This is part of its continuing engagement with provincial and local leaders to strengthen science- and technology-driven agriculture in North Cotabato.

The discussion highlighted how Project SARAI—Smarter Approaches to Reinvigorate Agriculture as an Industry in the Philippines—can support evidence-based planning and policy formulation for the province's agricultural sector. Groups to pioneer climate-sustainable energy systems as just transition value chain

La Carlota City, Philippines

— The Hacienda Esperanza Communal Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries Association (HECARBA), Alter Trade Foundation Inc. (ATFI), and Philippine Movement for Climate Justice (PMCJ) entered into an agreement on Jan. 16, 2026, to work together to operationalize a distributive renewable energy (RE) microsystems in their community in La Carlota City, Negros Occidental. The system is envisioned as a value chain to build a climate-resilient local economy.

"If we want a climate-resilient economy in the future, we must pursue a just transition to clean renewables. The rapid scaling up of renewable energy must redound to sustainable, resilient economic development. To get into this tract, value chains on clean, renewable, and sustainable local production and economy are very important drivers. This is happening now in Negros Occidental. The transition is not just to RE, but also to a society that protects and sustains both people and the planet," said Ian Rivera, PMCJ national coordinator.

The Distributive RE Microsystems towards Community Empowerment through Resiliency Building Sustainable Production and Area Development Enterprise (DREM2CERSPADE) program will be realized and coursed through HECARBA farmers' muscovado plant production. PMCJ and ATFI will help farmers secure funding and acquire the necessary technology for the project.

"Through a solar photovoltaic (PV) setup, HECARBA farmers will develop a democratically-owned, operated, and managed distributive RE microsystems in their muscovado plant. This off-grid system will be integrated into the community's muscovado production, which has already been successful for decades in increasing the community's incomes. However, livelihoods and incomes have been severely affected at the onset of the climate crisis. In our collective study, integrating clean energy and sustainable

DOST Continues 2025 NSTW Momentum with MAGHANDA for Kids Program in Region I

Continuing the momentum of the 2025 National Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (NSTW) held in Laoag City, the Department of Science and Technology—Ilocos Region (DOST-Ilocos), in partnership with the Department of Education Region I, brought the MAGHANDA for Kids program to the 3rd Mangidaulo

Rehiyon Uno: Regional Learners' Convergence in Bolinao, Pangasinan. The program aimed to strengthen disaster risk reduction (DRR) awareness among young learners through age-appropriate, science-based discussions and hands-on activities.

During the morning sessions, experts from DOST-PAGASA engaged students in interactive lectures and workshops. Ms. Sharon Juliet M. Arruejo, Assistant Weather Specialist, led the session "Understanding Clouds: The Science Behind Fluffy Skies," guiding learners through cloud formation and hands-on experiments that demonstrated how clouds are formed. She also facilitated "Storm Chaser 101: Unraveling the Secrets of Tropical Cyclones," where students practiced basic typhoon tracking and learned how meteorologists monitor tropical storms.

Meanwhile, Engr. Richard C. Orendain, Weather Facilities Specialist III, conducted engaging lecture-workshops on flood dynamics and the water cycle. These included practical activities such as river transect walks, which illustrated how rainfall and river systems contribute to flooding. The exercises allowed students to apply scientific principles to real-world scenarios, deepening their understanding of hydrometeorological hazards. Through these discussions and hands-on activities, student learners from Region I gained practical knowledge on disaster preparedness, climate science, and weather monitoring—equipping them with essential skills to better respond to natural hazards in their communities. **(Lemuel Castigo)**

PMCJ and ATFI, with HECARBA, want to promote the project as a community-based RE and just transition model for grassroots resilience, to be replicated in many vulnerable rural communities across the country.

"We have started a partnership with local governments through a subnational strategy in shifting energy systems to clean renewables, and we are being confronted with the situation that there are thousands of marginalized communities in the Philippines, such as in the Bicol region, which are in the same situation as that in Negros Occidental. In partnership with these LGUs, we can hasten the transition of these communities. We are grateful to HECARBA for serving as the pilot area for popularizing this just transition program in the Negros Island region. We can't wait to see this unfold," said Rivera.

FFCCCII: REVISED ECONOMIC TARGETS MUST SPUR URGENT REFORMS

Manila, Philippines – The Federation of Filipino-Chinese Chambers of Commerce and Industry, Inc. (FFCCCII) called today for urgent national reforms following the government's recent revision of economic growth targets for 2026–2028.

The government now projects 5–6% growth in 2026, rising to 6–7% by 2028, citing the lingering impact of the DPWH flood-control corruption scandal and global trade uncertainties. FFCCCII warned that these figures must not limit the nation's ambition.

“To truly transform lives, the Philippines must aim for 8% growth or more,” said [Spokesperson Name], FFCCCII. “Ambition is not optional—it is necessary for meaningful job creation, poverty reduction, and inclusive prosperity.”

