PAGLILINGKOD SA KOMUNIDAD AT KAPAKANAN NG MGA TAUHAN NG PNP

IPINAGDIWANG nitong Setyembre 8 ang ika-53 kaarawan ni P/BGen Dominic L. Baccay, acting regional director ng Police Regional Office 4A, sa pamamagitan ng pagdadala ng pagdiriwang nang mas malapit sa komunidad at sa pamilya ng PRO 4A.

Tampok dito ang isang outreach activity para sa 42 pamilya sa Biñan City, Laguna, at ang pagkilala sa 10 natatanging Non-Uniformed Personnel (NUP) sa kani-kanilang larangan at opisina.

Sa pamamagitan ng “Tulong at Pag-Asa: Paggunita ng Kaarawan sa Pamamagitan ng Serbisyong Bayanihan” outreach activity, personal na nakiisa si P/BGen Baccay kasama ang kanyang asawang si Gng. Maybelline L. Baccay, adviser ng PRO 4A OLCFI, sa pamamahagi ng tulong sa 42 pamilya sa Biñan City.

Bilang bahagi ng pagdiriwang ng kanyang kaarawan, personal ding namahagi ang heneral ng mga grocery package at cash gift sa 10 tauhang NUP bilang pagkilala sa kanilang serbisyo at mahahalagang kontribusyon sa kani-kanilang larangan.

Itinampok sa pagdiriwang ang paggunita sa kanyang buhay at karera, na kinatampukan ng iba't ibang pagbati at mga espesyal na presentasyon mula sa mga tauhan ng PRO 4A.

Sa kanyang mensahe sa kaarawan ay ibinahagi nito ang positibong pananaw sa buhay, pati na rin ang responsibilidad at pagkakataong kaakibat ng pamumuno sa PRO 4A.

“Pinipili kong manatiling positibo sa lahat ng nangyayari sa aking buhay. Dumaan ako sa mga pagsubok at tagumpay, ngunit bawat karanasan ay nagturo sa akin ng mahalagang aral. Umaasa akong ang aking karanasan ay makapagbibigay-inspirasyon sa susunod na henerasyon na manatiling positibo, magpatuloy sa kabila ng mga hamon, at laging piliin ang tama. Ang pagtitiwala sa akin ng pamumuno sa PRO 4A ay kapwa isang responsibilidad at pagkakataon—upang makapaglingkod sa mas maraming

tao, makapagdulot ng positibong pagbabago, at makapagbigay-inspirasyon sa iba na mamuno nang may layunin at kababaang-loob,” pahayag niya.

Nagtapos ang pagdiriwang sa isang “boodle fight” na nagsilbing pagkakataon upang pagbuklurin ang pamilya ng PRO 4A sa diwa ng pagkakaisa at samahan. Pinagsama-sama sa pagdiriwang ng ika-53 kaarawan ni P/BGen Baccay ang serbisyo-publiko, pagkilala sa mga dedikadong tauhan, pasalamat, at pagpapalalim ng samahan; sumasalamin ito sa kanyang B.E.S.T. (Be Visible, Engage Immediately, Serve Together, and Transform Trust) Policing Framework na nakabatay sa Focused Agenda ng Chief, PNP—partikular na sa pagpapataas ng moral at pagtataguyod sa kapakanan ng lahat ng tauhan ng PNP. **(*Larawan at teksto mula sa PNP*)**

Naarestong kawatan, nahulihan ng baril

ISANG kawatan ang naaresto matapos mahuli sa aktong tangkang pagnanakaw na nagresulta pa sa pagkakakumpiska ng baril kamakailan sa Imus City, Cavite.

