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USAPING PAMBANSA SA ACPSSI, TINALAKAY

Sa Media Forum na pinangunahan ni Daniel Long, kasama sina Ado Paglinawan, Vice President for Internal Affairs of ACPSSI, sinabi ng Pangulo ng ACPSSI ni Herman "Ka Mentong" Tiu Laurel na ang bansa ay Nasa Pagitan ng Alanganin at Panganib.

Ang Pilipinas sa ilalim ni Bongbong Marcos ngayon ay naiipit sa pagitan na siyang hegemonikong Estados Unidos ng Amerika at ng Malalim na Dagat ng Isang Umuusbong na Tsina na sinabi ng diplomatikong taga-Singapore at dating pangulo ng U.N. Security Council na si Kishor Mahbubani na hindi na mapipigilan ng sinumang partidong naghahangad na pigilan ito.

Noong 2020, inilathala ni Kishor Mahbubani ang librong "Has China Won? The Chinese Challenge to American Primacy." Siyam na taon bago ang librong iyon, napansin na ng U.S. ang Pag-usbong ng Tsina at ang hamon na idinudulot nito na nag-udyok sa pagbabago ng direksyon at sa anunsyo ni Obama ng "Pivot to Asia" ng Amerika upang ilipat ang 60% ng mga pwersang militar nito sa Asya-Pasipiko.

Mula nang maganap ang "Pivot to Asia," pinag-aklas ng U.S. ang tatlong kliyenteng estado nito na Hapon, Pilipinas, at Timog Korea ng mga senaryong pampulitika upang magtanim ng mga isyu ng "lawfare" laban sa Tsina: ang nasyonalisasyon ng Hapon sa mga Isla ng Diaoyu, ang pagsampa ng Pilipinas sa malisyosong "kaso ng arbitrasyon," at ang pagtatapos ng Timog Korea sa "Sunshine Policy" nito sa Hilaga.

Noong 2017, sinimulan ng U.S. ang Trade War 1.0 sa ilalim ng unang termino ni Pangulong Trump at ang unang malakas na ingay ay ang pag-aresto noong 2018 sa Chief Financial Officer ng Huawei na si Meng Wanzhou sa Canada sa kahilingan ng U.S. Noong 2019, ipinasok ng U.S. ang Covid 19 sa Tsina. Ipinagpatuloy ni Biden ang digmaan sa taripa laban sa Tsina na pinasidhi ng Trump 2.0.

Matapos ang digmaang pang-ekonomiya ng Trump 2.0 sa Tsina, ang depisit sa kalakalan ng U.S. dito ay nasa \$202-bilyon pa rin noong 2025.

Sinimulan ni Trump ang Digmaan sa Iran noong Pebrero 28, 2026 upang limitahan ang suplay ng langis at enerhiya sa Kanlurang Asya patungo sa Tsina, ngunit ito ay nagbalik-wasak sa U.S. Habang ang Tsina ay patuloy na umuunlad sa pamamagitan ng iba't ibang pinagkukuhanan ng enerhiya at lalo na ang mga sariling mapagkukunan ng nababagong enerhiya (renewable resources). Ang pandaigdigang kadena ng suplay at merkado ng Tsina ay nagmula sa patuloy na pagtatangka ng Amerika na pigilan at limitahan ang patuloy nitong pag-angat. Mahbubani: Ang tunay na dahilan kung bakit hindi mapigilan ang Tsina.

Nagsagawa ng Palihan sa Pagbuo ng Ortograpiya ng wikang Mëñubù Dulángan ang Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino (KWF) noong 6-8 Agosto 2026 sa Paraiso Verde Hotel, Lungsod Koronadal.

Ang mga gawain ay pinangunahan ng mga mananaliksik ng KWF na sina Dr. Jose Evie G. Duclay, Rolien Mark M. Balisi, at Christian DS. Nayles; SWK ng University of Southern Mindanao (USM); mga gurong manunulat mula sa DepEd Sultan Kudarat, at mga elder ng komunidad ng Mëñubù Dulángan mula sa pitong (7) bayan ng Sultan Kudarat.

Naging katuwang ng KWF sa pananaliksik na ito ang mga kinatawan mula sa Sentro ng Wika at Kultura (SWK) ng USM para matiyak ang maayos na implementasyon ng mga gawain at mapalakas ang ugnayan ng dalawang institusyon sa mga proyektong pangwika.

