

#### KONSEPTO UPANG MABAWASAN ANG PANGANIB SA PANINIGARILYO SA HARM REDUCTION AND NICOTINE SUMMIT

SA pamamagitan ng pagpili at hindi pagpipigil, 18,000 Pilipino at patuloy na dumadami ang nananawagan para sa isang bansang walang usok.

Ang panawagan ay ginawa sa Harm Reduction & Nicotine Summit na may temang: "Pagtataguyod ng Maayos na Talakayan tungkol sa Pagbabawas ng pinsala mula sa Tabako" na ginanap kamakailan sa EDSA Shangri-La.

Ang kaganapan ay inorganisa ng pitong tagapag-ayos kabilang ang Nicotine Consumers Union of the Philippines (NCIP), SINAG, at iba pa.

Kinilala ni Anton Israel sa NCUP mga tagapag-ayos, ang kanilang adbokasiya, at mga naabot na tagumpay. Binanggit ni Israel na 170,000 Pilipino ang nasasawi bawat taon paninigarilyo, dahil sa nawawalan ng pagkakataong kumita, at naaapektuhan ang buhay

ng milyun-milyong iba pa. Binanggit niya ang matagumpay na gawi ng paninigarilyo sa Sweden at vaping sa ibang mga bansa. "Hindi nagsisinungaling ang mga numero kaya narito tayo upang ibalik ang Agham," sabi ni Israel.

Ipinakita ni Dr. Rogelio "Jong" F. Varela, Jr., Tagapangulo ng Kagawaran ng Surgery ng Healthway Qualmed Hospital, ang konsepto ng pagbawas ng panganib.

Si Dr. Varela ay may diabetes ngunit uminom siya ng Coke at kalaunan ay umiinom din ng iba pang soda, kaya nang muling uminom siya ng Coke, hindi na ito tulad ng dati ang lasa.

Binigyang-diin niya na nang sabihin niya sa kanyang mga pasyente na ang paninigarilyo ay nagdudulot ng kawalan ng kakayahang magkaanak at problema sa pagtayo ng ari, nagsimulang maging interesado ang mga ito. "Kailangan nating ituro sa kanila na ito ay nagdudulot ng kawalan ng kakayahang magkaanak at problema sa pagtayo ng ari," sabi ni Dr.

Naabot ng Sweden ang mas mababa sa 5% o

4.5% na pang-araw-araw na paninigarilyo, na siyang kahulugan ng panitikan ng Europa ng walang usok.

Pagsapit ng 2025, magiging walang usok ang Sweden dahil sa 4.5% na pang-araw-araw na paninigarilyo.

Ang laganap ng paninigarilyo sa Pilipinas ay ganoon na mayroong 14 na milyong naninigarilyo. Sinabi ni Dr. Varela.

Sinabi ni Dr. Varela, "Kailangan nating maging walang tabako at tumigil sa paninigarilyo. Kung makita nating naninigarilyo ang mga pasyente, sabihan sila na huminto sa paninigarilyo kung hindi natin sila matuturuan."

"Naabot na natin ang rurok ng patakaran. Kailangan nating makipag-ugnayan sa mga tao at turuan sila. Talaga namang kailangan nating palawakin ang mga pagsisikap upang matulungan ang mga pasyenteng ito," dagdag pa niya.

Sinabi ni Dr. Rohan Andrade de Sequeira, cardio-endocrinologist at Tagapagtatag ng Society of Medical Harm Reduced Advocates (SOMHRA), na sa India, mayroong 1.35 milyong pagkamatay bawat taon, at 267 milyong kabuuang gumagamit ng tabako para sa isang bansa na may populasyon na 1.4 bilyon.

Idinagdag ni Dr. Sequeira na 8.5% ng kabataan ay gumagamit ng oral na tabako. Binanggit niya na 38% ng mga pagkamatay ay sanhi ng sakit sa puso tulad ng Ischaemic heart disease, stroke, at cerebrovascular disease.

"Noong 2023, may 168,000 bagong kaso ng kanser sa bibig kada taon," sabi ni Dr. Sequeira. "Sa tingin ko, nangunguna na ang Pilipinas sa pagbabawas ng panganib," dagdag pa niya.