Ang tangkang pagnanakaw ng mga bakal ay isinagawa ng suspek na si alyas Rico, residente ng Imus City, sa isang gusali sa Barangay Malagasang 1-G, ng nasabing lungsod dakong alas-6:00 ng gabi nitong

Legarda isinusulong ang libreng matrikula sa master's degree, merit-based system at mas matibay na pananagutan para sa 2.25M kawani ng gobyerno

Sa mahigit 2.25 milyong kawani na nagpapatakbo ng mga serbisyo ng pamahalaan-sabuon-bansa, nanawagan si Senator Loren Legarda ng mas malaking pamumuhunan sa kakayahan ng mga lingkod-bayan at mas matibay na mga sistemang kumikilala sa mahusay na trabaho, sumusukat sa resulta, at nagpapanagot sa mga institusyon ng pamahalaan. Habang ipinagdiriwang ng bansa ngayong Setyembre ang ika-126 na anibersaryo ng Philippine Civil Service, ipinahayag ni Legarda na ang pagkilala sa mga kawani ng gobyerno ay dapat sabayan ng mga polisiyang nagbibigay sa kanila ng mas maraming pagkakataong paunlarin ang kanilang kakayahan at gawing mas madali para sa mahuhusay at tapat na kawani na magampanan nang maayos ang kanilang trabaho.

“Kapag maayos ang trabaho ng isang kawani, ramdam iyan ng tao. Mas mabilis ang transaksyon, mas maayos ang serbisyo, mas malinaw ang sagot ng ahensya, at mas napapakinabangan

ang pondo ng bayan. Kaya kung mataas ang pamantayang hinihingi natin sa mga lingkod-bayan, dapat seryoso rin ang gobyerno sa pagbibigay sa kanila ng pagkakataong humusay,” ipinahayag ni Legarda. Ayon sa Civil Service Commission, may 2,256,693 career at non-career government personnel noong Hunyo 2026. Ang tema ng pagdiriwang ngayong taon ay “Bawat Kawani, Lingkod Bayani: Puso, Dangal, at Galing Para sa Bayan.”

Si Legarda, na chairperson ng Senate Committee on Civil Service, Government Reorganization and Professional Regulation, ay naghain ng mga panukalang nakatuon sa propesyonal na pag-unlad, sistemang nakabatay sa husay at performance, pananagutan sa pamahalaan, at mas malawak na access sa pampublikong impormasyon. Kabilang dito ang Senate Bill No. 2099, o ang Government Employees Free Master's Degree Tuition Act, na naglalayong magbigay ng libreng matrikula sa mga state universities and colleges para sa mga kawani ng gobyernong kumukuha ng master's degree. Inihain din niya ang Senate Bill No. 513, o ang Bagong Dugong Lingkod Bayan Act, na naglalayong magtatag ng National Public Service College na mangunguna sa paglinang ng mahuhusay at tapat na mga pinuno sa pamahalaan.

“Maraming kawani ang gustong mag-aral pa at palawakin ang kanilang kakayahan, pero may gastos na kaakibat ang graduate education. Kung ang kaalamang makukuha nila ay magagamit sa paggawa ng mas mahusay na polisiya at serbisyo, dapat lang mamuhunan ang gobyerno sa kanilang pag-aaral,” ipinahayag ni Legarda.

Isinusulong din ni Legarda ang mga reporma sa paraan ng pagsusuri sa performance ng pamahalaan. Layunin ng Senate Bill No. 1850 na magtatag at gawing bahagi ng sistema ng gobyerno ang isang performance measurement system na nagtataguyod ng meritocracy. Samantala, layunin ng Senate Bill No. 515, o ang National Results-Based Governance Act, na palakasin ang monitoring, evaluation, at paggamit ng ebidensya sa mga programa

at proyekto ng pamahalaan. “Dapat may saysay ang performance evaluation. Kung mahusay ang trabaho, dapat kinikilala. Kung may programa namang hindi gumagana, dapat makita agad, maitama, at hindi patuloy na pondohan dahil nakasanayan na. Public funds should follow programs that actually work,” ipinahayag ni Legarda.

Binigyang-diin niya na ang maayos na pagsukat sa performance ay nangangailangan din ng access sa maaasahang impormasyon at mas matibay na mga pananggalang laban sa korapsyon.

Inihain ni Legarda ang Senate Bill No. 523, o ang Tapat na Paglilingkod Act, na naglalayong gawing bahagi ng sistema ng pamahalaan ang isang pambansang anti-corruption mainstreaming agenda at palakasin ang mga mekanismo para sa integridad at pananagutan sa buong gobyerno. Samantala, layunin ng kanyang Senate Bill No. 304, o ang Open

Government Data Act, na obligahin ang mga ahensya na regular at kusang maglabas ng mga datos ng pamahalaan na mahalaga sa paggawa ng polisiya at sa kanilang operasyon.

