAN CITY (PIA)

-- The Quezon City Government found a partner in retail giant SM supermalls for its massive vaccination rollout by putting together its own team of doctors and nurses to help inoculate senior citizens and individuals with comorbidities in the city.

"The city has had numerous partnerships with the private sector throughout the pandemic, and we're glad to be working with them still as we vaccinate our residents and immunize them against COVID," said Mayor Joy Belmonte.

Belmonte said the partnership addresses the lack of available healthcare workers who will conduct the vaccination among residents.

"We have agreed that their own medical team can give the shots to qualified SM employees who reside in QC, provided that it will be supervised by our City Health Department," Mayor Joy added.

The city has opened a vaccination site at the Skydome of SM City North Edsa to cater to mall employees who reside in the city and are medical frontliners, senior citizens, and persons with comorbidities ages 18 to 59 years old, or those who fall under A1 to A3 categories, respectively.

Also vaccinated on the site were qualified senior citi-

zen residents of Barangay Sto. Cristo, where the mall is located, and its nearby barangays.

According to Business Permits and Licensing Department (BPLD) head Margie Santos, this move will also help boost the economy as frontline workers, such as those who work at malls and supermarkets, will get vaccinated faster.

"There are close to 16,000 SM employees who work and reside in the city and are qualified to get the vaccine. By teaming up with their employer SM, we can be assured that all of them will be vaccinated protecting not just the employees but also the families they go home to after work. We really appreciate SM and other private sector partner for lending us a hand amid manpower crunch," said Santos.

More vaccination sites are expected to be opened in several other branches of SM malls within the city to cover the target employee population.

The city is also currently in talks with other private sector groups such as Robinsons Malls, Ayala Malls, Araneta City, Eastwood Mall, and the IT and BPO sector. All are considered essential establishments during Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine classification. (PIA NCR)

started their pantry on Sunday, with the items donated by relatives and friends gone in an hour.

Another netizen, Malia Olvido Bautista, thinks the government did not fail in helping the people and critics must stop putting political colors to the initiatives.

"Ito ang magandang attitude ng Pinoy, Matulungan sa kapwa. Walang mayaman sa ginagawa nila, 'Ika nga, helping hand ang meron. Sana lang wag bigyan kulay. Let's help. Senator Win Gatchalian, meanwhile, said community pantries are signs that "ordinary Filipinos are ready and willing to help the needy."

"Ito ay ang pinakamagandang simbolo ng modern-day bayanihan na lahat tayo ay may kakayahang tumulong (This is modern-day unity that shows everyone is capable of helping)," he said in a statement on Monday.

Former representative and current Technical Education and Skills Development Authority Deputy Director John Bertiz said community pantries remind him of a famous quotation by former US President John F. Kennedy.

"Ask not what your country can do for you, ask what you can do for your country or at least communities or fellow Filipinos. Sa panahon ngayon dapat talaga magtulungan ang bawat isa, kasi laban po natin lahat ito (In times like this, we should all help one another because this is everyone's fight)," Bertiz said. (PNA)

DOE assures enough power supply during dry months

MANILA – As power demand peaks during the dry season, the Department of Energy (DOE) does not foresee rotational brownouts as long as there will be no further shutdown of power plants that could substantially impact the Luzon grid.

DOE Assistant Secretary Redentor Delola said in a press briefing Thursday that the current power supply can cater to the peak demand of 11,841 megawatts (MW), which is expected mid-May, even if seven power generation companies are offline from April to June.

Firms that have been on outage since last month are Asia Pacific Energy Corporation, Caliraya-Botocan-Kalayaan Power Company Ltd, Luzon Hydro Corporation, First Gas Power Corporation, GN Power Marivales Center Ltd. Co., Petron Corp., and Sem Calaca Power Corporation.

Some of the outage will extend until July and August. Delola previously said the DOE is already looking into shutdowns that are caused by scheduled maintenance and technical glitches, among others.

"Given these extended outages, what we are seeing in our profile is there is a possibility of yellow alerts during week 15 to week 18. That's the second week of

April and the first week of May. We expect another round of yellow alerts during week 21 to week 25," he said.

DOE Undersecretary Felix William Fuentevela said consumers need not worry about yellow alert status as this would not lead to power interruption.