Ang suspek na si alyas Emman ay naharap sa paglabag sa Republic Act No. 10591, kilala rin bilang Comprehensive Law on Firearms and Ammunition, at gayundin sa paglabag sa gun ban ng Omnibus Election Code kaugnay ng Special Election sa Dasmariñas City, Cavite. Nabatid na dakong alas-4:30 ng hapon nitong Setyembre 1, sa Fatima Proper Road, Barangay Fatima 1, Dasmariñas City, ay nagsagawa ng operasyon laban sa mga iligal na baril sa pamamagitan ng isang buy-bust operation ang mga tauhan ng Provincial Intelligence Unit (PIU), bilang nangungunang

yunit, kasama ang mga tauhan ng Dasmariñas City Police Station.

Nagresulta ang operasyon sa pag-aresto kay Emman, na kasalukuyang naninirahan sa Barangay Molino 4, Bacoor City. Kabilang pa sa mga narekober ang isang pitaka, dalawang Android cellphone, at apat na iba't ibang identification card; isang tunay na P1,000.00 bill na ginamit bilang buy-bust money, na isinama sa dalawampu't siyam na piraso ng P1,000.00 boodle money; at isang motorsiklong Yamaha na kulay asul at itim.

Editorial

Paghahanda sa tagtuyot

SA kabila ng nararanasang patuloy na pag-uulan ay hindi isinasaisantabi ang mga kaukulang hakbang o paghahanda sa banta ng panibagong tagtuyot mula sa El Niño.

Kung mararanasan ang panibagong tagtuyot ay direkta itong makakasakal o gigipit sa lokal na supply ng pagkain.

Mas matinding krisis din ang posibleng maidudulot nito sa pandaigdigang merkado at presyuhan ng bigas.

Ang pamunuan ng Department of Agriculture ay nagpalabas ng direktiba sa lahat ng kanilang ahensya para sa patuloy na pag-aayos at pagpapatatag ng mga El Niño response plan.

Isa sa nakikita para mabawasan ang epekto ng tagtuyot ay ang gagawing paggamit ng DA sa mga pinakabagong datos ukol sa panahon, suplay ng tubig, galaw ng merkado, at lagay ng pananim.

Cloud seeding, pagtatayo ng solar irrigation, paglilipat ng produksyon sa hindi apektadong rehiyon at iba pang mga hakbang ang isinasaalang-alang ng kagawaran.

Mahalaga rin ang direktang tulong-pinansyal na ilalaaan sa mga naapektuhang magsasaka.

Punlang pinalago ng sipag

Lumaki si Teresita D. Dita sa Sta. Maria, Laguna. Bagama't elementarya lamang ang natapos sa pag-aaral, maaga niyang natutuhang tumayo sa sariling mga paa. Maaga siyang naganapbuhay sa pamamagitan ng pagluluto at paglalako ng mga kakanin sa kanilang bayan kasama ang kanyang ina.

Dahil sa kaniyang paglalako at sariling paggawa, naging pamilyar ang lasa ng kaniyang mga kakanin sa kanilang komunidad, at ang kaniyang kahusayan sa paggawa ng mga ito ay kinilala sa kanilang bayan. Sa katunayan, ang kaniyang sariling gawang suman ay dalawang beses na nagwagi sa Marilag Festival, isang pagdiriwang ng agrikultura at kultura sa Sta. Maria, Laguna.

Subalit nang siya ay nagkaroon na ng sariling pamilya, hindi na naging sapat ang kita ni Teresita sa kaniyang kakanin para sa pagpapalaki ng kanilang anim na anak. Upang mapagkasya ang kita, lakas-loob na pinasimulan niya, kasama ng kaniyang asawa, ang pagmamanukan at pagbebenta ng mga itlog nito. Naging matapang ang mag-asawa na ipinuhunan ang kanilang ipon upang masimulan ang kanilang unang negosyo.

At hindi naging madali ang mga unang araw ng pag-aalaga ng manok at paghihintay sa pangingitlog nito. Kailangan din nilang mamuhunan sa pagpapanatiling ligtas ng mga manok laban sa mga peste at virus na maaaring magdulot ng sakit sa kanila. Subalit sa kanilang patuloy na pagsisikap, nakapagsusuplay na sila sa kanilang bayan ng mga itlog na nagkakahalaga ng PHP 280 hanggang PHP 290 sa bawat tray nito. Kasabay

ng patuloy na pagtitinda ni Teresita ng kakanin, ang negosyong ito ang bumuhay sa kanilang pamilya.

Noong 2016, nakilala ni Teresita ang CARD, Inc. (A Microfinance NGO) at naging kliyente nito. Bilang isang bagong kliyente, kumuha siya ng kanyang unang loan na nagkakahalaga ng PHP 3,000 na siyang sumuporta sa kanilang paitugan.

