Ayon kay Alex Aguinaldo, kurador ng NHCP na nangangasiwa sa mga programang pang-alaala kaugnay ng magtiyuhin na Heneral Goyo at Marcelo H. Del Pilar sa Bulakan, gumawa ng 15 pahinang social media card ang komisyon na ipinaskil sa official facebook page ng NHCP Museo ni Marcelo H. Del Pilar.

Pansamantalang dito muna itinatanghal ang mga makasaysayang petsa kaugnay kay Heneral Goyo dahil wala pang dedikadong museo para sa binatang heneral.

Sa ikalawang pahina ng eksibit, ipinakilala siya bilang si Gregorio "Goyo" Sempio Hilario Del Pilar upang bigyang diin ang pagiging pamangkin siya ni Marcelo H. Del Pilar, dahil kapatid nito ang kanyang amang si Fernando H. Del Pilar. Ipinanganak ang binatang heneral sa barangay San Jose sa Bulakan, Bulacan kung saan kasalukuyan nakatindig ang kanyang dambana.

Bukod dito, ipinapakita rin sa nasabing eksibisyon ang kaugnayan ni Heneral Goyo kay Deodato Arellano, ang unang supremo ng Katipunan. Dahil noong nag-aaral siya sa Ateneo Municipal De Manila, ang binatang heneral ay nanatili sa tahanan ni Hilaria Del Pilar, kapatid na babae ni Marcelo asawa ni Arellano.

Habang nag-aaral, ang binatang heneral ang lihim na kinatuwang ni Marcelo upang mamahagi ng inilimbag niyang "Caiigat Cayo", na isang pampletong laban sa mga Kastila at Prayle. Hanggang mag-ing kasapi siya sa Katipunan sa Edad na 17.

Sa mga sumunod na pa-

hina ng online exhibit, isa-isa nang ipinakita ang mga naging papel ni Heneral Goyo sa pagganap tungo sa kalayaan ng Pilipinas.

Halimbawa na rito ang magkasunod na labanan na bahagi ng Rebolusyon ng 1896, gaya ng Labanan sa Masukol sa Paombong ng Nobyembre 26, 1896 na sinundan ng Labanan sa San Rafael noong Nobyembre 30, 1896.

Nakasama niya sa pakikipaglaban ang kababatang si Anacleto Enriquez sa pagkubkob naman sa simbahan ng San Rafael. Tinagurian itong "Masaker sa San Rafael" dahil sa nasa 800 katao ang namatay, na nagresulta sa literal na pagbaha ng dugo na hanggang tuhod sa loob ng nasabing simbahan.

Sa isa ring bahagi ng online exhibit, isinasaad na muntik nang mamatay si Heneral Goyo sa labanan sa Kakarong de Sili sa Pandi noong bagong taon ng Enero 1, 1897, nang dumampi sa kanyang noo ang Bala ng Baril. Ito ang nagtaas sa kanya sa pagiging isang lieutenant. Ipinamalas naman ni Heneral Goyo ang kanyang malikhaing pamamaraan sa pakikipaglaban sa kanyang ginawang pag-salakay sa simbahan ng Paombong noong Setyembre 1897.

Sa isang misa, habang nagsisimba ang mga Kastila sa pangunguna ng mga prayle, nagsuot ng pambabae sina Heneral Goyo at ang kanyang mga kasama habang kunwaring nakikiisa sa misa.

Dito sila nakahanap ng tiyempo upang makubkob ang mga kalabang Kastila pati na ang pagbawi sa mga abuloy na pwersahang kinolekta ng mga prayle.

