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PANGANGALAP NG LANGUAGE PROFILE SA WORDLIST SA WIKANG ATTA

Isinagawa ng Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino (KWF) ang pangangalap ng language profile at wordlist sa wikang Atta sa bayan ng Pudtol, lalawigan ng Apayao nitóng 9–10 Hunyo 2026 sa Barangay Cabatacan, Pudtol, Apayao bilang bahagi ng proyektong Balidasyon ng mga Wika ng Pilipinas.

Pinangunahan nina Bb. Dannielle T. Laggui at Bb. Rona Geneva P. Alcantara, mga mananaliksik ng KWF, ang pangangalap ng datos. Naging posible ang gawaing ito sa suporta ng Pamahalaang Bayan ng Pudtol sa pangunguna ni Punong-bayan Edmar D. Pascua, JD, katuwang ang mga kawani ng Pambansang Komisyon sa mga Katutubong Mamamayan (NCIP), Luna Community Service Center, at ang komunidad ng mga Atta.

Layunin ng pangangalap na makabuo ng mas komprehensibong talâ ng kalagayan ng wikang Atta, kabílang ang mahahalagang impormasyong pangwika na magsisilbing batayan sa mga susunod na hakbang para sa dokumentasyon, pananaliksik, at pangangalaga sa wika. Kinikilala ang wikang Atta bilang isa sa pitóng (7) malubhang nanganganib na wika sa Pilipinas.

Batay sa datos ng Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) noong 2020 na sinuri ng KWF, tinatayang nása 97 sambahayan na lámang sa bayan ng Pudtol at Luna sa lalawigan ng Apayao at bayan ng Gattaran sa Cagayan ang gumagamit nitó bilang pangunahing wika sa tahanan.

Ayon sa United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO 2023), nanganganib ang isang wika kapag unti-unti na itong hindi ginagamit ng mga nagsasalita nitó, nagiging limitado ang paggamit nitó sa iba't ibang larang ng komunikasyon, at hindi na ito naipapása ng nakatatandang henerasyon sa mga nakababatang

henerasyon. Maaari din itong impluwensiya ng mga panlabas na puwersang pangkultura, pang-ekonomiya, panrelihiyon, o pang-edukasyon. Bukod dito, nakaaapekto rin ang negatibong pananaw ng isang indibidwal o komunidad sa paggamit ng kanilang sariling wika. Sa pamamagitan ng patúloy na dokumentasyon at balidasyon ng mga nanganganib na wika, pinalalakas ng KWF ang mga hakbang para sa pangangalaga, pagpapasigla, at pagpapatúloy ng mayamang pamana ng mga katutubong wika sa bansa para sa susunod na mga salinlahi.

Camp BGen Vicente P. Lim-- Arestado ang isang Regional Most Wanted Person na kinilalang si alias "Aries" sa isinagawang manhunt operations ng mga operatiba ng Warrant Section, Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT), at Intelligence Unit ng Bacoor Component City Police Station (CCPS) matapos mauwi sa isang armed encounter ang pagpapatupad ng warrant operation sa Brgy. Zapote 1, Bacoor City, Cavite, bandang 6:45 PM noong Hulyo 19, 2026.

Matagumpay na naresto ang suspek na imbes na payapang sumuko dahil sa bisa ng Warrant of Arrest ng Regional Trial Court,

Branch 114, Bacoor City, kaugnay ng paglabag sa Sections 5 at 11, Article II ng Republic Act No. 9165 o Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 ay nakipagputukan pa umano ng suspek laban sa mga operatiba. Tinamaan ng bala sa kanang binti ang suspek at agad na dinala sa Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital upang mabigyan ng kaukulang medikal na atensyon.

Narekober sa lugar ang isang caliber .38 revolver at isang 9mm fired cartridge case. Inihahanda na rin ang karagdagang mga kasong Attempted Murder, paglabag sa Republic Act No. 10591 (Comprehensive Firearms and Ammunition Regulation Act), at Article 151 ng Revised Penal Code laban sa suspek.

Binigyang-diin ni Acting Regional Director PBGen Dominic L Baccay, ang matibay na kampanya ng Police Regional Office 4A laban sa mga wanted persons at iba pang lumalabag sa batas, kasabay ng pagpapatibay ng kaligtasan at kaayusan sa buong rehiyon alinsunod sa pinaigting na Enhanced Managing Police Operation (EMPO) sa focus agenda ni Chief, PNP PGen Jose Melencio C. Nartataes Jr.