"Huwag tayong mangamba dahil meron pa tayong susiyente na kuryente. Hindi s'ya nageresulta sa power interruption. Pero 'pag nag-red alert na po 'yan, 'yon ang nagkakaroon ng mga rotating brownout (Let's not worry because we have sufficient power. It won't result in a power interruption. But if it's a red alert, that's when we will have rotating brownouts)," he said.

During a yellow alert, the DOE will closely monitor generation companies so that there will be no further power plant outages that may escalate into a red alert.

"Since mababa 'yung demand, 'yung projection ng yellow alert hindi rin mang-yayari. Ibig sabihin maganda ang sitwasyon natin (Since there is a lower demand, our projection of a yellow alert might not even happen). And it's already April, so we are almost one-third away from the peak period," Fuentevela said. (PNA)

Higit na mas mataas ito sa 19% o 3,707 na kasalukuyang may COVID-19 pa o tinatawag na active cases. Nakapagtala naman ng 3% o 541 ang namatay dahil sa nasabing sakit.

Dahil dito, hinikayat ng gobernador ang mga Bulakenyo, pati na ang mga pumupuna sa mga hakbang ng pamahalaang nasyonal at lokal, na wala aniyang magaling sa panahon ng pandemya kaya mas kailangan na makiisa ang lahat sa mga ipinatutupad na alintuntunin at huwag lamang humanap ng mga mali. Sapagkat higit aniyang mas marami ang napagtagumpayan ng pamahalaang panlalawigan ng Bulacan sa laban sa pan-

demya ng COVID-19. Patuloy din sa pagtaas ang testing capacity ng pamahalaang panlalawigan mula nang agarang ipatayo ang Molecular Laboratory na sinabayan ng pagkakaroon ng mga GeneXpert machines.

Mula sa pagsasagawa ng 23 swab tests kada araw noong Hunyo 2020, nakakapagtest na ng nasa 653 kada araw nitong Marso 2021. Dahil dito, umabot na sa 70,561 na mga indibidal ang naisailalim sa testing ng pamahalaang panlalawigan.

Mababa rin ang positivity rate. Nasa 3% lamang o tatllo sa sampung isinasailalim sa swab tests ang nagpopositibo.

Sa kabuuhan naman mula nang umarangkada ang testing noong Hunyo 2020, nasa 16% ang nagpositibo o 11,083 sa 70,561 na sumailalim sa swab test.

Samantala, nirerepaso na sa Sangguniang Panlalawigan ang pagkakaroon ng sariling planta ng oxygen na planong itayo sa likurang bahagi ng Bulacan Medical Center sa Malolos.

Natapos na rin ang konstruksyon ng bagong dalawang palapag na gusaling Provincial Health Office kung saan ilalagak ang bagong lokasyon ng Bulacan Provincial Blood Center.

MANILA – The National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO) has seized some PHP1.2 billion worth of illegal drugs and arrested almost 8,000 suspects from November 2020 to April this year.

NCRPO chief Maj. Gen. Vicente Danao on Friday said seized drugs include shabu weighing a total of 175 kilograms, 329 kilograms of marijuana and 884 tablets, and 300 ml of ecstasy.

Citing a report, Danao said 7,941 drug suspects were arrested in the 4,618 anti-illegal drugs operations in the NCR from November 11, 2020 until April 15 this year.

He said the NCRPO is consistent in its campaign to stop the proliferation of illegal drugs, particularly those distributed and sold despite health protocols due to the pandemic. (PNA)

MANILA – The Philippine Overseas Employment Administration (POEA) has warned the public against fake e-mail messages appearing to be from the agency.

In a Facebook post on Wednesday, the agency cautioned the people not to open such e-mails using the name of its chief Bernard Olalia as these may contain viruses.

"Spam emails have been sent using olalia@poea.gov.ph. Those e-mails were not from the office of the POEA Administrator so please disregard and do not open the attached files," the post said. "They may contain a disguised program (malware, adware, spyware, virus, etc.) that could damage your computer system or steal your data."

The POEA also apologized to those that have received such an email.

"We apologize for any confusion or harm that the malicious e-mails may have caused," it said. (PNA)

Holy Child is the Protector of the Philippines for half a millennium.