Iba pa rito ang ginawa niyang ambush kay Prayle Moises Santos na kura ng Katedral ng Malolos at mga kasama nito noong Marso 1897. Sa nasabing ambush ay nabawi nila ang limpak-limpak na perang mula sa sapilitang abuloy na nakolekta sa ka-



PETITION

PETITIONER through counsel unto this Honorable Court most respectfully states:

1. That petitioner is of legal age, married to the respondent, Filipino citizen and a resident of #11404 M. Reyes St., Brgy. Mabuhay, Carmona, Cavite but presently staying at Classic Flat 9 Misrah I Barrieri Msida Malta, being an Overseas Filipino Worker.

She is represented by the **PUNZALAN FAUSTINO PUNZALAN MARASIGAN & ASSOCIATES LAW OFFICES** where she may be served with the Honorable Court processes;

2. That respondent is also of legal age, married to the petitioner, Filipino citizen and a resident of Blk. 7B Lot 33 Brgy. Gregoria De Jesus, GMA, Cavite, where he may be served with the Honorable Court summons and other processes;

3. That petitioner's parent had been separated and she was previously staying with his father in Marinduque until sometime in 1990 when petitioner spent the school vacation with her mother in Carmona, Cavite;

4. That after her vacation, petitioner's father didn't fetched her in Carmona, Cavite constraining the petitioner to stay with her mother and later on, enrolled as third year high school student at Carmona High School;

5. That during her stay in Carmona, petitioner met new classmates and friends, one of whom is the respondent Marlon Dominguez;

6. That after their initial meeting, respondent courted the petitioner until the former won the heart of the petitioner. They started their relationship as boyfriend-girlfriend while they were both in forth year high school;

7. That petitioner and respondent's relation was on and off until they become intimate, which her mother later on discovered. Petitioner's mother became so uneasy of their relationship that one night, while they were staying at their house all by themselves, petitioner and respondent were just considered to have eloped;

8. That after the "pamamanhikan", petitioner and respondent finally got married on June 14, 1992 at the Philippine Independent Church in Biñan City, Laguna. Petitioner was surprised how she was able to get married to the respondent, being a minor at that time. Copy of their Certificate of Marriage is hereto attached as **Annex "A"**;

9. That after the wedding, petitioner stayed with her parent-in-law. Respondent meanwhile was able to get a job and their relationship as husband and wife started smoothy;

10. That later on, petitioner noticed changes with the respondent until she discovered that respondent has an extra-marital relation with his co-employee that resulted to their separation;

11. That petitioner still stayed with her in-laws until after two (2) months when the respondent came back. Petitioner was hoping that respondent would change and gave the respondent a second chance, accepting him to her fold;

12. That petitioner then got pregnant and delivered their first baby on July 13, 1993, who was given the name John Paul M. Dominguez. Copy of his certificate of Live Birth is hereto attached as **Annex "B"**.

13. That respondent again landed a job but he started to have vices such as gambling and oftentimes goes out with his colleague leaving the petitioner and their child alone at the house;

14. That these vices had been the subject of several arguments between the petitioner and respondent that resulted to physical violence by the later against the former. These happened several times to the extent that respondent burnt petitioner's clothes aside from asking the petitioner to leave their house;

15. That petitioner endure all the pain for the sake of their child, hoping that respondent will somehow realized his mistakes and they could start anew with their child. Petitioner being fully aware of the adverse effect of having a broken family;

16. That petitioner was then able to have work but the respondent became too jealous about it. Respondent would often, during their arguments, uttered words like "May pinagmamalaki ka na dahil may trabaho ka!";

17. That these insecurities manifested the narrow thinking of the respondent. Petitioner never complained about the salary of the respondent, petitioner never asked for money from the respondent nor even asked how much was the respondent's salary;

18. That the glimpsed of hope came when petitioner got pregnant with their second child and again, their relation started smoothly. However, like before it was just temporary for the respondent became more physical whenever they have arguments. Copy of the Certificate of Live Birth of their second child is hereto attached as Annex "C";

19. That petitioner sometimes will go to the work with black eye and hematoma to different parts of her body as a result of the physical abuse of the respondent but would still stay because of their children. Petitioner suffered too much pain not only emotionally but physically but these pain could temporarily be healed whenever she looked upon her children;

