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SHURE SUMMIT 2026, "FROM MEETING ROOMS TO CENTER STAGE"

Ang Shure ay ipinamamahagi ng Audiophile simula pa noong 1987 ay crustaceans.. ayon kay Tia de Guzman ng Audiophile Components, Inc., pinagdurugtong nila ang Pilipinas sa pamamagitan ng komunikasyon at tunog simula noong 1981. Noong 1981, nagbebenta sila ng mga produktong Hapon. Pinagsisilbihan ng Audiophile ang bawat uri ng tunog sa pamamagitan ng apat na channels. Kada tatlong buwan (quarter), nagsasagawa sila ng mga simulation sa disenyo, mga pagsasanay, at nagbibigay ng suportang teknikal. Ipinaliwanag ni Gerald Lee, Associate Manager ng Market Development, kung paano nila pinaunlad ang kanilang mga produkto. Aniya, ang Shure ay hindi lamang kumpanya ng audio kundi gumagamit din ng teknolohiyang AI at ito ay madaling gamitin (user-friendly). "Maaari kang magkaroon ng solusyon sa audio na all-in-one," wika ni Lee. "Maaari mo itong subaybayan mula sa iisang platform ng audio," dagdag niya. Mayroon ang Shure ng MXA920 ceiling array, at ngayon ay mayroon na ring MXA320 na may mga bagong katangian tulad ng saklaw para sa buong silid (room level coverage) dahil ang MXA320 ay mayroon na ngayong Designer 6 na may ganitong kakayahan. Gayunpaman, ang MXA310 ay sampung taon na sa merkado. "Mayroon din kaming MXA920. Salamat sa inyo. Isa ito sa mga pinakasikat naming produkto," ani Lee. "Mayroon na kaming may kakayahang umangkop na saklaw gamit ang MXA901, na may kasamang madaling i-adjust na saklaw," dagdag pa niya. Inanunsyo ni Lee na mayroon na silang MXA925 na may mga bagong katangian tulad ng naka-built-in na AI-enabled IntelliMix, kung saan napansin ang pagangat mula sa MXA920

patungong MXA925 dahil sa mas marami nitong kakayahan. Ang AI Denoiser ay ang sistema kung saan binabantayan ng boses ng tao ang ingay. "Ang AI Deverb na nakabuod sa MXA925 ay nag-aalis ng ingay sa silid (acoustic room noise) na para bang magkaibang-magkaiba ang araw at gabi," ayon kay Lee. "Hangga't walang echo na umaabot sa 200 hanggang 300 milliseconds o mayroon namang AI Acoustic Echo Cancellation, walang magiging problema," dagdag niya. Iniharap din ni Lee ang MXW Next Fusion Mode kung saan pinapayagan nito ang lahat ng panig na masiyahan sa tunog at hindi na nangangailangan ng karagdagang mikropono para sa mga kalahok o sa mga tao. "Inilunsad noong nakaraang taon ang IntelliMix Room Kits at ngayon ay sertipikado na ito para sa Zoom," sabi ni Lee. Ang Automatic Pairing Protocol ay nangangahulugang i-install ang mga aparato, ikonekta ang mga ito, at i-on ang mga ito. "Likas sa atin ang makaramdam ng pagod sa pagpupulong (meeting fatigue). Ngunit hindi iyon ang gusto namin," ani Lee. Inirekumenda ni Lee ang pagpapalaki o Scale gamit ang IntelliMix Foundation System na maaaring gamitin sa mga silid para sa hybrid na pagsasanay. Ang IntelliMix Bar Pro Kit ay ang kagamitang AV (Audio Visual) ng Shure

Hayun nga at opisyal na ibinaba ng Senado ang bilang ng botong kinakailangan para sa paghatol matapos makakuha ng 13 votes na pabor, isa ang tumutol at anim ang hindi nakilahok sa botohan.

Kaya mula sa dating 16 sa kabuuang 24 miyembro ng senado ay ibaba sa 14 o 2/3 sa kabuuang aktibong 20 miyembro.