Ipinahayag ni Legarda na ipinapakita ng mga panukalang ito ang uri ng reporma sa civil service na nais niyang isulong bilang chairperson ng komite, kung saan ang propesyonal na pag-unlad ay sinasabayan ng merit, nasusukat na performance, transparency, at accountability.

“Kahit gaano kaganda ang isang polisiya, kung mahina ang sistema ng pagpapatupad, hindi ito mararamdaman ng tao. Kaya ang pagpapalakas sa ating mga kawani at sa mga institusyong kanilang pinaglilingkuran ay mahalaga upang ang bawat batas, programa, at pondong inilaan ng pamahalaan ay mauwi sa serbisyong tunay na napapakinabangan ng sambayanan,” pagtatapos ni Legarda.

‘Lupin’ ng Maynila, Iniharap sa media ni Mayor Isko

INIHARAP sa media ni Manila Mayor Francisco ‘Isko’ Moreno Domagozo ang tinaguriang alyas ‘Lupin’ ng Maynila matapos ang pagkakaaresto nito kamakailan.

Sinasabing si Lupin, 47, binata, at residente ng 1815 Antonio Rivera St., Barangay 234, Zone 23, Tondo, Manila, ay notoryus umanong holdaper ng mga coffee shop.

Nagsagawa ng pinagsamang operasyon ang mga tauhan ng Special Mayor's Reaction Team sa pamumuno ni PLT Ryan O. Valenzuela, sa ilalim ng pangangasiwa ni PLTCOL Cicero M. Pura (hepe ng S.Ma.R.T), katuwang ang mga tauhan ng Sampaloc Police Station (PS-4) sa pamumuno ni PLT Christopher Nogoy (PCP Commander, Gulod PCP) at sa ilalim ng pangangasiwa ni PLTCOL Bryan B. Sagayadoro (Station Commander, MPD-PS4) sa kahabaan ng Antonio Rivera St., Barangay 234, Zone 23, Tondo, na nagresulta sa pag-aresto sa suspek na si Lupin dahil sa paglabag sa batas hinggil sa robbery (Art. 293 ng Revised Penal Code) at R.A. 10591 (Comprehensive Firearms and Ammunition Regulation Act).

Matatandaan na nitong Setyembre 5 dakong alas-

11:30 ng gabi, habang nakaduty ang biktima sa OSS Café Shop na matatagpuan sa G. Tuazon St., Sampaloc, Maynila, ay maingat na lumapit sa kanya ang suspek at nagpakilalang miyembro ng barangay.

Ipinalaalam ng suspek sa kanya ang tungkol sa clearing operation sa tapat ng kanilang coffee shop. Lumabas ang biktima ngunit doon ay pinagbantaan siya ng suspek habang nakatutok ang baril.

Nagbabala ang suspek na papatayin siya sakaling tumanggi ibigay ang kanyang cellphone (iPhone 14) na nagkakahalaga ng humigit-kumulang Php 48,000.00, at agad na tumakas si Lupin.

Kabilang sa mga ebidensyang nakumpiska ay ang isang iPhone 14, isang piraso ng improvised na baril na kilala rin bilang “Pen Gun,” at isang piraso ng 9mm live ammunition. Sa pagkakaharap kay Lupin sa media ay mahigpit na nagbabala ang alkalde na huwag subuking gumawa ng ano mang krimen sa Maynila.

Sabi ni Mayor Isko, palaging nakahanda ang puwersa ng Manila Police District sa paghahabol at pagtugis sa mga kriminal saan man maglungga o magtago ang mga ito. **(*Larawan at teksto ni CH*)**

Natuklasan sa dalang sako ng suspek ang isang caliber .22 revolver na walang serial number at dalawang (2) live ammunition.

NASA mahigit labing-apat na libong guro ang nakikitang karagdagan ng Department of Education.