The oldest religious icon of the country has been enshrined and widely venerated at the Basilica del Minore del Sto. Nino in Cebu City under the care of the Augustinians of the Province of Sto. Nino de Cebu-Philippines.

The popular image of the Sto. Nino was given by the Portuguese navigator Ferdinand Magellan to the local queen Humamay (later named Juana), after her baptism on April 14, 1521. On April 28, 1565, Miguel Lopez de Legaspi's expedition landed on the island of Cebu. One of his soldiers found an image of the Child Jesus in a hut believed to be the same image Magellan had given the queen of the island forty-four years earlier.

"The Post Office pays its homage to the image of Señor Sto. Niño of Cebu, the source of hope and faith of the people, who is historically recognized as the oldest religious relic in the Philippines," Postmaster General Fulgencio said.

He added that the stamp features the rich cultural heritage showcasing our country's many manifestations of art. The milestone commemoration of the arrival of the image of Señor Santo Niño is one such important moment that recalls the uniqueness of Filipino culture and history".

The area subjected for the clean-up drive has been declared a Marine Protected Area in which a series of proactive Artificial Marine habitations (artificial coral reefs) were installed by the PCG, Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary (PCGA), and the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) in previous years. A total of five (5) sacks of non-biodegradable materials were collected from the activity.

The underwater clean-up activity was spearheaded by PCG-Cavite Commander Lt. Michael John Encina with the active involvement of the LGU and stakeholders to be the primary coast guardians in taking care of their own marine ecosystem even in the midst of the pandemic.

Also through the SCUBAsurero, formed by a growing group of scuba divers, dive clubs, dive centers, dive shops, and resorts with the advocacy for cleaner oceans through safe and environmentally-sound marine activities, everybody will take responsibility to take action in the restoration and maintenance not just of the province's marine biodiversity but of the country's renowned beaches and pristine waters as well. PGC to hold 1-day Voluntary Vaccination for Senior Citizens of the province

Trece Martires, Cavite (PIA) – In its bid to protect the vulnerable members particularly the Senior Citizens (SCs) of the province thru CoViD-19 inoculation, the provincial government headed by Governor Jonvic Remulla will hold an experiment for a one-day Voluntary Vaccination for SCs to be held in the municipality of Silang.

This was prompted by the survey result showing 65% of the population of the province comprised mostly of senior citizens are still hesitant to get vaccinated with the CoViD-19 vaccine. Current statistics show that there are 348,000 registered SCs in the province.

"Senior Citizens have the highest risk of death from CoViD-19. Kahit sabihing nasa bahay lang kayo ay pwede pa rin mahawa sa mga kasamahan na malimit sa labas. Walang mayaman o mahirap sa pandemya. Mula sa mga indigent hanggang sa mga bilyonaryo. Everyone is at risk," Remulla gently reminded.

The experiment will be held

in the coming days at Barangays Inchican and Tibig with the turnout of participants giving an assessment on the perception of the target beneficiaries (SCs) towards CoViD-19 vaccines.

The governor guessed that 50% of the target SCs will not come out to get inoculated.

Likewise, Remulla had coordinated with the National Task Force (NTF) Vaccine Czar Sec. Galvez for the allocation of CoViD-19 vaccine intended for the SCs of the province.

Governor Remulla also disclosed that the Novavax vaccine for the wide scale vaccination program of the provincial government is expected to arrive soon.

The said vaccination program aims to inoculate those outside the groups prioritized by the national government. These are the healthy and productive residents of the province aged 18-59 years who actively contribute to the economy. (*Ruel B. Francisco, with reports from Jonvic Remulla FB page*)

Meralco doesn't owe Muntinlupa franchise tax: SC

MANILA – The Manila Electric Company (Meralco) won a case against the Muntinlupa City government after the Supreme Court (SC) ruled that the local government's conversion from a municipality into a city "does not endow the authority to impose a franchise tax."

In a decision recently made public, the SC en banc granted the petition of Meralco and reversed and set aside the January 31, 2011 decision of the Court of Appeals (CA).

The SC ruling reinstated the September 19, 2003 decision of the Pasig Regional Trial Court (RTC) Branch 67 and declared void Section 25 of Municipal Ordinance 93-95 (Revenue Code of the Municipality of Muntinlupa of 1994).