Tama ba ito at paano kung mali lalo at mapapatunayang sadyang may paglabag ay ano ang mangyayari sa trese?

Sa bilis ng takbo ng panahon ngayon, mas hinahanap ng tao ang mga pagkaing praktikal at madaling iluto katulad ng mga frozen food. Bukod sa nakababawas ito sa oras at gastos sa pagluluto, hindi rin ito madaling mapanis, kaya naman naitatabi pa ito nang mahabang panahon. Taong 2000 noong pinasok ni Sahlee Quizon, mula sa Sta. Cruz, Laguna, ang paggawa ng mga frozen food. Ang pinakauna niyang produkto ay boneless na bangus. Kilala ang isdang bangus sa pagiging matinik, at ang tinik na ito ang muntik nang kumuha sa buhay ni Sahlee noong minsan siyang nabilaukan. Naroon man ang takot, dito niya rin nakuha ang inspirasyon na gumawa ng boneless bangus.

Sampung taon nang nagtatrabaho si Sahlee sa iba't ibang kumpanya, ngunit napatunayan niya na iba pa rin ang saya kapag may sarili kang negosyo at hawak mo ang sarili mong oras.

"Pagdating kasi sa negosyo, umaga pa lang mayroon ka nang pera; kumbaga, hindi mo na kailangang hintayin ang kinsenas at katapusan, basta masipag ka, araw-araw kang kikita."

Upang mas marami pang mamimili ang makakilala sa kaniyang mga produkto, ginamit niya ang social media upang mag-post online. Dahil sa internet, bukod sa mga kustomer ay nakakuha rin siya ng mga reseller.

Sa ngayon, mayroon siyang apat na reseller na katuwang niya sa pagbebenta. Sa paglipas ng panahon, hindi na lamang boneless na bangus ang kaniyang

ibinebenta; sinimulan na rin niyang gumawa ng mga gawang-bahay na tocino, longganisa, shanghai, embutido, chicken inasal, barbecue, at siomai.

Habang lumalago ang kaniyang negosyo, hindi rin maiiwasan na magkaroon siya ng mga kakumpetensya. Ganoon pa man, hindi natinag si Sahlee dahil naniniwala siya na sa huli, kalidad pa rin ng produkto ang hahanapin ng mga tao.

Araw-araw ay umaabot sa 60 kilong karne at 20 kilong bangus ang ginagawa niya. Bugbog man ang katawan sa trabaho, pinipili pa rin niyang gawin ito nang mag-isa dahil ayaw niyang may mabago sa kalidad at lasa ng kaniyang produkto. Para kay Sahlee, ang sikreto ng isang matagumpay na negosyo ay kombinasyon ng sipag

at tiyaga.

"Sa simula, may mga pagkakataon na hindi lahat ng produkto ay maibebenta sa isang araw, pero darating yung panahon na babalik-balikan ito ng customers mo," saad niya. Pinansyal na suporta mula sa bangko

Taong 2013, naging kliyente siya ng CARD MRI Rizal Bank Inc. (CARD RBI), isang microfinance-oriented rural bank sa ilalim ng CARD MRI. Sa loob ng halos 13 taon, ang CARD RBI ang naging katuwang niya sa pagtataguyod ng kaniyang pamilya at kabuhatan. Sa tulong din ng bangko, nakahiram siya ng pera para sa edukasyon ng kaniyang mga anak, nakapagpagawa ng bahay, at nagkaroon ng karagdagang kapital para sa kaniyang negosyo noong 2020.

Sa kasalukuyan ay mayroon siyang hiniram na PHP 95,000.00 na ginagamit niya bilang pandagdag na kapital sa kaniyang negosyo.

Sa pamamagitan ng kaniyang negosyo, naitaguyod niya ang pag-aaral ng kaniyang limang anak; tatlo sa kanila ay ganap nang mga propesyonal, habang ang dalawang pinakabata naman ay kasalukuyang nasa kolehiyo.