Tila suntok sa buwan lamang lalo at mangangailangan ang kagawaran ng tinatayang P4.29 billion.

Sinasabing walang inilaan na pondo para rito sa 2027 National Expenditure Program. Nakapaloob sa panukalang 2027 budget ang nasa P976 bilyong pondo para sa kagawaran. Gayunman ay humihingi pa ang DepEd ng karagdagang P145.19 bilyon na nakatuon sa mga programang hindi nabigyan ng sapat na pondo sa NEP.

Gumugulong sa Kongreso ang pagtalakay sa 2027 national budget kaya naroroon ang posibilidad na mabago ang alokasyon para sa recruitment ng mga bagong guro.

Pangarap mula sa usok ng Tinapa

Sa barangay ng Nanguma sa Mabitac, Laguna, isang babae ang abala sa pagpepreserba ng mga isda bilang produkto upang kalaunan ay maibenta niya sa kanilang bayan.

Si Sheryl Jamillo, ngayo'y 46 taong gulang, ay dating full-time housewife na nag-aalaga sa kanyang siyam na anak. Para sa kanya, hindi biro ang magpalaki ng anak at mag-asikaso sa buong pamilya. Ngunit mas naging mahirap ito dahil sa kita ng kanyang asawa lamang sila umaasa.

Bilang bunga ng ganitong sitwasyon, naglakas-loob si Sheryl na maghanap ng mapagkakakitaan habang inaalagaan ang kanyang pamilya. Ngunit dahil unang taon lamang ng hayskul ang kanyang natapos, hindi naging madali para sa kaniya ang makahanap ng trabahong may pagkakataon din na maalagaan ang kanyang mga anak. Kaya naman sa kaniyang buong kakayahan, sinubukan niyang magnegosyo. Nagsimula siyang bumili ng wholesale na tinapa upang ipagbenta sa kanilang bayan.

Noong 2016, nakilala ni Sheryl ang CARD, Inc. (A Microfinance NGO) matapos maimbitahan ng isang kaibigan at kalaunan ay naging kliyente nito. Sa pamamagitan ng mga serbisyong pampinansiyal na maaari niyang ma-avail bilang kliyente, nabago rin ang pananaw ni Sheryl tungkol sa negosyo.

Sa halip na maging reseller ng mga tinapa, napagdesisyonan ni Sheryl na aralin kung paano ito mismo gawin. Gamit ang kaniyang unang loan sa CARD, Inc., pinasimulan niya ang paggawa ng sarili niyang tinapa.

Hinarap niya ang pagod mula sa paghahanap ng magagandang isda at sa paglilinis ng mga ito. Matiyaga niyang inaral ang pagtitimpla at pagpapausok sa mga isda hanggang sa makagawa na siya ng sarili niyang mga tinapa.

Dahil si Sheryl na mismo ang nagtitimpla ng mga tinapang kaniyang ibinebenta, nagkaroon siya ng pagkakataong pasarapin pa lalo ang lasa nito. Sa kaniyang paggawa, nasisiiguro niyang perpekto ang pagkakaitimpla ng mga tinapa.

Bukod sa pagpapasarap ng lasa, pinagbuti rin ni Sheryl ang hitsura ng mga ito. Sinisiiguro niyang ginintuan mula sa pagkakausok ang hitsura ng bawat tinapa at iniingatang hindi ito masira upang magmukha itong kagana-gana. "Kasi kung masarap nga siya, eh kung mukha namang madungis, hindi rin siya kaagad bibilhin," sabi niya. Para kay Sheryl, kung gaano kasarap ang produkto, dapat ganoon din kaganda ang hitsura nito.

Dahil dito, lalo nang nakilala ng mga kustomer ang kaniyang sariling gawang tinapa at muling bumabalik sa kaniya upang bumili pa ng mas marami.

Sa loob ng halos sampung taon bilang kliyente ng CARD, Inc., nasubukan na ni Sheryl ang iba't ibang loan services nito. Kabilang dito ang educational loan para sa pag-aaral at enrollment ng kanyang mga anak, lalo na para sa kanyang ikaapat na anak na ngayon ay papasok na sa kolehiyo. Nakapag-avail na rin siya ng housing loan na ginamit niya sa pagpapatayo ng kanilang bahay sa Brgy. Nanguma.