Binigyang-diin ni Sequeira na ang nicotine mismo ay hindi sanhi ng kanser. Malinaw ang Ang agham: nicotine hindi carcinogen. "Dapat maituwid impormasyon maling na ang paninigarilyo ay nagdudulot ng kanser. Ang mga byproducts nito ang nagdudulot ng kanser," sabi ni Dr. Sequeira.

Ang mga suspek ay kinilala sa mga alyas na Boss, Christian; kapwa residente ng Parañaque City; at Emmanuel, naninirahan sa Bacoor City.

Ang matagumpay na buy-bust operation ay isinagawa dakong ala-1:30 ng madaling araw sa Bacoor City nitong Oktubre

Pinangunahan ng mga operatiba ng Drug Enforcement Unit ng Bacoor City Component Police Station ang operasyon sa pakikipagugnayan sa PDEA na isang police poseur buyer ang matagumpay na nakabili ng iligal na droga mula sa mga suspek.

Nasamsam mula sa pagiingat ng mga suspek ang isang unit white Toyota Hilux; isang piraso ng P1,000 (buy-bust bill money); isang knot-tied transparent plastic bag na naglalaman ng puting kristal na pinaniniwalaang shabu; at anim na heatsealed transparent plastic sachet na naglalaman ng pinaniniwalaang shabu na may tinatayang kabuuang timbang na 105 gramo at may standard drug price value na P714,000.00.

HULI ang dalawang High Value Individual matapos ang matagumpay na buy-bust operation na isinagawa ng kapulisan kamakailan sa Dasmariñas City, Cavite,

Ang dalawang suspek, na sina alyas Bi at Ge, kapwa residente ng Dasmariñas City, ay naaresto dakong alas-6:00 ng gabi nitong Oktubre 13.

Isinagawa ang operasyon ng magkasanib puwersa ng Provincial Drug Enforcement Unit ng Cavite Police Provincial Office, Dasmariñas City Component Police Station at Regional Police Drug Enforcement Unit 4A, na may koordinasyon sa

PDEA.

Sa nasabing operasyon ay nakumpiska ang tatlong piraso ng heat-sealed transparent plastic sachet na naglalaman ng puting kristal na pinaniniwalaang shabu na may tinatayang kabuuang timbang na humigit-kumulang gramo, at may standard drug price value P680,000.00; isang piraso ng P500 bill (buy-bust money); at isang unit ng android cellphone.

Ang operasyon ay isinagawa gamit ang Alternative Recording Device na nasaksihan ng isang media representative at isang halal na opisyal ng barangay.

**TIMBOG** ng isang City Level Most Wanted Person sa operasyong isinagawa ng pulisya kamakailan sa Bacoor City, Cavite.

Ang akusado na si alyas residente Cobra. Bacoor City, ay naaresto alas-4:15 dakong hapon nitong Oktubre 14. Gamit ang Alternative Recording Device isinagawa ang operasyon ng mga tauhan ng Warrant Section Bacoor ng Component City Police Station.

Ang pagkakaaresto ay sa bisa ng warrant of arrest na inilabas ng RTC Branch 201, Las Piñas City, nitong Oktubre 6, na may inirekomendang piyansa na P300,000.00.

Ito ay para sa kasong paglabag sa Section 3 ng Republic Act 10883 (Anti-Carnapping Act of 2016).

### Legarda – Indigenous Peoples, nagsisilbing haligi ng bansa

selebrasyon ng Indigenous Month Peoples ngayong ipinagdiwang Oktubre, Senadora ni Loren Legarda ang malaking ambag ng Indigenous ambag ng Indigenous Peoples (IPs) sa kultura, pagkakakilanlan, tradisyon ng bansa, pati na rin sa tuluy-tuloy na kaunlaran.

"Buhay na ang natatanging kultura at kaugalian bago pa man dumating ang mga mananakop. Hindi lamang ito karangalan, ito'y kayamanang sandigan ng bansa," giit ni Legarda.

"Matagal na nating kinilala ang mga katutubo bilang pundasyon ng bansa. Sila ang naglatag ng maraming kaalaman at tradisyong tinatamasa natin hanggang ngayon," dagdag pa niya.