The local measure stated that a franchise tax on private persons or corporations operating public utilities within its territorial jurisdiction will be collected "at the rate of 50 percent of 1 percent of the gross annual receipts of the preceding calendar year."

The case started on June 28, 1999 when the City of Muntinlupa demanded Meralco to pay franchise tax from 1992 to 1999.

Meralco ignored the demand letter dated August 21, 2001 on the premise that Muntinlupa, which was then still a municipality, did not have the power and authority to impose and collect a franchise tax since, under the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991, only provinces and cities have the power and authority to collect franchise tax.

Meralco claimed that the city "cannot breathe life into an ordinance that was void from the beginning".

The SC noted that its passage "was beyond the corporate powers of the then Municipality of Muntinlupa" and "deviated from the express provision of Republic Act 7160 (LGC)."

"While ordinances, just like other laws and statutes, enjoy the presumption of validity, they may be struck down and set aside when their invalidity or unreasonableness is evident on the face or has been estab-

lished in evidence," the SC ruled.

The CA earlier said even if the ordinance was enacted in 1992, the assessment of Meralco's franchise tax duties should be computed from March 1, 1995, when Republic Act 7926 was signed into law converting Muntinlupa from a town to a highly urbanized city.

"It is our view that although the ordinance was void when first passed, the legality of its provision was cured by the enactment of RA 7926, which converted Muntinlupa into a highly urbanized city," the CA said. "Thus, [Meralco's] obligation to pay franchise tax to appellants accrued only from the date RA 7926 took effect." (PNA)

BOC-MICP Bolsters E-TRACC Operation

AS part of the efforts to enhance trade facilitation and anti-smuggling efforts, the Manila International Port (MICP) on April 15, 2021, bolstered its Electronic Tracking of Containerized Cargo (E-TRACC) operations through the activation of the E-TRACC Arming Station.

The arming station is a Port initiative and is supported by the Office of the Commissioner through the Internal Administration Group (IAG). It is designed to facilitate the seamless and efficient arming and removal of trackers. This will also provide the necessary office space for MICP's E-TRACC team. Additional

trackers were also acquired which now gives the port a total of 2000 functioning trackers.

The E-TRACC system was implemented by the Bureau in 2020 and has been providing real time Global Positioning System (GPS) tracking of containerized cargo for better management of volume, traffic and security. The trackers are designed to alert any tampering and allows for the swift action of the Bureau's Enforcement and Security Service Quick Reaction Team (ESS-QRT) to prevent the possibility of smuggling activities.

Also done during the activity was the recognition of the MICP's E-TRACC team composed of members of the Piers Inspection Division (PID) headed by Dr. Siegfred L. Manaois. The award recognizes the efforts of the Division in implementing the E-TRACC system in the country's largest port in terms of volume.

With the activation of MICP E-TRACC arming station comes the strengthened commitment to facilitate trade and enhance border security under the guidance of BOC Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero. PR

ERC, DOE dapat imbestigahan ang unplanned outages ng ilang planta – Gatchalian

LUNGSOD CALOOCAN (PIA) -- Hinikayat ni Senator Win Gatchalian ang Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) at Department of Energy (DOE) na imbestigahan na ang mga napabalitang unplanned outages o biglaang pagtitigil ng operasyon ng ilang power plants sa Luzon na nagdulot ng pagtaas ng singil sa kuryente nito lang nakaraan.

Inudyukan din ni Gatchalian ang DOE na pagtuunan ng pansiñ ang mga logistical concerns na kinakaharap ng ilang power producers upang mapigilan ang mga pagsasara ng iba pang planta sa mga darating na araw at baka ito'y makaapekto sa COVID-19 vaccine rollout na inaasa-hang magtutuloy-tuloy na sa Mayo o Hunyo ngayong taon.

"Hindi dapat tayo magkaroon ng brownouts dahil padating pa ang mga bakuna natin sa katapusang buwan o kaya sa May o June. Masedelan itong mga vaccines. May iba na kailangan ng almost sub-zero freezing temperature o mga freezer na kaya ang negative 20 degrees. Kaya

kung may brownout tayo, saan natin ilalagay ang mga bakuna natin? Malaking dagok 'yan sa atin at maaantala yung vaccination process natin," sabi ng Senate Energy Committee Chairperson.