Taong 2021 naman, kumuha siya ng PHP 20,000 loan at nagdagdag ng isa pang negosyo: ang pagpapalago ng mga punla. Katulong ang kaniyang asawa. Nag-alaga sila ng mga punla ng lansones at ibinebenta ang mga ito sa halagang PHP 130 hanggang PHP 150 bawat isa.

Subalit tuwing tag-init, nagiging mahirap para sa kanila ang pag-aalaga ng mga ito dahil sa matinding init at mabilis na pagkatuyo ng lupa. Gayunpaman, patuloy nilang binantayan

at diniligan nang mabuti ang mga punla. Patuloy nilang pinatubo ang mga ito kung kaya hindi natigil ang kanilang pagsu-supply hanggang sa makarating ang kanilang mga punla sa iba't ibang bahagi ng lalawigan ng Laguna at Batangas.

Tulad ng kanilang mga manok na matiyagang nag-abang sa panahon ng pangingitlog, ang buhay ni Teresita ay unti-unti na ring nagbubunga. Lahat ng kanilang mga anak ay mayroon na ngayong sariling mga pamilya, at siya ngayon ay isa nang lola sa kaniyang walong apo. Kahit na narating na niya ang ganitong yugto ng buhay, patuloy pa rin niyang pinatatakbo ang kanilang negosyo.

Kalaunan ay kumuha muli ng PHP 50,000 na loan si Teresita na kanyang hinati-hati bilang working capital para sa kanyang tatlong

negosyo upang matiyak ang patuloy na operasyon at paglago ng mga ito.

Sa ngayon, kumikita sila ng halos PHP 60,000 kada buwan mula sa pagdi-distribute ng mga itlog. Dahil kilala si Teresita sa mga masarap niyang kakanin, tuloy-tuloy ang kanyang paggawa ng mga pre-order nito kung saan siya kumikita ng PHP 2,000 kada batch ng order. Ang kanilang mga punla ng lansones ay kumikita naman ng humigit-kumulang PHP 20,000 buwan-buwan.

Sapat at kontento man ang buhay niya ngayon, ngunit para kay Teresita, ang pag-abot sa ganitong yugto ay bunga ng mahabang panahon na walang patid na sipag, at matiyagang pagpapahalaga at pagpapalago sa kung ano ang mayroon sila. **(Jireh Pearl Casionan, Junior Writer)**

WeLoveU Holds 941st Worldwide Blood Drive in Dasmariñas

The blood drive helps save the lives of those in need of blood and promotes a culture of voluntary, non-remunerated blood donation

The International WeLoveU Foundation (Chairwoman Zhang Gil-jah, hereinafter referred to as WeLoveU), a global welfare organization, held the 941st Worldwide Blood Drive at Emilio Aguinaldo College Medical Center-Cavite (EACMC-C) in Dasmariñas, Cavite, on August 31. Through this blood drive, WeLoveU has helped people who need blood for surgery, childbirth, cancer treatment, and other types of medical care, contributing to the spread of a culture of voluntary non-remunerated blood donation. The Worldwide Blood Drive is actively being carried out in the Philippines and many other countries, including the Republic of Korea, the United States, Peru, Colombia, Kenya, and Australia. A representative from WeLoveU said, "The Worldwide Blood Drive is a life-sharing initiative that helps save people suffering from blood shortages, because blood can only be obtained through donation." He added,

"To bring hope to our neighbors with the heart of a mother who loves her family, our members and citizens from Cavite and Laguna have come together without hesitation. We hope many people will be able to return to their happy everyday lives." From the morning, a steady stream of people arrived at EAC Medical Center-Cavite to donate blood. They underwent a pre-donation health screening, including blood pressure checks and blood tests. 68 out of approximately 200 participants successfully donated a total of 29,716 mL of blood. A single blood donation can help save up to three lives. Therefore, their donations could help give the gift of new life to 204 people. EAC Medical Center-Cavite helped ensure that the entire blood donation process was carried out safely, contributing to the success of the Worldwide Blood Drive. It also provided refreshments for every donor. At the opening ceremony held before the blood drive began in earnest, Dasmariñas City