Dumarating din ang mga

pagsubok sa kanyang negosyo, lalo na kapag matumal ang benta at tumataas ang presyo ng isda. Ngunit naitatawid ito ni Sheryl sa tulong ng mga business loan niya na naging daan upang makabawi siya sa kanyang paggawa at pagtitinda ng tinapa. Malaki rin ang tulong ng kanyang pag-iipon sa nasabing microfinance na institusyon, pagkat dito niya natitiyak na mayroon siyang mawi-withdraw sa panahon ng kagipitan.

Sa ngayon, patuloy pa rin siyang binibilhan ng tinapa ng kaniyang mga kustomer. Ang iba sa kanilang may tindahan ay kumukuha ng wholesale sa kaniya. Isa naman sa kaniyang mga loyal na kustomer ay bumibili rin sa kaniya nang

wholesale upang i-resell ang mga tinapa sa ibang bansa.

Sa lahat ng ito, ang payo ni Sheryl ay simple lamang: "Tiyaga lang. Tapos kapag mahirap ang panahon ng negosyo, e di konting tipid." Nais ni Sheryl na patuloy pang palaguin ang kanyang pagtitinapa upang balang araw ay maipamana niya ito sa kanyang mga anak.

Katulad ng usok sa kaniyang tinapa na nangingibabaw pataas, nagsimula lang si Sheryl kumita para sa pamilya. Ngunit higit pa sa pagtatawid sa pang-araw-araw na pangangailangan, lalo pa siyang nagsumikap, pinagtagumpayan ang mga hamon sa negosyo, at natutong mangarap. **(Jireh Pearl Casionan, Junior Writer)**

NACC, RACCO IV-A Cite Five Child-Caring Agencies Advancing Quality Care for Children in CALABARZON

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, CAVITE — Five child-caring and social welfare agencies in CALABARZON were recognized by the National Authority for Child Care (NACC) for their implementation of adoption and alternative child care programs and services during the Third Quarter Child-Caring Agency (CCA) Meeting convened by the Regional Alternative Child Care Office IV-A (RACCO IV-A) held on September 2, 2026, in General Trias City, Cavite.

Receiving the NACC Certificate of Recognition (COR) for Adoption and Alternative Child Care Programs and Services were Samaritans Place, Timothy Project International Mission Inc., Agape Impact Ministries, Cribs Foundation Inc., and Casa Dei.

The recognition marks the agencies' compliance with prescribed standards for the delivery of adoption and alternative child care services and highlights their role as partners of the government in protecting children and supporting appropriate family-based care.

For children who cannot remain safely with their biological families, the quality of care they receive while under alternative care can shape their safety, development and prospects for a permanent family environment. This makes the standards governing child-caring agencies more than an administrative requirement.

Through its certification and monitoring mechanisms, NACC evaluates whether partner agencies have the systems, personnel and practices necessary to deliver services consistent with the best interests of the child.

The certification process is anchored on the NACC Certification Assessment Tool and the implementing rules and regulations of Republic Act No. 11642, or the Domestic Administrative Adoption and Alternative Child Care Act, together with applicable NACC policies and standards.

Assessment and monitoring examine the agencies' program management, case management, service delivery and helping strategies and interventions. These areas help determine whether agencies are equipped to provide appropriate care and manage cases responsibly while children are in alternative care.

The five recognized agencies now join NACC's network of partners working to strengthen the country's adoption and alternative

child care system and support pathways toward safe and permanent family-based care.

The awarding took place during RACCO IV-A's Third Quarter CCA Meeting at Mama's Hope Foundation in General Trias City, where participating child-caring agencies and social welfare partners also came together to discuss matters affecting the delivery of adoption and alternative child care services in CALABARZON.

PGC's medical and dental mission goes to Indang

On September 3, 2026, residents of Brgy. Alulod in Indang benefited from a Medical and Dental Mission that brought much-needed healthcare services directly to the community.

A total of 500 patients were assisted during the activity with healthcare services which included medical and dental consultations, Fasting Blood Sugar (FBS) tests and ECG procedures, giving residents access to basic health screening and assessment.

