## DOST Strengthens Regional Startup Ecosystem Through the Rollout of iHubs Across SOCCSKSARGEN

## Sun Drying Innovation Gains Ground at 2026 National Summit

The 2026 National Sun Drying Tray Summit and Presentation of Accomplishments gathered science leaders, regional implementers, and technology partners from February 24 to 26 at La Breza Hotel in Quezon City. The three day event brought together representatives from all regional offices of the Department of Science and Technology, the National Research Council of the Philippines (DOST-NRCP), and the Office of the Undersecretary for Regional Operations (OUSECRO). Hosted by the DOST Regional Office II in Cagayan Valley, the summit underscored strong interregional collaboration in advancing postharvest technologies for Filipino farmers and fisherfolk. At the center of discussions was PORTASOL, short for Portable Solar Dryer, developed by Mr. Francisco Popoy Pagayon. Originally designed for drying palay, the technology has evolved with the support of DOST to accommodate nearly all types of farm produce,

including corn, coffee beans, cacao, fish, and high value crops. According to Mr. Pagayon, what began as a solution for rice farmers has expanded into a versatile system that responds to the varied drying needs of agricultural and fishery communities.

PORTASOL offers a hygienic and enclosed drying facility powered by renewable solar energy. Unlike traditional open sun drying methods that expose produce to dust, animals, sudden rain, and uneven heat, the system provides controlled airflow and protection from contaminants. This results in better product quality, improved food safety, and reduced postharvest losses. Its portable design also allows farmers and fisherfolk to deploy the unit in different locations, making it adaptable to community based operations and small scale enterprises.

The first two days of the summit were dedicated to regional accomplishment reports, deployment updates, and sustainability plans. Regional offices presented data on the number of units distributed, beneficiary profiles, training activities conducted, and income improvements observed in pilot communities. Discussions also tackled operational challenges such as maintenance concerns, site selection, weather variability, and strategies for strengthening local ownership. Mr. Pagayon actively engaged with participants to address technical issues and gather feedback for further refinement of the technology. On the final day, participants conducted a project visit within the National Capital Region to observe PORTASOL in actual operation and to engage directly with beneficiaries. Farmers and processors shared testimonies on how the technology improved drying time, reduced spoilage, and enabled them to command better prices in the market due to higher quality produce.

## DILG, PCW Move to Strengthen Bawal Bastos Law vs Digital Sexual Harassment

The Department of the Interior and Local Government, together with the Philippine Commission on Women, is pushing for amendments to Republic Act No. 11313 or the Safe Spaces Act, also known as the Bawal Bastos Law, to close existing gaps and strengthen protection against emerging forms of gender-based sexual harassment, particularly those facilitated by technology. During the DILG Kapihan on Friday, PCW emphasized that abuse is evolving, with many cases now occurring through digital platforms. These realities, the Commission said, require clearer and more comprehensive legal provisions. The proposed amendments aim to explicitly address technology-facilitated gender-based violence and expand coverage to groups not clearly protected under the current law, including student interns and trainees.

## Malacañang urges end to objectification of women, calls for respect and dignity in public discourse

Marking Women's Month, Malacañang on Wednesday called for an end to the culture of objectifying women, stressing that women deserve respect and dignity, not to be reduced to subjects of vulgar remarks or sexualized fantasies disguised as compliments. In a Palace press briefing, Presidential Communications Office and Palace Press Officer Claire Castro emphasized that women should be guided, uplifted, and honored— never treated as objects of public display or crude imagination that some even expect them to be grateful for. "Hindi kami babae lang

— babae kami... This is empowering women to empower all women," Castro said.

During a proceeding in the House of Representatives on March 3, a lawmaker made remarks referencing an actress and claimed he could not be held liable for thoughts he formed in his imagination about her. In response to the incident, Castro underscored the administration's position on upholding respect and dignity for women, particularly in public discourse.

"Kababaihan, hindi dapat ginagawang paksa ng bastos na pananalita. Let us end the culture of objectifying women. Ang kababaihan ay ginagabayan, inaangat, ginagalang at hindi ginagawang paksa ng malaswang pagpapantasya na ipagmamalaki pa sa publiko," the Palace Press Officer noted.

Castro, a lawyer, decried the persistent mindset that normalizes verbal harassment and sexual objectification, warning that such attitudes continue to undermine efforts to build a culture of respect and equality. "Na dapat pa raw na ituring na compliment kapag ginawan ng kalaswaan sa

enactment of RA 11313 on April 17, 2019.

The DILG stressed that strengthening the Safe Spaces Act is part of the government's broader commitment to gender equality and inclusive governance. By updating the law to reflect current realities, the government aims to ensure that protection against sexual harassment remains effective, enforceable, and accessible in every space, whether physical or digital. **(DILG)**

organization dedicated to restoring historical markers and monuments in Manila City, the cleaning and restoration activity included key historical items such as the 1872 Cavite Mutiny marker, Capital Marker, and the Ermita de Porta Vaga Façade and Marker. In a statement, the city government noted that the project will prioritize the restoration of the Ermita de Porta Vaga replica monument and its marker. "Recognizing our city's historical value as a cradle of revolutionary heroes and martyrs, they vowed to help the City Government in restoring these markers and monuments to their former glory."

The Ermita de Porta Vaga has been repeatedly defaced and vandalized over the past year, which captured the attention of civil society organizations. **(PB-PIA CALABARZON, City Government of Cavite)**

## PBBM orders agencies to guard against abusive price hikes on commodities

President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. has ordered concerned agencies to prevent price gouging on commodities, including oil and other basic goods, amid the conflict in the Middle East. In a Palace press briefing, Presidential Communications Office (PCO) Undersecretary and Palace Press Officer Claire Castro said the government is implementing appropriate safeguards to ensure that no abuses are committed by private companies or businessmen selling products. "Hindi pa po 'yan napapanahon," Castro said when asked about the oil price increase due to the ongoing conflict in the Middle East. "Nakita po natin na binanggit din po mismo