Samantala, ang suspek ay kasalukuyang nasa ilalim ng hospital arrest habang nagpapagalang. Matapos mabigyan ng medical clearance, sasailalim siya sa inquest proceedings para sa mga karagdagang kasong isasampa laban sa kanya ng Bacoor CCPS. **(RPIO 4A)**

Kung dapat ay maging responsable sa partisipasyon sa halalan ay higit na kailangang maging matalino sa pipiliing kandidato.

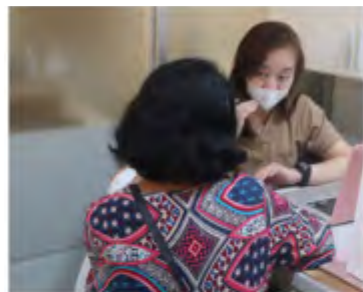
Masusubok sa eleksiyong ito kung mananatiling mananaig ang tanyag.

Reinforcing its commitment to preventive healthcare, the Provincial Government of Cavite (PGC) joined the celebration of Hypertension Awareness Month through the #BeSurePresyonAyCheck campaign by conducting a Medical and Dental Mission at the Carmona Community Center on July 14, 2026, bringing essential healthcare services closer to residents.

PSA IV-A Strengthens Customer Access with CRS Mobile Outlet in Talisay, Batangas

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA IV-A) continues to strengthen its commitment to delivering accessible and citizen-centered public service through the successful conduct of its Civil Registration System (CRS) Mobile Outlet in the Municipality of Talisay, Batangas held on June 15, 2026.

The mobile outlet was organized to provide residents with convenient access to essential civil registration services without the need to travel to the nearest PSA outlet. The activity significantly reduced travel time and transportation expenses for residents while ensuring fast, reliable, and efficient delivery of PSA services.

A total of 137 clients were served, with 233 document requests successfully processed during the activity.

In addition to the mobile outlet services, dissemination of information was also conducted and distribution of the Information, Education, and Communication (IEC)

materials on RA No. 9048 and RA No. 10172, RA No. 9255, National ID, and the requirements for legitimization, adoption, and annulment of marriage. IEC materials on Gender and Development (GAD) principles were also disseminated.

The successful implementation of the CRS Mobile Outlet was made possible through the support and collaboration of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Talisay and the Local Civil Registrar's Office.

SP holds public hearing on proposed ordinance strengthening anti-hazing measure in Cavite

In a move to reinforce the Province of Cavite's commitment to protecting students and promoting safe educational environments, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan conducted a public hearing on Proposed Ordinance No. 092-2026, which seeks to strengthen the implementation of Republic Act No. 11053 or the Anti-Hazing Act of 2018, on July 21, 2026, at the Conference Room of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

Authored by 4th District Board Member Nickanor N. Austria, Jr. and co-authored by 1st District Board Member Juan Ysmael R. Gandia and 2nd District Board Member Alde-Joselito F. Pagulayan, the proposed ordinance aims to establish stronger preventive measures, monitoring mechanisms, and local coordination among educational institutions, local government units, and covered organizations to curb hazing incidents in the province.

The public hearing was presided over by BM Alde-Joselito F. Pagulayan, who underscored the significance of the initiative in strengthening youth protection and public safety.

"This is the first step in the right direction," BM Pagulayan said, emphasizing the importance of collaboration among government agencies, educational institutions, and organizations in preventing hazing and protecting the welfare of students.

One of the highlights of the hearing was the presentation by the Cavite Provincial Investigation and Effective Management Unit of the Philippine National Police (PNP) Cavite, which provided participants with data and updates on fraternity-related incidents in the province. The discussion of the proposed ordinance was facilitated by Provincial Board Secretary Michelle F. Alcidi, allowing stakeholders to share their insights and recommendations to further enhance the measure.

The public hearing was attended by representatives from the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)-Cavite, Department of Education (DepEd)-Cavite, Association of Private Schools in Cavite, State Universities and Colleges, Office of the Provincial Information Officer, Office of the Provincial Legal Officer, Sangguniang Panlungsod/Bayan Committees on Peace and Public Safety, youth representatives, and officers of covered organizations across the province.