From Thread to Future: How DOST's RYPIC Keeps an Ilocano Weaver's Dream Alive

In every swift movement of a local weaver's hands lies a quiet labor of love, enriching a cherished tradition, art, and culture of weaving that often goes unnoticed in the rush of the modern world. Yet beneath every neatly lined thread rests a real story of hard work, persistence, and quiet success waiting to be told.

The Ilocos Region is home to over 1,000 weavers—individuals, family businesses, and community groups who have dedicated their lives to keeping the traditions of their ancestors alive. For years, however, weaving communities across the region faced a major problem: expensive costs and an unreliable supply of good quality thread.

To many, panag-abel—the traditional Ilocano way of handloom weaving—might look like an old art best seen in museum displays, cultural trade fairs, or special celebrations. But for Carolyn Sabado, a weaver from the Dream Weavers of Lower Surong in Vintar, Ilocos Norte, the threads she handles are far more than just items on display.

They are the base of her everyday life and hope for her community's future.

Even as a young girl, Carolyn had a genuine love for crafting. Her mind was naturally filled with bright colors, detailed inabel patterns, and creative textile designs. But creative ideas alone, without raw materials and proper support, often stay as just dreams.

This is where the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), together with the DOST-Philippine Textile Research Institute (DOST-PTRI) and DOST Ilocos Region, came in to help. By giving specialized technical training and modern weaving equipment like Thera Looms, DOST helped Carolyn and her fellow manghahabi (weavers) turn their craft into a steady and growing business.

To solve the lack of thread and high production costs for the long term, DOST built the region's first Regional Yarn Production and Innovation Center (RYPIC) right in Vintar, Ilocos Norte. This facility directly solves the thread

shortage by processing local, natural plant fibers—such as abaca, bamboo, banana, pineapple, and cotton—into high-quality thread.

For Carolyn, this support did more than just boost her family's daily earnings. Handweaving also served as a peaceful activity that helped her physical health, supported her family, and helped protect the inabel tradition.

"Habang napagpapatuloy ang pag-aabel, naroon dapat 'yung determinasyon na dapat ay malayo ang marating ng inabel mo, hindi lang sa loob ng komunidad... at umaasa kami na marami pa kaming mabebenta," (As long as we keep panag-abel alive, we must hold onto the determination to bring our inabel far beyond our community... and we hope to sell much more,) Carolyn shared.

• With RYPIC Vintar now open, local weavers no longer need to worry about running out of materials or buying expensive imported threads. Instead, the thread moving through their looms comes straight from the farms of local Filipino farmers.

On August 7, 2026, President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. saw firsthand how science, technology, and new ideas at RYPIC Vintar are bringing new life to the local textile industry. Led by DOST Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr., alongside Regional Director Teresita A. Tabaog and DOST Ilocos Region officers, the team introduced Carolyn and her fellow weavers to the President. During their short talk, the weavers shared how DOST's support changed their lives and shaped the future of weaving in the region.

Keeping our culture alive in modern times requires everyone's support. With every thread guided by the hands of local weavers, DOST shows that when science and communities work together, the fine threads of our past stay strong, bright, and meaningful for generations to come. (*DOST Ilocos Region*)

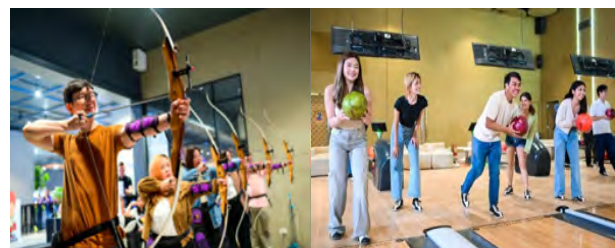

SSS LoanLite is a digital microloan facility designed to provide qualified members with accessible, secure, and affordable short-term financial assistance for immediate needs. It is part of SSS' continuing efforts to promote financial inclusion, strengthen member services, and provide members a safer alternative to informal and potentially predatory lending arrangements. **First SSS loan facility for employed members with fully digital application**