Bilang pangunahing mayakda ng batas na nagtatag ng National Indigenous Peoples Day tuwing Agosto 9, sinabi ni Legarda na patuloy na hinaharap ng mga katutubo ang samu't saring suliranin.

Kabilang dito ang mga isyu sa ancestral domain, matitinding bagyong dala ng climate change, at unti-unting pagkawala ng tradisyon dahil sa globalisasyon.

Giniit ng four-term senator na hindi ganap na mabubuo ang isang bansa kung hindi kikilalanin at pag-aaralan ang kanilang mga tradisyon, at kung hindi pangangalagaan ang kanilang kabuhayan at kalusugan.

"Maraming kaalaman ang hatid sa atin ng Indigenous Peoples laban sa climate change, sa food security, at sa pangangalaga ng kalikasan dahil matagal na nilang napatunayang mabisa ang mga tradisyong ito," ani Legarda.

Bukod pa rito, itinampok din ang karunungan ng iba't ibang IP sa documentary series na "Dayaw," na ideya ni Legarda. Siya rin ang host ng naturang programa.

## Imbestigasyon ng mga ghost projects, ng ICI bigyan prayoridad ang Ilocos Norte

Sinabi ng negosyante at dating Gobernador ng Ilocos Sur na si "Chavit" Singson Luis na dapat iisa lamang salita ng lahat, binanggit na naguguluhan na ang mga tao ngayon.

ngayon, "Sa hirap tayong umunlad kung ganito ang paraan pamahalaan sa pamamahala na ililihis lamang nila ang isyu," sabi ni Singson.

"Marami ang nagsasabi (proyektong ito kontrol sa baha na multo) pinakamalaking ang scam na nangyari sa bansa," dagdag niya.

"Para maniwala ang mga tao kay Pangulong Marcos, dapat niyang unahin ang kanyang lalawigan. Kung malinis siya, tulungan natin siya," sabi ni Singson.

"Bigyang prayoridad ang kanyang lalawigan. Magkalapit lang ang aming mga lalawigan. Tapat kami sa Ilocos Sur," dagdag pa niya.

"Sinasabi ko sa ICI, prayoridad bigyang ang Ilocos Norte. Sa Senado, tinakpan nila ito at nang lumitaw ang Ilocos Norte, huminto sila sa imbestigasyon," sabi ni Singson.

"Ibig sabihin, maraming isyu ang kailangang tugunan ngunit nailihis ito mula sa tunay na isyu," dagdag niya. "Bakit kailangan nating lumipat sa ibang proyekto mula sa kontrol ng baha patungo sa kalsadang pang-agrikultura," sabi ni Singson.

"Mabilis makalimot ang mga Pilipino. Guinness Sa Book of Records, tinaguriang pinakamasamang Pangulo ang kanilang ama," dagdag niya.

Chavit Singson lamang ang nagsabi na walang sinuman ang makakatalo kay Inday Sara sa pagkapangulo. "Noon, ang araw ko ay puro pera - pera ang lahat. 5,500 na mga munisipalidad, halos lahat nag-usap ay tungkol sa kanilang mga sariling problema," sabi ni Singson.

Matagal na niyang hinihintay hanggang sa naging "Antay Marcos" siya. "Parang kami ang naloko. Paano nagawa Sara Discaya na makalikom ng P31 bilyon para sa mga proyekto sa kontrol ng baha. At ngayon ako

ng katiwalian," sabi ni Singson.

"Paano nagawang makapasok ng mga Discayas sa Ilocos Norte gamit ang 38 proyekto. Ipakita ang kanilang mga proyekto doon. Ang nangyari ay 'mga taktika ng paglilihis'. Wala nang mga proyekto para sa kontrol ng baha," dagdag pa niya.

Setyembre 21, sinabi ni Singson na wala namang mangyayari sa mga rally dahil may sariling agenda sila. "Tawirin natin ang mga linya ng partido. Walang Duterte. Walang Dilaw. Walang pampulitikang kulay," sabi ni Singson. Binigyang-diin niya, "Dapat magkaisa ang mga Pilipino, lalo na ang kabataan, upang sa tuwing magkakaroon ng rally, isa lamang iyon, ngunit ang kabataan ang dapat magpasya, sigurado akong maraming susuporta sa inyo."