20. That respondent the applied for work abroad and was able to work in Dubai. Petitioner then learned that respondent again had an affair with another women in Dubai but could not do anything;

21. That sometime in February 2007, respondent went back to the Philippines to attend the wake of his parent. After the burial, petitioner and respondent talk that again resulted to their arguments and separation;

22. That respondent went back to Dubai and petitioner learned after several years that respondent had a relation and living with another woman, with whom he had previous relation;

23. That mindful of the welfare of his children, petitioner was then able to work abroad and finally had come to realize that the change she hoped for would no longer come and it was then that she has finally decided that enough was enough and she had to stand up for her rights because if she would let this pass again, the little concern and respect she has for herself would forever be gone;

24. That petitioner with the help of her friend was able to consult with a lawyer and after telling her story was advised to have his marriage declared null and void considering her minority at the time of marriage;

25. That after securing the necessary documents with the National Statistics Office including the petitioner's Certificate of Live Birth which is hereto marked as Annex "D", it was shown that petitioner was only 16 years old and 10 months at the time of her marriage with the respondent on June, 1992 having been born on July 26, 1975;

26. That under Section 5 of the Family Code, it is provided that:

"ARTICLE 5. Any male or female of the age of eighteen years or upwards not under any of the impediments mentioned in Articles 37 and 38, may contract marriage".

27. That relative hereto, Section 2 of the same Code provides for the essential requisite of marriage. Quoted hereunder is the said provision:

"ARTICLE 2. No marriage shall be valid, unless these essential requisites are present:

- (1) Legal capacity of the contracting parties who must be a male and a female and
(2) Consent freely given in the presence of the solemnizing officer."

28. That further, Section 4 of the same Code provides the effect of the absence of any of the essential requisites of marriage. Again, pertinent portion of the provision is hereto quoted:

"ARTICLE 4. The absence of any of the essential or formal requisites shall render the marriage void ad initio, except as stated in Article 35.

x x x x x"

29. That without being repetitious, petitioner being a minor was only sixteen (16) ten (10) months at the time of her marriage with the respondent on June 14, 1992 and has no capacity to enter into marriage. Hence, her marriage should be declared void ab initio in accordance with the afore-quoted provisions of the Family Code;

30. That lastly, petitioner and respondent have not, during their marriage, acquired any real properties.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed of the Honorable Court that judgement be rendered

declaring the marriage between the petitioner, Airyn Mirambil-Dominguez and the respondent, Marlon Dominguez, held on June 14, 1992 be declared null and void ab initio due to the absence of one of the essential requisites of marriage that is legal capacity of the petitioner in accordance with Articles 2, 4 and 5 of the Family Code.

Other relief's just and equitable under the premises are likewise prayed for.




“Kung kinakailangang lumabas ng bahay upang bumili ng pagkain o gamot, siguraduhin po natin na tayo ay may suot na bota o

Ayon kay Janairo, base sa kanilang natanggap na ulat na may anim na kaso ng carbon monoxide poisoning kung saan tatlo ang nasawi sa Rodriguez, Rizal.

“They were exposed to fumes from their portable generator,” ayon kay Janairo.

Imus LGU bags 1st Place in the Manila BAYani Awards and Incentives

Imus, Cavite (PIA) – The City Government here ranked first in the recently concluded Manila BAYani Awards and Incentives (MBAI) National Awardees of 2019 among all five LGUs selected in the country.

The MBAI is the Department of Interior and Local Government’s (DILG) initiative to grant cash incentives to LGUs that have shown exemplary performance in meeting specific indicators of the Manila Bay Clean-up, Rehabilitation, and Preservation Program (MBCRPP).

DILG-MBCRPP shares the innovative practices of the LGUs just like that of the Imus LGU’s projects and programs implemented to effectively manage environment resources such as liquid waste, solid wastes, and informal settlers at the locality, through creativity and innovation.