SSS LoanLite is the first SSS loan facility for employed members that allows qualified private-sector employees to apply through a PFI's mobile application without the employer certification normally required for conventional SSS loans. The application and related transactions are facilitated through the UD mobile application, eliminating the need for members to secure and submit the usual employer certification for conventional SSS short-term loans. Qualified members may apply for loans ranging from ₱1,000 to ₱20,000, depending on the average of their 12 latest Monthly Salary Credits. Available repayment periods are 15, 30, 60, or 90 days, with an interest rate of 8% per annum, equivalent to approximately 0.67% per month. The fully digital process is designed to make loan application more convenient and may allow eligible applications to be processed and approved within minutes, subject to the applicable SSS and PFI requirements, verification procedures, and system processing. **Eligibility and other requirements** To qualify for SSS LoanLite, members must meet the eligibility requirements under SSS Circular No.

2026-005, including the applicable age, with at least 36 total contributions, including at least six posted monthly contributions within the 12-month period immediately preceding the loan application, having no past-due Short-Term Member Loans or active SSS Micro Loan, maintaining an account with the PFI enrolled in its online facility, and meeting the other requirements on existing loans, benefit claims, and SSS account status. All eligibility requirements under SSS Circular No. 2026-005 shall apply. Members are encouraged to review the Circular for the complete eligibility requirements, loan terms, conditions, and other program details. The Circular is available on the official SSS website. Repayments will be collected according to the agreed schedule through an automatic debit arrangement, which will serve as the default collection mode. Deductions will mainly be made from the account where the loan proceeds were credited. Members are encouraged to repay on time to maintain good standing and remain eligible for future SSS LoanLite availment, subject to applicable requirements. **Safer alternative to informal lending** De Claro said SSS LoanLite is intended to help address members' short-term financing needs while encouraging them to use formal financial services. "SSS LoanLite is part of our broader effort to expand access to formal financial services and protect our members from predatory lending. Through our partnership with UD, we are supporting faster, safer, and more convenient access to credit for qualified members," de Claro said. SSS reminded members to use only the official UD mobile application when applying for SSS LoanLite and not to transact with individuals or third parties offering to process their loan applications. Members are advised to carefully review the loan disclosure statement before accepting the loan, including the applicable interest, fees, repayment schedule, and other terms and conditions. SSS will continue to work with its other PFIs to make SSS LoanLite available through their respective digital platforms, providing more qualified members with convenient access to formal short-term credit. #

PMNFT U23 Sasabak na sa Asian Games

Ang Pambansang Koponan ng Pilipinas sa Men's Football sa ilalim ng Under-23 (PMNFT U23) ay puspasang naghahanda sa kanilang pagbabalik sa Asian Games sa unang pagkakataon mula noong 1974, nang huling sumabak ang bansa sa ikapitong edisyon ng quadrennial sports meet na ginanap sa Tehran, Iran.

Dahil sa makasaysayang prestihiyo ng Asiad at lakas ng mga makakalaban, nagpatawag ang PMNFT U23 ng 29 na manlalaro sa national team pool habang sila ay naghahanda at nagsasanay sa Adidas Football Park sa Pasay City at sa Rizal Memorial Stadium (RMS) sa Maynila.

Bilang bahagi ng kanilang paghahanda nagkaroon ang PMNFT U23 ng isang friendly match laban sa koponan ng Philippines Football League (PFL) na Stallion Laguna isang propesyonal na klab na pinangunahan ng Golden Boot runner-up noong nakaraang season na si Finn McDaniel kung saan nagwagi ang U23 squad sa iskor na 2-0. Ang mga forward na sina Janjan Jalique at Aidan Astilla-Boronda ang nagpasok ng mga panalong layunin para sa pambansang koponan.

Binigyang-diin ni PFF President John Anthony Gutierrez na naging masusi ang mga paghahanda ng Pederasyon para sa kampanyang ito.