The activity reflects the Provincial Government of Cavite's continuing efforts to strengthen local policies that promote safer communities, uphold the rule of law, and protect the rights and welfare of the youth through proactive governance and multi-sectoral collaboration. —

PRO4A Steps Up Crackdown on Oil Pilferage, Seizes P5.5M Worth of Petroleum Products

Camp BGen Vicente P. Lim, Laguna – Police Regional Office 4A intensified its campaign against economic crimes after operatives of the Batangas Police Provincial Office arrested a suspected oil pilferer and seized approximately ₱2.4 million worth of diesel fuel during an operation in Barangay Dominador East, Alitagtag, Batangas on July 20, 2026.

The operation, conducted by the Provincial Intelligence Unit in coordination with the Alitagtag Municipal Police Station, resulted in the arrest of a 48-year-old suspect and the confiscation of an Isuzu tanker truck loaded with 30,000 liters of diesel, two 20-liter containers filled with diesel, and a siphoning hose. The total value of the recovered evidence, including the tanker truck, was estimated at ₱5.5 million.

PBGEN Dominic L. Baccay, Acting Regional Director of PRO 4A, lauded the operating teams for the successful operation and reaffirmed the PNP's commitment to protecting legitimate

businesses and the public from economic crimes. "PRO CALABARZON will sustain intelligence-driven operations against oil pilferage and other forms of economic sabotage. We will ensure that those who exploit the petroleum industry and violate the law are brought to justice," PBGen Baccay said.

The suspect is now in the custody of the Batangas Police Provincial Office and is facing charges for Violation of Presidential Decree No. 1865 (Oil Anti-Pilferage Act of 1983). The operation supports the Chief, PNP's intensified anti-criminality campaign and aligns with PBGen Baccay's B.E.S.T. (Be Visible, Engage Immediately, Serve Together, Transform Trust) program, reinforcing PRO 4A's commitment to combating economic sabotage and safeguarding public welfare.

Meanwhile, from July 1 to present, PRO 4A confiscated a total of P5, 509, 375.00 for Violation of Presidential Decree 1865 or the Oil Pilferage Law. **(RPIO 4A)**

PTFOMS, CICC strengthen collaboration to protect journalists from cyber threats

The Presidential Task Force on Media Security (PTFOMS) and the Cybercrime Investigation and Coordinating Center (CICC) today signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to ensure the safety and security of journalists online. Undersecretary Jose Torres Jr., PTFOMS Executive Director, said the "strategic alliance aims to address and mitigate the growing cybercrime threats and harassment faced by media workers."

He noted that as digital platforms become essential tools for journalism, the risk to media practitioners from online harassment, threats, data privacy breaches, disinformation, and cybercrimes has heightened.

The MOA seeks to extend protection to journalists in the digital sphere, ensuring the exercise of their rights to free expression and information is preserved. The CICC, established under the Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012 (RA No. 10175), is mandated to enhance cybersecurity. Through the collaboration, PTFOMS and CICC will pool their resources, expertise, and legal frameworks to provide enhanced protection against cyberattacks targeting journalists.

Under the agreement, PTFOMS and CICC will work together to address and resolve cybercrime issues concerning media personnel. The CICC will render assistance on complaints reported by PTFOMS, ensuring expedient referrals to law enforcement and prosecutorial bodies. It will also supply digital forensic support, cyber intelligence, and technical resources to streamline investigations and ensure accountability and effective prosecution of offenders.

The collaboration will also see CICC sharing its cybersecurity expertise with PTFOMS to bolster its operational capacity in monitoring investigations. The partnership includes coordinating with local government units, media organizations, civil society, and other stakeholders to strengthen digital security measures for media workers.

Undersecretary Torres said these efforts underscore the government's commitment to defending press freedom by fostering a secure environment where journalists can work uninhibited by cyber threats.

He said individuals perpetrating online attacks on media workers will face due consequences.

The enhanced protection across physical and digital domains exemplifies the Ferdinand Marcos Jr. administration's dedication to democratic values that reject violence against journalists, encourage the unrestricted movement of information, and uphold the importance of the press.

"This partnership marks a progressive step toward nurturing a society where ethical journalism and responsible reporting flourish," said Undersecretary Torres.