Notably, the City of Imus is the first in the province to have a functional wastewater treatment facility in public markets, schools, slaughterhouses, and public hospitals.

These water treatment

facilities were also built at the Imus National High School, Imus Pilot Elementary School, and Buhay na Tubig Elementary School which is part of the Green School program including rainwater harvesters installed at 35 public schools in the city.

The LGU also included junkshop owners and pig growers for the recovery of recyclable wastes, special wastes, and biodegradable wastes with a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) that would ensure its effective recording and monitoring.

The MOA declared that junkshop owners are required to submit a quarterly report to the barangays regarding the total amount of waste collected or purchased from residents while the pig growers would submit a slip containing the amount of biodegradable wastes collected from households.

Meanwhile, the development of the Imus Linear Parks that serves as a place for recreation and sports for residents of nearby communities helped maintain the waterways and prevented informal settler families to squat on the property.

Partnerships with different stakeholders such as Mentoring for Work Services, Inc. (MWSI), schools, CEMEX, Gawad Kalinga, Coca Cola GERMA, and the Bureau of Jail Manage-

Ito ang ikatlong pagkakataon na sinalakay ang naturang bookies na nagpapanggap bilang playstation. Kinumpiska ng MPD ang lahat ng nakuha na kagamitan na ginagamit sa bookies habang inihahanda ang kaukulang kaso laban sa mga nahuli sa naturang bookies. Nito lamang Nobyembre ay muli na naman kumilos ang pamunuan ng Games and Amusement Board (GAB) Anti-Illegal Gambling Division para pigilin ang pagbabalik ng illegal na bookies sa horseracing ngayong aprubado na ang pagbubukas ng industriya ng karera sa bansa. Sa pangunguna ni GAB- AIGD Chief Glenn Pe at sa koordinasyon sa Manila Police Department- District Intelligence Division (MPD- DID) ay nagsagawa ng joint anti-gambling operation sa Kalimbas Street Sta.Cruz, Manila na nagresulta ng pagkaka-aresto ng tatlong suspek na nagpapatakbo ng illegal na bookies. Ayon sa Chairman ng GAB na si Abraham Mitra “Ngayong pong nagbabalik na ang industriya ng karera ay balik din sa illegal na gawain ang ilan nating kababayan. Ngunit makakaasa po ang ating publiko na gagawin namin ang lahat para matigil ang kanilang gawain” Sa atin pong kababayan, kung nais po ninyo suportahan ang industriya ng horseracing na mahabang panahon ding nalugmok dahil sa lockdown, doon na po tayo magpunta sa legal at may online apps na rin po para maiwasan ang contact” aniya. Nakatakdang sampahan ng kaukulang kaso na paglabag sa PD 1602 na naamyendahan ng RA 9287 (illegal horseracing bookies) ang mga nadakip na sina Hazel Francisco, Brual Acuna at Jaime Adalim. Nakumpiska sa kanila ang TV monitor, iba’t-ibang paraphernalia at cash. Ang tanong may pag-asa ba talagang mawala ang illegal na bookies sa bansa?

CAGAYAN DE ORO – The Philippine Sinter Corporation in Villanueva, Misamis Oriental, a subsidiary of JFE Steel Corporation in Japan, commends the Bureau of Customs (BOC) - Port of Cagayan de Oro for facilitating the release of its shipment covering 27,500 metric tons of Russian Anthracite Coal in just 25 minutes under Project FAST-CaReS, otherwise known as “First ASEAN Standard Time Cargo Releasing System”, on November 11, 2020.

As one of the most trusted traders engaged in the movement of bulk and break-bulk cargoes in Northern Mindanao, the Philippine Sinter was among the selected companies of the Port of Cagayan de Oro to participate in the project. The facilitation of the shipment consigned to Philippine Sinter surpassed the record of the pilot bulk cargo of Pilipinas Kao Incorporated which was released in 26 minutes under FAST-CaRes on October 28, 2020.