"Dapat gumalaw dito ang ERC dahil noong November 2020, naglabas sila ng isang polisiya na lahat ng planta ay dapat makapag-deliver batay sa tinatawag na reliability index. Kapag bumagsak sila doon sa polisiya ng ERC at hindi nila ma-justify kung bakit pumalya 'yung planta, magmumulta sila," dagdag pa ni Gatchalian.

Ayon sa datos ng Independent Energy Market Operator of the Philippines (IEMOP), sa billing period para sa buwan ng Marso ng kasalukuyang taon, nagkaroon ng 1,580 megawatts (MW) na non-coincidental unplanned outages o kabuuang 61.3% ng mga naitalang nasirang mga planta sa nasabing buwan.

Para naman sa billing period ng Abril pero hanggang Abril 18 lamang, umabot sa 1,428 MW ang non-coincidental unplanned outages o kabuuang 62.8% ng mga

nasirang planta sa nasabing buwan.

"Dapat ring imbestigahan ng DOE ang ilang alegasyon tungkol sa logistics. Dahil nga pandemya ngayon, hindi dumarating ang mga spare parts, kaya nagkaka-problema sa logistics. Dapat magawan agad ito ng aksyon para hindi sabay-sabay na bumagsak ang mga planta," sabi ni Gatchalian.

"Dapat gawin ng pamahalaan ang lahat ng makakaya para maiwasan ang brownout. Kaya ang solusyon dito at all cost -- dapat yung mga planta huwag bumagsak, huwag silang mag outage," pagtatapos niya. (PIA NCR)







The SC upheld the guilty verdict for violation of Republic Act 3019 or the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act and falsification of private documents.

She said several countries have successfully employed contact tracing as a cornerstone of their Covid-19 response plans, such as South Korea, Singapore, and Germany.

She cited the World Health Organization (WHO) stating that contact tracing is an essential public health tool that will break chains of transmission when systematically applied.

She recommended the hiring of contact tracers under the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) - Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers (DOLE TUPAD) program, particularly in the NCR Plus bubble areas composed of Metro Manila, Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna, and Rizal. "This can also be expanded to other areas where there continue to be high incidence of Covid-19 positive cases," Legarda added.

Based on information by DOLE, the Department has already coordinated with the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) for the hiring of contact tracers to be employed under the TUPAD program.

"Hiring TUPAD workers to take on a more challenging role as contact tracers will not only give our displaced workers a source of income but will also give them the sense of fulfillment that they are doing a crucial job in the country's fight to curtail the spread of the virus," Legarda said.

She said the country can employ a uniform and systematic contact tracing system all over the country to have more organized data and assist our contact tracers in gathering significant information faster.

"Our fight against this unseen enemy is a fight easily won through a whole-of-government, whole-of-society approach. Let us work together as one, aiming for a common goal of sustainable and inclusive growth and recovery amid the ongoing pandemic," she said. **(PNA)**

RHU Tanza reports on COVID-19 situation, vaccination in the municipality

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) --The Rural Health Unit (RHU) of Tanza has recorded more than 2,400 COVID-19 confirmed cases after more than a year since the pandemic hit the country, the 4th among the cities and municipalities with the highest number of COVID-19 cases in the province.

"Out of the more than 2,400 COVID-19 confirmed cases, 600 are active cases," Municipal Health Officer Dr. Ruth Punzalan said.

Meanwhile, the local government had inoculated a total of 1,300 healthcare workers and senior citizens since the start of the vaccination rollout using AstraZeneca vaccines.

Despite the global shortage of AstraZeneca vaccine, the RHU assured the healthcare workers and senior citizens who received the 1st dose of AstraZeneca jab that they will receive the 2nd dose since additional supply is expected to arrive soon.

Dr. Punzalan said vaccination for the A2 priority group will continue with the recent approval of the Sinovac

vaccine by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for the inoculation of senior citizens.

About 300 senior citizens per day are targeted to be vaccinated on a first come first serve basis at the Tanza Specialists Medical Center that started Tuesday, April 2021.