DOST, PGIS, PHIVOLCS ENHANCES DISASTER PREPAREDNESS, ASSESSMENT THROUGH DRONE OPERATIONS WITH REDAS TRAINING IN ILOCOS SUR

VIGAN CITY, Ilocos Sur — The Provincial Government of Ilocos Sur (PGIS), in partnership with the Department of Science and Technology Ilocos Region (DOST Ilocos Region), and DOST PHIVOLCS (Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology) kicked off the four-day capacity building initiative titled “REDAS Training on Exposure Data Collection and Processing Using Remotely Piloted

Aircraft (RPA) for Earthquake and Tsunami Impact Assessment” here today. In her message, DOST Ilocos Region Director Teresita A. Tabaog, emphasized that equipping disaster preparedness and assessment of LGUs thru trainings such as this strengthens capability which ensuring lesser disaster impact while utilizing modern technologies such as

drones. She added that these initiatives brought by DOST stands with its battlecry of “Agham na Ramdam” in the communities. Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officers (LDRRMO) of the Province of Ilocos Sur, together with personnel from the DOST participated in the training. Central to the training is the Rapid Earthquake Damage Assessment System (REDAS), a specialized software platform developed by Dr. Bartolome C. Bautista, former Deputy Director of DOST PHIVOLCS. It is a platform designed to enable local planners to model potential impacts from multiple hazards—including earthquakes, tsunamis, floods, severe winds, and agricultural crop damages. This is to better inform contingency plans and disaster risk reduction strategies. This initiative aims to merge modern hardware (drones/RPAs) with scientific analytical software (REDAS) to enhance local disaster risk reduction, management, and emergency response capabilities. It features the hands-on quadcopter drone skills under Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) safety guidelines to map high-risk areas. By feeding aerial imagery into the REDAS, participants learn to simulate multi-hazard impacts—enabling the province to build science-backed contingency plans in RPA Operations and REDAS applications. Completers will earn formal credentials in both Quadcopter RPA Operations and the REDAS Module. This formal certification recognizing their competency in drone operations and scientific exposure database development will lay a stronger foundation for disaster-resilient communities in Ilocos Sur. DOST remains driven in its vision of bringing innovation straight to the people wherein stakeholders will not just be preparing for disasters but staying one step ahead of them. **(Jean Claire Almosa & Edrussell Castillo)**

“Benteng Bigas Meron Na” reaches 12 million beneficiaries as DA expands access to affordable food nationwide

More than 12 million beneficiaries across the country have already benefited from the P20-per-kilo rice that President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. promised during the campaign in 2022. Agriculture Secretary Francisco P. Tiu Laurel Jr. said the government's flagship “Benteng Bigas, Meron Na!” continues to expand, making 20-peso-per kilo rice now available in around 800 participating outlets nationwide. The Department of Agriculture target to have 1,500 outlets by the end of the year to bring affordable, quality rice closer to Filipino families in more communities while strengthening support for local farmers and fisherfolk, Secretary Tiu Laurel said. “Ang target natin ay yung mga lower income lalo na ang mga PWD, 4Ps, single parents at seniors. Target natin is 15 million households,” the agriculture chief said. The program currently distributes around 15,000 to 20,000 metric tons of P20 rice every month, with the DA aiming to double this to 40,000 metric tons monthly by December to ensure that more Filipino families can access affordable staple food amid global and local challenges. Despite the effects of El Niño, the DA assured the public that the country's food supply remains stable, emphasizing that there is no reason for concern as the government continues to implement measures to secure the nation's food needs. “Marami naman tayong supply, ample, walang cause for any alarm, we are food secure,” the Secretary said. Beyond making rice more affordable, the initiative also creates a reliable market for locally produced palay, allowing farmers to earn better while ensuring consumers benefit from lower food costs. “Masayang-masaya ang farmers... Nakakatulong

talaga sa kanilang kabuhayan,” the Secretary noted. To further strengthen the agriculture sector, the DA continues to invest in long-term interventions such as solar-powered irrigation systems, farm-to-market roads, agricultural credit through the Agricultural Credit Policy Council (ACPC), climate resilience programs for farmers and fisherfolk, and measures to prevent fish kills during extreme weather conditions. The department is likewise accelerating infrastructure investments through public-private partnerships, with a target of constructing 10,000 kilometers of farm-to-market roads within two years, while also pursuing the country's first three mega hatcheries to boost aquaculture production and improve the livelihood of fishing communities. The DA is also pushing reforms that encourage greater investments in rice milling, drying, and storage facilities to strengthen the