Councilor Fernando Laudato expressed his gratitude to the participants, saying, "I thank the International WeLoveU Foundation for conducting this meaningful act that gives life to those who are in need of blood." Dasmariñas City Bureau of Fire Protection SF03 John Bryan T. Añonuevo emphasized that blood is needed in various rescue situations happening in the community, and expressed his appreciation. Former Cavite 4th District Representative Francisco 'Kiko' Barzaga also graced the gathering and congratulated the Int'l WeLoveU Foundation for organizing such a meaningful initiative. Juan Carlos De Jesus Faylona (20) said he was happy to take part in volunteer work for his neighbors. He smiled and added, "One person's blood donation can save the lives

up to three people. So, I'm so excited and happy for being able to join this meaningful event through which I can practice a mother's love." John Edison Collado (30) pledged to volunteer again at future events, saying, "It's fulfilling to do something that benefits the community." The Worldwide Blood Drive is a global life-saving movement that creates a virtuous cycle of sharing, where a small act of blood donation by one person spreads to two people, then four, and beyond. Since its launch in Korea in 2004, the blood drive has attracted over 151,000 participants in 67 countries, approximately 67,000 of whom have successfully donated blood (as of June 2026). The blood drive has potentially saved more than 200,000 lives. It has also been held regularly across the country since 2012.

In grateful recognition of its outstanding contributions, WeLoveU has received certificates of recognition from Emilio Aguinaldo College Medical Center – Cavite. In addition to blood donation, WeLoveU actively carries out a wide range of welfare initiatives across the country. In June this year, WeLoveU repaired the typhoon-damaged school building at Biasong Elementary School in Talisay City, Cebu, and held an international cooperation seminar to discuss how to ensure sustainable education, based on the project. In August last year, WeLoveU renovated the restrooms at Camp Crame High School in Quezon City and conducted handwashing education to improve personal hygiene at Macabud Elementary School in Montalban, Rizal. This helped students lead healthier

school lives. WeLoveU's environmental welfare initiative called "Clean WORLD Movement," which aims to promote well-being by creating cleaner and more pleasant environments, has also been carried out in various locations across the country, including Seminary Road in Bahay Toro, Quezon City, and Tanza Marine Tree Park. In recognition of its dedicated efforts across a wide range of activities, WeLoveU has received certificates of recognition and appreciation from Secretary of Social Welfare and Development, Governors of Laguna and Oriental Mindoro, Member of the House of Representatives of the Philippines from Tarlac, Mayor of Quezon City, Director of the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) National Blood Services, and many others.

SSS marks 69th anniversary with stronger member protection, expanding services

QUEZON CITY, The Social Security System (SSS) marked its 69th Anniversary, reaffirming its commitment to protect Filipino workers and their families while strengthening the System's financial sustainability, expanding access to social security, and transforming the delivery of services. Carrying the theme "Bawat Isa Protektado, Bawat Bukas Sigurado," the anniversary celebrates nearly seven decades of providing social security protection while looking ahead to the evolving needs of Filipino workers and their families. During the 69th Anniversary Press Conference at the SSS Main Office in Quezon City, SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Robert Joseph M. de Claro presented the System's latest performance and key initiatives, highlighting the continued expansion of benefits, financial assistance, retirement savings, and digital services. "For 69 years, SSS has been a steadfast partner of Filipino workers and their families, providing protection when they need it most. As we move toward our 70th year, we are focused on making that protection stronger, more accessible, and more responsive while ensuring that SSS remains financially sustainable for generations to come," de Claro said. Finance Secretary and Social Security Commission (SSC) Chairperson Frederick D. Go underscored the importance of maintaining the SSS' financial strength to ensure that it can sustainably provide and expand social protection

to more Filipino workers and their families. "A stronger fund means a stronger capacity to pay pensions and benefits. It means greater assurance that when today's worker retires, or when hardship strikes a member's family, SSS will have the capacity to respond," he said. **₱205.56 billion released in benefits** From January to July 2026, SSS released a total of ₱205.56 billion in benefit payments to members, pensioners, and their beneficiaries. Retirement and death benefits accounted for the largest share of Social Security benefit payments totaling ₱180.86 billion from January to July 2026. This included ₱110.83 billion for regular pensioners and ₱43.89 billion for survivor pensioners, covering 2.70 million and 1.23 million pensioners, respectively. **Pension reform strengthens retirement protection** SSS continues to implement the Pension Reform Program (PRP), the first multi-year pension increase program in SSS history. Under the PRP, pensioners receive annual pension increases every September from 2025 to 2027. Retirement and disability pensioners received a 10% increase in their monthly pensions, while death and survivor pensioners received a 5% increase. For 2026, SSS has disbursed approximately ₱6 billion in additional pension benefits to help pensioners cope with inflationary pressures and higher energy costs. The pension increase was released earlier in June as part of SSS'