Para patatagin ang kahandaan ng PMNFT U23, inilipat ng University Athletic Association of the Philippines (UAAP) sa Oktubre ang pagbubukas ng Season 89 men's football tournament upang matiyak na available ang mga manlalaro at coach ng UAAP para sa Asiad. Kabilang sa mga manlalaro ng UAAP sa national pool sina Fonsi Gonzalez, Joshua Meriño, at Jian Carai ng University of the Philippines (UP); sina Dov Cariño at Mateo Lacson ng Ateneo; at sina Iñigo Castro at Joaquin Collo ng La Salle. Samantala, ang head coach ng UP na si Popoy Clarino ang tumatayang lead assistant coach para sa pambansang koponan.

isang assist.

Tumipa si Tominaga ng 10 sa 18 mula sa field, 8 sa 10 sa twos, para sa kanyang 34 puntos kasama ang anim na rebounds at isang assist para sa Hokkaido.

Nagdagdag si Dwight Ramos ng 17 puntos, tatlong rebounds, apat na assists, at isang steal.

"Pineserbisyuhan ng PFF ang pagpapasalamat sa UAAP sa pag-align ng kanilang iskedyul bilang suporta sa Philippine under-23 Men's National Football Team sa ika-20 Asian Games sa Nagoya, na nagbibigay-daan sa mga nangungunang manlalaro sa kolehiyo na lumahok. Nagpapasalamat kami kay UAAP President Mark Molina, Executive Director Rebo Saguisag at UAAP Board of Trustees, Football Commissioner Rely San Agustin, at sa host ng Season 89 na Far Eastern University para sa kanilang patuloy na suporta," ani Gutierrez.

Malugod na tinanggap ni PMNFT U23 head coach Garrath McPherson ang draw ng grupo, na sinabi niyang nagbibigay ng balanse sa pagitan ng pamilyar at sariwang mga pagsubok para sa kanyang mga manlalaro.

"Matapos ang napakatagal na kawalan sa kumpetisyon, nagpapasalamat kaming makasali sa isang napakaprestihiyosong torneo at handa kaming i-showcase ang aming kalidad sa alinmang grupo," ani McPherson.

"Nagbigay sa amin ang draw ng halo-halo ng pamilyar at hindi pamilyar na kalaban na ikinagagalak ko. Ipinakita namin ang antas ng aming paglalaro sa huling dalawang laban namin kontra Vietnam, kaya mayroon kaming magandang pagkaunawa sa isa't isa. Ang dalawa pang kalaban, ang Uzbekistan at Kuwait, ay nagbibigay ng pagkakataon na makaranas ng mga bagong pagsubok. Ang karanasang ito ay makatutulong sa pag-unlad ng ating mga manlalaro."

Inilatag din niya ang kanyang inaasahan sa mga manlalaro sa huling yugto ng paghahanda para sa torneo.

"Ang pokus nila ay dapat nakatuon sa paggawa ng lahat ng posibleng paraan sa kanilang mga klab upang mailagay ang kanilang sarili sa pinakamagandang pisikal at mental na kondisyon para katawanin ang bansa," ani McPherson.

Ang men's football tournament sa Asian Games ay nagtatampok ng mga koponan na Under-23, kung saan pinapayagan ang bawat kuponan na magpasok ng tatlong manlalaro na lampas sa age limit. Nakalagay ang Pilipinas sa Group C kasama ang nagtatanggol na bronze medalist na Uzbekistan, dating quarterfinalist na Kuwait, at ang pamilyar na kalaban na Vietnam.

Ito ang unang pagkakataon na makakaharap ng PMNFT ang Uzbekistan at Kuwait sa head-to-head na kasaysayan, habang ang Vietnam naman ay kilalang kalaban na matinding nakasagupa ng Pilipinas sa semifinals ng parehong U23 ASEAN Championship – Mandiri Cup at Southeast Asian Games noong nakaraang taon.

Bubuksan ng PMNFT U23 ang kanilang kampanya laban sa Uzbekistan sa Setyembre 15 (2:30 PM), bago kalabanin ang Vietnam sa Setyembre 18 (2:30 PM) at ang Kuwait sa Setyembre 22 (1 PM). Lahat ng mga laban ay gaganapin sa CS Asset Minato Soccer Stadium sa Nagoya, Japan, kung saan ang mga nakasaad na oras ng pagsisimula ay nakasaad sa Philippine Standard Time.