“This is a very good procedure, very good for us multinational companies because it is very hard before and time consuming in getting clearances but now we can do it in 25 minutes,” Philippine Sinter Makati Office Vice President Rey Santos said.

Atty. Roswald Joseph Pague, Head of Office of the Strategy Management (OSM) of the Port of Cagayan de Oro, also expects for more trusted companies of the Bureau to benefit from the project.

Meanwhile, District Collector John Simon presented a Certificate of Recognition to Philippine Sinter for the successful operation. In his statement, he said that the feat is a proof that processes can be streamlined and that a world class customs administration can be achieved.

The Project Fast-CaRes is the first in the country that adopts the ASEAN standard time of 30-minutes cargo clearance from the electronic lodgement of the goods declaration to the actual release of the cargo

to the importer’s premises. This initiative of the Port of Cagayan de Oro is in support to Customs Commissioner Rey Leonardo Guerrero’s 10-Point Priority Program in the area of trade facilitation. **PR**

TANZA RECEIVES SCHOOL BUILDING FROM SM PRIME

SM Prime Holdings through SM Foundation inaugurate and turn over (November 20) a two-story, four classroom school building to Punta Elementary School in Barangay Punta II, Tanza, Cavite. It is one of the most populated schools in the district with a total enrolment of 2,210 students in SY 2019-2020.

Situated in a 10,000 sq. meter area with 34 classrooms with a ratio of 1:55 per section. Many of its students come from barangays in Punta I and II and from the municipality's relocation sites where some Metro Manila informal settlers have found new homes.

The new SM classrooms will be utilized by Grade 2 pupils. According to School principal II, Dr. Gloria Casiano, before the COVID pandemic, Grades One and Two held shifting classes with four sections using the school's covered

court as classrooms.

"It was only in July when we had the ground-breaking ceremony. How excited the whole Punta ES community to see the building rise despite Covid. And today, we are more excited, overwhelmed! Thank you very much SM Foundation and SM Prime Holdings! Your donation will serve as haven in nurturing the young minds of our Puntaceños."

The school buildings follow the design of other donated SM school buildings and with added amenities: fully-furnished, PWD-friendly and emergency-ready. It has **200 armchairs** of which 20 are specially designed for left-handed pupils, four sets of teacher's desk/table, 16 wall fans, eight panoramic concave whiteboards, four wall clocks, four regular washrooms with flush toilets and wash basins. PWD-ramp leading to a spacious PWD washroom with flush toilet and wash basin.

Person with Disabilities of the **Foundation of These-abled Inc. (FTI)** make the armchairs and the **teacher's table/chair sets**. This collaborative effort between FTI and SMFI has empowered persons with disabilities.

Also added innovations are new features in the school building to ensure wellness

of the school population: all fully furnished library hub, guidance and counselling room, and a clinic with an isolation room where pupils can be given first aid treatment or isolated at the onset of early symptoms of illness.

A handwashing facility with **10 faucets** was also constructed with storage of gardening tools of the pupils. The handwashing facility supports the UN SDG and DepEd WASH, school-based program that promotes correct hygiene and sanitation practices through hygiene and sanitation education and the provision of standards for safe water supply and appropriate sanitation facilities.

Punta Elementary School is one of the oldest schools in the municipality, having been established in June 1937. In its campus is 50-year old tree where pupils take advantage of its natural shade to read or study their lessons. To make them comfortable, the school building team of SM Foundation led by Ms. Juris Soliman developed the area into a study garden by putting four tables and eight benches made of hollow blocks.

The school building brings the total school buildings donated by SM Foundation to 101. Aside for Punta Elementary School, Basud Elementary School in Sorsogon City and Banisil National High School in general Santos will be recipients of SM school buildings this year.