support for pensioners amid the national energy situation. As of July 2026, the average basic monthly pension was ₱5,704, inclusive of the additional ₱1,000 benefit for Social Security pensioners and ₱1,150 for Employees' Compensation pensioners. **Contribution collections remain strong** Members' contributions reached ₱235.33 billion from January to July 2026, continuing to provide the primary funding base for SSS' benefit and service obligations. During the period, SSS recorded ₱268.14 billion in total revenues and ₱212.64 billion in total expenditures, resulting in ₱55.50 billion in net revenue. Operating expenses amounted to ₱7.09 billion, equivalent to 24.3% of the ₱29.22-billion charter limit, reflecting the System's continuing efforts to maintain prudent expenditure management. **₱1.29 trillion investment portfolio** SSS continues to maintain a diversified investment portfolio to support its long-term obligations and preserve the value of the pension fund. As of July 2026, the System's total investment level stood at ₱1.29 trillion, with an annualized return on investment of 4.64%. Government securities accounted for 49% of the portfolio, followed by equities at 14%, loans to members and pensioners at 13%, real estate at 12%, and corporate notes and bonds at 8%. The remaining investments were in bank deposits, externally managed funds, and mutual funds.

SSS manages its investment portfolio through prudent risk management and disciplined asset allocation to generate sustainable returns while safeguarding the pension fund. **Expanding financial assistance** In response to rising energy costs, inflationary pressures, and broader economic challenges, SSS has enhanced its loan programs to provide members with more accessible financial assistance during times of need. The Enhanced Emergency Loan Program (ELP), which took effect on 1 May 2026, provides qualified members with access to up to ₱20,000 at an interest rate of 7% per annum, with a six-month repayment moratorium. The program also relaxed the contribution requirement from 36 to 18 months, provided that the member has at least six posted contributions within the last 12 months. SSS has also rolled out the SSS Micro Loan Program, or SSS LoanLite, which provides qualified employed members with a fully digital option for short-term financial assistance through participating financial institutions. UnionDigital Bank is the first participating financial institution to make SSS LoanLite available through its mobile application. Representatives of the other participating financial institutions, Rizal Commercial Banking Corporation (RCBC), Land Bank of the Philippines, UnionBank of the Philippines, and Standard Economics, were also present during the SSS 69th Anniversary Press Conference, underscoring the

strong partnership between SSS and its financial institution partners. The other LoanLite partners will make the facility available through their respective digital platforms as their systems become ready. **Strengthening retirement savings** SSS is also expanding opportunities for members to build additional retirement savings through the Mandatory Provident Fund (MPF) and Pension Booster (PB). As of July 2026, MPF contributions reached ₱263.12 billion from 9.18 million members. The PB recorded ₱2.09 billion in contributions from 95,745 members, giving members another option to build additional retirement savings. Expanding social security coverage As of July 2026, SSS had 44.25 million covered members, including employed, self-employed, voluntary, and Overseas Filipino Workers. The System also maintained 292 local offices nationwide and 30 foreign offices, allowing it to serve members in the Philippines and abroad. SSS was likewise serving more than 1 million active employers, strengthening its partnership with employers in expanding and sustaining social security coverage. **Preparing for the future** SSS is developing new programs designed to respond to the evolving needs of its members. Among these is the Energy Sustainability Loan Program, which will allow qualified members with Mandatory Provident Fund accounts to borrow up to ₱400,000 to install solar panel systems at

home. The loan will be payable over seven years at an interest rate of 6% per annum. SSS is also developing the Mandatory Provident Fund Loan and Pensioners' Card as part of its continuing efforts to expand financial and service options for members and pensioners. **Continuing 69 years of protection** The 69th Anniversary celebration will continue throughout September with activities recognizing SSS members, pensioners, employers, and partners. Pensioners' Day on 11 September will honor the country's pensioners and highlight the importance of sustained social security protection in retirement. The opening of the SSS Foreign Office in Madrid on 11 September will serve more than 70,000 Filipinos in Spain. SSS Global Kabayan Day will be held in Hong Kong on 12 to 13 September and in Barcelona, Spain on 13 September to provide services and honor OFWs and pensioners. The 2026 Balikat ng Bayan Awards on 21 September will recognize outstanding partners and stakeholders whose contributions have helped advance SSS programs and strengthen social security protection. As SSS moves toward its 70th year, the System remains committed to strengthening its financial foundation, expanding social protection, and delivering services that respond to the changing needs of Filipino workers and their families.