Hanggang ngayon, ginagamit pa rin niya ang internet upang i-post ang kaniyang mga produkto online bilang bahagi ng kaniyang marketing strategy. Umaasa at determinado si Sahlee na sa mga susunod na taon ay mas mapalalago pa niya ang kaniyang negosyo.

Kinatawan ng media bilang saksi

NAGKAROON ng paglagda kamakailan sa pagitan ng Presidential Task Force on Media Security (PTFOMS) at Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) ng Memorandum of Agreement para sa pagpapalakas ng kaligtasan at seguridad ng mga personalidad sa media na nagsisilbing mga saksi sa mga kasong may kaugnayan sa droga.

Tiniyak sa media ni PDEA Director General Undersecretary Isagani R. Nerez ang dedikasyon ng kanilang ahensiya sa tapat at tuluy-tuloy na pagpapatupad ng kasunduan, habang binibigyang-diin ang kalayaan ng pamamahayag, pananagutan sa publiko, at kaligtasan ng lahat ng manggagawa sa media.

"Pinagtitibay namin ang isang ugnayang kumikilala sa isang pangunahing katotohanan: ang pagprotekta sa mga mamamahayag at manggagawa sa media ay isang sama-samang responsibilidad," ito naman ang pahayag ni Undersecretary Jose A. Torres Jr., ang Executive Director ng PTFOMS.

Hindi tulad ng mga ordinaryong saksi, ang mga insulating witnesses ay gumaganap ng isang partikular na papel sa pamamagitan ng pagmamasiid at pagpapatotoo sa ilang mga pamamaraan ng pagpapatupad ng batas sa mga operasyon na may

kaugnayan sa droga.

Pagtitiyak ng naturang kasunduan na ang mga manggagawa sa media sa kapasidad na ito ay makakatanggap ng naaangkop na proteksyon at suporta.

Sa pamamagitan ng MOA ay magpapatupad ang PTFOMS at PDEA ng mga hakbang upang protektahan ang mga manggagawa sa media na nagsisilbing 'insulating witnesses' alinsunod sa Seksyon 21 ng R.A. Blg. 9165, at tiyakin ang kanilang kaligtasan laban sa posibleng paghihiganti ng mga akusadong sangkot sa droga. Maganda ang kasunduan subalit paano naman kung ang media representative na nagsilbing testigo ay hindi na nakikita at wala na ring pagdalo sa hukuman para sa pagdinig ng kaso?

Halimbawang ang media representative na ito ay nasa dalawampung beses nagsilbing testigo kaya 20 criminal case number din ang dapat na pagpunta niya sa korte para sa hearing.

Dahil hindi na nga siya natatagpuan kaya ang naaapektuhan at naabala ay ang media outfit na kanyang dating pinagsilbihan.

Ang media outfit na iyon ang napapadalhan ng mga subpoena ng korte para sa bawat case number.

Sana ay mabigyang pansin at matalakay ng PTFOMS ang tungkol naman dito.

SSS pays tribute to pensioners with annual Pensioners' Day

QUEZON CITY, The Social Security System (SSS) honored nearly 4,000 pensioners at its annual Pensioners' Day celebration on 11 September 2026, held in 19 selected venues nationwide as part of the pension fund's 69th anniversary.

SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Robert Joseph M. de Claro said the event recognizes pensioners' years of hard work and contributions to the Philippine economy. "We institutionalized this activity as an expression of

gratitude to them for their significant contribution to our society," de Claro said, describing pensioners as pillars of nation-building.

The celebration carried the anniversary theme, "Bawat Isa Protektado, Bawat Bukas Sigurado", which underscores the SSS' commitment to protecting workers, members and pensioners against life's uncertainties while helping secure their families' future. Pensioners urged to avail of Pension Loan Program

De Claro encouraged retiree and surviving spouse pensioners to avail of the Pension Loan Program (PLP) to help meet their immediate financial needs.