Sinabi ni Singson na Setvembre ang 21 ay magulo dahil ang bawat isa ay para sa sarili. Namahagi siya ng pagkain sa panig ng Corinthian ng EDSA

na ang inaakusahan noong rally at maayos naman ang lahat, ngunit ang nang dumating hapon, inamin ng mga taong naka-maskara na binayaran sila ni Martin Romualdez upang sumali sa rally.

Narda Dellova, 38, an Iraya Mangyan and CARD client from Puerto Galera, proudly showcases her handcrafted Mangyan woven products. Each piece is a reflection of her culture, creativity, and resilience.

In the peaceful mountains of Talipan, Aninuan in Puerto Galera, Narda Dellova works with steady hands. At 38, her fingers move with the grace of decades of tradition, artistry, and purpose. Each weave reflects the life she has built, the challenges she has overcome, and the dreams she continues to chase

Narda's story begins far from the bustling towns and busy streets. She is a proud member of the Iraya Mangyan, one of the eight Mangyan ethnolinguistic groups native to Mindoro Island. They are skilled traditional crafts. particularly basket weaving using nito vines and buri palm leaves. Their weaves, rich in symbolism and beauty, are more than just objects; they are cultural expressions passed down through generations.

Born into a humble family where farming is their way

of living, Narda spent her early years surrounded by rows of rice paddies, vegetables, and the simplicity of mountain life. "We grew what we needed. My parents worked the land, and we sold what we could in our community," she shares.

But when the time came for her family to leave the highlands and settle closer to the town, something new was planted in Narda's heart—a seed of creativity nurtured by her mother's hands.

"My mother began weaving baskets made from buri palm and nito vines. At the age of 10, she learned the craft with natural ease, absorbing not just the technique, but the heritage embedded in each loop and knot," Narda recalled

Despite her passion for learning, financial hardships forced Narda to put her dreams of formal education on hold. Instead, she devoted herself to weaving and helping her parents to support the family's needs. Now. Narda has her own

support the family's needs. Now, Narda has her own family, with a husband who works as a construction worker and a daughter studying at Mangyan



Elementary School. She stands at the heart of her family's livelihood, weaving not just baskets, but a better future.

Each of Narda's handmade creations made with nito vines and buri palm leaves, such as flowerpot holders, fruit trays, jewelry boxes, coasters, organizers, earrings, and more, tells a story. The materials, gathered from the mountains or collected with help from neighbors, are transformed over days, weeks, and even months into intricate pieces of functional art. "Every item is a piece of my effort, my culture, my hope," she said. But her journey took a transformative turn in 2013, when CARD staff visited her community. Introduced

to the products and services of CARD Bank, a microfinance-oriented rural bank, Narda saw an opportunity she couldn't pass up. With a starting loan of PHP 4,000 and eventually growing up to PHP 32,000, she was able to invest in her weaving and meet her family's needs.

"Being a client of CARD Bank has helped me in many ways, especially when we had nothing and I needed capital to continue my work," she shares.

Her involvement didn't end with financial support. Through CARD MRI Hijos Tours, a tour company under CARD MRI, Narda became a part of the Home Stay Tour program launched in June 2025 in Puerto Galera. Her crafts, along with the works of fellow Iraya Mangyan weavers, now take center stage at Bahay Tabudan, a traditional weaving house at the Mangyan Village in Aninuan, Puerto Galera. Here, the participants and visitors not only buy crafts. They can also witness the magic of weaving through live demonstrations.

"I'm happy to teach others about our craft. Through Hijos Tours, more people now understand and appreciate our culture and skills," she says.

As she weaves, her eyes are set on the future, particularly on her daughter, who is now the same age she was when she first learned the craft. "I told her that, aside from education, weaving is a gift I want to pass on. I have started teaching her already," Narda smiles.

She hopes that one day, their Mangyan-made products will reach a broader market, touching hearts beyond their island home. And with every fiber, every weave, every story shared, Narda Dellova proves that no dream is too far when it is stitched with passion, purpose, and pride.