The RHU is also planning to start the vaccination of the A3 Priority group or persons aged 18-59 years with comorbidities as they call on residents belonging to this group to register for the CoViD-19 Vaccination program of the LGU using the online registration link found on Mayor Yuri A. Pacumio's FB page.

Pursuant to the provincial government's directive to intensify the conduct of the vaccination program of all the LGUs in the province, Mayor Pacumio is looking into the possibility of partnering with Vista Mall, and using the Tanza Sports Complex as additional COVID-19 hubs to speed up the distribution of the vaccines to achieve herd immunity. 3 most wanted persons fall in NCR, Cavite ops

MANILA – Three wanted persons were nabbed in separate operations in Metro Manila and Cavite province this week, the National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO) reported on Thursday.

NCRPO chief, Maj. Gen. Vicente D. Danao, Jr., citing police reports, said suspect Benito Parrenas was arrested in Caloocan City at around 1 p.m. on Wednesday. He is listed as the second most wanted person of the Mina Municipal Police Station in Iloilo City.

Parrenas has two standing arrest warrants for murder issued by two local courts in Iloilo.

At around 2:30 p.m. on the same day, frustrated mur-

der suspect Alvin Bernabe was arrested in Navotas City.

Bernabe, the sixth most wanted person of Navotas City, has an arrest warrant for frustrated murder issued by the Malabon City Regional Trial Court.

On Tuesday night, authorities also nabbed rape suspect Glenard Pilat in a manhunt operation in Cavite City.

Pilat is the second most wanted person of the Sta. Josefa Municipal Police Station in Agusan del Sur. The arrested suspects are now under the custody of operating units for documentation and proper disposition pending issuance of commitment order from the court of origin. (PNA)

ECQ aid distribution extended until May 15

MANILA – Local government units (LGUs) have until May 15 to distribute the cash aid to 22.9 million low-income residents of the National Capital Region Plus (NCR Plus) affected by the two-week implementation of enhanced community quarantine (ECQ), Malacañang said Tuesday. "In-extend ang deadline na makumpleto ang pamahagi ng financial assistance hanggang 15 ng Mayo 2021 (The deadline for completing the distribution of financial assistance has been extended until May 15, 2021)," Presidential Spokesperson Harry Roque said in a virtual presser.

This developed following appeals from several LGUs to extend the deadline for the distribution of assistance in NCR Plus, which covers Metro Manila and the provinces of Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna, and Rizal, Roque said. Under the guidelines earlier released by the Department of the Interior and Local Government and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), local officials must complete the release of aid "in 15 calendar days upon receipt of the funds if the assistance is in cash or within 30 calendar days if assistance is in-kind".

Roque said LGUs have been given more time to finish the distribution of aid to avoid mass gatherings, considering that the country is still grappling with the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19).

"Tayo ay nasa panahon po ng Covid-19. Bawal ang malakihang pagtitipunton. Kailangan pangalagaan ang kaligtasan at kalusugan ng lahat (There is a Covid-19 pandemic. Mass gatherings are prohibited. We have to ensure the safety and health of everyone)," he said.

Roque added that local officials are also looking for "flexible" arrangements by distributing the assistance either through digital means or house-to-house. The most restrictive ECQ was implemented in NCR Plus from March 29 to April 11 due to the alarming surge in coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) infections.

The status was downgraded to modified ECQ from April 12 to 30.

President Rodrigo Duterte earlier approved the allocation of PHP23 billion worth of emergency subsidy for low-income households. Each beneficiary can receive either in-kind or cash assistance amounting to PHP1,000 per person or a maximum of PHP4,000 per family.

DSWD Secretary Rolando Bautista earlier admitted that there was a "slow start" of the distribution of aid in NCR Plus but guaranteed improvement in the coming days.

The DSWD reported Monday that around 7,470,149 low-income earners or 32.5 percent of the 22.9 million recipients have already received the assistance, as of April 18. (PNA)

BOC Facilitates the Joint Cluster Meeting of the NSW-TWG

CUSTOMS Commissioner and National Single Window - Technical Working Group Chairman Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero successfully concluded the Joint Meeting of the NSW-TWG Tax and Duty Exempt Cluster, and the NSW-TWG Relief, Consignment, and Foreign Donations Cluster on April 20, 2021 through virtual conference.