The SSS launched the PLP in September 2018 to provide retiree pensioners with access to low-interest loans without requiring ATM cards as collateral. In September 2025, the program was expanded to include surviving spouse pensioners, giving them access to safe and affordable credit.

"The SSS pension loan is a secured cash loan with a transparent interest rate of 10% per year, computed based on a diminishing principal balance," de Claro said.

Qualified retiree pensioners may borrow an amount equivalent to three, six, nine, or 12 times their Aggregate Monthly Pension, subject to a maximum loan amount of ₱300,000. Available repayment terms are six, 12, and 24 months.

"For qualified surviving spouse pensioners, the loan amount is equivalent to 50% of their Aggregate Monthly Pension multiplied by three, six, nine, or 12 months, subject to a maximum of ₱150,000. Available loan terms are six and 12 months," he added.

The Aggregate Monthly Pension consists of the basic monthly pension and the ₱1,000 additional benefit. A dependent's pension is excluded from the computation.

He said the SSS ensures that pensioner-borrowers retain a net take-home

pension of at least 40% of their Aggregate Monthly Pension once monthly loan amortizations begin.

Eligibility and application

Retiree pensioners applying for the loan must be registered on the SSS website with updated contact information and an enrolled disbursement account. They must be 85 years old or younger at the end of the loan term, have no deductions from their monthly pension and have no existing advance pension under the SSS Calamity Loan Package.

They must also have been receiving an active monthly pension for at least one month and must not have been disqualified because of fraud committed against the SSS.

Surviving spouse pensioners must have an SS number and be registered on the SSS website with updated contact information and an enrolled disbursement account. Those who are not SSS members must secure an SS number as a surviving spouse pensioner before registering online.

They must be at least 18 years old when applying and no older than 85 at the end of the loan term. They must have no pension deductions, no existing advance pension under the SSS Calamity Loan Package, and must have been receiving an active monthly pension for at least one month.

Surviving spouse pensioners must also be the sole payee of the death benefit and must not have been disqualified because of fraud committed against the SSS.

De Claro said that PLP applications can be filed either over-the-counter through the E-Centers of any SSS branch/service office, through E-Partners or online using the My.SSS account.

"Pension loan proceeds will be credited to the borrower's existing pensioner disbursement account or to another account enrolled through the Disbursement Account Enrollment Module," he added. #

PSA IV-A Encourages Batangas Civil Registrars to Explore National ID Authentication Services

The Philippine Statistics Authority Regional Statistical Services Office IV-A (PSA RSSO IV-A) encouraged members of the League of Civil Registrars of Batangas Province (LCRBP) to explore the National ID Authentication Services (NIDAS) during their 3rd Quarter Meeting held on September 17, 2026, at NDN Resorts, Brgy. Aya, Talisay, Batangas. Registration Officer III Juliedin B. Nohay provided an overview of NIDAS, including its Tier 1 and Tier 2 services, the authentication process, and the requirements and procedures for institutions interested in becoming NIDAS relying parties.

Ms. Nohay emphasized the potential of NIDAS to strengthen identity verification in civil registry transactions involving the issuance and availing of civil registry documents.

By providing an authorized means of authenticating an individual's identity through the National ID, NIDAS can serve as an added safeguard against identity-related risks, complement existing verification procedures, and support more secure and efficient delivery of civil registry services. Its potential integration into appropriate digital systems may also contribute to the ongoing digital transformation of local government services, particularly by enabling more seamless and reliable identity verification in digital

transactions.

The presentation was followed by an open forum where the civil registrars raised questions and sought clarifications on the implementation and possible applications of NIDAS in their respective offices.

Among the concerns discussed were subscription fees, the duration of the subscription contract, and the proper use and protection of the Digital National ID. The participants expressed interest in learning more about NIDAS, with two Local Civil Registry Offices (LCROs) requesting information materials to facilitate discussions with their respective information technology personnel and explore the possible integration of the service into their systems.