local rice industry, reduce dependence on imports, and create more opportunities for Filipino farmers over the long term. For Secretary Tiu Laurel, the department's mission extends beyond increasing production—it is about helping Filipino farmers and fisherfolk build sustainable livelihoods. “Tanging hangad ko ay kumita ‘yung ating mga farmers and fisherfolks. While in office, one of my main missions is to create the atmosphere and give them the infrastructure for them to be able to make money.” The agriculture chief likewise encouraged stakeholders to continue working with the government in improving the country's food systems. “Kung meron kayong gustong paratingin at mga ideas, it is very welcome and we have an open structure. Ang utos po ng Pangulo ay tutukan nang maayos ang agrikultura, hopefully maayos namin lahat ng mga problema ninyo,” he said. **PND**

12 Bansa kalahok sa 10th Senior Aerobic Gymnastics Asian Championships

Tatanggapin ng Pilipinas ang mahigit 350 banyagang delegado kapag ginanap ang ika-10 Senior Aerobic Gymnastics Asian Championships na inihandog ng Philippine Sports Commission mula Agosto 4 hanggang 7 sa modernong at malawak na Tagaytay City Velodrome.

Inilunsad ng Gymnastics Association of the Philippines (GAP) at aprubado ng World Gymnastics at Asian Gymnastics Union (AGU), tampok sa event ang pinakamahusay na aerobic gymnastics sa Asya at layuning pasiglahin ang sports tourism program ng bansa.

Labing-dalawang bansa sa Asya ang magsasal sa pitong kategorya: indibidwal na lalaki at babae, mixed pairs, trios, grupo, aerobic dance at aerobic step. Ang mga age group ay 12 hanggang 14 para sa Youth, 15 hanggang 17 para sa Junior at 18 pataas para sa Senior.

Ang mga bansang kalahok ay

Cambodia, Chinese-Taipei, Hong Kong, Indonesia, India, Japan, South Korea, Mongolia, Thailand, at Vietnam.

Ito na ang pangalawang malaking international na kompetisyon na ipinapakita ng GAP sa ilalim ni Cynthia Carrion at ng PSC sa ilalim ng chairman na si Patrick Gregorio sa loob lamang ng siyam na buwan matapos ang Junior World Artistic Gymnastics Championships noong nakaraang Nobyembre.

Ang Lungsod ng Tagaytay, sa pamamagitan ni Mayor Brent Tolentino at ng presidente ng Philippine Olympic Committee na si Abraham Tolentino, ay nagpahayag ng kanilang kahandaan na mag-host ng event at ipakita ang ganda nito sa mga dayuhang delegadong dumalo.

Maglalagay ng mga hakbang sa seguridad para sa event. Naghanda rin ang lungsod ng mga cultural showcase at hospitality program.

"Sa pamamagitan ng Championship na ito, naniniwala ako na ang mga lokal ng lungsod at ang buong bansa ay nagkakaisa sa pagdadala ng isport sa Asya sa bagong antas at upang hikayatin ang lahat ng Asianong atleta na ipagdiwang ang disiplina at isulong ang kanilang mga hangganan ng kahusayan," sabi ni Carrion sa Forum ng Philippine Sportswriters Association.

Sinabi ni Carrion, na sinamahan ng sekretaryo-heneral ng GAP na si Rowena Eusuya, na ang pagsasagawa ng mga ganitong kaganapan ay hindi lamang maganda para sa sports kundi para rin sa bansa sa pangkalahatan.

"Pinag-iisa ng sports ang mga tao. Ang sports ay parang musika. Bumabalik ang mga alaala. Kausap din ito sa layunin ni PSC chairman Gregorio sa pagho-host ng mga international sporting events para pasiglahin ang sports tourism," sabi ni Carrion.

"Tinatanggap namin ang pagho-host na ito bilang bahagi ng aming programa sa sports tourism. Tulad ng sinabi ko, ang sports ay magandang balita," muling binanggit ni Gregorio, na siya rin ang chairman ng National Sports

Tourism-Inter Agency Committee.