Also present in the Meeting were Anti- Red Tape Authority (ARTA) Director General Jeremiah Belgica as Vice Chairperson for NSW Onboarding Matters, and BOC Management Information System and Technology Group (MISTG) Deputy Commissioner Allan Geronimo as Vice Chairperson for NSW Technical Matters.

At the Joint NSW-TWG Meeting, the DOF TRADENET Project Management Office (PMO) presented the initial findings of the TRADENET Readiness Assessment Survey which aims to provide baseline information to help in formulating a sound strategy to effectively manage the onboarding of all the target TRGAs within the year 2021. The survey found that majority of the regulatory government agencies have their own Information Technology (IT) departments, with a number of agencies having their own automated systems for trade-related processes. To further expedite the onboarding process in the TRADENET system, the Meeting agreed to prioritize these agencies especially those who have under-

taken onboarding activities such as business data gathering and commodity codes identification.

The ARTA, as Vice Chairperson for NSW Onboarding Matters, reported a decision to send out Notices of Warning to agencies that are not responsive and are not complying to the Ease of Doing Business and Anti-Red Tape Advisory Council Resolution No. 12 and ARTA Memorandum Circular No. 2021-01. The EODB-ARTA Council Resolution No. 12 mandates the onboarding of the 73 trade regulatory government agencies involved in the processing and issuance of license, permit, clearance, and certification for movement (import-export-transit) of cargo to the TRADENET on or before the second week of April. ARTA also reported that those who will still fail to comply will be subjected to investigations or appropriate administrative actions including but not limited to violations of RA 11032, AO 23, RA 6713, and RA 3019.

To ensure the sustainability of Cluster Meetings and activities, following agencies were nominated as Chairpersons of their respective NSW-TWG Clusters: Department of Finance – Revenue Office (DOF-RO) for the NSW-TWG Tax and Duty Exempt Cluster; and Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) for the NSW-TWG Relief, Consignment, and Foreign Donations Cluster. HONTIVEROS FILES BILL SEEKING TO END HUNGER AND MALNUTRITION

Senator Risa Hontiveros has filed Senate Bill No. 2126, otherwise known as "Ensuring Zero Hunger for All Filipinos" to address the glaring gaps in the government response in addressing hunger and malnutrition.

"Itutulak ng Zero Hunger Bill ang gobyerno upang unahin ang problema sa gutom at ang karapatan ng bawat Pilipino sa pagkain lalo ngayong marami sa ating mga kababayani ay naitulak sa kahirapan," she said.

"The Philippines has committed to end hunger and eradicate poverty by 2030 as part of its Sustainable Development Goals. Kailangan itong maging pangunahing adhikain. Hindi ito dapat maantala o maipagpalibutan dahil buhay ang nakataya," Hontiveros

added. The bill mandates the state to take appropriate steps to ensure the realization of individual's right to food, design policies and fund programs that will create conditions that will free Filipinos from hunger and reexamine existing policies on the use, exploitation and management of resources to achieve the goal of ending hunger.

It will also provide for adequate, coherent and transparent policies that encourage and promote private citizen's active participation such as through food banks and community pantries. "Food banks and community pantries should be institutionalized so they can get the right amount of support from the government to serve and reach more people in need," she

said. Moreover, this measure fully integrates the whole of government approach to eradicate hunger. Government and all its instrumentalities would be compelled to work together across portfolio boundaries to achieve an integrated response to eliminate hunger.

Once passed, a Commission on the Right to Adequate Food will also be established as the primary policy-making and coordinating body to guarantee the full exercise of the right to adequate food. A 'National Food Policy' would be formulated by the Commission which will serve as a nationwide framework of programs that will address hunger, help achieve food security, improve nutrition and promote sustainable

agriculture. Through the adoption of a National Food Policy, the government will be held more accountable as any violation of the right to food will be punishable by law, Hontiveros said.

"The real health disaster is still ahead of us. It will not be enough to provide short-term solutions. There should be a long-term perspective to strike at the root of the problem to be able to provide a secure future and ensure the right to food for everyone," she said.

"This proposed law will pave the way for inclusive, social, equal and sustainable growth and development to ensure that there is enough food available for all Filipinos," she concluded. PR