While supporting the government's focus on health, education, and employment, FFCCCII stressed that inclusivity can only emerge from a strong, fast-growing economy. Growth that benefits only a few, they noted, is growth betrayed.

The organization pointed to Vietnam, which achieved 8% growth in 2025 and targets 10% in 2026, as proof that disciplined governance, investor confidence, and strategic reforms yield measurable results.

FFCCCII outlined key pillars for accelerating Philippine growth:

- **Human Capital Development:** Outcome-focused spending on education and public health to build a skilled workforce.
- **Anti-Corruption Measures:** Establish an independent, well-resourced agency to restore confidence.
- **Industrial & Agricultural Growth:** Support domestic production, reduce smuggling, and tackle unfair competition.
- **Economics-First Diplomacy:** Pursue foreign policies that open markets for Philippine goods and services.

- **Infrastructure & Innovation:** Accelerate infrastructure while investing in digital transformation, R&D, and green technology.
- **Tourism & Creative Economy:** Promote the Philippines globally, creating jobs and showcasing national assets.

FFCCCII emphasized that favorable macroeconomic conditions, including lower inflation and prospective interest-rate cuts, should serve as a launchpad for acceleration, not comfort.

“The revised targets reflect current momentum, but momentum can be changed,” FFCCCII said. “This is the decade to choose ambition over accommodation, reform over resignation, and action over excuses.”

CvSU develops e-governance system for barangays

SILANG, Cavite (PIA) — Students at the Cavite State University (CvSU) in Silang have developed a digital platform to modernize barangay services and enhance the efficiency of grassroots governance.

Developed as a thesis by Dave Espiritu, Neejay Lazaro, Arianne Jose, Kenneth Naquila, Luvrickx Kelley Lanzona, Ruel Panti, and Ruel Vincent dela Peña of the CvSU Silang's College of Information Technology, the One Bayani, One System was designed to digitize barangay records management systems, improving services and governance.

Cereneo Santiago, thesis adviser and Project Leader of the OneSys Extension Project, emphasized that OneSys was built to modernize barangay recordkeeping to ensure that local services are more responsive to community needs.

“Yung real-time access sa mga data, mas mabilis ‘yung pag-issue ng certificates, at mas organized ‘yung blotter and permit tracking. Mayroon

rin itong built-it analytics para sa planning, and reporting.”

By integrating resident profiling, certificate issuance, and blotter management into a real-time database, the One Bayani, One System can help barangays transition to digitized and data-driven governance.

“Yung records ay standardized at nao-audit, at nakakapag-generate agad ang mga barangay ng reports na nasesent nila sa DILG [Department of the Interior and Local Government].”

Slated for adoption across all barangays in Silang, the three-year project began in 2025 with a goal of streamlining government services.

According to Santiago, the local government and barangay leaders have shown strong support for the project.

“[By] 2028 ay dapat ginagamit na ng lahat ng barangay. Actually ngayong 2026 ay maa-achieve na namin yun. Yung ibang barangay kasi ay nagrequest na. In 2026, start na namin yung cluster 2 with 16

barangays.”

Once fully implemented in Silang, the One Bayani, One System for possible adoption in the entire

Binigyang-diin din ng pinuno ng PSC ang kahalagahan ng pakikipagtulungan sa mga State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) na may malalawak na bakanteng lupa, tulad ng UP Mindanao, UP Diliman, at UP Los Baños.

Nagsimula ang konstruksyon ng mga pasilidad pampalakasan sa UP Mindanao nang maging host ang Davao ng 2019 Palarong Pambansa ngunit hindi pa ito natatapos, samantalang ang swimming pool sa loob ng UP Diliman campus ay nananatiling hindi tapos sa halos isang dekada.

"Palaguin at tapusin natin ang

mga pasilidad na ito. Bilang isang tagapagpasimula, ang PSC ay malapit na makikipagtulungan sa mga LGU habang nakikipag-collaborate sa mga SUC upang mapakinabangan at magamit ang kanilang mga hindi nagagamit na lupa na may layuning tuklasin at paunlarin ang talento," sabi ni Gregorio.

Itinuro ni Gregorio na ang pangako ng mga pambansang samahang pampalakasan na magtatag ng kani-kanilang mga sentrong pagsasanay sa mga lalawigan kung saan karaniwang kinukuha ang kanilang mga atleta ay mahalaga sa mga pagsisikap sa rehabilitasyon at renobasyon.

"Kasinghalaga rin ang pagtatatag ng mga pangmatagalan at maayos na pinamamahalaang sentro ng pagsasanay para sa mga atleta sa mga lalawigan.

Ang pagrerebisa sa tennis center ay malapit nang matapos kasabay ng Philippine Women's Open WTA 125 na nakatakda mula Enero 26 hanggang 31.