"Matagal na naming gustong isagawa ang event na ito at ipinagmamalaki naming sabihin na sa wakas ay nagawa na namin ito," dagdag pa ni Carrion.

Sabi ng masipag na GAP chief na para sa ilang mga lalawigan tulad ng India, na magpapadala ng pinakamalaking grupo na may 50 atleta sa lahat ng kategorya, "magiging pangunahing batayan ito para sa kanila sa pagpili ng kanilang mga kalahok sa 19th Aerobic Gymnastics World Championships sa Pamplona, Spain sa Disyembre."

Sinabi niya na sa senior division, ang magkahalong pares na sina Arcenio Cadlos at Charmaine Dolar, na nanalo ng silver medal sa 33rd Thailand Southeast Asian Games noong Disyembre, ay magiging malalakas na kandidato para sa medalya para sa bansa host sa apat na araw na paligsahan.

Sa Dolar, inaasahan din naming magpakitang-gilas sa women's individual event at sa women's trios nina magkapatid na sina Dorothy Grace at Danielle Grade at si Princess Johana Pama," sabi ni Carrion.

Dahil sa kabuuang premyong nagkakahalaga ng ₱248,000, lalong tumataas ang pananabik para sa inaabangang paligsahang ito. Ito ay sinusuportahan ng International Billiards and Snooker Champion na si Marlon "Marvelous" R. Manalo, the Games and Amusement Board (GAB) Chairman Atty. Francisco J. Rivera, at Barangay Malamig Chairwoman Cynthia Caluya.

Ayon sa tagapag-ayos ng paligsahan na si Roel Esquillo, ang yugto ng pagpili (single elimination) ay gaganapin sa ika-23 hanggang 26 ng Setyembre, habang ang pangunahing bahagi ng paligsahan ay sa ika-27 at 28 ng Setyembre.

"Ginagawa namin ito upang

itaguyod ang bilyar sa mga nagsisimula pa lamang. Upang matuklasan ang mga bagong talento at mga kampeon na pang-mundo," pahayag ni Esquillo, na maraming beses nang nagwagi sa Japan Billiards Championship.

Ang paligsahang ito na may pahintulot ng Games and Amusement Board (GAB) ay nangangakong magiging mahigpit ang mga laban habang nag-aagawan ang mga manlalaro para sa premyong ₱120,000 para sa kampeon, habang ang ikalawang pwesto ay makakakuha ng ₱40,000.

Ang ikatlo at ikaapat na pwesto ay makatatanggap ng ₱20,000 bawat isa. Ang ikalima hanggang ikawalo ay makakakuha ng ₱8,000 bawat isa, habang ang ikasiyam hanggang ika-labing-anim ay makauwi ng ₱3,000 bawat isa. 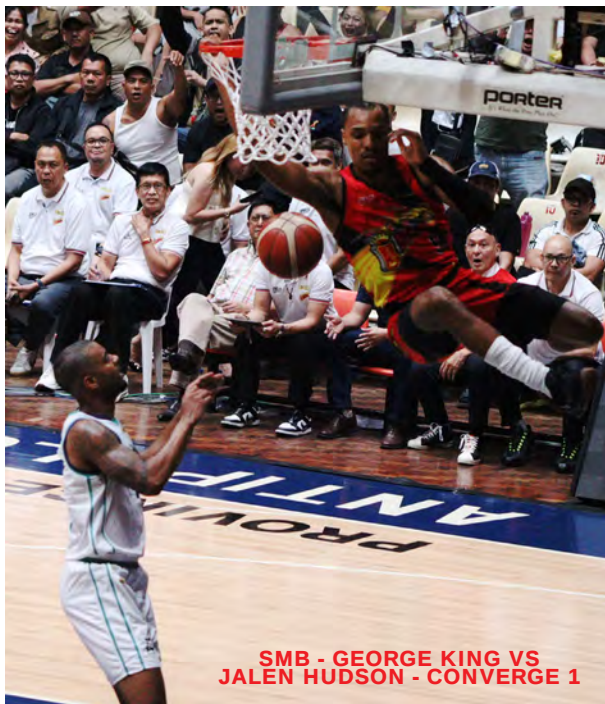
Beermen wagi kontra FiberXers ng PBA Governors Cup

Nagpakitang gilad sina George King at CJ Perez para sa San Miguel nang maitalaga nila ang unang tala ng Converge sa PBA Governors' Cup sa pamamagitan ng panalo na 128-122 sa Ynares Center 1 sa Antipolo.

Nagtala ng puntos si King ng 41 mula sa 16 sa 32 na field goals, kabilang ang 12 sa 18 sa dalawang puntos at 2 sa 5 sa apat na puntos, para pamunuan ang Beermen sa laro.

Si Perez naman, bigla na lang sumigla at nagtapos sa 31 puntos mula sa 12-for-17 na shooting, kasama na ang halos perpektong 5 sa 6 sa long-range na mga tira. Kailangan ng SMB ng isang malakas na pagsabog sa ikatlong quarter, kung saan nakapuntos ang koponan ng 41 puntos, para makuha ang komportableng kalamangan na kanilang hawak hanggang sa katapusan.

Nagkaroon din si King ng 11 rebounds, apat na assists, tatlong steals, at isang block habang

Sertipikasyon para sa liquidation ng 2019 SEA Games inilabas ng PSC

Handa ang Philippine Southeast Asian Games Organizing Committee (PHISGOC) sa anumang lehitimong pagsisiyasat matapos nitong ilabas ang sertipikasyon ng Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) na nagpapatunay na ganap nang na-liquidate ang P2.08 bilyong pondong inilaan para sa pagho-host ng bansa sa 2019 Southeast Asian Games.

Ayon kay PHISGOC President at Chief Operating Officer Ramon Suzara, matagal nang nakumpleto, naisumite at sumailalim sa independent audit ang lahat ng rekord ng organisasyon, kaya handa itong makipagtulungan sa anumang pormal na imbestigasyon.

Ipinaliwanag ni Suzara na idinaos ang ika-30 edisyon ng SEA Games mula Nobyembre 30 hanggang Disyembre 11, 2019. Bagama't naantala ang ilang obligasyon matapos ang torneo dahil sa pandemya, sinabi niyang kinumpirma ni PSC Chief Accountant Erik Mayores na ganap nang na-liquidate ang PHISGOC noong Marso 2022.

Sa sertipikasyong may petsang Hulyo 20, 2026, nakasaad na batay sa rekord ng Accounting Division ng PSC, naisumite ng PHISGOC Foundation ang

kabuuang 100 porsiyento ng liquidation reports kaugnay ng P2.082 bilyong financial assistance na ipinagkaloob ng PSC para sa pagho-host ng 30th SEA Games. Dagdag pa ni Suzara, ang lahat ng dokumentong pinansyal ng PHISGOC ay sumailalim din sa independent audit ng PricewaterhouseCoopers/Isa Lipana & Co.

Bukod sa maayos na liquidation ng pondo, iginiiit ng PHISGOC na ang matagumpay na pagho-host ng Pilipinas ang pinakamalinalaw na patunay ng naging maayos na pamamahala nito.

Sa naturang edisyon ng SEA Games, tinanghal na overall champion ang Pilipinas matapos humakot ng 149 ginto, 117 pilak at 121 tanso, o kabuuang 387 medalya—ang pinakamataas na medal haul sa kasaysayan ng bansa sa biennial meet.

"Isa itong organisasyong binuo ng iba't ibang ahensya at departamento ng pamahalaan para tiyakin ang matagumpay na pagho-host ng Pilipinas. Nagawa natin ito at ipinagdiwang ito ng buong bansa," ani Suzara.

Binigyang-diin din niya ang patuloy na pakinabang ng mga pasilidad sa New Clark City (NCC), na nananatiling tanging internationally certified athletics venue (World Athletics Class 1) at aquatics venue (World Aquatics) sa bansa na kayang magdaos ng mga kompetisyong pangrehiyon.

Aniya, ang NCC sports facilities ay isang mahalagang proyektong itinayo ng Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA) sa loob lamang ng 18 buwan at natapos bago ang pagbubukas ng SEA Games.

Tiniyak din ng PHISGOC na nakahanda itong tugunan ang anumang partikular na alegasyon sa tamang proseso at iharap ang lahat ng kinakailangang rekord sa anumang lehitimong imbestigasyon.
